
Among the ideas was the Police Federation calling for the Riot Act to be reintroduced - it was scrapped in 1967, and wasn't a complete success anyhow.

The buzzing front lines '85 were, by '91, colonised by artists' picture galleries and framers, without a copper in sight. Dispossessed, the working class was shipped off to reservations in Basildon or Basingstoke.

Kinnock and Hattersley tried to out-Thatcher the Tories in their commitment to law and order, deploring all law breaking, upto and including, the evasion of TV licenses.

The Communist Party dissolved itself and its leading theoretician Bea Campbell, became the country's foremost exposer of satanic covens.

#### **AT THEIR recent Wolverhampton** AGM, the loony liberal wing of the Green Party took full control.

Out goes grass roots democracy, in comes 'leadership as a principle' a strong executive and all the usual lies.

Architects of a new constitution, that aims to turn the Greens into 'a mainstream' party including old Etonian Johnny Porritt, and mad evangelical Christian Tim Cooper, are keen to combine the 'radicalism' of the SDP with the 'democratic' structures of the SWP!

Their Green 2000 factions' victory marks the end of a 20 year battle between the real Greens, and exponents of the politics of boredom.

The 2000 slogan that Green 'is neither Left nor Right' is borrowed from Herbert Gruhl, who set up a German Green Fascist Party, the ODP.

For old Etonians like Porritt and Claret swillers like Sarah Parkin, class

Parkin, who coughed up the Poll Tax on her two homes in Leeds and Scotland, slagged off party members who pointed out the Greens non-payment policy, and was rewarded with a new fax and a wodge of money by last year's party council.

Time after time Parkin - styled by fucked off German Green Euro M.P.s as 'the Green Queen of Europe', condemns opponents as 'socialist parasites'.

#### COLLAPSE

Parkin is feted by the media simply because she is determined never to let on about radical Green policies such as anticapitalism, gay and lesbian liberation, or workers self management.

Having got control of the organisation, Green 2000 intend to whip out all such 'controversial' policies, expel the real Greens and fill the party with thousands more of their own drippy, yuppie, 'armchair' members.



Despite being unable to get their own way on the conference floor and losing every significant debate, Jean Lambert forced through their motions with 500 proxy votes.


These had been wrestled out of an unwilling membership by Porritt, who wrote to thousands of members on his own personal notepaper, to argue that if they did not do his every word the party would collapse.

Dr. John Morrissey, probably the most sussed and dangerous opponents of the eco-yuppies, insists it is all a plot to get the

Party to merge with the SLD, so as to provide Porritt with a cabinet post.

Most radical members assume the party is now so fucked that it will collapse within a year or two, leaving the way clear for those with some seriously revolutionary politics to fight for the planet.

Others are getting ready to do a bit of direct action, and what could be a better way of fighting pollution, than putting a lead free Molotov to the Porsches, and other assorted yuppie vehicles of the Greens' new self-styled leaders.









LATEST STATISTICS show that one in three people in England and Wales have paid NOTHING towards this years poll tax.

Local council's income is down by 10% on last year. In Scotland the situation is better, with less than 50% collected. The anti poll tax movement is calling for all debts to be written off, we say we can make this a reality by making this tax impossible to collect.



By mid September almost 70 people have been jailed for non payment in England and Wales, Labour councils have jailed 47 of these. But the jailings have failed miserably in their attempt at intimidating a mass movement.

Most non payers summonsed to appear at committal proceedings, which can order imprisonment, are not turning up. In Leeds as many as 90% simply ignore the summons. This is the best tactic to combat the jailings. For the simple fact that if you are not in court, your case cannot be heard, and you can't be jailed!

#### INVALID

The worst the magistrates can do is to issue a warrant for you to appear later. The cops are non to pleased about enforcing such warrants. In Warrington the Cheshire police are refusing to act on these warrants.

And London Fight the Poll Tax reports that up till mid September NO ARRESTS in London have been made following nonattendance. In Leeds warrants have been issued, but unless they are physically handed to the person concerned they are invalid.

Councils claim that they are only trying to "protect services" when they chase up non payers. But it is the poll tax itself, whereby central government controls the purse strings, which is ultimately designed to cut and privatise services. Workers are opposing these cuts, not in massive numbers yet but its the start. 900 council housing and treasury workers were still on strike, against compulsory redundancies, in mid September in Liverpool. In Glasgow on 11/9/91 300 Building and Works workers invaded the district council chambers, angry at the Labour councils plans for lay-offs.

IT WAS a dark, wet, miserable morning of 1st october. The day of the first warrant sale in Glasgow.

At 6 o'clock a crowd of around 50 had gathered outside the APT Federations office. Due to the fact that no auctioneers would hold the sale on their premises the council had gone to the trouble of hiring out the former Turnbull St police station nearby.


Co, arrived late with the seized goods in the back of a transit van. The furniture belonged to a Greenock family who owed £360 in poll tax.

It was at this point that the crowd, now over 200 strong, began to push at the gates. Eventually they were through and surrounding the van. Only 40 cops had been assigned to control the crowd, and there was no problem in pushing them aside.

Finally the council will hold the seized goods in storage for the next 6 months in the hope of holding another sale. How much more will this cost them? Not forgetting that all this is for a debt of £360. Who is kidding who?







#### DIRECT ACTION

The 'cuts connection' show that the poll tax cannot be looked at as a single issue. The anti poll tax movement has been successful because of its mass involvement and grass roots organisation, its reliance on direct action, and its independence from political parties. These are lessons we must all learn for future struggles.

