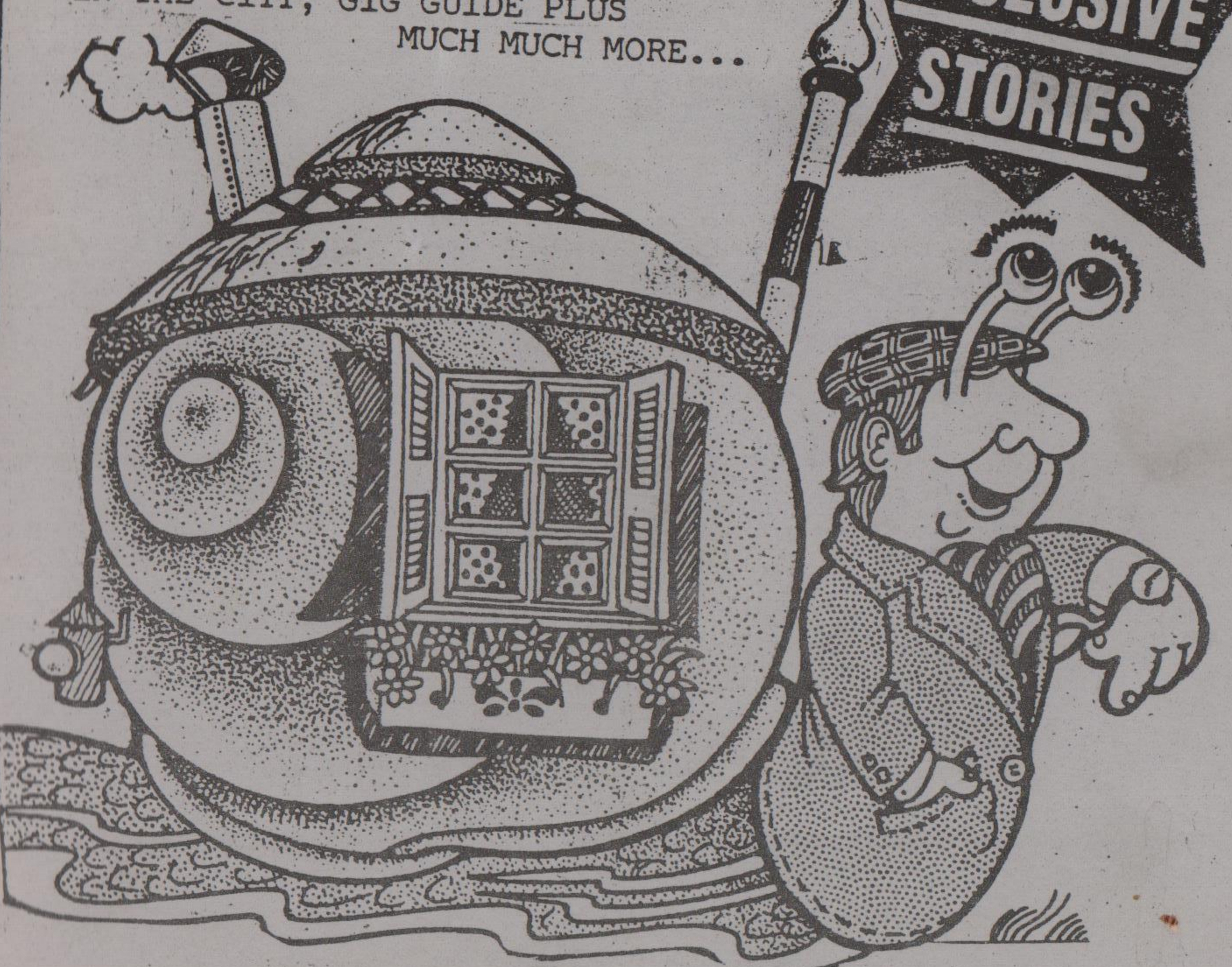

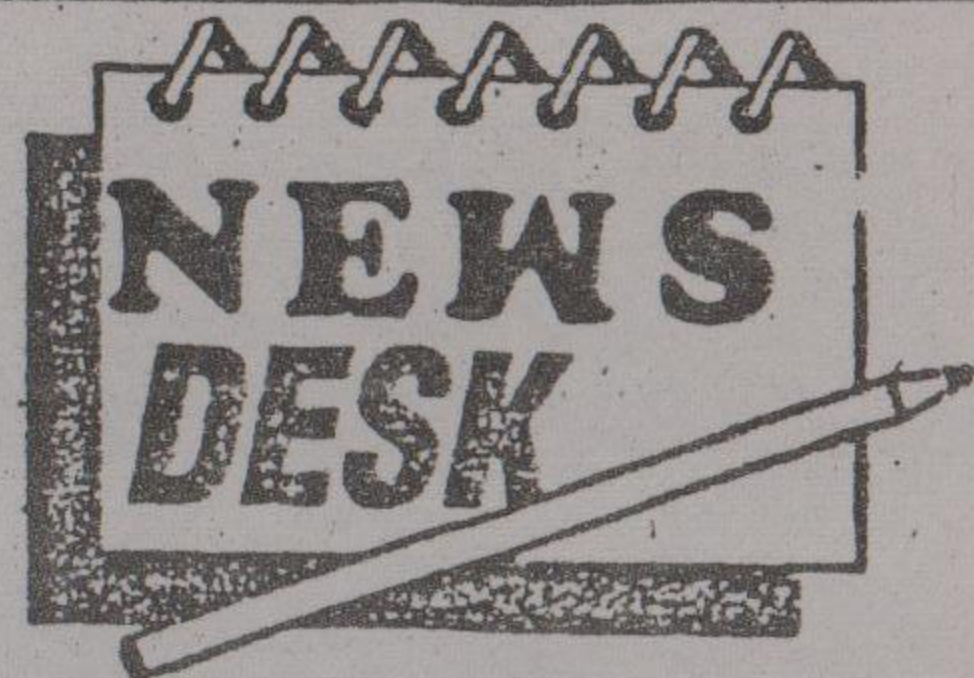

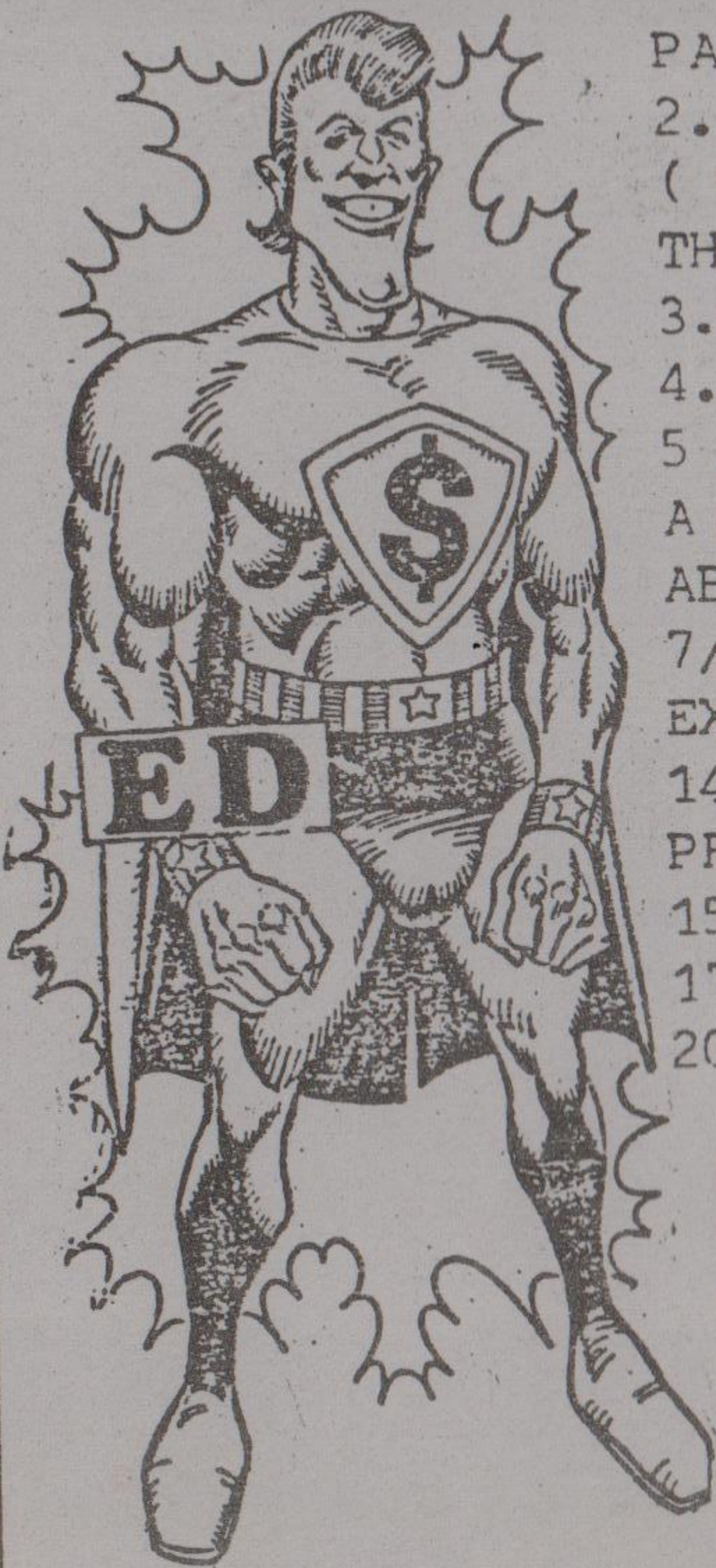

Listen out for 'Kudos' (active radio) which will be on the air in about four weeks time, from 8 till 10 in the evening during week days, which is obviously run from a secret location in Nottingham somewhere. The disc jockeys are Andrew Mayhem and Gary Moore, these are not their real names. Andrew 23, and Gary 20 want to get it