HASN'T THIS clever boy let the cat out of the bag?

This is a watershed election: If the Tories get in again they'll have had eighteen years of uninterrupted one party rule. No one under the age of 36 will have ever seen a change of government during their voting life.

Talk of democracy will be a hollow joke not even believed by Tory journalists.

A weighted electoral system, with hundreds of thousands not even on the electoral role - deprived of the choice to vote for two identikit leaders of two identikit parties.

This is coupled with the fact that Tory newspapers (most of 'em!) and vested economic interests will do the hatchet job on Labour during the pitiful election campaign if there are any blips in John Major's popularity ratings.

NO CHANGE

If Labour-voting Scotland goes its own way after the election, there'll be no way that Labour could ever defeat the Tories in England: it'd become crystal clear to millions that the ballot box can't really change anything.

The answer ISN'T to sit along with the rest of the Lefties, crying into their beer and dreaming about a Labour victory in 1997!

The fact is that with the electoral system offering no prospect of change, mass civil disobedience and direct action campaigns, like the anti-poll tax movement, will be seen as the only way that we can change things

If the one-party dictators of Eastern Europe can be overrun by mass people power, so can their opposite numbers here. The opportunities will be immense for our brand of fighting: nononsense class politics.

INSURRECTION

This summer, months of burying our heads up our bums or whining about the state of things would be madness. Let's get out on the streets and estates to build a vigorous movement of direct action and community resistance, to the government and all the politicians and civil servants who piss about with our lives.

Within a year of Thatcher's first election victory, working class communities rose up with the Summer Insurrection of 1981. Our lives are no different from then: we still have a ruling class, we still have politicians and we still get shafted because they're scared to let us run our own lives.

We can make the democracy of the streets reveal the 'democracy' of the ballot box as the complete impotent sham that it is.

It's time to make our voices heard; during the election campaigning of the political parties, at the anti-election rally in Trafalgar Sq, and at the town halls on election night.. and way, way after.

WHENEVER THE government, State or bosses start putting the boot into the working class, one of the stock responses you get from people is: "But we're supposed to be living in a democracy".

"Supposed" is the correct word. You don't have to live very long in this society - if you've got anything between your ears that is - before you realise how little control ordinary working class people have over their own lives.

And yet huge amounts of time and money have been spent in getting us to believe that the five yearly farce of electing a government means having control over our own lives. The ways in which our socalled democracy operates don't stand up to any kind of close scrutiny.

SCAM

For a start, look at the way in which the last two governments have carried on since the re-jigging of the constituency boundaries in 1983.

The Tories used the Boundary Commission to drastically alter the old parliamentary seats to cobble together constituencies which they thought they could win with no bother.

They changed the electoral map to ensure that they would be in with a good chance of winning every General Election, with Labour relegated to permanent opposition.

The Labour Party realised this and went to High Court to challenge it, the 'impartial' and 'non-political' judge promptly told them to sod off and the scam went ahead.

The result is that both the 1983 and '87 elections were won with a 'landslide' majority, enough to out vote any opposition, on any issue. They did this with the votes of 42% of those who could be bothered to vote (never mind those millions who aren't entitled to, or who didn't vote) which means 58% voted against them.

So this 42%, or just over eight million people, vote in a government that rules over fifty-five million people!

LACKEYS

Some people think that if we had a different system of voting - based on proportional representation or whatever that a better, more representative form of government would result.

But the sad fact is that even with the 'fairest' system of voting in the world, we would be still no nearer having control over our lives than we are at the moment.

The reason for this is obvious, you are not, and never will be, allowed to vote for the replacement of the people who hold the real power in our society. We are allowed to vote for the lackeys, the office boys

and girls who make sure the system runs smoothly, but never for the people who hold the ultimate control.

And who are they? The ruling class, a tiny percentage of the population who own and control the vast bulk of this country's wealth.

These are the people who organise 'investment strikes', runs on the pound - anything to sabotage a 'democratically elected' government that they don't like. Their power is backed up by the civil service, the police and the armed forces and is even given the moral blessing of the church.

REFORM

The whole parliamentary set-up, has never existed for any other purpose than to serve their interests, while they themselves have been, except for the prospect of revolution, immovable.

When you point this out people say, "Yes, but the ruling class fought against us getting the vote for years. So it must mean something?"

For centuries, until the 1832 Reform Act, this country was governed by 600 families through parliament. Only the rich were allowed any say.

They fought tooth and nail against giving the vote to more people because, then, parliament was a powerful institution representing their interests.

As more Reform Acts brought more of the population into the voting process the ruling class realised that if they were to preserve their power, another

form of government had to be created that they could depend

It's no coincidence that the origins of the modern civil service can be traced back to this period. A whole new power structure was created which, while it was supposed to 'assist' governments, in fact acquired enormous power on its own account.

They provide the government of the day with the backup and resources to implement whatever schemes they want to force onto us.

More sinister than the Whitehall pen-pushers are the so-called "Secret Service" and the upper reaches of the armed forces. Without exception they are the product of an upper class background and a select few public schools.

In his book "Spycatcher" Peter Wright tells of their attempts to bring down the go out the window, and we'll all be looking down the barrel of a gun. As a famous Tory politician said at the turn of the century "There are more important things than parliamentary majorities".

ENEMY

Parliament was never meant to preside over radical change. The nationalisations and the welfare state that came after World War Two only came about because millions of people weren't going to go back to the same shit as before the

As one Tory MP said at the time; "If we don't give them reform, they'll give us revolution".

