It's been an old cliche, that any trend doing the rounds in the US will soon be hitting the shops in Britain and Europe.

But that's not all that gets borrowed from the Americans.

The way the U.S. ruling class control America has given more than a few pointers to our ruling class, in their economic and social policies.

NIGHTMARE

Grey-faced John Major's verbal diarrhoea about US style Work-fare scheme for Britain's 'idle masses' highlights one of our worst nightmares - going down the road of capitalist America.

Now, we're not knocking the Yanks as a people, but their country is the richest and most class divided nation on the planet. Dynasty lifestyles neighbour soup kitchens and cardboard box cities. Sounds like London, doesn't it?

The British government has been influenced by the US's attempt to solve the crisis of capitalism and batter the working class at the same time. The New Right coming to power in the US (Reagonomics) and in Britain (Thatcherism), consolidated

Despite all their talk of "rolling back the state", they have in fact built a slimmer but more authoritarian state. Less services and more social control.

CONTROL

Killing two birds with the same stone, the New Right pushed forward the selling of state services (allowing big business to venture into new markets, and profits) while the state's responsibility to run services is reduced.

It can now concentrate on the institutions of social control; a stronger police force, more prisons and a bureaucratic and draconian welfare system.



The added bonus to them of using the sell-offs to fund tax cuts to gain electoral support has happened both sides of the Atlantic. In the US, elections can be won or lost on tax policies. When you realise that less than 50% vote in elections, you get an idea who benefits.

WORKFARE IS WARFARE

Mass unemployment and the workfare scheme have engineered to been reconstruct the labour market, the way the bosses want it.

Across the Atlantic, the reconstruction is more advanced, with a low-paid pliable workforce: - 'do what your told or piss off.

Back home there has been a Workfare scheme in effect for 16-18 year olds -Youth Training, with little opposition because the opinions of working class 16-18 year olds are worth jack

Workfare will bring a whole new layer of low paid jobs, affecting the whole labour market by bringing down wages. The unemployed or scheme workers, are and will continue to be socially isolated (through bad press), and scapegoated for bringing down the rates of pay. Blaming the victim not the perpetrator.

SMUG BASTARDS

The smug Tory bastards are all too keen to play the other side of the coin, blaming the workers themselves for high unemployment. 'Pricing themselves out of the market' is their excuse, not ours!

They make out that potential allies in our class are the causes of all your problems. DIVIDED, FOOLED, AND RULED - is often the only defence the ruling class can rely upon. It works and it hurts.

Americans; it's the blind logic of capitalism and the state. Staggering on, trying to find a way for the class system to adapt and survive and create more wealth for the powerful.

In the US the New Right faltered, electorally, with Bush's defeat. The Clinton administration will be more practical and imageconscious.

The Tories have been on the rocks for some time now, but don't be lulled into the illusion that they'll keel over and die. They are ploughing

> on with their rightagenda wing (privatisation and nasty pieces of state legislation).

The captain's changed, but the Tory ship is still on course despite severe some Maastricht-like political storms.

working class. We don't have to win elections or even relieve our 'radical' consciences, what we have to do is basically survive.. with nothing more to





As usual, their so-called 'evidence' gained during the mobilisation against the fascist band, Skrewdriver, last September (otherwise known as the Battle of Waterloo), was invented. But this time, they excelled themselves; their spelling mistakes were identical!

When it was put to two cops that it was slightly odd that both had managed to misspell all the same words, the bumbling fools completely denied it!

The defending solicitor called it "astonishing". The cops called it sheer coincidence and sod all to do with them making up evidence in the police canteen. If anyone believes that they probably

there to protect us all as we sleep in our beds at night.

The coppers were so daft that even the eyes of the law had no choice but to throw the case out as a result of a foolish fit-up. Even the prose-

cutor didn't complain, what could he say? "Well, your honour, I must put it to you that both of these police officers are equally thick!"

This was another success from Waterloo - many of the anti-fascist defendants have been acquitted and no one is facing serious charges - and a good thing too. After all, the beating of neo-nazis gathering at Waterloo Station on their way to a fascist gig deserves medals, not punishment.

The Battle of Waterloo took place when Skrewdriver's nazi organisation 'Blood and Honour' tried to organise a London gig. The last time they tried was in 1989 with the so-called 'Main Event'. They were beaten off the streets on that

occasion, and ran off to Germany to lick their wounds.

With the rise of fascism there they obviously thought it was time to crawl out from under what ever stone they had been hiding beneath, and hold a nationally advertised gig, with its meeting point as Waterloo station.

Due to Anti-Fascist Action mobilising for it the nazi's were beaten and chased off the streets. Up to fifty bonehead, beer-bellied bully boys were hurt, some seriously.

A Blood and Honour spokesman, who had earlier been offering the media interviews saying; "you'll be able to spot us, they'll be 1,000 of us there", was whining afterwards to the Guardian about how everybody hates them and "what about our freedom of speech."

The fight against these swastika shitheads has to be both political and physical they must never even think they can control or dominate our streets. That's why Waterloo was a major defeat for them and one that turned the slogan "they shall not pass" into a reality.



kwik save... CEANUP fast buck!

The New year saw the start of a so-called 'price war' between supermarket chains.

Sainsburys claimed to have discounted 1000's of products in a mass publicity splash. The other chains rushed out their own discounts, and everyone claimed they had the lowest prices and rubbished their rivals.

Despite clear evidence that many discounts weren't quite what they claimed to be, the media announced it was a shoppers paradise.

GIVE AWAYS?

many stores seemingly offering ever greater price cuts, shoppers may ask the question - how can they afford to do it? Well one things for sure, they're not giving the stuff away.

In reality stores will carry a loss on some lines, as by having seduced you into the store they know they'll make more money on all nondiscounted goods we need to buy.

Some stores will in fact make a loss over a short period, because they've made



can do this. Another way of sustaining low prices for a while is by cutting back on wages and worsening work conditions for staff; and of course cutting staff numbers.

FAST BUCK And if the stores can keep these discounts for weeks on end, in this recession, it begs the question, why did it cost so much in the first place?

One chain-store who received a fair bit of publicity so much profit in the past they was Kwik Save. Friend to the

low-income shopper... Give us a break!. They say they serve the public by cutting out the thrills and selling the goods as cheap as possible. Not nearly as cheap as it could

In 1991 Kwik Save made over £100 million profit. Fair bit of a mark up. It makes you wonder what the real cost of food is, if they can run cheap products but still make a packet.

