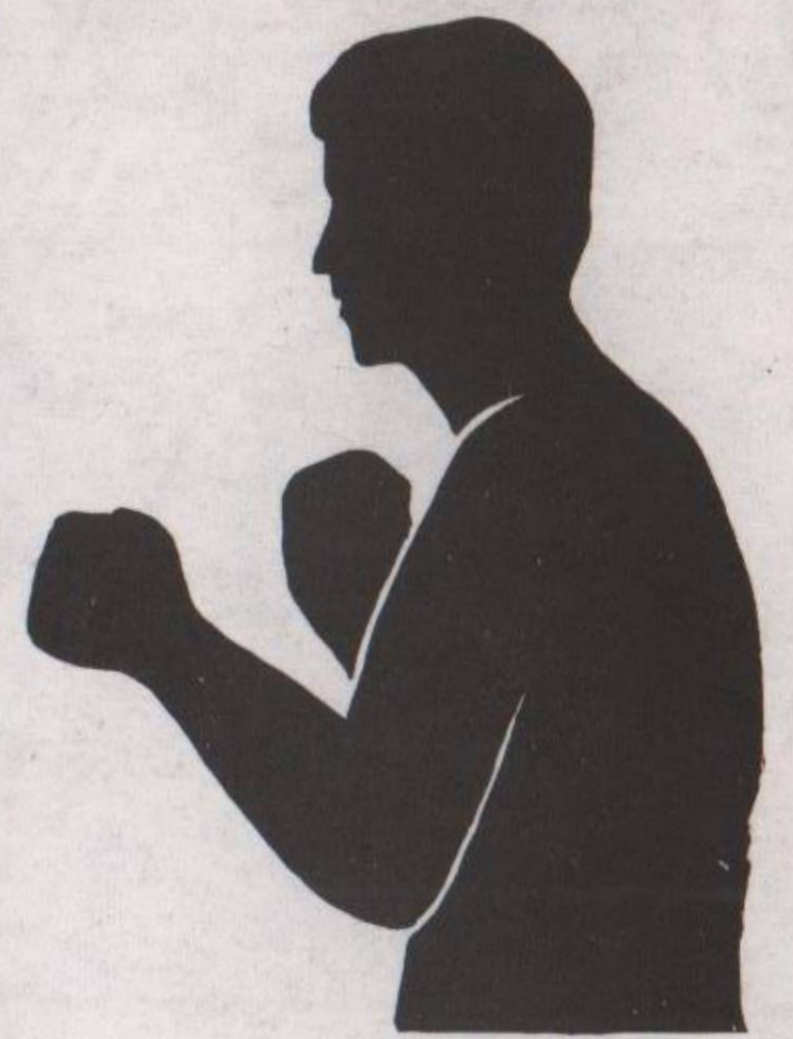

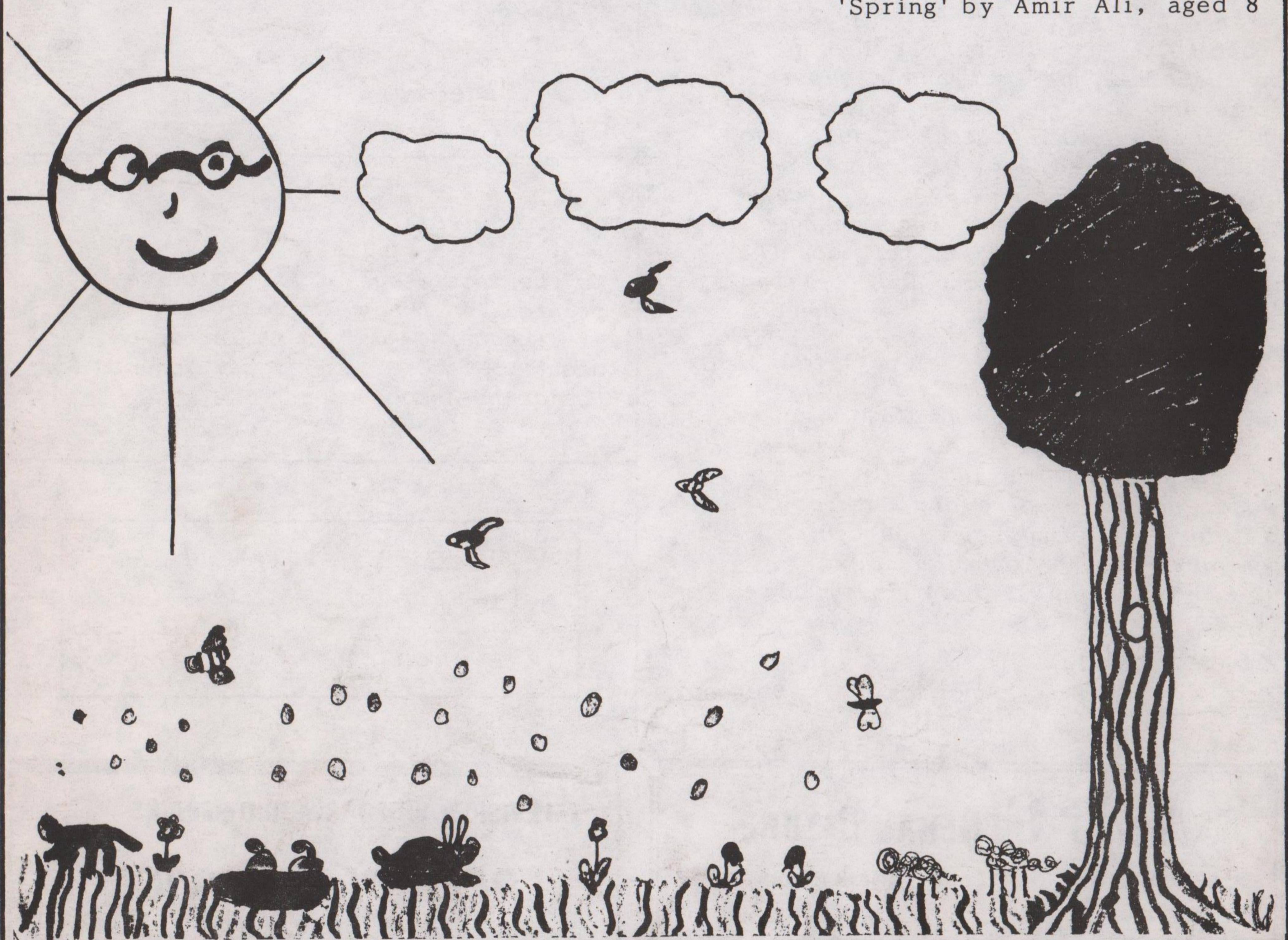

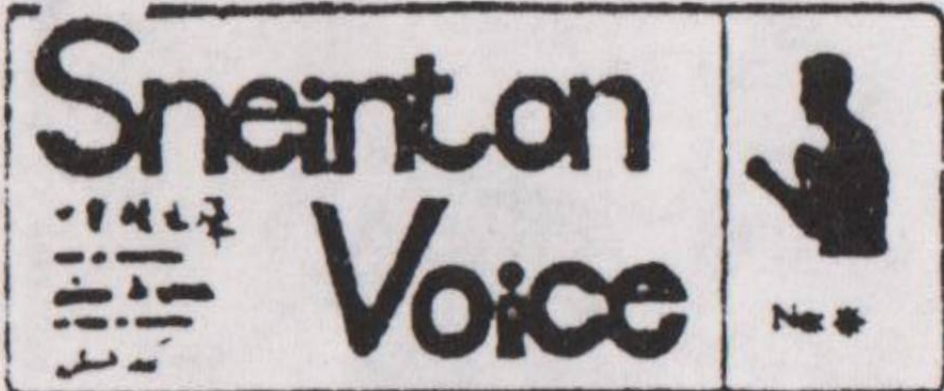

As your local County Councillor, I have been campaigning for the last two years to get the Sneinton Link Road abandoned in favour of the Manvers Street Link Road. I am very pleased therefore to tell you that after consultation with the City council, the conclusion has been reached that the best and cheapest route and also the safest will be the Manvers Street Link Road, which should go ahead some time in the late 1980's or early 1990's. Because the road line has now been changed I am also very pleased to tell you that the Police contact point will be staying until such time as a permanent Police Station can be sited in the area.