One of the dumbest things people ever have to listen to is when some prat says: "We live in a free country". Were these people dropped on their heads when they were babies or what? What do they think the likes of

us by faceless civil servants, lied to and misled by power hungry politicians, harassed and beaten up on picket lines etc., if we resist we are fitted up, if we are a threat we are banged

All we can say, is if that's democracy, they can shove

But one last thought; this pox ridden system doesn't just carry on because the State and ruling class can rely on their brain-dead uniformed thugs to keep us under control.

LIES AND MYTHS

It carries on because there are many people who have swallowed the lies and myths of the system, who are willing to give up control over their own lives and leave everything to the powers that be, who, of course "always know best."

This has to change. As people see the main political parties merge into one, huge, capitalist blob. And what remains of the welfare state shattered into a thousand tiny pieces we should ask ourselves; how much more of this shit are we going to take?

To get rid of this system, and all the parasitic filth clinging to it, we should be coming together now to find out ways of finishing it off once and for all.

They are there to try to keep us in our place, the bottom, and them in theirs, the top. When Thatcher called the miners "The enemy within" she spoke for all her class, that's how they look



THEY ARE the natural party of government, or so they keep telling us.

and unemployment.



They seemed to promise an new age of wealth and freedom, but the truth, as we all found out, was a more centralised State, with a greater use of force against anyone who opposed it.

The so-called economic miracle of the 1980's turned out to be more a question of how

North Sea oil cash, and the flogging off of State industries could be wasted. Leaving us slap bang in the middle of the longest and deepest slump since the War. Apart from the millions constantly on the

those in work could afford a new car, video and a foreign holiday. But it was all on the never-never, and when work dried up the bailiffs soon took it all back.

While all this went on the Tories friends and backers; the rich and powerful did get richer and more powerful. Whilst wealth did not filter downtoworking class people, poverty, crime, homelessness, bankruptcy, unemployment and ill health did.


THE PARTY of the working class, we are told. It was formed in 1900 from the Independent Labour Party that was in turn founded in 1893 by Keir Hardie.

Labour's idea was for a working class party which would 'reform' capitalism to socialism and avoid the bloody conflict of a class war.

Labour

It had many people in it, then and now, who believe in the idea of a classless society where power is in the hands of everyone, not in the hands of a tiny few. They were influenced by Marx and believed that a "working class government" would bring the revolution closer.

Alongside them Labour has

many people who believe in social democracy. They want a society which cares for all but without challenging the basic economic system and its inequalities.

Labour had its day after World War Two. Their welfare state seemed to offer a future of increased wealth for all. The fact that capitalism goes through booms and slumps brought that idea crashing around their heads in the 1970's.

During the 70's Labour

paved the way for the Thatcherism of the 80's. It was Labour who allowed unemployment to double during 1977 to '79. It was Labour who started the cuts in the health and education services.

The new image of Neil Kinnock is a victory for the social democratic tradition over the more radical Marxist tradition in the Labour party. But both have been shown, over time, to be equally wrong.

Labour

Kinnock's drift from the left to the right of the Labour party happened because he realised that to gain political power you have to be acceptable to the

ruling class. You have to convince them that you do not threaten their power, or they will do everything in their power to destroy you. Just look at the way the Establishment and media layed into the ex-Labour leader Micheal Foot and eventually

destroyed him. While there are many in the Labour party who still want revolutionary change they will never see it from a Labour government, especially now since Labour is so like the Tories in its policies.

Founded out of the 1970's Ecology Party. The Greens hoped to follow the success of the Greens in Germany.

They are a strange mixture of libertarian idealists, back-tothe-land hippies and right wing protect-green-England types.!

They have a good understanding of capitalisms assault

on the environment and what it means for us. But their ideas on the way forward are confused and disturbing. At times they have argued for racist antiimmagration laws, and limits on how many kids we can have! As well as other oppressive

IDEALISTS

In an attempt to tame

capitalism parts of the Green party seem to see state control as the way forward. But, totally opposite to this they also argue for greater local democracy.

All this is typical of a party that is controlled by middle class idealists and misfits who, like the state communists of Eastern Europe, think they know best when it comes to building a new society.

After a recent party conference many of the best Greens left, disillusioned and pissed off with the way the party was being controled by the middle class careerists.

Despite all the hype the Greens can only offer, at best, to reform capitalism. The are no threat to the ruling class and never will be.

For most of that time it was the party of progression and change, against the traditionalists of the Tory Party. It took its support from the newly growing middle class of that

The radical vision of the working class after World War Two saw the loss of support to the Labour Party. Since then it has spent its time arguing for a

compromise between what it says is the class conflict base of the other two parties. Its activists used to be seen as a joke, with many of them typical middle class, bearded, sandal wearing vegetarians.

STUPID

These days, as the differences between Tory and Labour have all but disappeared, its call for a middle way seems more and more stupid.

With the founding of the short lived SDP, and its eventual merger with the Liberals, the

Liberal Democrats finally entered the 20th Century at last. But the romantic vision of 'caring capitalism', a society without class conflict where everyone is middle class, works hard, and gets a fair wage has not been lost.

The blinding fact that capitalism cannot work like that seems to have missed them.

They offer no challenge to the basic inequalities of this sick system.

And now that Fergie has taken to sitting under blue plastic pyramids we're faced with the prospect of a whole legion of Royal weirdoes living long and healthy lives.