Kwik Save found a niche

in the market and cashed in on it. That market is us. Their stores are concentrated in poorer working class areas, where Sainsburys and Marks and Spencers will not open stores, because there is no market for their more upmarket goods.

BACK TO BASICS

Shoppers on the dole or on low incomes, spend nearly all their income on the basics and need to have cheap goods. So don't be fooled by the shopper-friendly image of stores like Kwik Save, they'll sell cheap, but at a profit.

Next they'll be giving us food stamps, like in America, to pop down to your friendly local lower-income supermarket for some shoddy goods at prices which could be lower, and where the staff have forgotten what a decent wage is.

JUST DO IT

If you really wish to improve your standard of living, and get the bargains worth leaving the house for, we can only suggest you get a large coat or go late night shopping -

AFTER THE STORE

HAS CLOSED!

Recently workers at the Hoover plant in Cambuslang, Glasgow were given an ultimatum of face closure or accept new work practices imposed by their bosses.

Under closer scrutiny workers faced a false choice which could become guide lines for future attacks on our class.

LILLY LIVERED

The acceptance of the deal offered and endorsed by union leader Jimmy Airlie, is the most

blatant example of lillythe livered, weak representation of workers interests; not surprising from the type of union bureaucrat who leeches on the workforce.

It's the acceptance of a deal which includes;

wage cuts (of over £50 for some workers),

the withdrawal of sick pay,

monitors in the work place which will spy on workers' productivity,

keeping militancy PERIOD. down by keeping workers competing for jobs from outside tenders,

removal of four shop stewards posts,

that shows the union bosses attitude: to defend their own positions, but those on the lower rung of the union can expect nothing.

With union leader like this, who needs bosses!

NO DEAL

But Hoover have presented the deal as a choice, meaning an ultimatum; refuse the deal or face mass redundancies, or, accept it and another Hoover Plant in Dijon, France closes with a loss of 600 jobs. Some choice! Some deal!

This is the typical tactic of divide up a workforce, so that they compete with each other out of fear for their survival, instead of mounting an attack on the deal.

STITCHED UP

They take the piss when splashed across the newspapers and on the T.V. they boost their sales by a; "Two free flights offer if you spend more than £100" marketing campaign.

The union, so eager to please the bosses with nice industrial relations failed to

> use opportunity to sabotage the campaign, if the bosses imposed this stitch-up deal.

Such opportunities rarely crop up where the workerscould have the company by the balls. To

waste it was criminal.

Most union leaders, these days seem to want the quiet life, with cosy chats with the management, and God forbid no industrial conflict. Well get this straight bosses and workers will always be in conflict.

SCABS

Those who meekly accepted this deal in the hope that it would mean the company would stay loyal to the workers, would do well to learn the lessons of those workers at Ravenscraig Steelworks and the Nottingham scab miners of the U.D.M.

The bosses have loyalty only to the profit margin, the company and their class.

We owe no loyalty towards them or towards a union leadership who is unwilling or unable to do its job; they should be defending workers interests, not the bosses profits.

SHI Doo

A LOOK AT WHAT'S CHANGED IN THE USA...

So goodbye George Bush, you murdering capitalist bastard.

SENSELESS

In Britain, the Labour Party has worked itself senseless over Clinton, claiming he has shown the way for social democrats to regain power. We say that Republican/ Democrat or Tory/Labour are two sides of the same capitalist coin - and just as hopeless and useless to us as each other.

Clinton' first act as President was to support another bombing run over

CHANGE

SETTING THE 總AGENDA?總

The crisis over the pits has prompted the setting up of the National Miners Support Network during October last year.

The network, set up by some Labour MP's, the NUM and Women Against Pit Closures to provide information and practical support against the pit closures. This sort of organised public support is vital these days given that many defeats of strikes have occurred in isolation from wider support.

But what support miners get is crucial. There is now an established anti-pit closure movement since the Tories agenda was unveiled, of which the network will play a central role.

But we cannot be under the illusion that this movement is under the control of working class activists. The movement has brought together all sorts of politicos, middle class liberals, as well as working class activists from trade unions and communities.

SOLIDARITY

If this network is to be more than a bandwagon for a liberal middle class agenda against the Tories, headed by Left-wing Labour MP's, and followed by every lefty outfit that hangs on the coat tails of the Labour Party, then grass roots working class involvement must set the agenda.

The whole point of the

'Coa! not Dole' movement should be to create the necessary support and solidarity for the miners to carry out their struggle and win.

Not to revitalise illusions in bureaucratic union structures. Not to ejaculate over even bigger illusions like a General Strike. The various lefty politicos who believe this is possible are either stupid or insane, or both. Either way they hinder the agenda for real solidarity.

STRATEGY

The working class base of such a movement needs to assert its identity and it's own agenda. From the lodges, pit communities and other working class communities and workplaces, should come the leadership (ie. the positive direction).

From these areas there could be genuine gains for our class; developing the aims, and tactics of an effective strategy outside of the liberal moralism of the rainbow coalition and even the NUM leadership.

An effective strategy for the miners will need to ensure not only support and solidarity, but also control of the campaign. Labourite bureaucrats will argue "that's like having your cake and eating it". Too right! It's time we stopped excepting second best, and started taking more.

Direct links between



workers in the same position, ie. the public sector facing cuts, could prove to be an effective force. Though if the opportunity to build links with the private sector arises all the better.

Miners and other workers do not have to be led into effective action. The day-to-day struggle against the bosses (private or public) means they are quite aware of their strengths and weaknesses, and their possible options.

Support is needed, but support to empower workers,

not hinder them. We would argue that grass-roots democratic organisation, bottom-up, as well as an effective strategy, with attainable goals is the most positive action.

GET STUCK IN

Those who genuinely support the miners will need to acknowledge this; are the miners and their communities in control of this campaign? In the end, Labour MP's want Labour governments; Leftwing parties want to build their parties to take power; but it's miners, their relatives and

friends, who live in the threatened communities, as well as the rest of the working class who are facing the biggest devastation from the bosses recession. There lies the real basis of coalition and support.

having your place turned over or your car nicked. And if you're old, on the dole or have got sod all anyway, having what little you've got nicked from you is doubly gutting.

