A communique from the Mark Carney Collective



The Tory fucks have won, Labour are dogshit, UKIP gargoyles lurk in the gutter. Parliament is no longer our priority - our priority is survival. A Tory majority is a declaration of war.

The Tories propose to deepen right to buy and tear down social housing: from Heygate to Broadwater we wake up tomorrow wondering when will they come for our homes? From the NHS to disability allowance, the Tories are dismantling the safety nets that keep us alive. When will they come for our bodies? How long will they starve us in the workplace? Who will they throw on the scrap heap? From the snoopers' charter to the removal of legal aid, the Tories will deepen the violent capacities of the state. How many times will they frisk us on our estates? How many cops will kettle us in our streets? The Tories will expand the prison industrial complex. Who will they take? From Yarl's Wood to Holloway Prison how many of us will be incarcerated? The Tories will abject and attack migrants. How many of our neighbours will they throw overboard?

This is a declaration of war; they don't want us to survive; our survival is their living defeat; our recuperation is their abolition; our recuperation is escalation.

They are the lawmakers. But a law only exists if they can enforce it.

David Cameron's spittle has no magical powers. Between his decrees and the destruction of lives that matter stretches a chain of enforcement which depends on us complying. If democracy means anything it's not putting a cross in a box or waving a placard in a pen, it's intervening in this chain.

Vote against Foxtons and dispossession: Organise eviction resistance, build up to rent strikes. Support the E15 mothers,

Sweets Way, the fight for the Aylesbury. When everybody hurts we can't continue pretending that plate glass has feelings.

Vote against the unaffordability of day-to-day living with do-it-yourself reductions. If it says it's ready to eat, just eat it. Self-pay, no way! Support tube workers. Help them build for a revenue collection strike. Overcome barrier sensors and individualism simultaneously by getting friendly with the backpack of the person in front. Up the RMT!

Vote against the cops, the ultimate brute enforcers, with bricks and bottles. When the walls have ears, do not let your ears have walls: Refuse to collaborate: intervene, film, obstruct and confuse the pigs whenever and wherever you can.

Vote against work: work slower, demand more money, do less. Increase your wages yourself, expropriate from the tills and the stockroom. Find your friends, start your own union, refuse to be told what to do. Steal, Squat and Sabotage your way to gainful employment.

The future on offer offer no way out, but the creation of a culture of resistance offers us a joyous path to emancipation. In the age of austerity that decimates our lives, we can no longer afford passivity. The time to vote for freedom is now: We must generalise the resistance.