Our resistance to the poll tax is potentially striking at the heart of capitalist rule. This whole stinking system is maintained, ultimately, by fear of the police and prison. But when enough people stand together and refuse to cooperate with their legal system the police and courts are powerless.

Using imaginative tactics, and direct action against those concerned, we can make the whole country a no go area for arrests and jailings of non payers.



**TOMMY SHERIDAN** -THE MESSIAH???

At around 7 o'clock the crowd marched off to the site of the sale, now swelled to over 100 people. When they reached the gates they were found to be bolted, and four women then produced chains and padlocks and began padlocking themselves to the gates.

Sheriff officers, Abernthy McIntyre and

The crowd then started to rock the van with the intention of turning it over and getting at the scum inside.

#### 'EASY, EASY'

It was at this point that an announcement was made saying that due to the threat of violent scuffles the warrant sale was being cancelled. The crowd sadly backed off, and chants of "easy, easy" rang out. A victory for the anti-poll tax movement, but a lot of questions still remain...

Why did everyone listen to every word spoken by "the Messiah" Tommy Sheridan? Having ignored an interdict that was served on him banning him approaching the sale, he then proceeded to give his victory speech. To which the crowd stood opened mouthed! No doubt he wants everyone to know of his "bravery", a martyr to the end!

So what now of our glorious Labour councillors. Having wasted tens of thousands on an advertising campaign encouraging people to pay up, they also bear the brunt of the expense of the

#### BANKRUPT

So finally the council have thrown in their last card. Having used threats of wage arrestments, benefit reductions, warrant sales, pathetic adverising campaigns, the council are still owed over £200,000,000 in unpaid poll tax. Thousands more people are joining the non payment campaign.

So what now? It seems the councils last hope is to declare non payers bankrupt. Already Lothian have been succesful with this on a few attempts. But what happens when people lose their homes?

Debts to banks and credit facilities will have to be written off. People will have to be found homes, putting yet more pressure on the councils.

It would seem that instead of doing the right thing and witing off all debts owed, and declaring an amnesty for non payers, the council still intends to waste yet more money chasing up non payers. Yet after two and a half years they still think that they will get the money back.

But as the old saying goes.. They aint seen nothing yet!

CROWDS, 500 and 200 strong, success-fully stopped two poindings in Cambuslang/Rutherglen, Glasgow in late August and early September.

IN MIDLOTHIAN sheriff officers had to call the police twice to get into a non-payers home, There were three arrests at Mayfield, but NOTHING was poinded.

LOTHIAN social workers have refused to cooperate with 'means enquires' into non-payers threaten with warrant sales.

WHEN Parkinson & Hamer Auctions, in Bury, attempted a sale for Madagans Bailiffs angry protesters gathered, and others made dummy bids. The auction manager went home to a real fire, his house had lost an argument with a petrol bomb!

30 people carry out a 'peoples poining' at the homes of Lothian Councillors Begg and Geddes.

THE TREACHEROUS filth of Labour Barrow Council got well-stuffed by an anti-poll tax activist in the courts in late September:

The council had tried to apply for 6000 liability orders against non-payers - obviously, they thought the magistrates would be right on their side, until one non-payer asked to see a document actually authorising the summonses.

The cocky councillors hadn't got one, so all 6000 cases were chucked out of court!

Now that's a handy tip for any of you due in court soon...

SALFORD Labour council sent down post office worker Charles Doherty, who has a collapsed lung, for 30 days for non payment.

This was despite him saying he would try to pay. There then followed a demonstration outside the home of Bill Hinds, the council leader. He soon buckled in and had Charles freed.

This shows that when we take the battle to their homes, when we make them feel uncomfortable and hated, they soon give in.



AS THE Poll Tax starts moving into its death throes we must start looking at where it all began.


Tommy Sheridan, we now learn, is actually going to stand against the Labour candidate in the next general election. Is there any real surprise in that statement.?





### CARDIFF KIDS CLOBBER COPS!

THE RECENT UPRISING on the Ely estate in Cardiff, South Wales, wasn't as directionless as the media would have us believe:

They claimed that the cause was a racist incident involving an Asian shopkeeper, Abdul Waheed, after he locked a shoplifter in his shop, or by a feud between him and another



THE BLACKBIRD LEYS estate, in the South-East of Oxford, has been in the wars with the Old Bill.

The riots that erupted in early September were an excellent example of fightback against the filth, intent on flexing their muscle on the estate.

The police tried to stamp out the hotters' skillful car displays, which have provided the estate with many a good night of entertainment.

Cheeky coppers thought they could stamp out hotting displays and break the resistance of the community - but, they were wrong!

With all this media hype given to joyriding, people throughout the country could be forgiven for thinking this was the latest craze, like skateboarding.

#### PART OF THE CULTURE

But on the Blackbird Leys estate, the car culture has been there for years. The estate was built with the intention of Cowley plant.

A lot of the workers knew how to break into the cars, and take them to pieces, etc.

sussed - with jobs of pinching, racing and the monitoring of police activity, done on a very professional level.

Now we're not going to make moral judgements about whether it's cool to nick working class peoples' motors. For one thing it happens and what we think or say isn't going to change it one bit. It's up to the Blackbird Leys community to sort out those dilemas ( if they are dilemas at all).

#### WHAT ARE THE COPS UP TO?

You might be wondering why the cops are running an anti-hotter campaign now? It's been going on for a couple of years now, on the estate.

Well it's not just about hotting, though this is the issue they are using. It's about trying to break a strong, anti-cop commnity.