People who do this kind of anti-social activity are idiots and should be treated as such. We have no time for those who terrorise their own community, their own class.

MONSTER

But behind the Tory media's headlines screaming for "all criminals to be hung, drawn and quartered" (unless of course they're MP's or rich City stockbrokers). Is the fact that the rising crime rate is a product of Tory Britain, a Frankenstein's monster that is now running out of their control.

In the late seventies and early eighties advertising companies started promoting not only products, but 'lifestyles'. These 'lifestyles' were that of the young, rich successful business people, the Yuppies.

Gradually what's happened is that people are now doing the police's work for them: keeping us divided

confronted by images that say if you don't own a certain car, dress in a particular way, and go abroad twice a year on holiday you're a sorry-arsed failure.

The result is that some people who can't afford these things, and importantly have no hope of ever being able to because of lack of work or crap pay decide to get them through other means.

BREAKDOWN

On it's own this argument is full of holes, but couple this with capitalisms basic theory which says: "the only way to get on is to screw all those around you", and the complete breakdown in working class community and solidarity that has been the deliberate policy of the Tories, and some people feel that there's nothing wrong in robbing off your own. They are very wrong.

Now don't misunderstand us, we are all for crime when it betters our communities, like the selling on of stolen goods that people couldn't otherwise af ord, and the like.

For their part the cops condemn anti-social criminals - but the reality is that they love 'em! These scum are doing the police's work for them: keeping us divided

from, and scared of, each other.

Muggings, burglaries (especially against our old folk), mindless assaults - it all creates a climate of fear that undermines our communities, and more importantly allows our rulers to say; "see, look what happens, what we need is a strong government and hard police."

It's clear that the cops won't do anything about stopping anti-social criminals

from terrorising the rest of us.

The only way is to do it ourselves, to sort our own problems out: no, it's not easy and there are difficulties with it - but we must take the responsibility and drive antisocial criminals out, or educate them as to what's right, so they understand who the real enemies are.

DIRECT ACTION

In the last year there have been some outstanding examples of this happening right across Britain. Often, the people involved have given the idiots a chance to stop their activities or to explain their behaviour.

If this hasn't worked, then such direct action as

kidnapping or smashing up their own possessions has.

Yet it's no good just feeling proud and moral to be against these people and their actions - our class has to fight the system that forces people into such behaviour.

And that means we must

take on the government and bosses to get what we need rather than what they want to impose on us.

To do so means we must be strong and united. To be so we need to get rid of antisocial crime; we need to strengthen our communities against the attacks of police, government and recession. The real enemy are the

bastards on top who control our society, not each other - rob the rich - not the poor.

In it's time, the rag has done happily-married specials on Princess Anne and Mark Phillips,



Now the ANC and the ruling white National Party sit down to discuss the future for South Africa, a future that might very easily see Mandela as President.

Mandela is already making his position very clear: "I believe that President de Klerk and other senior members of the National Party.have the interest of the country at heart" he stated recently. The Secretary-General of the ANC, Cyril Ramaphosa, declared that the most important task was "to build the South African nation".

DROPPED

talk mobilisation, strike action, street protests has been dropped or severely watered down. The talk is now of accommodation with the government, of negotiated settlements and the only argument is over the timing of these agreements.

SLAVES But life for the vast mass of working class South Africans has not changed that much. They are still forced to slave for a living with the constant threat of

The ANC have never wanted to change the social structures of South African society - they have just wanted to lead it. White government, black government, de Klerk, Mandela -it's still shit at the bottom.

RESISTANCE But the years of struggle and resistance cannot be wished away now that negotiations have started. The South

African working class has shown its strength and potential in the last 20 years. The problem for the ANC is whether they can divert and disempower the working class.

REVOLUTION


The next couple of years might be fairly quiet. But the social conditions of the working class will not be The changed. impoverishment of the vast mass will continue. Now that the ANC is revealed in its true colours, the chance for a revolution that sweeps away all forces who seek to represent, govern, oppress and exploit is that much greater.

THREE BLACK MEN serving life for a series of robberies and a murder carried out in 1988 by what was known as the 'M25 gang', have just had their appeal put back for the fourth time. They will have to wait until June 1993 at the earliest.

Supporters of the M25 Three - Raphael Rowe, Michael Davis and Randolph Johnson (previously unknown to the other two!) are confident they will win their appeal.

The Home Office evidently feels it would be too embarrassing to release the M25 Three so soon after the Cardiff Three. And It's not just the number that's the same!

COLOUR BLIND! In both cases eyewitnesses said white men were involved. In the M25 case, Detective Superintendent Vincent McFadden held a TV conference confirming they were looking for two white men and one black man.



In both cases three black men were convicted, in spite of eye-witness reports and alibis contradicting the

conviction.

There was no forensic evidence used against Rowe and Davis; both, also had several alibi witnesses who were unchallenged in court. The police pressurised witnesses to make false statements, and three key



prosecution witnesses admitted to playing part in the robberies in question - their prints were found on the getaway cars! They were also found in possession of some of the stolen property and an air gun used by the gang (none of them faced charges - we wonder why!).

In the good old tradition of the judiciary, the judge directed the jury to the guilty verdict.

Five years has been taken away from these men's lives. Machael Davis has learned to read and write to enable him to campaign for freedom. They have made many contacts with other prisoners who are also fighting their cases.

SOLIDARITY

On the outside the unrelenting support of Valerie Davis and Joanne Rowe has got them wide support in their local communities and across the country.

Class War supports all genuine campaigns against wrongful convictions. The inter-prisoner solidarity and campaigning from the outside is the best action for these cases. Until we can build a society based on equality and justice, we'll be forced to defend ourselves from the fitups and crap of their system.

"The government and judiciary are more concerned to preserve the status quo in the criminal justice system than allow the many hundreds wrongly convicted prisoners the opportunity to get a fair hearing. The M25 Three case is the most prominent of these numerous cases".

On Wednesday 25th November the Police murdered a young motorist. 22 year-old Pearse Jordan's car was rammed off the road by 2 unmarked police cars, one behind and one hitting the drivers side. After the crash he staggered onto the pavement, dazed, and 4 plainclothes cops jumped from their cars. One of them shot Pearse 3 times with a rifle and some of them kicked him as he lay dying.

Even though this only happened a few months ago most readers will not remember this brutal murder, even if they were aware of it in the first place. That's because it didn't happen in Oxford, Manchester or Liverpool, but in Belfast.

