



As well as the same name, the contents need loking at with a microscope to see any real differences.


Underneath both documents glossy packaging and ad-man drivel along the "we are the best for Britain" type lines, is the same crap trying to get out.

That is surely second nature to spineless socialist bureaucrats.


COMMUNITY SPIRIT

It was when the march reached Victoria Road that all hell broke loose. This was when someone got arrested for selling Class War.

Meanwhile those people who really did defeat the Poll Tax were going about their usual business. Family, friends, neighbours, we have all contributed in one way or another. We all did it by standing together, united In our workplaces and communities.

We still have a long way to go. On the day that they announced the abolition of the Poll Tax, poindings were still being attempted in Greenock. We must continue to stand together.

Trying to get people to pay next year is going to be a hell of a job" -ALBERT TAIT, deputy finance secretary of the scottish local authorities.

"So what?", you might say, "kids are always being tested". But look again.

The education system in England and Wales is undergoing one of it's biggest transformations for decades. But, to what? An education system concerned with educating children instead of trying to brainwash them? Like hell we will!

IGNORANT GIT!

ignorant git Kenneth Clarke. Remember what he did to the NHS? Kenneth Clarke knows as much about state education as a donkey - probably less - but that doesn't matter so long as he does his job.

And what's that? To shape the state education system so that in a few years time it will be churning out user-friendly workers who will be able to deal with the increasingly technological world.

With the introduction of the National Curriculum, the Government has even more of a say in what is taught in all state schools (but not independent and private).

JOKER

Just like the health service, education is on the slippery path of privatisation, where, according to the tories, there is freedom of choice and greater parental control.

However the tories' ace card "SATs" has turned out to be a joker. It appears not all parents want their children tested at seven and they especially do not want the results published.

The government hoped that these tests would 'show up' the so-called bad schools and parents would take their custom elsewhere.

So far no parents in England and Wales have taken their children out of school in protest about the tests, but in Scotland things are beginning to hot up. In Strathclyde 55% of children were withdrawn from schools by their parents, and in Dumfries and Galloway parents have taken to the streets to protest.

PARENT POWER!

Teachers have threatened to boycott the tests and to strike but this will have no real effect on the government but to give them Just look at who's in charge, that the excuse to sack the trouble makers. Scotland has shown the parents of England and Wales the way forward,

Parent power does exist!

The education system doesn't give working-class kids a decent education. It just creams off the "best" and leaves the

Working-class kids have forced upon them a middle-class culture, where to succeed is an uphill struggle.

MIDDLE CLASS TOSS-POTS

They fail not because they are "thick" but because they are in a system which is run by middle-class toss-pots who judge them by their own standards. The

education system is one of the most potent ways of reinforcing the class system.

So are Class War against education? No. But, what we want is an education system that is not based on control, that doesn't treat children as sub-human and goes beyond the "three Rs".

Will Kenneth Clarke give us such a system? No, no government will - they are all a bunch of so-called "highly educated" wankers who want to hold on to their priviledged places, and that means keeping us in ours.

The only way we will get the education we want is by taking control.

PART PANIC!

RUSSIAN WORKERS have been flexing their muscles and showing their might to the Communist Party

ruling class. Miners have been out for some time now demanding the resignation of Gorbachev as well as demands for pay increases. The strike action has been taken up by other industrial workers.

Workers have been setting up local strike committees and different sections of industry have been coming out in solidarity; strikers are well defiant to Gorby's calls to have bans put on strikes.

No doubt the West will credit this disruption to the influence of Boris Yeltsin. But when the miners' strike was first called, Boris wasn't at all sure where he stood.

PLOTTING

This strike wave has the Kremlin in a panic. Their power is slipping and they appeal to workers to end their strikes to avoid economic collapse.

But workers haven't got a lot to lose. While the Kremlin pleads, it's also plotting to send the army in as strike-breakers.

Russian workers have shown their ruling class that they mean business. It's them, not some jumped-up politician, who're forcing change in Russia. Workers there, like other places, have much more power than they realise - it's crucial how they use it.

Neither free market capitalism or state communist dictatorships can solve their problems.

Then...the working class of Russia can take back what the Bolsheviks stole from them in 1917: autonomous workers' power and a REAL revolution.

WE'VE HAD ENOUGH OF GORBY: RUSSIANS DEMONSTRATE.

IF LABOUR get into power they've said that they'll appoint a Cabinet Minister for Women.

But what will this Minister actually do for working-class women? Fuck all!

No doubt this position will be filled by some middle-class graduate who has nothing in common with, and no idea about what working-class women want.

Their idea of womens' liberation is a woman filling a high-powered executive role in some big multi-national company opportunities only open to the middleclasses and to which most working class

women have no desire or chance to reach.