HELP 'EM OUT...

A 14 YEAR OLD GIRL who was raped was denied the right to an abortion in the UK under the Irish constitution's "Right to Life" clause.

She only got permission from the Supreme Court when the uprour the decision provoked threatened the standing of the new Irish Prime Minister.

But where's the consideration for the victim?
There isn't any!

Despite the horrifying circumstances behind this case, again a woman's right to make up her own mind over her own body and future has been taken from her.

CONTROLLING WOMEN

Much Irish legislation is backward and bigoted, as one would expect in a catholicdominated country.

Divorce doesn't legally exist, the sale and distribution of contraceptives is regulated and abortion is illegal.

Not only is it illegal, but it is also against the law to provide information on abortion facilities abroad, or aid a woman in any way to have an abortion.

CONFUSING

Basically, the Irish government has laid down the law regulating irish citizens' activities abroad.

Recently, Dublin's largest public library withdrew from it's shelves a book which contained an a abortion clinic phone number in Australia! As if everybody who wanted an abortion could to fly to Australia to have it.

Most working class women find it difficult enough to get the money together to come to England. The actual legislation is vague and confusing, but right wing bigots zealously chase up anything they think may be an infringement of the law. Groups such as SPUC (Society for the Protection of the Unborn Child) and Family Solidarity are so powerful that they even set up their own parliamentary party.

But this comes as no surprise to us. The pathetic attempts of reasoning behind these groups is just another example of how those people who sit in comfortable, privileged positions, distant from the day to day realities of life force their backward moral values down on people, regardless of the implications to those involved.

Whatever the circumstances it's a womans right to choose and fuck the religious and moral ideologies that maintain this oppression of a woman's life.

NO NEWERS AGAINS

You might have noticed Anti-Nazi League posters, popping up all over - put up by the Socialist Workers Party.

They're also putting out adverts for support, in that wimpy liberal paper: The Guardian! The poster and advert highlight the wishy-washy politics behind the organisation: one, readers would be interested to know, that has no local branches, and no hope of any democracy. It panders more to the established left and other bleeding-heart liberals, rather than fighting fascism.

IRRELEVANT!

The poster campaign is a waste of money, and is irrelevant to fighting fascism. Pictures of Holocaust victims in WWII, and mugshots of French fascist leader, Le Pen, have little to offer antifascism in this country:

Neo-fascism has more to do with anti-immigrant racism than anti-semitism (though there are elements of anti-

like ANL, scared that fascists will bring about the Fourth Reich and destroy their precious 'democracy'.

1992...

Fascists might be stronger on the continent, but this is not the case here. Along with liberal politics, will come liberal helpings of middle class money (the real reason?).

It also provides an opportunity for the SWP to get a toe-hold into the European political scene. Hence the pictures of Le Pen and three coaches of ANLers at a recent demoin Paris. Europe = bigger markets for Trotskyite politics, no doubt!

But like their outdated propaganda campaigns, and futile attempts to push their politics on the continent, their actions over here speak for themselves:

On 2nd February, the ANL called a rally and 'expedition' in Bethnal Green, East London. Fifty or so ANL'ers turned up to listen to speeches, and wandered around an

semitism in the fascist movement); and will most people recognise Le Pen, or acknowledge him as a threat? In France, maybe, but in the U.K.?

For lifelong opportunists like the SWP leadership, crap politics have never stood in the way. So what will the SWP gain by setting up this front organisation?

Without doubt there will be Labour Party members etc, who rush into campaigns estate giving out leaflets. The fascists turned up armed with more than a few leaflets. Up to ten ANL'ers were attacked with at least one being hospitalised.

What are they up to? No security, no precautions. The fascists might be stupid, but compared to these wallies, they seem gifted.

MIDDLE CLASS WHINGERS

No doubt they'll whinge about it in their reports back to central command.

Their complete lack of understanding of the enemy (fascists in this case), goes hand in hand with lack of understanding of working class people who will not be convinced to join in the fight against fascism when they think that that the ANL is what anti-fascism is about.

Their attitude to fighting fascism is best summed up by a quote (off the record, off course) from one ANL leader, SWP hack Paul Holborrow: "I write books - I don't fight fascists".

NAFF

If that's the case, just stick to continental weekend trips, duff posters, selling naff badges and easing the consciences of liberals, and leave the fightback to the genuine anti-fascists.

GET THE FACTS STRAIGHT

Derek White did not die in Strangeways, but walked out. He died a couple of weeks later. He wasn't murdered inside, obviously, but he may well have been attacked, by prisoners OR screws - BUT, the real issue is not over alleged murder: that's just the excuse to fit-up the men who took on the prison system and got national coverage while they were doing it!


On the subject of violence, John Spencer, one of the Strangeways prisoners, was viciously attacked by EIGHT cops during a prison visit, in full view of other inmates and visitors. This took place DUR-ING the trial because he wouldn't turn Queen's Evidence.

He suffered serious head injuries, a broken nose and a

before you're allowed a special trial pass; the public gallery is encased in glass; and there's a dock made of toughened safety glass, with an opaque top. This is where the prisoners are kept.

PROTECTION

It serves to isolate them from their family and friends in the court and to create

This is what happens to working class people, whether black, white, Asian or Irish; when we stand up against the rich and their lackeys.


POLL TAX NEWS

LABOUR HELPS TORY TAX

ANYBODY WHO still has illusions about the Labour Party being the Party of the working class would've been knocked for six if they had listened to Parliament on Friday 21th Feb.