LIES

Although Pearse Jordan was a member of the IRA, at the time of the shooting he was unarmed and there was nothing in his car to suggest he was on "active service". The media immediately began pumping out lies, supplied by the Police (RUC)

APPLIED TO THE POST OF THE PROPERTY OF THE PRO

and the security services, about the incident. The misinformation included claims that Jordan's car had rammed the Police, he had been shot running away, that another man was arrested at the scene, that gloves and masks were found in his car, and that a bomb (and later a bomb factory!) was found nearby. All eyewitnesses accounts confirm that none of this was true.

OOPS!

Later that evening an "unofficial security contact" released the supposed name of the victim and details of his previous convictions. This man was not Pearse Jordan (who had never even been arrested, let alone convicted), but was presumably the intended target of this deliberate shoot-to-kill operation.

LESSONS

The British State has used every tactic it can, legal or illegal, against those who resist their rule in the North of Ireland. Anyone who wants to do more than pay lip service to the idea of working class revolution has a lot to learn from the situation there. Just looking at how far the British State will go to defeat Irish

republicans is a lesson in itself! The State's response to resistance in the six relatively small counties in Ireland shows us what working class people have in store on a wider front. The knowledge the ruling class have gained fighting the republicans has already been used against us, for example crowd control techniques learned in the six counties have become standard practice on the British mainland since the riots of the early 1980's, and of course Northern Ireland is a classic example of the divide-andrule tactic.

<u>UNDERSTANDING</u>

If the ruling class are learning from this struggle, then so should we. Anybody who expresses solidarity for the rioters of Los Angeles, Salford, Cork and working class communities all over the world, yet makes no effort to find out what's going on in Northern Ireland is a hypocrite.

Unless you're just an 'armchair revolutionary', happy to talk about fightback just so long as you don't have

to do anything yourself, you need to understand what's happening and why part of the working class of Ireland has taken up arms against the British State (if not, then think again).



KEEP FIGHTING

We don't offer uncritical support to the Irish republican movement, we have many differences and disagreements with their politics and tactics, but we do acknowledge the legitimacy of their struggle. To stand firm and keep fighting against everything the British (and Irish) State has thrown against

them is an amazing achievement. Pearse Jordan lived his life in the same conditions as many working class people in Britain and Ireland, he experienced the misery of a rundown community, shitty training schemes, long term unemployment and Police harassment. Living in West Belfast also offered the presence of a hostile army of occupation, the constant threat of sectarian attacks and demonisation by government propaganda.

Because he tried to change this situation he was murdered. Our ideas on revolution differ a lot from his, but we recognise him for what he was - a working class fighter.



THE POLITICS BEHIND THE HYPE

X marks the spot on everything from T-shirts to base-ball caps. But why has all this hype been given to a man feared by the establishment in the '60s?

A"racial extremist" or an advocate of extreme measures to liberate black people from racism, Malcolm X is a powerful symbol of Black Resistance. The likes of Spike Lee or Black Democrat, Jesse Jackson use Malcolm to boost their street credibility. But all he stood for stands in oppostion to these opportunists...

MALCOLM X, or Malik El-Shabazz, was from the southern states of America, in Omaha.

His father was a Baptist minister, the Reverend Earl Little, who was a supporter of the politics of Marcus Garvey (a black leader in the earlier part of this century) and the Universal Negro Improvement Association (UNIA). His father died at the hands of the Ku Klux Klan.



Malcolm Little went through school with little encouragement from teachers; he wanted to be a solicitor but was told by one teacher to concentrate on becoming a carpenter, as that was the 'best' a Black boy could achieve.

Malcolm learnt from an early age that 'success' was a white thing.

A BIT OF A HUSTLER

Leaving education behind Malcolm soon got a taste for street life as a hustler. By all accounts he was a bit of nasty piece of work. He ended up in prison, where he began to develop some politics and he got religious, becoming a Muslim.

Malcolm immersed himself in the Nation of Islam and the teachings of it's leader, Elijah Muhammed.

In his early days of political awareness, his views were dominated by the unquestioned word of Elijah Muhammed.

Malcolm's earlier speeches were often preceded by the religious words: "The honourable Elijah Muhammed teaches us..." This Elijah was a complete charlatan, and Malcolm X was later to break from his influence and see him for what he really was - a fraud and a brake on black militancy.

At the time the Nation of Islam seemed the most radical Black organisation in America.

It had little connection with Orthodox Islam of the East (both Sunni or Fundamentalist Muslims), and was hardly recognised by many Muslims. The membership was mainly comprised of hard working

preferred to preach that morality and separatism would be the salvation of the black population.

In 1962 the police shot seven unarmed Black Muslims, killing one and crippling

another, and then arrested them for assault! Malcolm was dispached by Muhammed to handle the defence. He wanted to widen the defence to a political campaign against the brutalising oppression that Black people face at the hands of the police.

Muhammed agreed to this at first, but suddenly called off the campaign.

Confronting the racist policies of the policie clearly infringed the Nation's "nonengagement" policy - a hypocritical policy of nonconfrontation with the

class black people who were well disciplined in Islamic customs and practices ie. no drink, drugs, adultery, etc.

The Nation would often go into black communities and kick out (or kick in) dealers and crooks, and anybody considered antisocial by the community.

This gave them a lot of credibility and support from their communities. However, they failed to tackle the wider problem faced by the black population: THE RACIST EST-ABLISHMENT. They would not confront the racist authorities, and

authorities, the black peoples' foremost enemy, even in the eyes of it's leader.



THE STATE? DON'T COLLABORATE!

Towards the end of his life, Malcolm argued that the non-engagrement policy of the Nation was just part of the collaboration between the Black Muslim leadership and the

establishment He even witnessed meetings between members of the Nation of Islam, the Ku Klux Klan and the CIA! Strange bedfellows indeed.

In his last speeches, Malcolm began to realise the role, and the reason for CIA backing of the Nation - as a safety valve for Black militancy within America.



A REAL REVOLUTIONARY

All talk of justice, but no challenge to the injustice; a deliberate policy of appeasement for which the leadership held a position of power and relative privilege over the black community.

Malcolm's final break with the Nation came about when he commented on Kennedy's assassination,

"...the chickens have come home to roost, and being an old farm boy myself, chickens coming home to roost never did make me sad; it always made me glad."