PATRONISING

They say that they will appoint more women judges and be looking into pornography, violence and sex-crimes against women. Yet they ignore the system which, on the one hand forces workingclass women into the likes of prostitution to earn enough to live, and then, on the other, criticises them for doing so.

Working-class women don't want someone patronising them and telling them that they too can be the President of ICI, and we certainly don't look to the Labour

Party to achieve equality.

We must remember that Labour are so tied up within the economics of the Capitalist system that even if they wanted to make some radical changes they couldn't.

NEVER

Therefore the real needs of workingclass women, such as abortion on demand, free childcare facilities, genuine equal pay and the ability to walk the streets at night without harrassment are not and never will be on their agenda.

We don't look to the Labour Party or middle-class reformist womens' groups to bring about the changes we want. We look to our own class with a revolutionary solution - a class war of men and women together against capitalism.

SQUAT

To add insult to injury, the family may have to live in a crummy bed and breakfast while the Council farts about, taking its time over necessary work to the property.

This is a classic case of divide and rule playing one desperate group off against another - don't let Local Councils get away with it... Squat the lot!

Another Council policy that stinks like a sewer is the refusal to house women who have escaped violent partners.

If a woman is unfortunate enough to own a home with a violent man, councils can legally not house her because "She has a financial interest in another property". Is she supposed to say "O.K" and go back to being beaten and abused?

TRICKS

Recently, the filth of Tory London Hillingdon Council have tried to use this trick against a woman, threatening to evict her even though she had little choice but to return to Barnsley, to the bastard who was beating her, or to live on the street.

There is good news though: a growing number of Council and Housing Association workers are refusing to put these measures into practice.

Against London's Action Homelessness has swung into action, with a full-scale picket of Earls Court's Ideal Homes Exhibition, organised by homeless people, and housing groups.

In the last 10 years, over 350,000 acres of OUR land has been sold off to rich developers, making the government a tidy profit of more than £124 million, money not intended to benefit us.


There are currently 300 woods on the market, up for sale to the highest bidder. 120 woods were sold off between June and December only last year.

As national and local government policies create the degeneration of our city communities and services, this massive sell-off exercise will make it even harder for us to get out of the smoke and enjoy a bit of countryside...UNLESS we do something about it.

AS WE REPORTED in the last issue of Class War the NHS is about to undergo a massive change in the way It operates - the first step on the road to splitting it up, then selling it off.

Well, since 1st April (how appropriate) the new-style NHS has been up and running. From now on every X-Ray, every test, every aspirin, every part of your treatment has a cost on it. And if your health authority hasn't got the money, then you won't get the treatment. It's strictly cash before care now.

The most fundamental change has been that now health authorities are given a set amount of money each year - once that money has been spent, there will be no more.

Wards will close and patients will be turned away. (So if you are going to get ill or have an accident, try to do it early on in the year) which is exactly what happened in Bristol in February when all nonemergency operations were stopped at the Bristol Royal Infirmary.

SICK COMPETITION

Now hospitals must compete for business, but there will be no extra doctors, nurses, beds or equipment and even if the health authority does save money it's highly unlikely that it will go to treating extra patients.

Particularly as most of the new Health Service's managers are on proformancerelated pay, which doesn't count how many patients they've treated, but how much money they've saved.

The idea is that hospitals should eventually make profits, and "customers" will have the choice of which treatment they want.

Like most of the other false "choices" that we now allegedly have, you only really have a choice if you have the money.

The rich and powerful will have the "nice" profit making hospitals, all pastel wallpaper and shinny new equipment while everyone else will have even longer queues and second rate treat-

Particularly those like the disabled and elderly who need long term care.

NO DEFENCE

OPTING-OUT of the NHS does have it's rewards - if you happen to be one of the managers.

You've really got to pity our poor Prime Minister...








THIS ONE is definitely for all you boyz and gaiz who like something different to dance to.



This is massive on the dance scene, and thought-provoking.



Yes, we give this man the "Prat of the Sports page Award", and anyway, what do Sheffield Utd know about the less physical side of the game, ie: skill and artistry?

NO SURPRISES

WHEN is mass murder an accident?

When the police are guilty!

The inquest into the Hillsborough massacre returned a verdict of accidental death... to the police's great relief.

At big games people are always in the hands of the police. The relatives of the victims cried "Whitewash! They killed our children!" at the police as the inquest result was declared.

A father of one of the killed added, "If 95 cops had been killed at Hillsborough I think we would have seen a different situation".