Labour's Bryan Gould released a set of official figures that proved that Labour Councils have been chasing non-payers harder than Tory ones! And not only that, Labour was also boasting about how the "poll tax would of collapsed without the efforts of Labour councils"!

It seems that in Labour areas non-payers were dragged through the courts quicker, and in far greater numbers than



Tory ones. And that was AFTER taking into account that Labour hold most of the large cities where there are highest rates of non-payment.

OFFER TO HELP

Labour's claim that it's forced into poll tax collection also got a hammering when Gould revealed that when the High Court ruled that computer evidence is inadmissible in poll tax cases, (see other story) Labour offered help to the

Tories to get the law changed quickly. Labour's excuse was that otherwise polltax collection would fall into "chaos".

Well, as the latest figures show that over 11,500,000 summonses have been issued in Britain it looks like chaos is what we've got at the moment anyway!

These figures show that an average of 26% of people had been threatened with court action in England and Wales. But in Scotland the figure rose to a whopping 77%!

POLL TAX CHAOS

POLL TAX collection ground to a halt on the 20th Feb. when the High Court ruled that councils computer printouts of non-payers were inadmissible in court.

This means that not only will local councils be unable to

take non-payers to court until late March (when a change in the law takes place) put that almost 150,000 people can appeal against their liability orders that were issued in the last three months.

Also, the 170 people jailed for non-payment have got good grounds to appeal for damages.

Jeremy Beecham, chair of the Association of Metropolitan Authorities leaves us in no doupt about serious the councils are seeing this;

"Magistrates are likely to throw out all applications for liability orders, and councils will be forced to stop issuing summonses."

To the manor burn!

This git, who works for Redditch council's bailiff firm, Bristow and Sutor, takes their policy of 'debt counselling' one step further. There have been a number of complaints about Stoke's threatening old ladies with iron bars and even posing as a copper to try and gain entry into peoples homes.

Bailiffs are well paid thugs whose job it is to intimidate people into parting with their belongings and hard earned money. The very nature of their trade means that their prey is people who are the most vulnerable.

IN MOST cities in Britain and Ireland joyriding goes on, it's the by product of a sick society that has nothing to offer working class youths except the dole, a crap government scheme, or a boring low paid job.

Cork, in Ireland, is no exception to this. What's different is the Gardai (police) have a novel way of try to stop joyriders. Because Cork cops don't seem to bother with the conventional ways, like chasing them for instance. They have more direct ways, and this let to the murder of a local youth, 21 year old William O"Hara.

William was the passenger in a stolen car, which didn't stop at a cop checkpoint, so a cop threw a brick at the windscreen, which smashed and hit William in the head. He died later after 15 days in a coma.

ANGER

This provoked an uprising amongst the local youths who put up graffiti: "Guards are murdering bastards", started fires and attacked first the fire brigade, and later the real targets - the Gardai. In an attempt to stop trouble, the night after William died the cops cruised the area arresting anybody out on the streets.

Predictably the media, cops and politicians all played down the trouble, and when they did report it was "crazed joyriders in fire brigade death ambush" type headlines. The truth was that the fire brigade were not the main targets, (good), and that there is a lot of real anger amongst people at the cops for murdering William. So it was hardly surprising when a newspaper reporter and photographer were attacked by the crowd at his funeral.

ECONOMICAL with the truth and unrestrained when it comes to laying off workers, British Coal has ran a series of full page ads in the national papers.

It described miners as "Britain's most successful businessmen", then announced a fortnight later that 1,705 of these underground entrepreneurs were to be made redundant.

The ads (which are part of a pre-privatisation campaign) starred miner Arnie Makinson from Stillingfleet Colliery in Yorkshire.

MAIMED

"Meet Arnie Makinson." The caption went. "He's a member of a workforce that's more than doubled productivity in just five years. He may not be Sir John Harvey Jones (former ICI Boss) but, as far as we're concerned, he's got as much to offer".

What Arnie hasn't got is a little and index finger on his right hand because they were crushed by coal cutting machinery. A maimed miner probably wouldn't do much good for the industry's image, so a British Coal photographer took a snap of Arnie with his hands tucked out of sight.

Arnie is still having surgery for the injuries and has lodged a hefty claim for compensation with British Coal.

AXED

Meanwhile British Coal Chairman Neil Clarke is planning to play Paul Daniels and make another 33 pits 'disappear' - because a 'streamlined' coal industry would be more attractive to investors.

Clarke learnt all about profitable mines during his time in South Africa, and the man who still says 'blick pipple' when he means 'black people' should be extremely cautious the next time he goes below ground to inspect a pit.

After all, the coal cutting machinery is liable to go haywire at any point, and Clarke might just find that jobs aren't the only things that can be axed.

THERE'S ONE set of morals for the poor and another for the rich.

If you're working class and you get caught shoplifting you're supposed to hang you head in shame - then spend the rest of you life hiding behind the curtains hoping the neighbours don't find out you're a thief.

When the rich steal it's called 'enterprise' and the national papers pay them thousands for their story.

Take the case of Peter Clowes who managed to persuade thousands of pensioners to part with £113m worth of savings which then vanished.

BORROWED

In an 'exclusive' interview with Today his wife, Pamela explained that Peter wasn't actually lying when he took the cash on the grounds that he was going to invest it; he did invest it - in himself.