For this classic quote he received a 90 day suspension, from which he never returned. This marked the real beginning of the revolutionary in him.

Malcolm was looking for solution to the Black peoples' problems.

Once he started to look beyond the confines of Muhammed's views, he quickly developed black liberation politics.

His politics developed to a point where he saw that black oppression is an international problem; because being a 'Negro' means you have brothers and sisters not just in Africa, but in the South Americas, the West Indies, within the former European colonies, including Britain. Scattered from Africa, courtesy of the slave trade.

He was inspired by Third World revolutionaries who challenged the Western colonial powers, and managed to gain some sovereignty for black people.



On this point Malcolm could be accused of being too optimistic about the positive aspects of these new Third World regimes; both in terms of the reactionary nature of some of them and, in the illusion that they were free from western control.

DOLLARISM

He was aware of the U.S. policy of economic and military control of certain regions which he called 'Dollarism', that is, social control through international finance and domination of the market.

Within the U.S he challenged the reformist Civil Rights Movement.

He believed they had got it wrong in terms liberating Black Americans; he wanted to elevate the black struggle to that of human rights rather than civil rights.

To confine the struggle to civil rights meant, for

Malcolm, to confine the issue to appealing to the U.S. authorities to grant reforms, which they always denied!

If it was a question of human rights. It would enable the black people of America to approach the international community to apply pressure through the U.N. as the Palestinians were doing.



He quickly became disillusioned with this tactic, when it was blocked by the unwillingness of the U.N. to grant Black Americans with this status.

The fact is that despite the official recognition of Palestinians as a people denied any self-determination, they are still no better off; still without a homeland. Malcolm, in





looking for a solution to his people's struggle, was too optimistic about the UN, the UN represents the ruling classes of the world, whether they are western or third world, black or white.

SEE, LISTEN, THINK.

After leaving the Nation of Islam, Malcolm X formed the Organisation of Afro-American Unity, which was a collective of black political activists, who according to Malcolm needed to:

"Learn how to see for yourself and listen for yourself and think for yourself".

Gone were the days of blind obedience to self-appointed leaders like the so-called "Honourable" Elijah Muhammed, or his contemporary equivalent, Louis Farrakhan; or big mouths like the Reverend Al Sharpe.

The underlying basis of the organisation was in building a positive identity for black people:

PRIDE, IDENTITY and UNITY, was an essential formula for black self-determination and liberation.



Without such a

process, blacks would still be mentally confined to the negative self-image promoted by white supremist culture.

The sort of negativity which makes black Americans view their homeland, their African roots and identity as backward, and therefore themselves as backward.



This is a problem faced by all oppressed groups, and is particularly relevant to the class war. The negative stereotypes of working class people as either simpletons or mad animals, is just as effective in sabotaging our fightback as a thousand police forces.

CLASS PRIDE, POS-ITIVE CLASS IDENTITY, AND EFFECTIVE CLASS UNITY are fundamental to the CLASS WAR.

HITTING THE NAIL ON THE HEAD

One off the biggest contributions Malcolm X gave to the politics of Black liberation, was to challenge non-violence and reformism of the civil rights movement:

"There can be no

revolution without bloodshed and it's nonsense to talk of the civil rights movement as revolutionary".

When it came to attacks on the movement and black people he was clear and unrepentant:

"...will be met with maximum physical retaliation from those of us who are not handcuffed by the disarming philosophy of nonviolence, and who believe in asserting our right to self-defence - by any means necessary".

SELF DEFENCE IS NO OFFENCE

This line was actively practiced by the Black Panther Party (For Self-Defence), who, like Malcolm X saw a real threat to their black communities from the police and other racists, and had the bottle to confront it in the most revolutionary way - by direct confrontation with the state.

When you start to break the myth that the state is the only legitimate user of violence, then you start to gnaw at the very power base which keeps them on top.

The move towards a revolutionary solution

towards racism meant his opponents would eventually kill him; he was aware of this because he had survived an attempt on his life, but carried on despite this even though his fate had been sealed.

BEWARE EXPENSIVE IMITATIONS

Now in the nineties, pseudo-radicals like Spike Lee (the Black film director and darling of Hollywood), have used the figure of



Malcolm X for their own agenda - trying to give the black middle class some credibility within the ghettoes. All the t-shirts, caps and hype have tried to incorporate a revolutionary figure into a consumer market; it's a case of 'move over Che Guevara, Malcolm X sells more than you'.

The cheek of reformist politicians like Jesse Jackson, who also jump on the bandwagon, and spoke at a commemoration of his death, is incredible: this Democrat forgets the words of Malcolm X on the two mainstream parties: "It's just a question of the fox ...or the wolf".

His opposition to idiots like Jackson are clear,

"We will organise, a sweep out of office of all negro politicians who are puppets for the outside forces".

And as for selfappointed leaders such as Louis Farrakhan, leader of the Nation of Islam - he damned himself and his corrupt organisation even before Malcolm X's death:



"Only those who wish to be led to hell or to their doom will follow Malcolm. The die is set, and Malcolm shall not escape...Such a man as Malcolm is worthy of death." More than coincidence that it was Black Muslims who pulled the trigger.

Whilst the Hollywood moguls allow Spike Lee the space to exercise his 'radical' conscience, to get bums on seats at the cinema (his 'block-buster' based on Malcolm X's life will hit the British big screen in March), the real inheritors of the X tradition - the rioters who

rebelled the only way they could against a racist state - might go beyond the image and look at the real substance of Malcolm X.

And use it to further their struggle for justice, freedom and equality.

So should we.

During some of the conferences and workshops organised in opposition to Decembers EC summit in Edinburgh, Belgian activists in Edinburgh for the summit revealed startling new evidence into the people and organisations pushing for this bosses Europe.

Their findings make a mockery of the idea of a free Europe of citizens, and of the notion that somehow European unification has got to be better than the present situation.

Their findings centre arround a group called the European Round Table, a self styled group of so called 'business leaders'.

There are hundreds of such pressure groups at all levels of the EC. What makes the ERT group so special is its membership, and the positions they occupy. Their March 1992 list of members in *Class War's* possession reads like a 'whose who' of the top bosses of Europe.

Some of the members include multi-nationals like BP, Shell, Philips, Unilever, Hoffmann-La-Roche, Trafalgar House and Nestlé.