QUESTION: If English clubs are so big how come they're all looking at new all-seater grounds with capacities of half or one-third of top European football grounds? (eg: Sporting Lisbon 90,000; Barcelona 110,000; AC/InterMilan 80,000).

ANSWER: Small, seated stadiums with high demand and therefore high prices at low cost = Loads Of Money!

ONCE UPON a time there were two organisations which ran football in England (abysmally), the Football Association, better known as the FA and the Football League.

The FA is responsible for the laws of the game, for running the FA cup and the England national team.

The League runs the four divisions which contain the 92 professional clubs most people support. From these clubs the majority of the England team are picked.

FULL SCALE WAR!

To cut a tedious story short the people in power of both organisations have never seen eye to eye in case they lost the power they misused.

Since the beginning of the professional game in 1888, the League and FA bosses have continued their petty bickering until today. Now it's broken out into full scale

Due to the interest generated by the last world cup in Italy the FA want to host the competition in this country in 1998 but to do this the potential venues or league grounds will have to be improved or rebuilt ..

However the government will only back the FA's bid for the world cup if both the FA and League merge to form one organ-

While the League was prepared to merge with the FA they wanted a 50/50 representation on the new organisation. The FA however weren't prepared to accept this and have come up with plans of their own, which if successful will leave the FA in power and be detrimental to the fans and the game of football in England.

The FA want to start a SUPER LEAGUE containing 18 clubs in the 1992-93 season, after next season. To do this they will take over the First Division and by relegating more clubs than will be promoted will end up with 18 clubs.

MONEY MAKING

There will however be two criteria involved in getting into the super league,

1, Promotion, and

2, Having a ground which comes up to the standards of the Taylor report, in effect an all seater stadium.

The FA's stated reasons for their superleague are...

1, To help the England team

2, To maximise the premier league's commercial opportunities

So as you see the FA has seized the opportunity to use the money making

potential of the First Division clubs in order to promote it's aim of hosting the 1998 World Cup and turn the Football League into little more than a Sunday school organisation.

As far as we're concerned these changes to the game will do nothing for the fans and indeed worsen conditions for the majority of players who play in the League.

The superleague will probably prohibit the likes of non-league clubs from gaining promotion into the League and further promotion to the premier division, something Wimbledon fans have already experienced, unless their grounds are brought up to FA regulations.







Having 18 instead of 20 or 22 teams in the premier division will not guarantee success for the England team. Most of the members of the Eire team which humiliated, even if it did not beat, England in the recent international match play in the Football League.

BOLLOCKS!

So the argument that the number of teams is too large and affects the quality of the national team is bollocks. Both the Spanish and French Premier Leagues also contain 20 clubs (the same as the Football League at the moment.)

What this argument between the FA and the League is all about is power and the FA have found the opportunity to knobble their rival for good at last.

What this probably means for the fans will be even higher prices to see their teams if they are lucky to get into the superleague. All seater stadia within two years. Lack of investment in the remnants of the Football League with a consequent drop in the, already crap, standards of the facilities and the game.

if football is to remain "The Peoples" Game" then we have to get rid of these parasites who run both the FA and the League.

Whichever one of these organisations retains control of the game is irrelevant to the paying public who go to support their team. These bastards just run the game for their own personal ends and have no real interest in us or the game we watch or play.

It looks like they've bought off some of the clubs already but they won't buy off us, the fans.

Down in Kent, struggling Fourth Division Football Club Maidstone United are facing more problems than just their position in the league.

After selling their ground - without first finding a new site - Maidstone are playing their third season ground-sharing with Beazer Homes premier division club, Dartford.

Now United are about to apply for planning permission for a new ground on the outskirts of their home town, three miles from the village of Hollingbourne.

BIGOTRY

Despite the site being on derelict farmland, the villagers are fighting the club's campaign. Although using pseudoenvironmental arguments, the anti-workingclass bigotry of Hollingbourne's mainly upper-middle-class residents was soon revealed as the real reason for their

opposition to the ground.

Their view of fans of the "people's game" is that we are all drunken louts hell-bent on attacking ordinary people or molesting their kids. If we're not pissing in people's gardens then we'd be breaking into their house or car!

Several football clubs, in whatever league, either ground-share, or like Maidstone, want new ones. eg; Charlton (see other story) and Bristol Rovers.

We must realise that in supporting our clubs' relocation schemes we may face, and be willing to fight, opposition from our class enemy.

Soccer clubs around the country are learning that they are being shat on, not only 'cos they're football supporters but their 1000s on April 2nd in support of because they're working class.

CHARLTON FANS MARCHED in their return to the Valley.

Independent fans' pressure has been crucial in forcing both the club and Greenwich Council into giving them back their "home".

Without it they'd probably have disappeared by now.