For years the estate has been strong and organised against the coppers; the estate has carried on dealing in soft drugs (no hard drugs are allowed on the estate), housing the workforce of the Austin Rover and has been the No.1 place for getting all sorts of car parts. Basically, the long arm of the law did not reach into Blackbird Leys. This is what pisses off the filth. But why now? Since 1989's big redundancies at the Cowley car plant, most of the residents do not now work for the same employer (if they had any work at all). The solidarity of the workplace, which was translated into a solid community base, did not exist anymore, so made the community

All were hyped by the press, all came up with nothing, total fucking embarrassments. The filth want to save some face.

Now, near enough a month and a half on (at time of writing) from the riots, the hotters are still doing the business. Only in a different place, because the council have built an island in the stretch of road used for hotting displays. The hotters have just stuck up two fingers to pathetic attempts to curb hotting.

As for the Beasts, as one ex-worker from the Cowley plant, put it, "Will get a kicking to fuck"; even if there are mass arrests, loads of people on the estate have done time and would do it again for a BEAST-FREE BLACKBIRD LEYS.



#### WHAT WAS IT ALL ABOUT THEN?

It's now quite obvious that the riot that took place over a weekend was definitely anti-establishment and antipolice, NOT a racist one.



When Cardiff's cops' first EVER appeared in riot gear in the town, on the Friday night (with the full support of local Labour MP, Rhodri Morgan) they were met with fierce resistance:

It was not Asian shops or houses that were attacked, but the cops, and the local poll tax collection office.

Because most of the residents worked in the same place, the community was well solid in strikes and in closing ranks when the police interferred in the estate.

Also, another by-product of this solidarity on the estate is that there are very little racial tensions in the community.



RACISTS COP IT!

a little less tight.

ALMOST 6 YEARS TO THE DAY, the streets of Handsworth and Lozells in Birmingham were taken over AGAIN by locals. This time in early September this year.

Birmingham's snivelling boys in blue showed once more what spineless bastards they are - allowing youth to loot all the shops in the area - knowing that if they intervened, they'd get a bloody good hiding, and rightly so.

#### **POWERLESSI**

The night's events began when an electricity sub-station was torched, leaving the whole of Handsworth and Lozells without power, for two hours.

Local youths were quick to take advantage of the situation, and went on a late-night free-for-all shopping spree,

Presumably, Asians were involved as over 600 fought the cops, and that's the way it should be!

#### EMPLOYING YOURSELF

Ely residents, suffering 30% unemployment, feel that: "If you come from Ely, you're blacklisted" by local employers.

They certainly enjoyed the 3-day event, as whole families grinned, watching youths take on cops on the ground and from nearby rooves.

What's more, the local council have worsened conditions on Ely by providing NO amenities.

Well, just enough bricks and paving slabs to vent your fury at the Old Bill!



The papers highlighted a knife attack on Alison Van Dyck. But what the papers deliberately left out was the fact that she was a blatant racist who campaigned against the black residents on the estate, on numerous occasions.

She was knifed as she tried to take photos of the rioters. She was also involved in knifing a woman; she got what she deserved.

The papers bleated about her not being able to keep up the mortgage payments. Not a lot of people on the estate shed a tear when she was attacked, or will they if she moves out. Good riddance to racist trash.

#### **ORGANISED FUN**

Joyriding has been around for years on the estate. Workers in the car factory used to nip over the fenced fields where fleets of Austin Rover cars were for their entertainment. About a couple of years ago hotting started getting big on the actual estate itself. Now it's well organised and

The beasts (coppers) have also realised the development of a rift between different age-sets, ie. those under 35-40, and those above the age of 40. They want to drive a wedge into the community, permanantly, so that they are divided from within.

Being the low-life that they are, they have (not surprisingly) used the racist card to gain some public support outside of the community, because a lot of Black and Asian youths are involved along side white youth, in hotting.

Well what do the police gain out of this: campaign, apart from exercising their power-hungry authority and upholding the capitalist law and order. The Oxford constabulary have had a few bogus raids over hard drugs (esp. when Olivia 'Too much heroin in my veins' Channon, overdosed, also attempts at trying to break the 'hotting ring', last time they did a raid all they came up with was somebody with a

taking control of the streets and redistributing wealth in a true Class War style.

The cops, keen to save their bacon (ho! ho!), grovelled about in the back of their riot vans, until the lights came back on.

When they finally showed their ugly faces, they learnt what would happen to them if they tried to attack local residents: by getting a stoning down the Lozells Road.


Only a small few were arrested that night, while the law did its best to try to play the whole thing down, dishing out £50 fines and a "slap on the wrist".

#### LESSONS FOR US...

#### England. Ram-raiding has taken off! Wellestablished for over 2 years in Tyneside. **DRIVE-IN STORES**

This form of free shopping is a direct response to capitalism and an increasing rich and poor divide.

Flash and fast cars are robbed and driven straight into shops that stock the expensive trinkets of a capitalist class society - things we could not "legally" afford.

After getting in, ram-raiding teams "shop" like crazy until the motor's full and before killjoy cops arrive. And no-one gets hurt.

It's all fair enough and the only ones to foot the bill are the businesses and their insurance companies, and rightly so.

#### THE MEADOW WELL STORY

Meadow Well Estate in North Shields, Tyne and Wear, is well known as "The worst place to live in the North East".

It's a sprawling, poverty-stricken housing estate, built in the 1930s, to rehouse people who had been forced to live in slums; to redevelop the city centre and to cheaply house ship-yard workers.

There are MANY of its kind all over

and women, in solidarity with their murdered friends first displayed a host of anti-cop graffiti and banners.

#### SPONTANEOUS ORGANISATION

Against this 60-year old backdrop of uncaring capitalism, anger turned to a totally justified human reaction - Riot.