Since the formation of the ERT in 1983, many of their reports and recommendations have gone to form the very core of EC policy and legislation. Their policies on issues like transport, the single market, unemployment, world trade and so on, have also become the official policies of the EC.

Several things are noticeable from the list: not all of the companies are based in the EC – Volvo, Hoffmann-La-Roche and Norsk Hydro. There are also a lot of companies with vested interests in maintaining private cars as the prime mode of transport - Pirelli, BP, Shell, Daimler Benz, Total, Fiat, Volvo

etc. Perhaps this is why they have produces a lot of reports concerning transport, like their March 1989 'The Need for Renewing Transport Infrastructure in Europe', or the June 1990 'Logistics and Transport in Europe' which just happened to form the basic for the EC's transport policy; roads, roads, and more roads.

Again the presence of some of the biggest polluters in Europe: the chemical, paper and oil companies, possibly had an effect on their influential May 1990 report called 'Environmental Issues for European Industry'.

Easy does it

News that five young people died in Greater Manchester since 1989 from dance floor dehydration and heatstroke, and helped on their way by drugs like Ecstacy, has alarmed the local city council.

However, their alarm doesn't streach as far as asking how someone can die of dehydration in a club in the middle of a city with an adequate water supply.

Perhaps the free market entrepreneurs have a part to play in all this. Maybe turning up the heating, disconnecting the taps in the toilets and charging two quid for a glass of water has something to do with the deaths by dehydration. Market forces, eh lads!

Just blew it

Nike, the sportsware company makes its biggest profits from the work they subcontract to countries with cheap labour. In Indonesia, where they subcontract their sports shoe work, they hold 'competitions' to win licences for the work. The licences are revised every month.

The result of this is 24,000 workers in six factories earning a daily average wage of less than 50 p. This is less than 30% of even the Indonesian minimum wage.

So the likes of Michael Jordan can get \$10 million for his name, and 24, 000 unnamed Indonesians get 50p a day for actualy doing the work. It's a funny old world. Not.

No Justice

Class War never did have any faith in the courts when it comes to defending the common man or woman.

But if the Tories get their way you wont even get the chance to sue the bastards who framed you in the first place!

The latest anti-working class piece of legislation is designed to lower the legal aid 'ceiling' of £77 down to around £44. This means anyone earning above £44 will have to pay a whopping percentage, if not all of their legal bills. This could stop a worker suing their boss for a back injury, or a person suing for wrongful imprisonment. Your money is now destined to end up in rich lawyer's bank accounts. British justice screwing you in the dock and in your pocket!

The venerable Guild of Fine Powder Purveyors has been rocked to the core by corruption allegations concerning some of its north London branch members. As many as 25 dealers in Stoke Newington are alleged to have been INVOLVED IN POLICING. Suggestions that dealers have given information to police officers are nothing new, but the Guild is currently investigating allegations that go much further—one dealer is alleged to

Suggestions that dealers have given information to police officers are nothing new, but the Guild is currently investigating allegations that go much further—one dealer is alleged to have been earning as much as £2,000 a month as a police officer. The dealer who can only be referred to as "dealer X" for life insurance reasons, was named in the confession of self-styled "honest cop" PC Dick Sonofdockgreen. The self confessed "woodentop" claimed he saw dealer X: arresting people, giving evidence, drinking with known "officers", wearing a brown leather jacket, blue jeans and white trainers.

Mr Bigg, the Guild's president told us that an investigation, code-named "Operation Crackpot", has been ongoing for 18 months. However, Roy Nark, head of stoke Newington's Guild branch denied there was any truth in the story: "these allegations have been made by self-confessed police officers-they are absolute rubbish". Admitting the investigation had lowered morale amongst the area's dealers, he said, "how can my men provide a service to the public with this hanging over them, knowing every time they make a sale they may be accused of being police officers".

Hugh Sless, the civillian member of the Pushers Complaint Authority (PCA) overseeing the whole investigation, said: "I am absholutely determined there musht be a cover-up, the truth musht come out. Theshe are sheriously allegationsh and if we find anyone ish guilty of witnesssh to them, we musht put them away for a long time". The inquiry continues.

Beating drums, blowing whistles and ringing a cow bell, 25 protesting claimants invaded an Edinburgh Benefit Office on 26 January — writes our 'Counter Information' correspondent.

Part of the National Claimants Federation Week of Action, the demo was called by the controversial Edinburgh Unemployed Workers Centre, to oppose the governments latest benefit cut.

Since December, new regulations remove benefits entirely from those judged not to be 'actively seeking work'.

Previously these claimants could still receive 60% of Income Support. Under the new rules claimants can have their benefit cut without warning.

'Any victimisation of claimants by the authorities should be met by demonstrations and direct action at the benefit office responsible' urged the Edin-

burgh demonstrators.

Other Claimants Federation activity included and Action For Benefit Rights picket of the Central London Employment Services office on 28 January.

Cheap Labour

on top of increased harassment at restart interviews. The government wants to cut the unemployment figures by pressuring people onto cheap labour schemes like Employment Action, Youth Training Scheme and Employment Training. The unemployed are

not the only ones under the governments axe. The misnamed Child Support Act hits single parents, involving harassment, and threats of benefit cuts. All attacks on claimants are an attack on the rest of the working class.

The facts

- Benefit rates are already below poverty level - benefits should be raised, not
- According to the governments figures there are 2,834,300 unemployed claimants, and only 95,000

- job vacancies.
- Most of the jobs available have low wages, poor conditions and horrific health and safety standards. People are quite right to refuse crap wages and conditions.
- Most jobs don't benefit society, they just make money for the rich or prop upthe government's power.
- Many unemployed people spend their time in activities which directly help the community, through voluntary work or just lending a hand.
- Many unemployed peo-

ple do important unpaid work like cooking, cleaning, caring for friends, relatives or children.

• Many unemployed people study part time at college.

People have a right to lead a life of their own, at the states expense if necessary, the idle rich do it, so should we!

Claimants are organising themselves to fight these cuts. Resist to Exist.

COUNCIL TAX... HOME TRUTHS

On April 1st the Council Tax will be introduced to replace the poll tax.

You may not be hearing much about it but the councils are in as much confusion as ever-spending loads bringing in another way of ripping us off. Whilst the Council Tax is a climbdown from the Poll Tax, it still means the rich are better off than under the rates system - which of course means we are worse off! We're paying for the benefits of the rich.