As Peter put it, he didn't steal the money, he "borrowed it" and then put it somewhere safe. And you can't get any safer than houses, which explains why Peter bought a

French Chateau, two penthouses and a £250,000 converted farmhouse in Cheshire.

And since sitting on, or rather in, people's money is stressful work, Peter had to buy a £2.5m yacht, a private jet and a fleet of cars to help him relax.

Pamela Clowes is finding it hard to understand why the thousands of small investors who Peter 'borrowed' from wanted to press charges. As far as she's concerned Peter's got butter in his mouth and it's still not melting. "I'm proud of Peter. He has done nothing wrong," she said.

In fact Pamela would probably say that Peter did the country a favour and eased the burden on the welfare state by helping six hundred penniless pensioners climb into an early grave.

Some of those who died after the fraud were to have discovered committed suicide. Pamela believes Peter's ten year sentence is a bit harsh con-sidering that all he did was steal £113m and help rid the world of a few decrepit old

grannies. Maybe it is a touch unfair considering that in the same month that Clowes started his ten year stretch, Lorna Emmerson, a working class woman from Harrogate, was given 15 months for stealing £360 from her employers.

If Clowes had been given 15 months for every £360 he'd stolen he'd have been sent down for precisely 392,381 years and 1 month.







THE STATE OF THE UNION

Recently, there's been a lot of interest and speculation about Scotland becoming independent. This article fills in the important gaps that the media and politicians have chosen to leave out...

START we're making it clear that we think that the end of the union between Scotland and England is a good thing.

This brief article explains why. Where we differ with the nationalists is over what sho-uld come after the Union is broken.

For a few years sections of the Scottish media and establishment have been becoming more excited about the idea of independence. The 'quality' press like "The Glasgow Herald" and "The Scotsman" are at times almost mouthpieces for the Scottish National Party, SNP,.

Most recently the scottish edition of "The Sun", has been running front page headlines saying: "RISE NOW AND BÉ À NATION ONCE AGAIN!"

So, are the streets full of nationalist demonstrations? Are strikes being called to break the link with England? Is there a mass campaign to stop paying taxes to London. Well no - not yet, despite the best efforts of parts of the media and some politicians.

CAPITALIST REASONS

What'shappening is that some sections of the and ruling middle classess can see the possibilities of rich pickings for themselves an independent Scotland as 'Great Britain' declines in economic and political power within Europe.

Capitalism is going through a massive reorganisation: right now the trend is towards bigger economic and social units that combine many nation

states.



The EEC is one of these .If these supertrade blocks are to work, the individual states within them are going to have to lose much of their independence and even bec-ome broken down into smaller units. This capitalist experi-ment is what the SNP's hopes are riding on.

BRITAIN - HOW IT ALL BEGAN

Despite all the efforts of the nationalists, the London establishment does not take their demands for independence seriously.

As usual colonial arrogance is preventing them from seeing the situation clearly: it's only

the recently that government seems to have realised that there is campaign independence at all!

Yet the history of the British Empire shows that once the nationalist bandwagon starts rolling, it can be hard to stop, Scotland could soon be at just such a point.

The United Kingdom of Britain is beginning to fall apart into its component parts. All nation states are artificial creations, a line on a map can only signify a piece of property it does not define what sort of people live there or their culture, language or histories. Nowhere is this more true than in the UK.

The British state was created by violence, treachery and bribery with



BRITAIN IS THE PROBLEM

The whole of Britain. but especially the 'edge'. is increasingly suffering from being held hostage to the needs of the City of London.The financiers need a high interest rate and artificially high sterling exchange rate to do their business with the rest of the world.

Present day Scotland is a good example of the stag-nation of those areas on the edge of the British State Its heavy industries went into decline in the 60's with mass unemployment and a sharp rise in emmigration. It never really had a boom like the south, its economy is still largely dependent manufacturing.

Whereas the south of England had a much more diverse industrial base that protected it from much of the worst of the last 20 year long recession that the rest of the UK experienced - until now that

Much of Scotland outside the cities continues to be owned by absentee landords and used as giant tax havens and leisure parks by the upper classes.

In common with scenic areas of Wales and England rural Scotland is being invaded by the wealthy who are using it for retirement homes, second homes and holiday homes.

The effect of this invasion is to price local people out of the housing market completely this together with the government ban on council house building has been a complete disaster for working class people in these areas.

In the North and the small area of the South Islands, there are people with children living in mobile homes and in some cases even tents.

IDENTITY Because of this there has been something of a cultural revival in Scotland recently, rather like the one that took place in Ireland towards the end of the nineteenth century

With this has come a widespread more understanding of the colonial nature of Scotland's past - and present.

Scotland's radical past and its contribution to the worlds' revolutionary traditions is being recognised and reclaimed.

The work of groups like "Workers City" in combatting the Glasgow's Euopean City of Culture pantomine shows what can be done to fight the distorted images and history that are being pushed at us. They have been engaging in a kind of cultural guerilla war with the Glasgow bourgeousie and scoring some major successes!

This heightened selfawareness is leading some to question the present, especially the connection with England and the continued colonial

occupation of land and industry by the English and Anglo-Scottiish upper classes.

A PARCEL OF ROGUES!

In 1792 Scotland's national poet, Robert Burns (the Immortal Bard!) wrote a bitter and angry poem called "A parcel of rogues"about how in 1707 the gentry of Scotland agreed to the union with England(in return for money, land priveliges from the english upper class:

"What force or guile could not subdue, Thro' many warlike ages, Is wrought now by a coward few, for hireling traitors' wages"

Today in Scotland the same kind of rogues are lining up to sell their own people again to the highest bidders.