off the ground to produce a radio station for people in their age bracket. There will be various sounds on various nights. 'Moore music, more Mayhem' is their phrase. And are looking to introduce a comedy show between the two of them called 'Moore Mayhem'. It will be in mono broadcast. Kudos came when they were walking down the street and they came across a leaflet with the word Kudos written on it, and so took the name from that.

'Astral Gait' a new band where formed early March vocals coming from Steve, bass Dan Lye, Sean on guitar, and kev on drums. They are made from several different groups. Steve came from National Anthem a punk band. Dan, Family of Noise while Sean and Kev were in Blood relatives. Astral Gait play a mixture of 'sci rock', that sounds good.

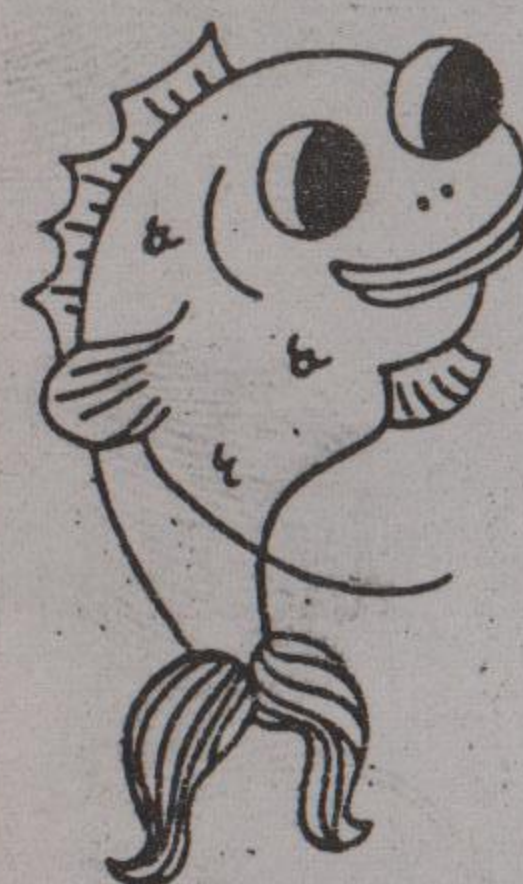

While at a French venue they met some people in the crowd who were also from Nottingham.