As with the Poll Tax, the councils are keeping as quiet as possible. You won't know how much your bill is until they are about to drop through the letter box. We predict that there will be some noise when they thump onto the hall carpets.

A CULTURE OF NON-PAYMENT

Councils are predicting problems getting people to pay. They fearthat "Aculture of non-payment" has developed; many people getting off with not paying the poll tax will encourage nonpayment of Council Tax. We think for once their right!

They had to give up the idea of us all having to pay and so it's back to one bill per household. Sent to the 'head' of the household or each flat.

The bills are based on house values at 1991 prices. The value was worked out by the Inland Revenue using the 'the Beacon Method', ie. an estate agent picks out a 'typical' house in your street and whatever value that was given applies to all houses on the street.

Which means people with valuable houses benefit, and those in poorer conditions are penalised. A fair tax? Bollocks!

You can appeal against

valuations. But you are likely to find that in order to get any reduction you would need an independent valuation which will cost you about £150 in order to reduce your bill by £25 a year. Yet another con.

VOTE-SEEKING

Regionally, London and the South East, where house prices are highest, would be hit the hardest. Fearful of

bills will be £100 more than estimates. So if you had a Poll Tax bill of £300, and now you're considered 'head of the household', you could have a bill in excess of £500.

This will affect residents in a household who are not considered the the 'head': a lot of tenants will face rent rises from landlords who want to make a profit but still pass

Why don't they learn? They'll never get the money, they'll just waste more trying to collect an uncollectable tax.

In order to reduce their bills, NOT ours, councils will cut services, encouraging private, expensive services... or no services at all.

MORE PROFIT

Though services are vital for our survival, they are given not as a right, but as a necessity for the whole class systemtowork. The education and health services are blinkered because it serves the needs of the bosses to have an adequete workforce, to employ or sack.

Transport to get us to work; recreation, housing and leisure is a bare minimum, in order to satisfy our needs and to keep us working from week to week. It's also a good opportunity to make more and more profit out of us.

As for the police, the armed forces, prisons and courts, again, paid for by us: they are blatant tools of intimidation and control. And we are expected to pay for the privilege!

DON'T PAY

For those who want and need to keep the money wasted on tax, they should do it with pride.

We don't accept the media and politicians who call us 'free-loaders' and 'scroungers'. Only through effective resistance, withholding our taxes, can we gain power and pressure against taxes and cuts in services.

Just remember, it was that tactic which made the most arrogant Tory government stand down on its flagship

The inevitable cuts in local services have already happened up and down the country. Town Halls slash services, often claiming poverty whilst spending on campaigns to ensure that all Poll Tax arrears are paid.

SNAPSHOTS OF SOMALIA

THE LATEST CHAPTER OF THE NEW WORLD ORDER opened when U.S. Marines entered Somalia early in December.

Their mission? To rescue the country from famine and civil war between rival gangs high on local drug, "gat".

As usual, things aren't always what they seem. It appears the marines are also having to fight off rival gangs of cameratoting bandits, desperate to keep reality at bay, whatever the

Relief workers and CNN reporters have agreed that the CNN coverage cost more than the entire food relief operation mounted by CARE International in Baidoa where 100 people a day are dying from starvation.

The real reasons behind the US intervention have got nothing to do with feeding starving children. There is enough food, but it costs money. Many Somalis are starving in relief camps close to markets full of food. Rich people never starve. Poor people do.

Somalia is one of the most aid dependent countries on the planet. 93% of this 'aid' comes from America and as a condition has to be spent on US exports. During the 80's, the US sent half a billion dollars worth of arms to Somalia, which are now being used to terrorise the people of Mogadishu, and, ironically to take pot shots at the US troops themselves.

BUYING GUNS, NOT BAKING BREAD

Somalia also has an external debt of \$2 billion. Of course, Western banks and Governments want their cash back. To do this they use a firm of bailiffs going by the name of the International Monetary Fund, which after taking control of the Somali economy, began a 'Structural Adjustment' programme. Government spending on social services was slashed by 75%, wages frozen, and trade liberalised, especially in the field of arms spending.

Local farmers were encouraged to grow crops for export rather than to feed the country, and the cash made from the exports was taken by the Western banks.

However, since the collapse of the Siad Barne dictatorship in December 1990, the IMF has had no firm Government through which to implement its policies and the economy has collapsed.

And so, enter the US, stepping in to judge the best local ruling class to defend Western capitalist interests. The winners will receive even more guns, and more cash to spend on paying back their debts.

WHAT CAN WE DO THEN?

So, what is the answer? Class War believes the best way to help someone else's revolution is to start your own: By destroying our ruling class and their Capitalist system, by raising the stakes in our part in the class struggle, countries like Somalia will be able to breathe a sigh of relief, after the grip of capitalism is loosened - and finally get on with sorting out their problems for themselves. It might sound far-fetched, but it's the only long-lasting solution - a real one, a million miles removed from guilty, hand wringing, rock megastars and their self-gratifying 'Live Aid', Freddie Mercury Aid or bolster up the nearest out-of-date pop singer's career in the name of charity mega-crap-extravaganza: these events change nothing.

The people of Somali can start by turning their guns on their own warlords and parasitic drug barons, and booting out the United Nations bootboys (and their bootboys), making sure the next few chapters of the New World Order get even stickier. Good luck to them!


SEGA/NINTENDO GAMES CONSOLES

There's been a bit of a boom in these recently - what with their own TV programmes and tabloid columns, not to mention the fact that megabillions of them have been sold over Christmas and new year. Predictably, there's been a moral panic about kids either not doing their homework or being led into a life of crime after playing "Splatterhouse 2" or whatever.

A lot of this panic cab be put down to the usual misunderstanding of"youth" culture, alongside a touch of bigotry. Let's face it, if a kid spent all day playing chess, people would be calling them a genius.

They're criticised for being "uneducational" - no wonder they sell so well. This is games culture aimed at the Bart Simpson Generation; underachieving - and proud of it.

In fact, the games have tended to move on (superficially, at least) from their all-male violent arcade



origins, towards more problem solving and lateral thinking games, like Scrabble - some even have a veneer of "social concern" such as Sega's trendy liberal new dolphin game "Ecco". Should be

called Eeucho!