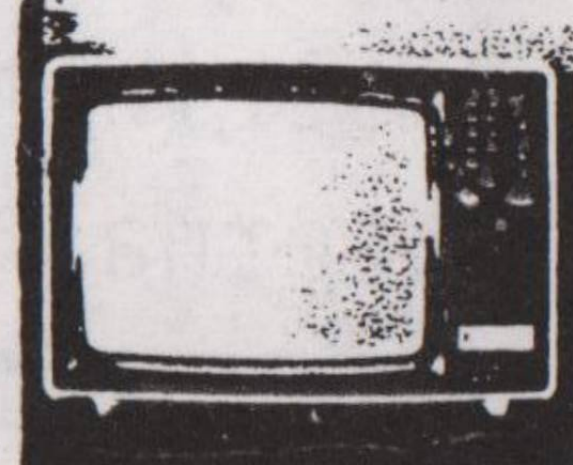

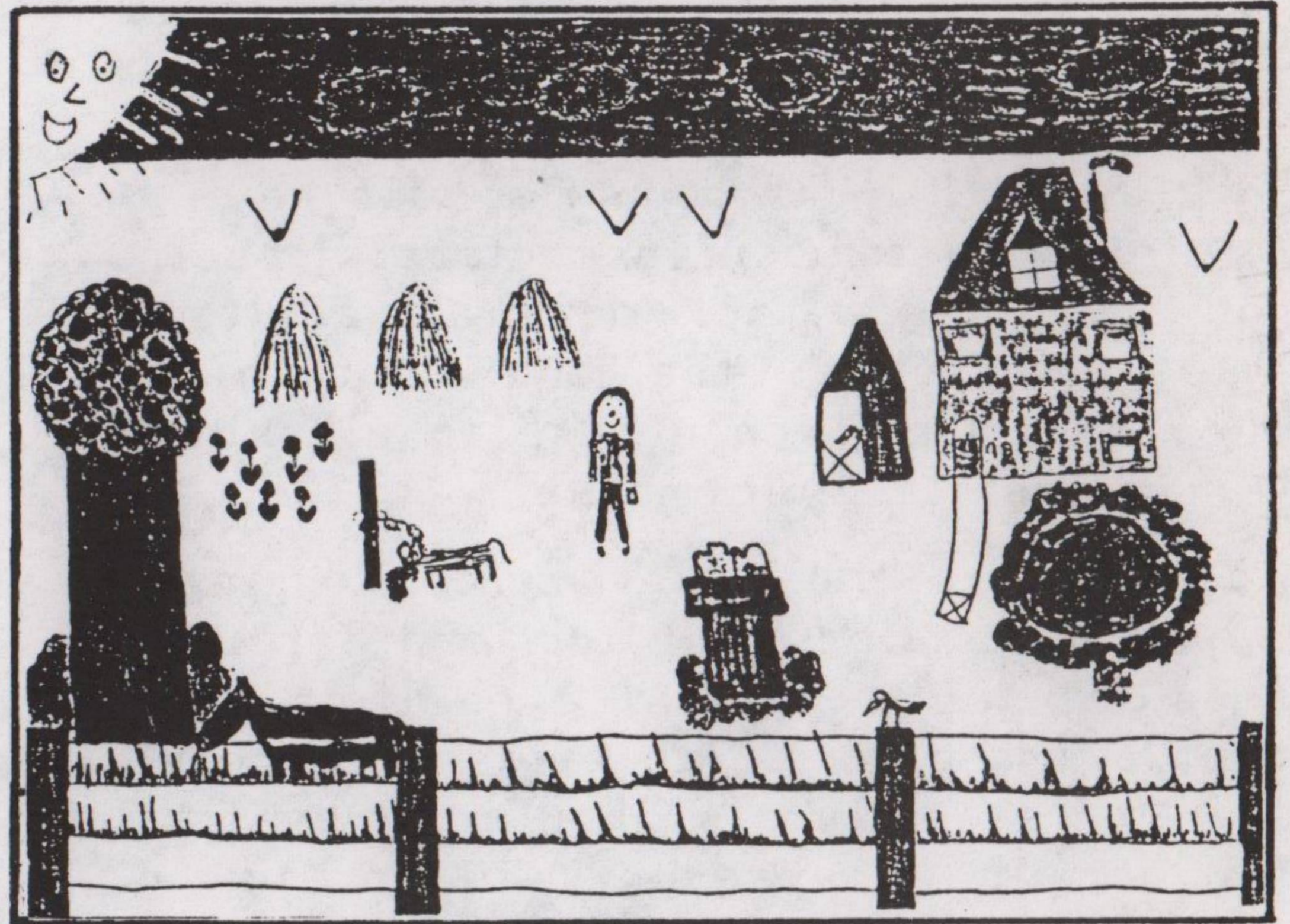

Benefit Cuts

Since the changes in social benefits and the new rules have come into force, my Advice Surgeries are inundated with people who are desperate for help. These people are from across the community of Sneinton; the elderly who have now lost up to £10 from their housing benefit, putting more hardship on them, the unemployed, especially the single unemployed who now find it very difficult to claim benefits to keep their standard of living above the poverty line. Families whose children before the changes were able to claim single payments for extra items, i.e. clothing, also those on the old Family Income Supplement who could claim school meals and milk. Those changes are now in force and many people in the area are beginning to realise that those benefits are no longer available.