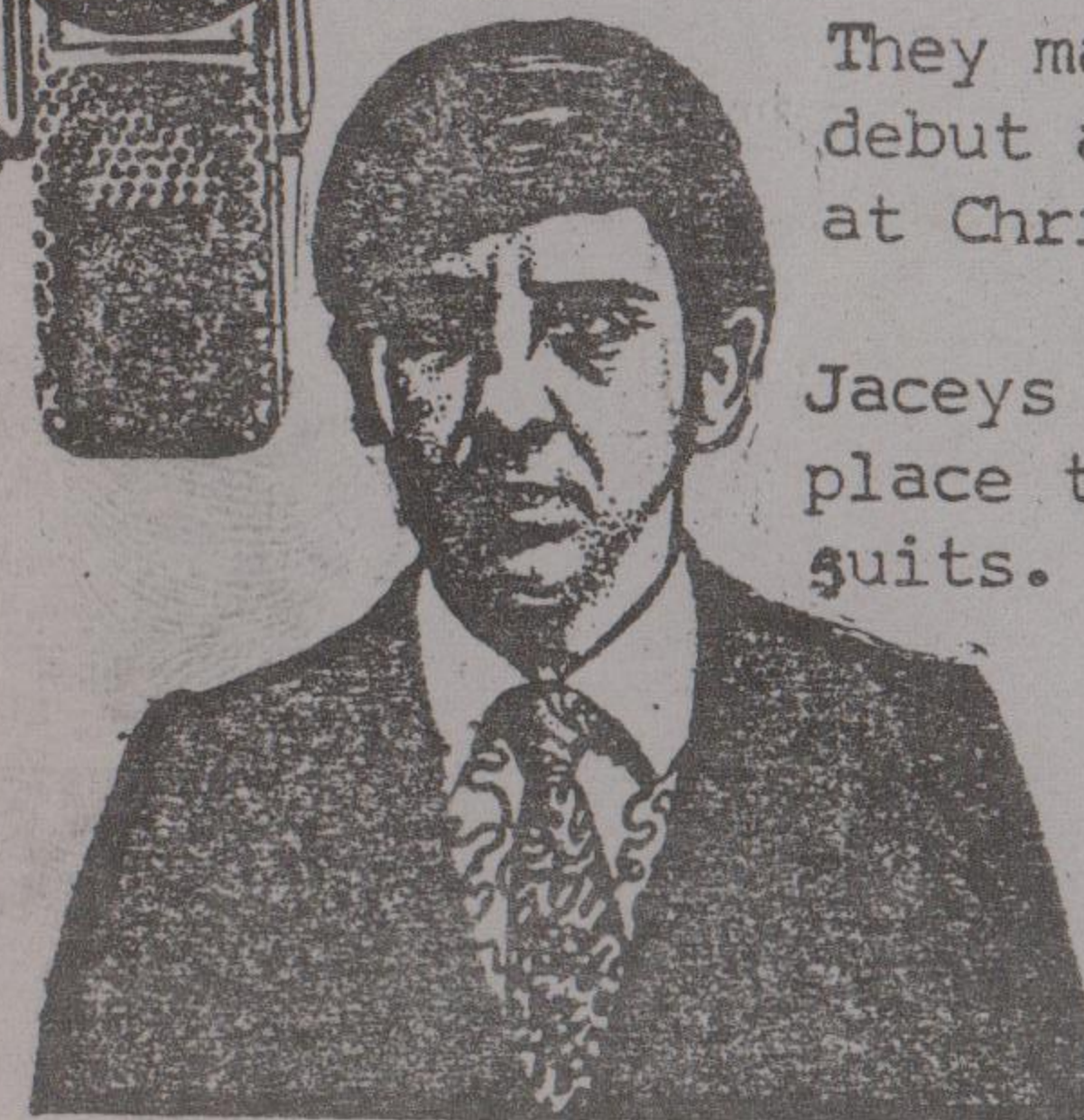
Pete bumped into his former school master, who recognised him by the sarcastic comments passed over the microphone.

Jaceys was the first place they wore their suits.