For 2 nights, cops in fear and riot gear surrounded the estate while up to 600 young residents took it over.

Although some families and shopkeepers were understandably afraid, the youth used common sense in creating barricades against the cops, with telegraph poles and felled trees.

Phone lines were cut to inhibit police contact; an electricity sub-station was put out, allowing darkness to cover a spot more free shopping at the small shopping centre on the estate.

throughout the whole of Newcastleupon -Tyne's west end.

In the press, Major burbled on about "copycat rioting" and "handfuls of Youths"; how "unacceptable" recent uprisings were what the prime minister was doing was putting down publicly something he and his cabinet of deadheads were shitting themselves over:

#### SO WHAT REALLY HAPPENED?

Class War's been in touch with contacts in Newcastle and the story is NOT of an isolated, copycat thoughtless riot, resulting in little more than a few outraged locals and the Dodds Arms pub being burnt down - What happened was a week-long riotous uprising!

Organised T.W.O.C. (taking without

consent) ram-raider teams had been down at Meadow Well estate in September, cleverly sussing out how to outmanoeuvre the cops, and how to organise against

#### **RAIDING!**

them.

Ram-raiding has been esta-blished in Newcastle for two years, and the TWOC squads know what

connected throughout more than 4 areas and fires and scuffles lasted well after the highpoint of Tuesday to Friday. Cops were being attacked well after this: two of 'em were petrolbombed.


#### **NEWS BLACKOUT**

The local media were instructed to institute a huge cover-up. Local radio stated that "no disturbances" were going on at the same time that uprisings were plainly in evidence not only in Newcastle, but in Sunderland, Gateshead and all over Tyneside and Wearside. To keep a lid on 'disorder', the state's media

#### **OUR OWN ENTERTAINMENT**

With up to 82% employment in parts, crap homes created through poverty and the need to turn to crime, the youth of Meadow Well took on the growing pasttime of ram-raiding seriously: it's excitement, solidarity amongst teams and benefits - ram-raided goods are proudly sported throughout the North East.

#### bopped on the nose!

On an estate that's next door to the huge insult of the 'Royal Quays luxury housing and hotel development; where residents claim it's as much of a no-go area for social funding as it is for the cops - male and female youth showed that they could organise, take advantage of a situation and follow through with a riot.

they're doing: using hand-held radios to communicate with each other, avoiding cop cars and police roadblocks.

The squads have been able to confound the cops by broad-daylight 'riding' in such posh motors as convertible BMW's.


#### WIDESPREAD!

The events of mid-September were expertly organised and widespread through the Elswick, Scotswood, Benwell and Crudders Park areas. Local paper ads were substituted by poster invites to riot!

Tyneside cops tried to persuade the press that all that happened was "not above the normal level violence for the area" - absolute crap!

Two housing offices were burnt out and all 'social services' departments in the West End had to close by 2pm throughout the week.





There are many important lessons to be learned:

When we are in violent struggle, we must organise; communicate; control events so that the right targets are dealt with in the right way; we must act in solidarity against the cops and make sure that when the State TV and newspapers carry out news blackouts, we are able to get the truth out - by our own newsletters, or even taking over local radio and TV boradcasts: it may sound far-fetched, but it's been done before and we can do it again.

#### THE STATE GOT SCARED!

Quite clearly such blackouts are done to prevent thousands more coming to join the uprising and beat the cops.

This is why they put so much time and energy into telling us all's well now, tht the were "copycat" incidents, that it was "tatooed yobbos and crackpots.. an anti-social minority"

We all know that this is complete lies,

Of 182 reported stolen cars this year, in the area, 135 were "recovered" by coppers on the Estate.

#### KILLER COPS!

Cop haassment, racist policing and curfews on our estates are nothing new. So when Northumbria cops formed their "ram raider squad", they wanted to teach a few lessons.

So they came in force, looking for Colin Atkins and Dale Robson, two ramming experts. Colin's family maintain that the cops fully intended to make the 17 year old's life a misery by constant hassle and 'surveillance'.

Colin and Dale died outright in a 125mph crash, being chased by cops. An admitted police tactic is to follow raiders, at high speed, putting the pressure on on straight sections of road and slowing at bends and curves,

There were only 4 arrests at the time. Since then the filth have been on a trawling mission, using helicopters with high intensity cameras; video surveillance from high buildings on raiders, to try to pull in as many "suspects" as possible.

#### FIGHT BACK!

While we openly criticise the anti-social aspects of some of the recent riots, Class War fully supports anti-State, antiestablishment, anti-police fightback.

Riot has, especially over the last 10 years, been the high-profile, massinvolvement side of this fightback.

**Politicians! Cops! Bosses!** Listen up! You've got a lot more coming to you!

While whole shopping centres were covered with messages of solidarity with the two men who died in Meadow Well: "Dale and Colin we'll avenge your death", other graffiti plastered the registration numbers of unmarked police cars over walls with a message to the cops:"We're gonna get you!"

Cops were so scared that attempts to take over the city centre were met with the forced closure of restaurants, bars and pubs from 8pm. Police barricades were thrown up all

designed to set the working class against itself - let's let them know the TRUTH.

THROUGHOUT SEPTEMBER mini-riots were happening all over Britain. The media black-out means they weren't all over the papers, and there are others we've missed but here's just some.

There was four nights of confrontation in Maltby, Yorkshire. Local youths attacked coppers dressed in full riot gear.

The Lawrence Weston estate in Bristol was the scene of two nights of rioting, with the filth coming under attack from petrol bombs and stoning. They replied with riot squads and even their helicopter!