If you need any help concerning your claims for either Supplementary Benefit, Income Support or Housing Benefit please contact me either at the Sneinton Library on Sneinton Boulevard every Monday evening or every Saturday morning at Greenwood Junior School.

Watch out!

The following 'interesting' details have come to the attention of the Editorial Committee:

If the poll tax goes ahead as planned in 1990, all local councils will have to employ Registration Inspectors. Their job will be to track down all adults who are liable to pay the Tax. For this they will be given access to all kinds of confidential information.

According to the Government, Housing Department files, applications for Concessionary Bus Passes, even lists of people using local libraries or receiving Meals on Wheels should be available for details. To prevent widespread evasion, door to door questioning will take place. Officials will be able to check whom you live with. They could even question your neighbours.

This secret file will be opened on every adult. It will include the inspector's notes, rumours and suspicions. There will be extensive powers to obtain the necessary information. Councils will be obliged to sell the register of names and addresses to whoever can pay, including huge databanks which send us junk mail.

No assurance has been given that you will be able to see this file in order to correct inaccuracies.

DID YOU KNOW...?

We have had further discussions with Mr. Bonham of the Environmental Health Dept, on the fumes emanating from Wright and Dobson, Carlton Road. We have been informed that, as a result of the pilot scheme on one of the four Stentor machines, the modifications necessary to improve abatement performance have been incorporated in a second installation. This means that abatement equipment has now been fitted to two of the four Stentor machines.

Additional testing of the installations, involving long runs of fabric processing, will be necessary in order for the Environmental Health Dept to determine the efficiency of the abatement machinery.

Provided that the Department is satisfied with its performance, Wright and Dobson hope to complete installation of the

abatement equipment on all four Stentor machines by the summer of this year.

On the technical aspect, it seems that the abatement machinery - which removes, by filtration, the hydrocarbon particles which are causing the pollution - is also designed to conserve energy. In fact, the energy conservation is expected to be so efficient that it will offset the cost of installation to an appreciable extent.

With the Department of Energy having been involved in the design of the abatement machinery, the success of this project in our neighbourhood could lead to further orders for the Nottingham based firm which produces it, not only nationally but also from the continent.

We propose to continue monitoring the environmental pollution and, hopefully, be able to report in a forthcoming issue of the Voice on the successful termination of the problem.