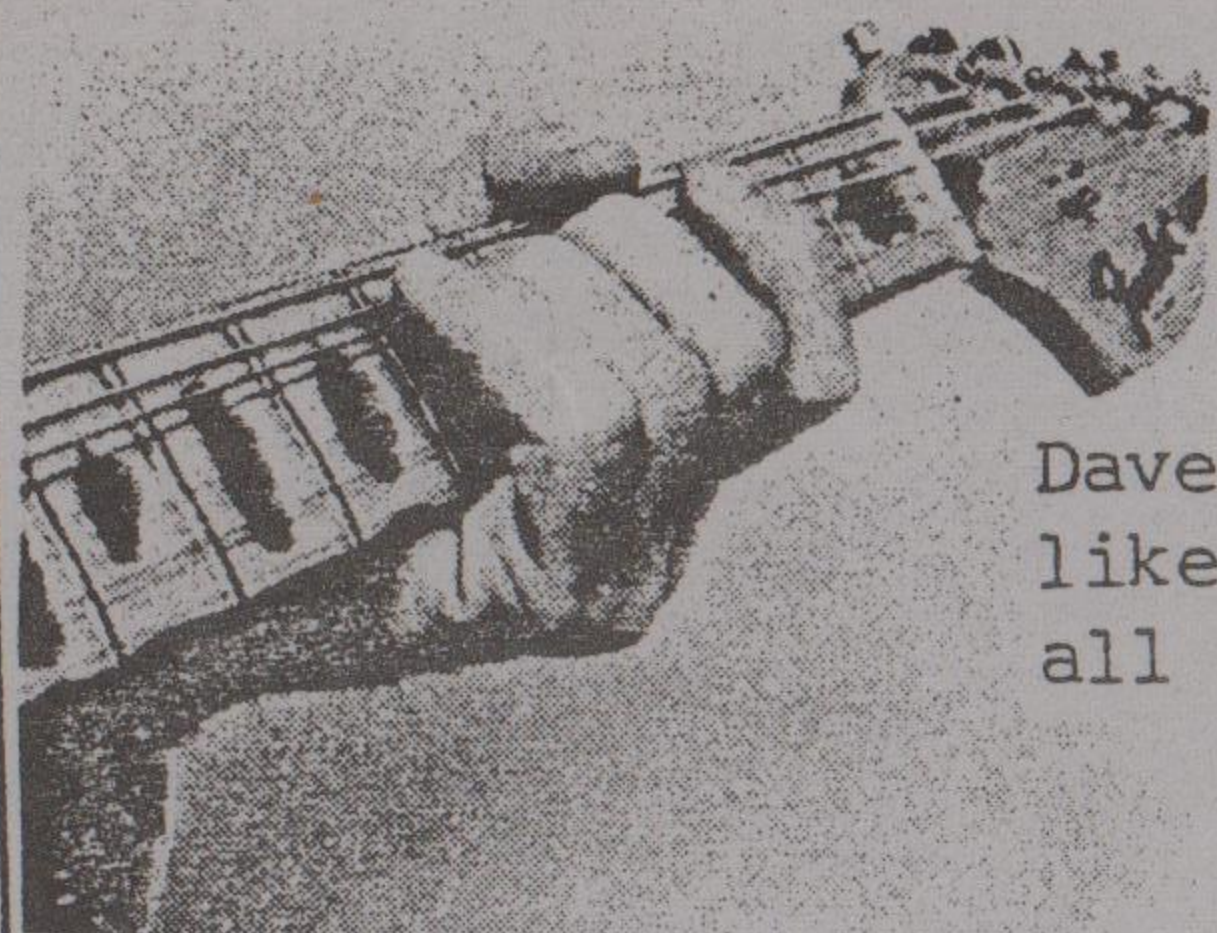

Pete turned down a job as a graphic designer for The Trader, the band have recieved a mention from them as well as The Recorder.





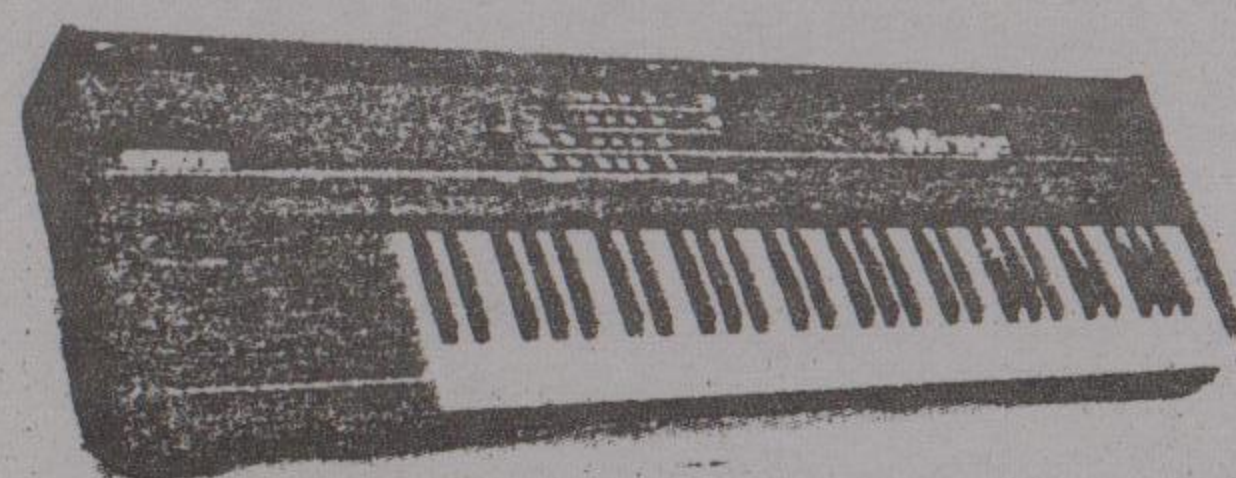
All members of the band can sing except the drummer Mark Makings.