Three nights of trouble in Radstock/ Midsomer Norton, Avon, by 100 or so youths was hushed up, with the only news being the odd piece in the local rag.

In the Brambles estate, Middlesborough, cops came under attack from a mob of youths who stoned them.


Five cops were injured when they were attacked by a mob in Devizes, Wilts, after trying to arrest a local man.





FOR MOST of us, the important political events of the past ten years have occurred, not in the smokefilled rooms of the union barons; not in the pine-striped rooms of Habitat socialists; not even the meat-free living spaces of the anarchist ghetto, but on the streets and estates of the urban working class.

From the blazing summers of 1981 and 1985, with riots up and down the country in the inner cities; the militant and violent industrial struggles of Wapping and the Miners' strike; to the recent Poll Tax riots, and now the recent riots in Newcastle, Oxford, Birmingham, Cardiff, etc.



Or, like in the Ordsall Estate in Salford, Manchester, where some of the community got together to physically stop those who were robbing off their own. They also got cash together to set up a reward scheme to get information about those who carried on doing so.

#### CONTAIN

There are countless other examples of working class people trying to establish 'justice' within their own communities. Throughout the world we can see other examples: in the North of Ireland, in the Intifada uprising in Palestine, in the townships of South Africa for example. In the end, the cops do fuck all to help us. They just want to contain us in our areas, keep us fighting amongst ourselves, only coming in when we're a threat. Up and down the country, when the filth come into our communities, people unite to fight them; when this unity goes as far as it must, we become a force to replace this shite society.

The fact is that the working class has been taking on the full brunt of the forces of the state.

Whether we have Major's softer Toryism, or designer socialism courtesy of Kinnock & Co, neither will be able to avoid the fact that there will be an on-going and ever escalating urban warfare.

#### HATRED

The police will become more and more a paramilitary force, who's main objective will be to over-whelm the rebellious sections of the working class.

Most cops these days know that they are no longer looked upon as 'Dixon of dock Green' type upholders of 'law and order'. They also know that large, and growing, sections of ordinary people would be only too willing to show how much they hate them.

But hatred of the cops does not always mean their eradication from our communities. A lot of working class people see them as a necessary evil to deal with anti-social crime which cripple our communities.

The choice between a draconian police presence or the 'law of the jungle', is a doomed choice if we are serious about our politics.

### 

Dublin people are no strangers to mass community action.

Since 1981 Concerned Parents Against Drugs groups have been actively forcing heroin dealers out of working class areas. C.P.A.D. came about after hard-pressed residents of inner city estates which were overrun by junkies, muggings and burglaries joined together to make their communities safe again.

Hundreds of people marched into the dealers flats and confiscated their drugs which were publicly destroyed. These direct action tactics have proved very successful in September recreation area which had been taken over by addicts. it's now a children's play area again. Charlemont Side and Visal Side fais have nightly dealer buster patrols. Dublins' working class communities have only one thing to say to the drug Salon and Allar Salend

Liberated zones are not a 'free-for-all' for those who are the strongest in the community.

If this happens the state will be in a stronger position impose to its law and order bullshit, because working class people will find it preferable than giving a free hand to racists, muggers and rapists etc.


So when it boils down to basics, the question remains, what do we do when the cops fuck off? This is when theory flies out the window and reality stares you in the face. It's the testing ground for the type of politics we believe in, which argues that the working class are the only ones fit to run our communities, not some gang of vigilantes.

#### CARE

It's not going to be easy, but then again when have we ever said that class revolution was going to be a piece of piss. It's a hard slog but worth it the end.

Radical community resistance is not just about rioting and taking on the Old Bill, it goes a lot further. There needs to be a development within our communities, where there is a relationship between street-fighters and the rest of our communities.

It's about attacking our enemies and consolidating and building up our gains. Every man, woman, child, young or old, all



riot or not.

It's our ability to care for each other and BULLSHIT. tend to all the vital services we can possibly cater for, by ourselves, and for ourselves; their community, is when ordinary working which eliminate the excuse of letting in the social (control) workers, who supposedly are meant to help us, but become just another set of parasitical creatures.

In the end it is us who can only determine what we really need, and to deal with our probiems which occur in our community. Don't be fooled, the state only wants to help you in order to control you; we can help ourselves.

The one thing that is needed to deal with the anti-social and counter-revolutionary elements in our communities (like informers, racists, those who rob off their own, wifebeaters, etc.) IS class justice.

This conjours up visions of crazed vigilante gangs who beat up anybody they disagree with or don't like the looks of, in many ordinary people's minds.

But this has been due to the constant

build up these communities of resistance, media bombardment which tries to imply that whether they are in the middle of a full-scale if we, OURSELVES, seek justice in our own way, it will always turn out reactionary - this is


> A fine example of people taking action in class people took up an anti-heroin campaign in Dublin (see other story).

> When does this justice start getting dispensed? During the riots, when we're building the barricades of the revolution? NO! It starts now. With thinking about what you'd do if you saw your mate's house getting broken into, if you saw a woman being harassed, if you saw a racist attack.

#### COMMUNITY

There's got to be a much better answer than calling in the cops, setting up a neighbourhood watch scheme, or just letting it happen, hoping it will go away.

It starts now, by reacting to anti-social acts, by making sure that the community knows about these acts, as Class War supporters in North Bristol did when a local man was knifed for asking some kids to quieten down outside his front door. (see poster)

#### **IRISH WOMAN Barbara MacKey** recently had to travel from her home in Listowel, Co. Kerry to London for an operation that is not available to woman in Ireland - an abortion.

