At the last alliance meeting two main issues were discussed at some length. The Freeze campaign (details of which are outlined in the separate article) and organisation.

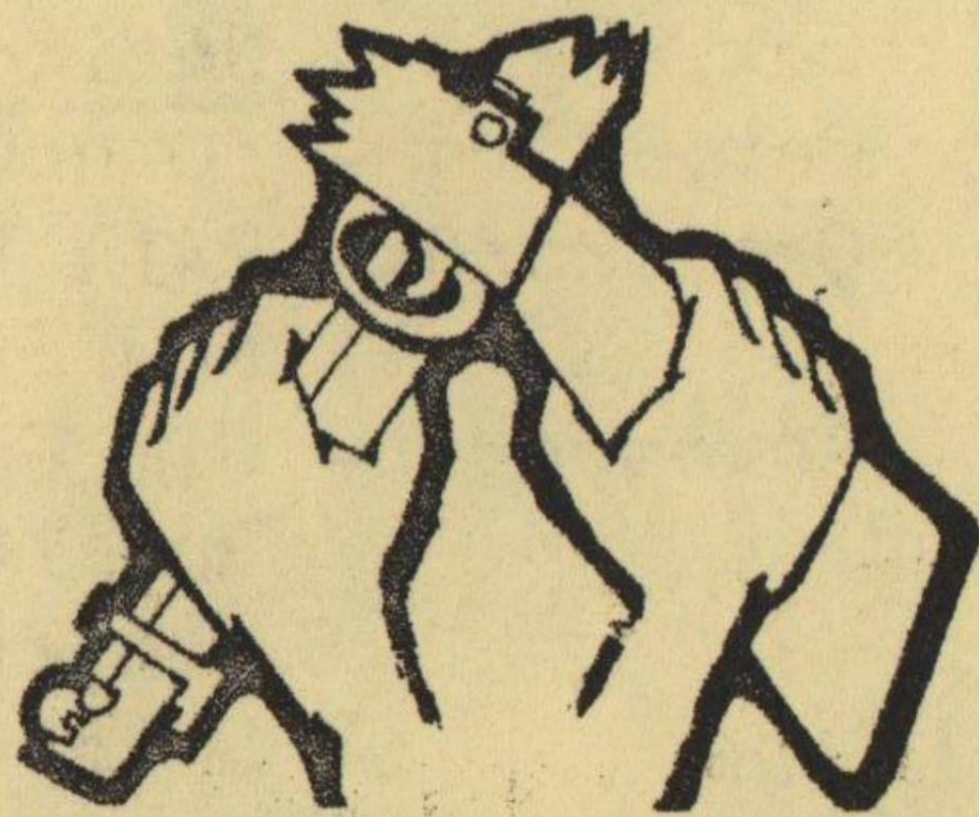