CHANGE OF BOSSES

This time they are scheming under the banner of an 'independent' Scotland-which of course Scotland means dominated by European instead English of capitalism.

The only change in their new Scotland will be at the top. We will have a change of Boss with Scots filling the posts in the new Scottish state and negotiating the best prices they can get for our labour power and our country's natural resources on the international market.

And what an ugly bunch they are! Alex Salmond the sleekit wee who leads the Scottish National Party, SNP, could be the first scottish prime minister.

Even worse, the Scottish Constitutional Convention that has been meeting, consisits of the 'great and the good', their self appointed task has been to determine what shape the future government should take even down to details like what electoral system to use and taxes to levy.



The rogues who make up this convention include Church Scotland, the Labour Party and the Liberal Democrats with a sprinkling of landowners and aristocrats, the natural enemies of the working class.

An independant Scotland is certainly a feasible proposition from a


IDEAS OF OUR OWN

After the spectacle last month of the queen celebrating 40 year as top Royal, we ask the question, should the monarchy be abolished... or beheaded?

Well believe it or not, there's still people (an ever decreasing number thankfully) who reckon 'old queenie' is alright really good for the tourist trade etc.

This support has got to be pretty bad, particularly when it comes from working class people, duped by all



the crap about her being an 'asset to the nation'. But how many people have false pride in the royals or who travel the world to stand in the drizzle at the gates of Buckingham Palace is not what this article is about

One argument against the monarchy comes from some on the left who follow in the tradition of republicanism. These date back to the French Revolution, but few latter day republicans want a repeat of the aristocratic bloodbath France enjoyed. **BENN'S BLEATING**

Their argument is that having a monarchy, even one with very few real powers, is not in keeping with modern democratic principles.

The likes of Tony Benn argue that "the monarchy is actually an elaborate cover for a structure of unaccountable executive, which is absolutely contrary to all the principles of democracy" (he then pauses for a swig of tea and a puff on his pipe) he goes on ...

"the 'royal prerogative' enables prime ministers to go to war, make treaties, appoint peers, bishops and judges, without even pretending to consult parliament"

These arguments are weak. Most countries in the world are republics and though they have varying degrees of democracy, they are all part of the global capitalist economy.

It is in the interests of big business that most decisions are made, whether or not ceremonial figure-heads get consulted is a smokescreen to this fact.

But, while we're talking about big business, the royal family suddenly come back into the picture, undoubtedly the richast woman in Britain if not the world, the queen heads a family with wealth and assets totalling £7 BILLION. And despite this huge sum the queen gets £57 million every year from the tax payer!

CAPITALISTS -

The royal family are not, as the media makes out, quaint, inoffensive, corgi/horse/plant lovers. They are ultra -rich capitalists presiding over massive amounts of shares and land, dealing in business, industry and property the world over.

Well, where do you start? It's not just their insulting antics (Fergie), their hypocritical prattle about charity

UNDERSTANDING OF GREEN ISSUES something in common with (princess Anne), or the poxy remarks about schooling and them and use this to get us to architecture (Prince Charfight for them.

THE QUEEN SHOWS HER

ROTTEN

We have no more reason to like them than we have to like George Bush or Saddam Hussein.

But their propaganda produces an irrational love for them which called patriotism. This, like royalty itself, stinks, and the sooner they, and all they stand for, take their rightful place alongside the rotting Maxwells of the world, the better for us all.



IN BRISTOL, squatting groups and others including Class War have set out to take squatting out of its 'alternative' ghetto.

Bristol has the worse record of homelessness outside London. Everybody including the bleeding hearted liberals have noticed the increase in people dossing out on the streets or in derelict buildings.

Though this is the visible side of the homelessness, there are thousands more living in Bed & Breakfasts, Hostels, friends floors, shacking up with relatives or renting sub-standard accomodation.

HARD WORK

Squatting has been going on in Bristol for a long time; Bristol Housing Action Movement has been doing a lot of hard work housing people

through squatting. But up to now squatting has been confined to the inner-city and has been largely part of an "alternative" scene activity.

BLITZ The SQUATTING ACT-ION CAMPAIGN was set up to push forward the idea of squatting being used as an option by the ever-increasing numbers of the homeless.

The campaign has carried out a poster blitz on as many of the 4,000 empty houses as possible, highlighting the problem Also a demo in front of the poshest hotel in Bristol was organised and a SQUAT ACTION CENTRE was opened in order to give advice and to help the home-less into vacant homes.

The Action Centre, was previously an estate agents before being left dormant for five years. But this didn't stop

owners Swinton Insurance taking out an injunction pronto, to be heard in Manchester (where their headquarters are) Justice went it's perverse way, with the help of an old codger, the judge.

The centre had a lot of support and was well used by people wanting legal advice or help in opening up a squat.

And despite Swintons attempts, the centre has not shut but simply moved down the road a little!



For the last 10 months, native villagers in Penan, Central Borneo, Malaysia, have been beating the bosses, cops and the army...

Malaysian authorities are so worried and caught unawares, that they've tried to stop the story of struggle getting out.

In the Penan's native homeland, in Central Borneo, thousands of trees are bulldozed into valleys to make temporary roads; small trees are burnt; there is the huge waste of 40 foot high piles of felled trees rotting by the river: the logging company scum only use 30% of all felled trees!