Barbara died of liver failure ten days after the operation, which was performed at the Rosslyn Clinic in West London. The Irish government has prevented Well Woman clinics from giving counselling/information to women who may need to travel to Britain for an abortion.

#### MORALIST SCUM

As a result there is a tendency for women to have their pregnancies terminated later resulting in increased stress and health risks.

The moralist scum SPUC (Society for the Protection of Unborn Children) have been campaigning alongside the church to stop the free distribution of information. These

bastards think they have the right to screw up womens' lives by denying them control over their own bodies.

SPUC not only want to stop abortion information they are against all forms of contraception and have even taken legal action to stop the Virgin Megastore in Dublin selling condoms.

These people should be treated like the backward, bigoted filth that they are. All laws and injunctions against counselling and information must be broken. The unavailability of abortion in Ireland and the need to travel to England effects working class women most of

The cost of the trip and the operation is beyond many peoples reach. Others cannot tell their families why they are going and recieve little or no support when they return. No woman's health should depend on her ability to pay for treatment.

In Ireland the fight for womens' rights to control their own bodies is a fight against the State, the Church and against the middle class, slime SPUC.


#### FANATICS

BRANCH BANNERS FROM BARROW, DENBY GRANGE AND ALLERTON SILKSTONE MAKING THEIR LAST APPEARANCE AT A YORKSHIRE MINERS' DEMONSTRATION DUE TO IMPENDING CLOSURES.

THERE IS a mood of renewed rebellion in the Yorkshire coal fields, which is likely to continue despite a collapse of strike votes in support of action taken by the Frickley colliery.

The strike began at Frickley colliery and spread quickly to Bentley (also in the Doncaster area), and later on Kellingly colliery in North Yorkshire, as well as a number of super modern pits in Selby voted to join the action.

The strike came about because of the arbitrary sacking of A.Proverbs, an underground craftsman.

Proverbs went to work at 5 a.m., one morning, and worked in an underground tunnel in dense heat with little ventilation, until 9.30 a.m., when he sat down to wait for assistance in dismantling a machine, and where he nodded off for 10 minutes.

#### PICKETS

The proceeding few nights, Proverbs had been kept up by caring for his sickly newlyborn baby. The bad air and the exhaustion made him nod off only to be caught by a vindictive bastard of an undermanager. Did he wake him up and give him a warning? Not likely, he tip-toed passed him and got a witness so as to secure his sacking without further notice! No wonder the coalfield was charged up and ready for the flying pickets to arrive. However, Frickley is already tied up with injunctions and writs for previous actions taken, and was compelled to go by the book (ie. the Tories' Employment Act) and urge a ballot in support of strike action. Every pit in Yorkshire balloted for a strike in support of their fellow worker, British Coal waited with bated breath. WITH THE next election now being put back to next year, to the anger of the I Labour Party. Class War looks at the possibility of a Labour govern-ment coming to power, and whether it would really make any difference now to the working class of this country.

The Labour Party is called by many people on the left as the Party of the working class. Although it is true its the party that most working class people vote for, it can't be said that it has ever given the working class anything to deserve the loyalty it receives.

In fact the exact opposite is true, the Labour Party stands in the way of real change, it offers many people the illusion of change, it gives people a excuse not to organise and fight back.

Nowadays its politics don't even pretend to represent working class people. A watered down version of the Conservative party, with no real principals, what ever the Tory's say Labour parrot.

fact that the Labour Party has risen to its old position of a "credible alternative" more to do with a rejection of Tory policies than a support for Labour one's.

But a "credible alternative " for who and for what? Credible to the British ruling class, establishment and industry and for the safe handling of the bosses interests.

To get to this position, as always, the Labour party has ditched any kind of link with left-wing policies and ideas, and moved continuously to the right, picking up the centre parties ground and consequently they (the SDP and the Liberal Democrats) have declined, bringing us back to the old two horse race of labour or Tory: take your pick ...

But what does a Labour government really mean for the working class ?

The Labour Party is in a permanent state of crisis because, while it claims to represent the working class, its actions constantly prove that it does no such thing.

when we unite and take on the ruling class ourselves.

And not by voting for someone else to do it, but we will always be held back as long as people pin their hopes and dreams on a Labour party that will change nothing.

The Labour party is the enemy of the working class just as much as the Tories, there is absolutely no difference what-soever - a fact that many people find it hard to believe , or just don't want to believe. But reality is there, in history.

The Labour party in power has always acted in what it sees at the best interests of the British ruling class here and overseas.

#### LABOUR IN GOVERNMENT

Within six days of the Labour government taking office in 1945, it sent of terror through the "Ulsterisation" policy, withdrew Special Category status from Irish political prisoners, built the H-Blocks and OK'd the torture of Irish political prisoners.

Finally they agreed to give extra seats to the Loyalists to keep the Labour government in power in 1978/79 and supported the murder of ten Irish hunger strikers in 1981.

#### **RACISM & IMMIGRATION**

The Labour government introduced the Immigration Act in 1968 which removed the right of British passport holders to enter Britain unless they had a grandparent resident in the country. In 1969 they removed the right of admission to Britain from the husbands and 1 Joi fiances of immigrants.

The recent Labour Party Conference proved even more, that they have nothing to offer working class people. Not that it ever did, but now it doesn't even pretend.

Class War has never held any illusions about the Labour Party past or present. It is and always has been a softer version of Tories, When working class people are angry, offer them an alternative and call it a socialist government.

