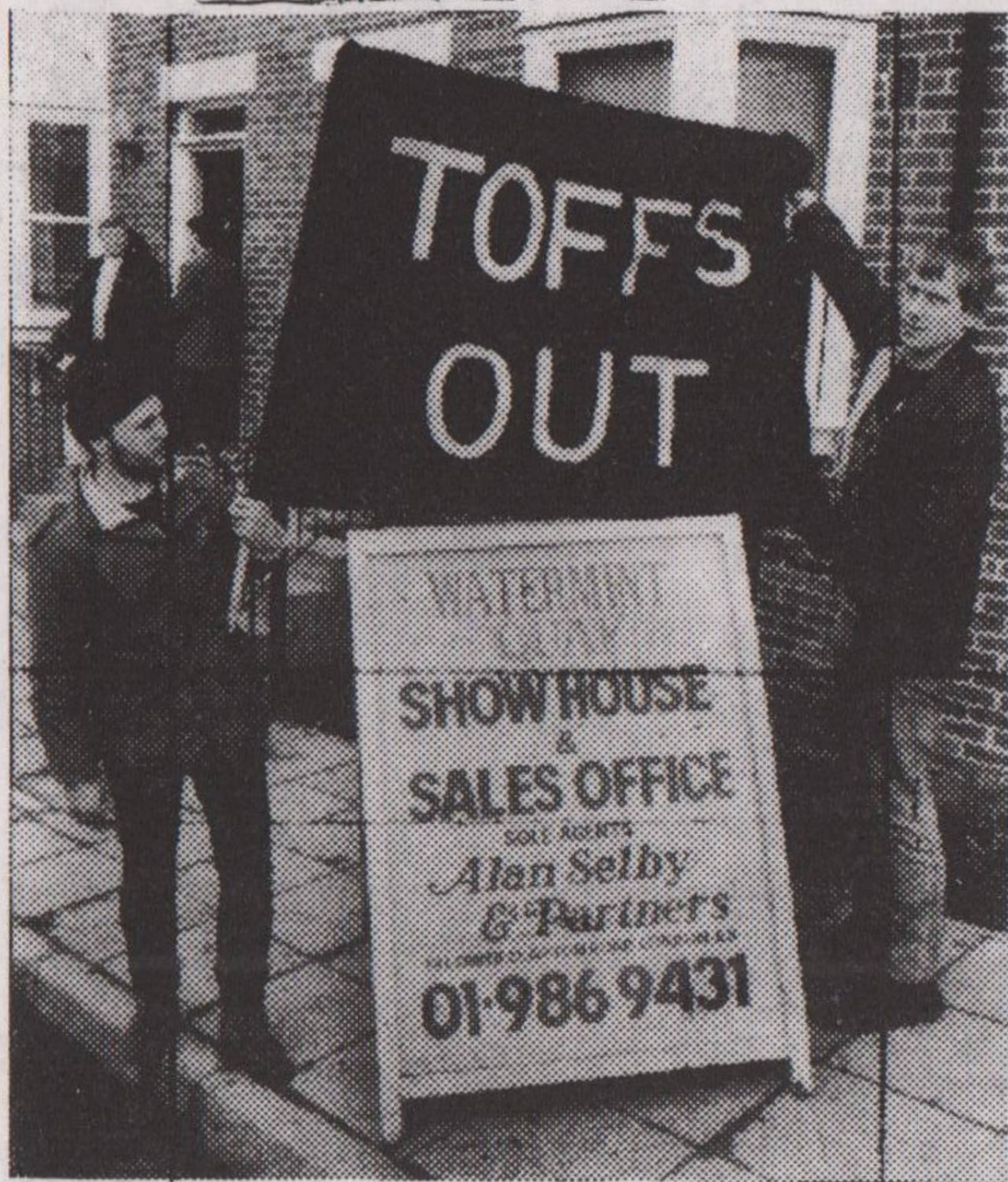
We all know that 'Eastenders' is just a 'soap', but it still makes you just that bit more sick when these so-called 'Eastenders' do the dirty on us.