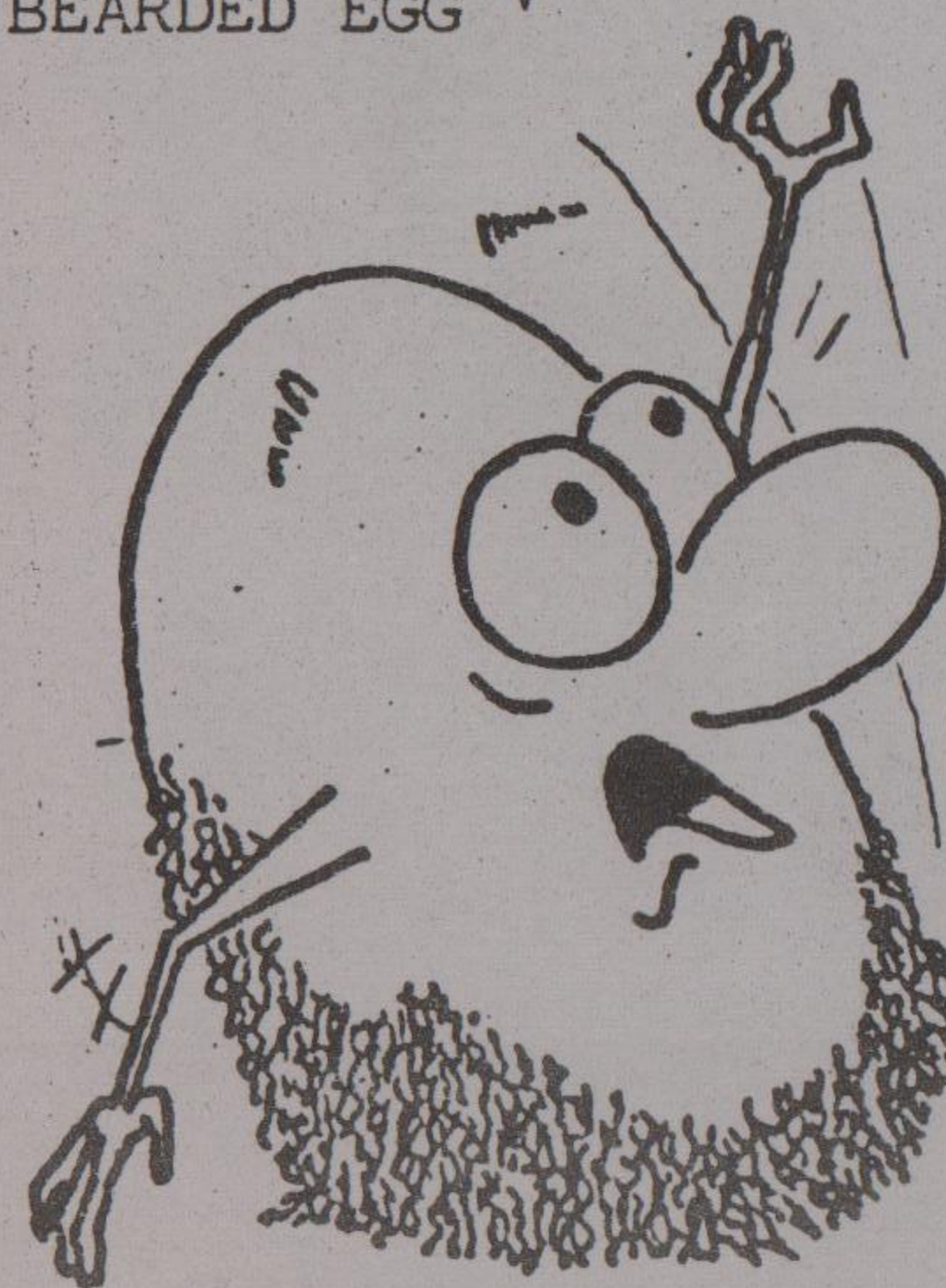
Hairy