In fighting back against the pirate logging companies who want to butcher their native homeland for a few quick bucks, the Penan people tried passive resistance... but that only resulted in arrests, and didn't stop the slow genocide of the villagers.

BEING PASSIVE DIDN'T WORK

So now, fighting firmly for their self-determination, for their own lands, they set up a blockade beside the British-built bridge that brings in the loggers and their equipment.

The blockade was set up at night, in pitch dark, by several hundred determined

Penan.

The ridiculous mess that capitalism and greed has made of the situation is best outlined by the workers from the big corporations, who freely admit:

"We know what we're doing is wrong..we can see there's no fertile land left after logging. All that grows is a type of creeper covering dead trees. We don't know why they want to go on and on into new areas".

Well, we do: the answer is out-and-out capitalism at the expense of people and their homeland. The Penan know too.

In a desperate measure, the logging company threat-

ened to charge the blockade with bulldozers.

DARTING FOR COVER!

The Penan responded by saying that if this happened, they'd use their poisoned blowpipes - both the army and the company shat and ran, and the blockade still remains, despite as yet empty threats that the logging companies will burn the blockade down.

If they try it, we're sure the Penan, having prior warning, will be ready to score 180 -: by all accounts their darts are something else!

Later, at the same college, a political debate was arranged between the Tories, Labour, Liberal Democrats, SWP and Class War. So it was very odd when a 'united front' of all the other parties said that if Class War came they'd all drop out! What are they scared of???

Overreaction was also the order of the day when twenty Fed members went to Gravesend, Kent, for a big paper sale and to meet the local activists. The cops had been going

Never ones to miss an opportunity, an impromptu public meetings was held with the Fed speaker going down really well and Class War having a big impact.

One - Nil to us!

'DREAM ON' 120 mins (15 cert)

In September 1991 the world became aware of the Meadowell Estate, North Shields.

But for five years before the riots, Kitty Fitzgerald, a member of Amber collective had been working on the estate, forming a writing group for women and writing 'Dream On'. In painting a realistic picture of daily life on the Meadowell estate, 'Dream on' is no tourist information film.

It follows the lives of three women and the way they deal with domestic violence, drink problems, debt and so on.

The film doesn't fall into the trap of sentimentality or of portraying the women as victims. In fact there is an overwhelming sense of pride in this film. It shows the way that working class people overcome difficulties with honour and anger. The three central characters are all

played by local actresses, with Anna-Maria Gascoigne making a considerably better performance than her more famous brother Gazza!

The strength of the film lies in the fact that Amber is a well established, local film co -op, who have a twenty three year history of making working class films on Tyneside. What is amazing is that this, their latest feature, ever got made. It's also heartening that it's on at the Odeon instead of some obscure arty cinema. We're sick of watching shite films that have nothing to do with our lives (this is definitely not one of them).

'Dream On' also has a great soundtrack with Dusty Springfield, The Fortunes and The Shadows to name a few. What more do you want! If you only go to see one film this year, make it this one.







'MISSISSIPI MASALA' 112 mins (cert. 15)

This film, by the progressive Asian woman director, Mira Nair, charts the story of a Ugandan Asain family: through exile from Idi Amin's regime, to life, work and cultural differences with a whole mix of social unity and disunity in modern-day Mississipi.

It's made with politics, humour, a lot of power and an obviously deep understanding of the day-to-day struggles facing young people growing up within two very different cultures - Don't miss it!

Despite this film being nearly three hours long it's a cracker!

It's about the assassination of President Kennedy in Dallas in 1963.

The film starts with a rundown of the political situation at that time.

It comes to the conclusion that the CIA, the Military and a bunch of loony right-wing Cuban exiles were behind the assassination of the President because he was unlikely to back them in a war against both Castro and Vietman.

'JFK' 200 mins (cert. 15)

It does this by showing Kevin Costner as a district attorney, struggling to bring one of the conspirators to trial four years after the event.

Throughout most of the film you are allowed to make up your mind as more and more proof of the conspiracy shows up, and this is what is good about it.



"On the morning of a fourth successive Tory victory, we would have to recognise that we are living in a different country; a place not so very far off a oneparty state, in which only the party of the wealthy and powerful is ever likely to rule". Robert Harris, Sunday Times.

HASN'T THIS clever boy let the cat out of the bag?

This is a watershed election: If the Tories get in again they'll have had eighteen years of uninterrupted one party rule. No one under the age of 36 will have ever seen a change of government during their voting life.

Talk of democracy will be a hollow joke not even believed by Tory journalists. -

A weighted electoral system, with hundreds of thousands not even on the electoral role - deprived of the choice to vote for two identikit leaders of two identikit parties.

This is coupled with the fact that Tory newspapers (most of 'em!) and vested economic interests will do the hatchet job on Labour during the pitiful election campaign if there are any blips in John Major's popularity ratings.

NO CHANGE

If Labour-voting Scotland goes its own way after the election, there'll be no way that Labour could ever defeat the Tories in England: it'd become crystal clear to millions that the ballot box can't really change anything.

The answer ISN'T to sit along with the rest of the Lefties, crying into their beer and dreaming about a Labour victory in 1997!

The fact is that with the electoral system offering no prospect of change, mass civil disobedience and direct action campaigns, like the anti-poll tax movement, will be seen as the only way that we can change things

If the one-party dictators of Eastern Europe can be overrun by mass people power, so can their opposite numbers here. The opportunities will be immense for our brand of fighting: nononsense class politics.