But the bottom line with the games, as usual, is that they are designed to fit neatly into the most cynical game of all-making as much profit as possible from as little

> One novel ploy that Sega and Nintendo use is the addition of "cheats" built into the games, enabling you to take short cuts, finishing the game quicker and presumably getting bored enough with easy success to tempt you into buying another.

> expense. What's new?

This is made worse by control Sega and Nintendo have over the games market, tailoring games only to their own machines. The real loser is the person buying these games at such stupid prices!

PUBLIC EYE

Shown after Coronation Street one Friday in January, this was a programme we might have expected to think would be informative and instructive - it's blurb claimed that the documentary would be looking at the recent activities of the British National Party and "asking questions of how the problem could be tackled". Instead it was an exercise in scare-mongering. It asked no questions whatsoever as to what could be done to oppose the fascists -it failed to mention work done by active anti-fascists up and down the country. It was as if we were all powerless.

It's treatment of the BNP was crass and ignorant, highlighting only the fear they cause. The BNP were portrayed as a movement on the rise, and we as it's passive victims.

The reality is that the BNP and it's international comrades, are victims themselves of capitalism's divisive nature. And that the BNP are being opposed and beaten at every turn by the people who work to educate, organise and physically confront fascists as they attempt to mobilise.

This was a liberal, whingeing documentary with neither guts nor honesty. Bad telly - give me Coronation Street any day!

Behind the punk/ska/rap hybrid lies a well-thought-out working class consciousness. The lyrics littered with admirable anti-fascist, anticapitalist polemic. The music rises and falls, chops and changes, the weak production made up for in the strength of the sentiments. Good stuff.

But the whole blood 'n' guts roar of this record - and it's spot-on lyrical sense - is smothered in a din of rabblerousing and air-punching. Everyone likes a singalong, fully-throated chorus, but overdoing it leaves you screaming along aimlessly. Go and see them live - they're of Britain's most outspoken anti-fascist bands.

Really crap tital, it looks like one of those selfindulgent, "Let's all be happy, no matter whether we're rich or poor" books but this one is good

Self-empowerment for class-warriors and ordinary folk alike! You've heard the expression "take control of your own life" but what does it really mean? Is it really possible in this capitalist class divided society? This book gives realistic practical exercises for boosting personal power, gaining more selfesteem, and turning fear into a useful tool for life (and revolution). Its dead easy to read, and hard to put down once you've started reading it. This book changes lives!

BASHING THE BASTARDS

"The 43 Group" by Morris Beckman (Centerprise Publications)

This book is subtitled "the untold story of the fight against fascism" and is written by a founder member of an organisation known as 'the 43 Group was set up in 1946 by mainly Jewish exservicemen who were appalled to see the fascists openly organising in this country. No-one else would do anything about them (like the government, the police, the established organisations) so they decided that they had to do it themselves. And they had no illusions about how to treat the fascists — physical confrontation was the way forward and there are some excellent stories here of the seemingly forgotten.

fascists getting badly turned

There are a few short comings in the book - for example, there is no attempt to explain the rise in fascism and the links between fascists and the state are never fully developed. It would be worth reading 'Fascism and Anti-Fascism' by Jean Barrot (recently republished by Unpopular books) to get a view on the political aspects of the struggle against fascist ideas. Nonetheless, 'The 43 Group' is a good read — as it says in the introduction, (which, amazingly, is by Vidal Sassoon, another member of the group): "Never again! became a command not a slogan"... some words that a lot of the left today have

want: pigs, Babylon, the Beast or just the plain old filth; one thing is for certain, as we venture further into the '90s, the police are going to have a rough ride.

On-duty or off duty, they seem to be on the wrong side of a good beating, for a change. The Dixon of Dock Green image is well and truly buried, along with a long line of other PCs who have kicked the bucket.

Gone are the days when most of our class are shocked at attacks on the cops.

LACK OF RESPECT

When Harry Roberts killed three coppers in the Summer of 1966, the public outcry raised £70,000 in donations to the dead coppers' families. No doubt, some were from blinkered working class people who saw the police as a neutral and respectul institution.

Now, in the 1990s, this clearly is not the case. Still, some people hold the police in high esteem, but the number of people who see the cops as their enemy is on the increase. Bad news, Constables, the

trend is unlikely to reverse itself!

During the '80s, the Thatcher regime gave more powers to the police. They used the police to a much greater deg-

ice to a much greater degree; they knew that their agenda to change the shape of Britain would seriously rock the boat conflict was inevitable, and the New Right under her, used the cops as their first line of attack.

From the pre-planned confrontation with the MIners in '84-85, to the inner city rebellions, and

of course the poll tax uprisings, the police were very quickly developing a more political role.

Even the whingeing liberal middle classes were getting scared of the growing powers of the police in such confrontations and disputes.

During the trial of the miners arrested during The Battle of Orgreave' (1984), for the first time it was revealed that there was an internal document

to go into certain districts, unrestrained by a lack of officers and more importantly, by the calls of moderation from the liberal est-

ablishment on heavy policing tactics. Control of

the streets is the number one priority of the cops, and don't they just love to try it on?

But the powers go be yound what is considered as "hostile areas". They want to control all areas - to be and remain the biggest gang in town.

Take for instance, festivals and raves. Last Summer, in the massively expensive

'Operation Nomad' three different police forces tried to stop the Avon free festival from happening. The result, to their horror, was to create the biggest festival/rave that this country's ever seen.

If you think how difficult it is to stop vehicles from parking up on any piece of common land, throughout three counties, you get an idea of the massive scale of their operation.

The police continued their 'no party here' policy throughout the Summer.

What are they afraid of? What are they up to? Well, it's simple, they can't stand, they in fact hate, anything outside their official control. Raves and festivals are obvious no-go zones for the cops; it is also a self-organised culture.

They'd rather stop all these free parties in favour of legal, paying raves that are infinitely easier to control. Ravers and travellers are waiting for the Spring assault. What lengths will they go to stop partying...and have they thought how difficult we'll be to police when they're chasing around the Green fields of England after party-goers?

A STITCH-UP IN TIME

Many people languising

in our jails are innocent.

It means higher arrest and conviction rates ie better "performance indicators"; for more funding, and more

Brownie points for those eager constables working their way to promotion and more power.

WE DON'Tsay all attacks on the cops are done by 'class concious




Now, more than ever, their public credibility is shot to pieces; and so is their image of being all-powerful - the fear factor's being reduced.