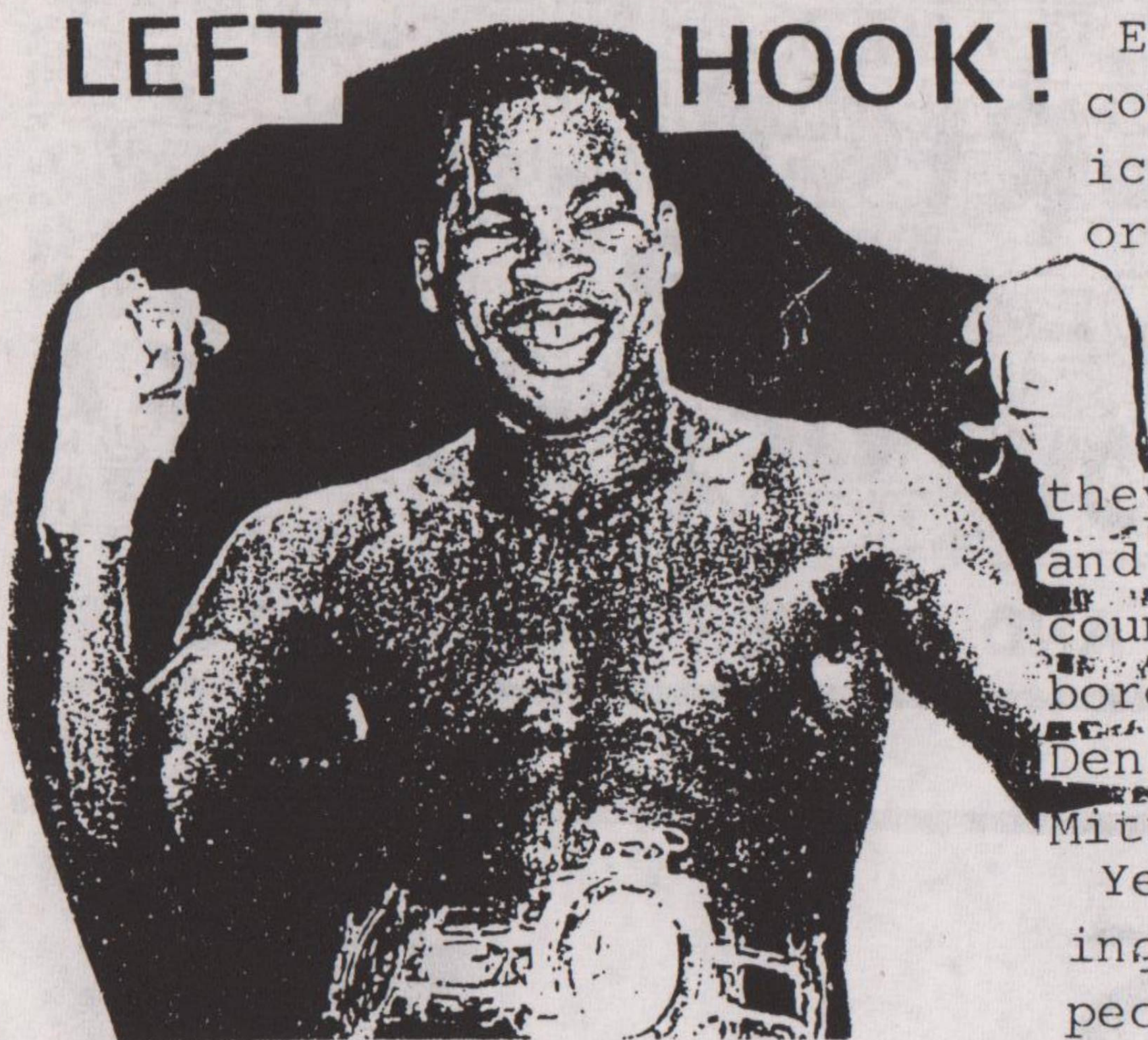

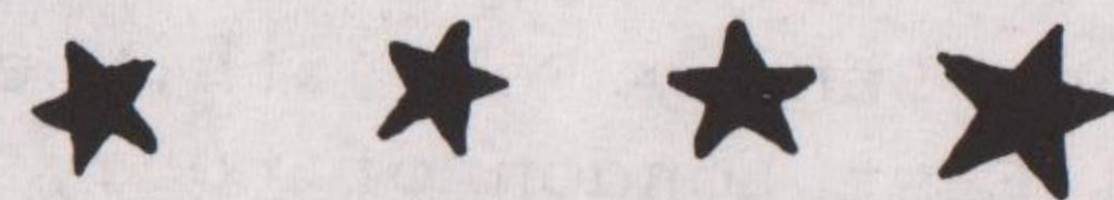
Sylvester Mittee

Over 250 people packed Hackney Council Chambers for the first public meeting of the Trevor Monerville family Support Group on Feb.17th.