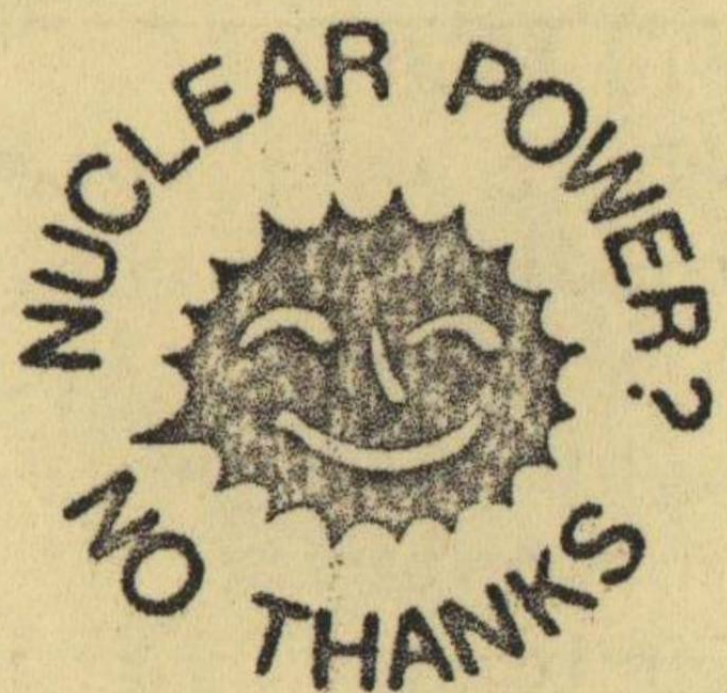
It was agreed to help our representatives to regional and national level by expressing our views on important issues. (e.g. the Freeze Campaign)

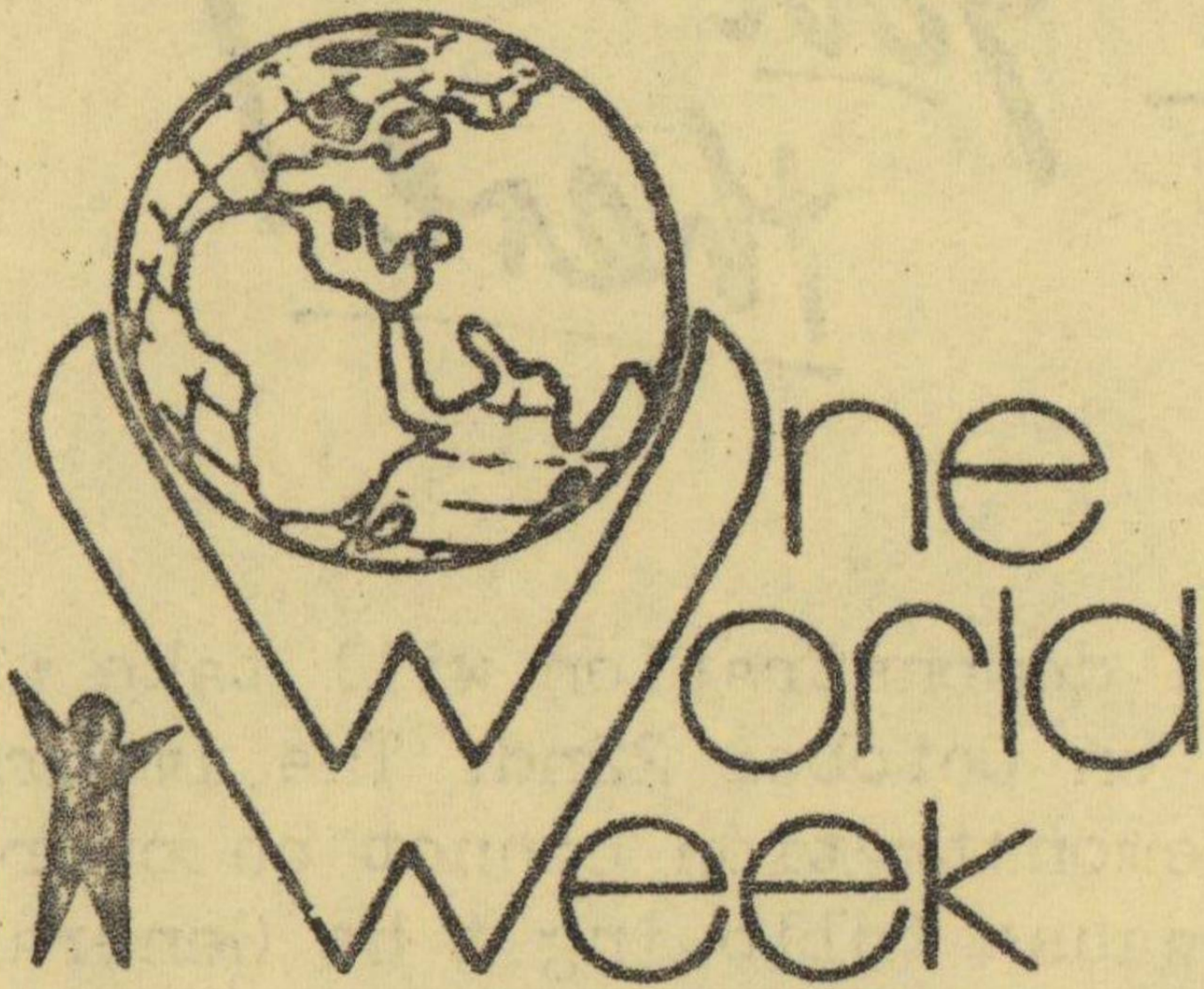