INSURRECTION

This summer, months of burying our heads up our bums or whining about the state of things would be madness. Let's get out on the streets and estates to build a vigorous movement of direct action and community resistance, to the government and all the politicians and civil servants who piss about with our lives.

Within a year of Thatcher's first election victory, working class communities rose up with the Summer Insurrection of 1981. Our lives are no different from then: we still have a ruling class, we still have politicians and we still get shafted because they're scared to let us run our own lives.

We can make the democracy of the streets reveal the 'democracy' of the ballot box as the complete impotent sham that it is.

It's time to make our voices heard; during the election campaigning of the political parties, at the anti-election rally in Trafalgar Sq, and at the town halls on election night.. and way, way after.

WHENEVER THE government, State or bosses start putting the boot into the working class, one of the stock responses you get from people is: "But we're supposed to be living in a democracy".

"Supposed" is the correct word. You don't have to live very long in this society - if you've got anything between your ears that is - before you realise how little control ordinary working class people have over their own lives.

And yet huge amounts of time and money have been spent in getting us to believe that the five yearly farce of electing a government means having control over our own lives. The ways in which our socalled democracy operates don't stand up to any kind of close scrutiny.

SCAM

For a start, look at the way in which the last two governments have carried on since the re-jigging of the constituency boundaries in 1983.

The Tories used the Boundary Commission to drastically alter the old parliamentary seats to cobble together constituencies which they thought they could win with no bother.

They changed the electoral map to ensure that they would be in with a good chance of winning every General Election, with Labour relegated to permanent opposition.

The Labour Party realised this and went to High Court to challenge it, the 'impartial' and 'non-political' judge promptly told them to sod off and the scam went ahead.



UNELECTED: the Queen, richest woman in the world

The result is that both the 1983 and '87 elections were won with a 'landslide' majority, enough to out vote any opposition, on any issue. They did this with the votes of 42% of those who could be bothered to vote (never mind those millions who aren't entitled to, or who didn't vote) which means 58% voted against them.

So this 42%, or just over eight million people, vote in a government that rules over fifty-five million people!

LACKEYS

Some people think that if we had a different system of voting - based on proportional representation or whatever that a better, more representative form of government would result.

But the sad fact is that even with the 'fairest' system of voting in the world, we would be still no nearer having control over our lives than we are at the moment.

The reason for this is obvious, you are not, and never will be, allowed to vote for the replacement of the people who hold the real power in our society. We are allowed to vote for the lackeys, the office boys

and girls who make sure the system runs smoothly, but never for the people who hold the ultimate control.

And who are they? The ruling class, a tiny percentage of the population who own and control the vast bulk of this country's wealth.

These are the people who organise 'investment strikes', runs on the pound - anything to sabotage a 'democratically elected' government that they don't like. Their power is backed up by the civil service, the police and the armed forces and is even given the moral blessing of the church.

REFORM

The whole parliamentary set-up, has never existed for any other purpose than to serve their interests, while they themselves have been, except for the prospect of revolution, immovable.

When you point this out people say, "Yes, but the ruling class fought against us getting the vote for years. So it must mean something?"

For centuries, until the 1832 Reform Act, this country was governed by 600 families through parliament. Only the rich were allowed any say.

They fought tooth and nail against giving the vote to more people because, then, parliament was a powerful institution representing their interests.

As more Reform Acts brought more of the population into the voting process the ruling class realised that if they were to preserve their power, another

form of government had to be created that they could depend

It's no coincidence that the origins of the modern civil service can be traced back to this period. A whole new power structure was created which, while it was supposed to 'assist' governments, in fact acquired enormous power on its own account.

They provide the government of the day with the backup and resources to implement whatever schemes they want to force onto us.

More sinister than the Whitehall pen-pushers are the so-called "Secret Service" and the upper reaches of the armed forces. Without exception they are the product of an upper class background and a select few public schools.

In his book "Spycatcher" Peter Wright tells of their attempts to bring down the

go out the window, and we'll all be looking down the barrel of a gun. As a famous Tory politician said at the turn of the century "There are more important things than parliamentary majorities".

ENEMY

Parliament was never meant to preside over radical change. The nationalisations and the welfare state that came after World War Two only came about because millions of people weren't going to go back to the same shit as before the

As one Tory MP said at the time; "If we don't give them reform, they'll give us revolution".

One of the dumbest things people ever have to listen to is when some prat says: "We live in a free country". Were these people dropped on their heads when they were babies or what? What do they think the likes of

us by faceless civil servants, lied to and misled by power hungry politicians, harassed and beaten up on picket lines etc., if we resist we are fitted up, if we are a threat we are banged

All we can say, is if that's democracy, they can shove

But one last thought; this pox ridden system doesn't just carry on because the State and ruling class can rely on their brain-dead uniformed thugs to keep us under control.

LIES AND MYTHS

It carries on because there are many people who have swallowed the lies and myths of the system, who are willing to give up control over their own lives and leave everything to the powers that be, who, of course "always know best."

This has to change. As people see the main political parties merge into one, huge, capitalist blob. And what remains of the welfare state shattered into a thousand tiny pieces we should ask ourselves; how much more of this shit are we going to take?

To get rid of this system, and all the parasitic filth clinging to it, we should be coming together now to find out ways of finishing it off once and for all.