#### SHAKEN

The Tory Party is in crisis. After twelve years in office they are not only under attack for their policies, economic and political (which have worried the establish-ment and the stock markets with high interest rates and increasing inflation figures), but also they have been forced to dump their beloved leader (Thatcher) and the Poll Tax after working class people fought back.

All this has shaken the Conservative Party to its foundations; even the Gulf War didnt improve their ratings in the opinion polls much.



Left-wing groups like Militant say that rank and file pressure can force the next Labour government to carry out socialist policies. (they've been trying that for 26 years, and they call Class War dreamers!) Now there is a split, with the "Real Labour" emerging, as more Militants have been booted out of the Labour Party than are left in!

They just think that it's a problem of leaders who back down in the face of opposition from big business, the banks and international bosses organisations.

But this is a big con - for it is not a question of leadership that stops the Labour Party from implementing socialist policies, but the simple fact that Labour never have or never will be a Socialist party.

It never can be, even if it wanted to, for it is part of the capitalist system. Socialism (anarchism, whatever) comes about through Another thing that is worrying the Tories is the revolution from below (us the working class)

conscript troops into the Surrey Docks, London, to break a ten week old strike. Three months later a national dock strike was smashed by the Labour government with the use of 21,000 conscript troops.

In Greece after the Nazi surrender, 40,000 British troops were deployed to crush the revolutionary resistance.

They turned the troops on the Malayan Liberation movement. They crushed the rising revolt of Indonesian nationalism in the interests of Dutch Capitalism and Imperialism.

The Labour government used British troops to restore French rule in Vietnam, rearmed Japanese troops and condemned Vietnamese people to thirty years of bloody war.

The Labour government created Zionist Israel and paved the way for genocide against the Palestinian people.

In 1950, they declared illegal a boycott of a royal visit to Kenya and jailed its organisers. It then deployed tanks, planes and armed police across the Kenyan capital, Nairobi to crush a 18 day general strike.

In Ireland they strengthened and guaranteed the loyalist Six County police state by passing the Government of Ireland act in 1949.

In Germany in 1945 the Labour



Labour implemented the 1971 Immigration Act, when they got into power. This act also extended powers of deportation and introduced the disgusting "virginity" tests which were carried out on Asian women immigrants.

In searches for "illegal immigrants", Labour used hundreds of police in blanket raids. A quarter of the Metropolitan Police force was used to smash the Grunwick strike, in 1974, by Asian women workers.


They used 5,000 police to protect an NF meeting in Southall in 1979. The police, launched a massive attack on anti-fascists arresting 800 people, injuring 1,000 and killing Blair Peach.

#### CONCLUSION

There is no question that the Labour Party is an anti-working class party that can never bring about socialism and can never be reformed. The illusion, and the party, must be smashed.

It is one of the biggest obstacles in the way of working class resistance, change and revolution social and political. There is no other way.

After 12 years of the Conservative Party, people are desperate for change, desperate to get rid of all the shitty anti-working class laws that have been forced upon us - but these will only be smashed by working class people organising themselves, not by voting Labour in 1992. Just take the poll tax. If we would have listened to the Labour Party, who said they would get rid of the poll tax in a lifetime of government, we would have been waiting for seven years (if they would have got to power). Until then we would have had to pay up and suffer because "that's the law". Voting changes nothing, it just means a new capitalist government with a different name. The last Labour government was brought down by it's war against the working class brought down by the same people its supposed to represent. class War along with the majority of working class people know exactly what the Labour Party represents. It should be every socialist's task not to build the Labour Party but to smash it.



The people who samshed the coup did not oppose it in the hope of haviong a Western style capitalist democracy, they smashed it because they couldn't put bread on the table and clothes in the shops, For most people in USSR communism mean poverty, but this wasn't because communism failed, it was because communism, in its true form, never existed there in the first place.

THE FORM of communism that developed in the Eastern Bloc following the 1917 revolution was very different from that envisaged by the original Communist revolutionaries.

In fact, to even call the forms of goverwere developed from the 1920s' communist is an insult to the very word.

Stalinist propagandists in the East, who were equally determined to hold on to their power, and therefore told their people an equally ridiculous load of bollocks.

Both sides used the 'cold war' to justify the measures they adopted in the name of nment and economic management that 'national security' or 'defence of the motherland/fatherland', and to ensure that there was no real physical contact between ordinary working people from the East and West. All that we had to go on was the lies and hysteria that they fed us! This complete lack ofknowledge of course helped to increase the 'surprise' effect of the popular revolts that have occurred in the Eastern Bloc over the last three years. In reality of course there was nothing surprising at all that people in the East should revolt, and are continuing to do so. After decades of living as near slaves, under the control of party bureaucrats and secret police, with continuous shortages, and continuous wars, it was completely natural that one day the people would revolt. The behaviour of the ruling class in the East, for that is what they became, is in reality similar to that of our ruling class, as both of them are only concerned in through more subtle means of divide and increasing their power, and

But the real force behind their political U-turn (they are both life-long Communist Party bureaucrats) has has been the stirrings amongst the working class, who quite rightly reached the conclusion that things couldn't get any worse!

The best example of these early stirrings is the Solidarity movement in Poland from 1980 onwards, which put the wind up the ruling class across the whole Eastern Bloc.

Undoubtedly Solidaritys' early success gave encouragement to workers all over the East, and it did of course get much exposure/support in the West - the first revolt in the East to do so.

We now know there have been literally hundreds of revolts throughout the Eastern Bloc since it began, beginning with the Anarchist opposition to the betrayal of the 1917 revolution.



parliamentary democracy, and towards a mixed economy.

However, whilst some of the uprisings could be termed revolutionary in that leaders have been overthrown and systems changed (a bit), in no country can it be said that a social revolution has yet occurred, although events are far from over.