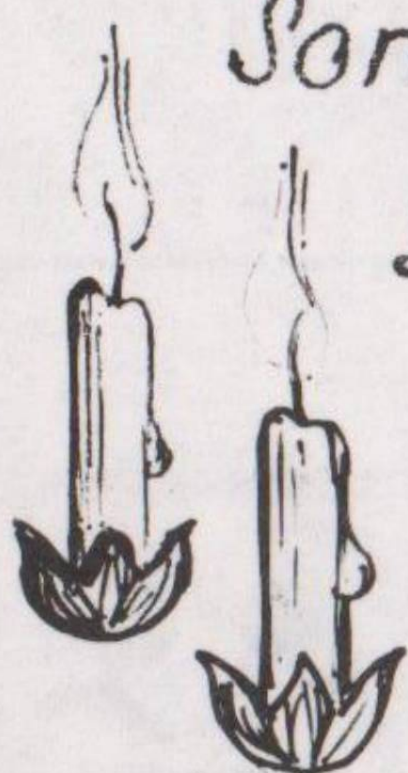

Seven Years of Sneinton Voice

- In 33 issues since April 1981 when the Voice first appeared, we have:-
- Produced articles outlining the Sneinton Area Improvement Scheme of a few years ago, and the improvements to pavements, buildings and general appearance of the area which were put into effect.
- Accepted the commission from County Council to produce a plan for the experimental 'one-way roads' in Sneinton, whereby traffic flows altered in consequence traffic accidents have been greatly reduced and Sneinton Boulevard, for instance, has become much less like a race track.
- Carried an exclusive report on the Daleside Road extension and removal of Colwick Road railway bridge.
- Exposed Boots' plan to release radioactive particles through their new incinerator and chimney on Pinder Street, and organised a meeting with local organisations and individuals with Boots' staff. Boots later admitted that some of their plans should not be made in an industrial area, and were to be phased.
- Exposed the Nottingham plan to close down Sneinton and re-locate stalls.
- Given exclusive coverage to City and County Council plans for loop roads connecting Manvers Street and Daleside Road.
- Printed readers' letters, comments and contributions.
- Investigated reports of pollution in the environment by 'Wright & Dobson' and discussed these with the Environmental Health Department.
- Organised outings for Sneinton residents on a canal boat trip and a visit to the Great Central Railway.
- Produced drawings from the County Council.
- Given publicity to such organisations as: the Sneinton Club (DAKO); Sneinton Festival and the Sneinton Bakersfield Community.
- Carried articles such as regular 'Sneinton' stories; means of dealing with 'cowboy' contractors; noise in the community; dangers of lead in the atmosphere; local life in the 1930s; recipes for English and foreign dishes.
- Exposed the effects of the Government's iniquitous Poll Tax; and given advice on welfare rights, social services, benefits and on changes in the rules which affected them.
- Reported from Stonebridge City Farm and Colwick Park.
- Printed the Diary which comprehensively informs readers of local organisations and events.

A DIAMOND JUBILEE

As an interest for your readers I would like to tell you a little of our family history, which is also part of the local history of Sneinton.

These premises at 115 Colwick Road were first changed into a hairdressing business in 1908, and from then there were four occupiers until 1928, these being till 1914 Frederick Clarke, 1920 Samuel Ward, 1922 Francis W. Clark, 1925 John Henry Agnew.

My father William Thomas Henry Bush was born in 1901 at 5 Harold Street, Sneinton and became a "Lather Boy" at the age of 12. He started his term of business at Colwick Road in 1928 and has continued, (apart from 3 years as a Fireman during the war) until his death in 1980. I came here to run the family business in February 1972 and my father took on semi-retirement. So 1988 is our Diamond Jubilee year for the family hairdressing business.

But I have recently found out that there have been Bush's in hairdressing since 1883, this first one being a Mark Bush at 58 Manvers Street, (now the Bus Depot).

Two other Bush hairdressers that I did know about are John Henry Bush 63 Manvers Street (near the Crystal Palace Pub) and Arthur Leonard Bush at 98 Union Road; this latter Bush also had salons on Willoughby Street and Denman Street.



From 1928 until approximately 1960 there were three Bush hairdressers in operation but I don't know if any of them were related to each other.

Does anyone know if they were related and would present family members please get in touch?

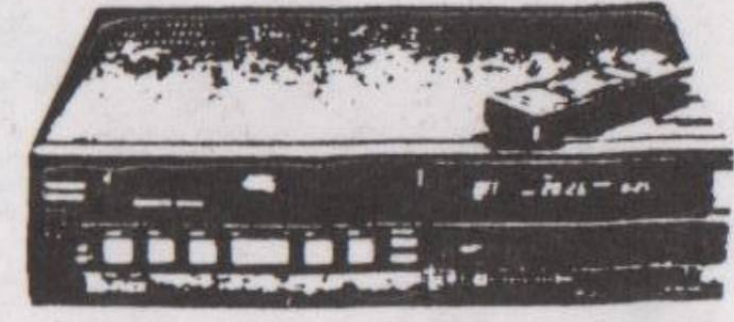
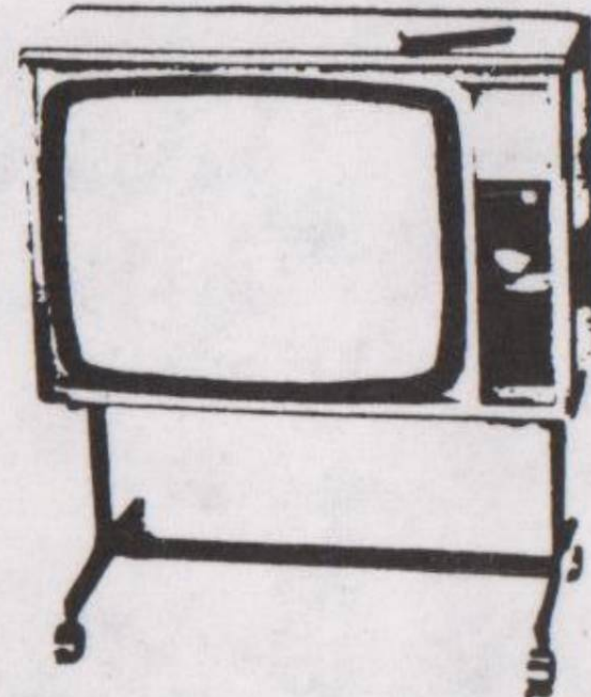
