In the lasest rioting and looting at Brixton in London, 20 people have been injured in the worst scenes seen yet. The picture below shows the amazing sight of a policewoman throwing a smokebomb at the unsuspecting shoppers while her workmates make sure that no one can stop her.

future-this miserable vision is something that assorted single issues such as CND and the recrui-



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


WASTE OF MONEY!