#### UNSTABLE

The reality for most workers remains much the same as it was 5 years ago - low wages, high prices, generally poor living conditions, and still little, or no real say in how their society is run.

They do have more freedom of movement, but have found the West doesn't want them.

They have also found that the problems of their old system has been made made much worse by exposure to Capitalism i.e. worse unemployment.

The West now admits that things will continue to get worse for much longer, indeed the West sees the East as so unstable that they can't even be bothered to make the initial investment required to exploit the cheap labour in the East.

The one party states, centrally planned economies, and secret police have as much

in common with real Communism as John Major has with Socialism, their degeneration, however, handed the West an excellent propaganda weapon, and enabled them to portray all things evil as Communist, even when they were obviously not.

Not only was the situation used to make Communism a dirty word, but Western propaganda also made the people of the East into some sort of ogres.

But the wall created between East and West, and the power of the military/security forces, ensured that until Solidarity, all revolts were kept more or less secret, and crushed ruthlessly.

The last decade or so has therefore seen a battle in the East between the Stalinist hardliners and the Liberals, with the former trying to keep the lid on the powder keg, and the latter seeking to let the peoples anger out a bit at a time, and if possible use it to their own advantage.

#### UPRISINGS

It should be stressed that neither were interested in what was best for ordinary people, they were only interested in ensuring that they stayed in control, and that there was not a revolution.

Their aim has been either to keep people down with guns and tanks, or



In short the workers in the East are now in the 'worst of both worlds', suffering simultaneously the failures of both the East and Wests economic systems (State Capitalism and State Communism).

#### TENSIONS

In many cases their new bosses/ruling class is almost exactly the same as the old. So was that struggle worth it?

Many workers may well feel bitter that so little is better now, and this is reflected in the increasing racial/ethnic/national/ religious tensions, there is now a power vacuum waiting to be filled.

And this is what is important for all those with libertarian politics. We have seen how easy it can be for others to overthrow their rulers. And workers in the East are unlikely to just lie down and accept the same old crap as before.

The potential for a true social revolution is there, is just means going out and organising for it.

#### REVOLTS

An example of this was the 'reds under the bed' hysteria, and the ridiculous hatred/ fear of 'Russkies'.

The greatest fear of the western ruling class was that their working class would realise and learn from the mistakes made in the name of Communism in the East, and we would come to realise the people in the East were, in fact, just like us!



It was therefore in the interests of the ruling class to create as big a division as possible between us and them.

They were of course aided in this by the

equally aware that they are sitting on a powder keg.

Just as every now and then our ruling class grants us reforms to make us think we're better off, so the more far-sighted rulers in the East have, over the last 20 years, commenced a process of liberalisation.

The best examples of this are Gorbachev and Yeltsin, who say they are in favour of a democratic society based on a mixed economy (part free market/part planned economy).


They have been forced into this largely by the economic mess the East is in, which is due largely to the enormous amounts spent on the military and security forces.



MOSCOW **DEMONSTRATOR** -WOUNDED FIGHTING THE COUP.






DUBBED "The rottwellers of the left" by some, the Class War Federation organised their first International Conference in the last week of September, in Shoreditch Town Hall, East London.

We drew encouragement from the popular revolts in Eastern Europe,




This was done through a process of debate, argument, discussion, constructive and negative criticism, ALL with a growing awareness of the different situations and cultures in which the class struggle has to operate.





#### DUPED



You must have a dim view of the working class, who are helplessly entrapped by 'meat-consumerism'; how could such a class, in your view, even achieve revolution.



DASTARDLY DEINI




...It seems the same can be said for the administrators of Rugby League according to "The Greatest Game," the fanzine of the Rugby League Supporters Association.

5, - A range of ways could be used to raise money without being unfair to ordinary fans. These include selling shares in the club to the supporters.

6, - Barcelona run a scheme similar to the Bond. As a result the ground is rarely two thirds full .

7, - The only good thing about Barcelona's scheme is that the members get to vote for the club chairman every four years. I wonder why Dein hasn't put this up as a benefit to Bond holders in Arsenal's scheme.

Thanks to the Arsenal fanzine 'One - nil down, Two - one up' for the Information.

Although Band Ald raised millions of pounds for charities in the developing countries to prevent famine, as well as resurrecting the careers of many pop stars well past their sell-by date, other events in following years have been less successful.

The two organisers, *Simon Dring* and *Chris Long*, who had worked on the Band Aid project decided to go one better and in publicising the event splashed out over £2.5 million on satellite links and a world pop concert.

They set up two parts to their organisation, one part was the trust responsible for donating the money raised to various charitable projects, while the other was a limited company called **Sport** for Sport Aid Ltd. set up to organise the events.

In the ensuing chaos the potential sponsor, 7-UP pulled out of the event, and less than the expected 750,000 runners

#### CHARITY HYPOCRISY

While thousands of ordinary people thought that by taking part they would help others less fortunate (or just more exploited) than themselves, they only ended up paying the wages of Dring and Long.

In a television interview Long admitted mistakes were made, however it seems he hasn't learned any lessons either. Since then he has set up another company called the **Challenge group** in order to promote sporting events. They were responsible for promoting a yachting grand prix on the Clyde. **This event lost a million pounds!** 

Charity is the tool used, not only to ease the guilt of the rich but to enable Wide boys like Dring and Long to make money out of misery.

Don't be fooled into thinking that your contribution is going to help someone less fortunate than you. It probably is going to pay for the all expenses paid piss ups laid on for the benefit of these so called professional money raisers.