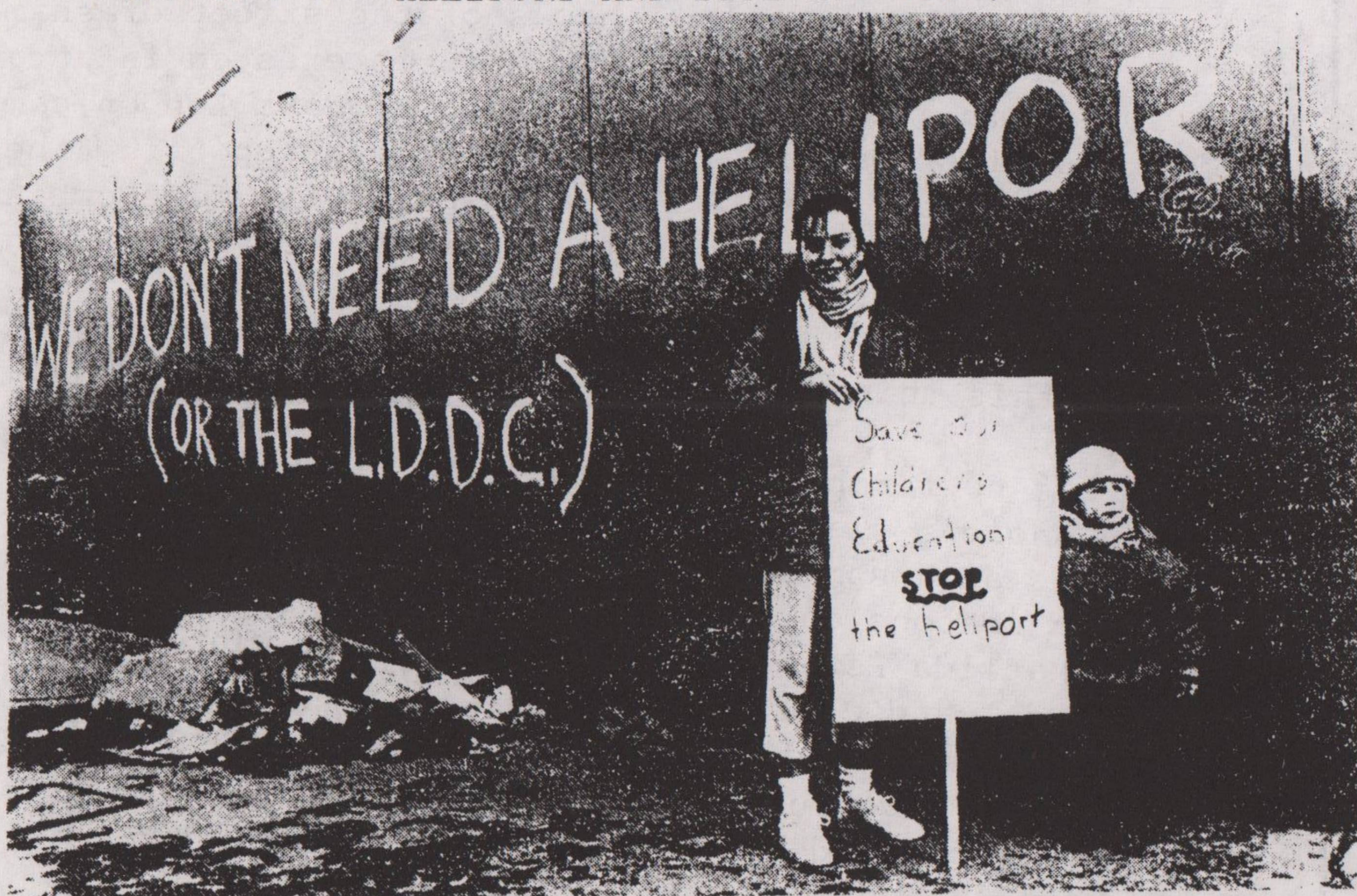
Trevor was picked up on New Years Eve by the police,and beaten seseless-he is now paralysed and braindamaged.
