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

Of course, we were not told that we were going to be used as cheap labour and exploited in every sector of the life. Most of the brothers were too timid to protest against the conditions they ter by rate exect ive were subjected to and all of them had to swallow the status of second class citizens. There was no effective organisation of the Black people, no of man had and and leadership among the brothers, no unity or plan for action, and due to this period of confusion amongst the Black people, the British Businessmen enjoyed the so called period of CALM AND I HACE. 
What is your record?

IMIGRATION BILL. A DECLARATION OF WAR.

Within a few weeks, the racist immigration (Aliens) bill will become a law given the present racist euporia in the govt. This bill is specifically aimed at all Black people. no matter whether we are West Indians, Pakistanies, Indians or Africans and THUS WE ALL MUST KNOW THIS INHUMAN BILL INSIDE OUT SO AS TO ENLIGHTEN OTHER BROTHERS ON IT AS WELL? What does all this mean for a Black Person?. Firstly, it is striking at the well established rights of the black worker as to where to sell his labour, who to sell his labour or where to live.

These rights have been fought for and won by the workers over the years x against the profit grabbing employers. It is well established that the modern worker is free to sell his labour to whom he pleases, to change his job without police intervention to live an area of his own choosing. Yet; the clauses of the Immigration Bill (known as Aliens Bill) will stike at all these ·and ruthlessly voilate every one of these principles. This bill is using the black worker, the original producer of the wealth of this nation as guinea pigs to perfact and refine the laws which undoubtly will be meated P'CICM DE FILL COLOUR out to entire working class. A YOUTH SPEAKS

ON Thursday, 8th July, 1971 about twenty Black Youths of our community got together for a meeting which was to be addressed by Black Fanthers from London, but the Panthers could not turn up. So the evening was spent on discussion of the problems facing the Black Youth in Bristol. Through the discussion we started to define for ourselves the kind of life we want which is being Denied Us. Our: average age was eighteen years. We grew up in Britain, received our education here and now feel united against racism in Britain, the racism which commels us to inferior status. Our demands

What are we concerned about? What are we trying to achieve? What ate our demands?

First of all we want an immeiate end to police brutality, most of us found that we have been manhandled, denied our rights by police at one time or another. Because the young refuse to be oppressed, the police concentrate on brutalising us. Every evening, near the cafes we are at, the

police come and watch us as if we are criminals doing our daily exercise in gaols. We are picked up off streets, searched at the whim of any officers and locked up in cells for as long as police have been able to hide the fact that they are holding us.

Unemployment

Over 80 , of the school leavers have been unable to find any jobs. The common experience was,

. I went for a job, but the youth employment exbhange sent another five white kids too, so the moment the employer looked at my black face, he said thaere was no job. I know that two days after me a white fellow got the very same job."

These kinds of humiliating experiences were common among those present.

Youth Centre

Over 90% of the membership of Baptist Mills Youth Centre is Black but it is run by a white youth officer with dictatorial powers to expel or suspend anyone. There is no representation of Black Feople in running of their own youth centre or in any say in who to expel or suspend. There was a growing militancy about these acts of injustice. We finalised a demand, We want a Youth Centre designed by ourselves, run by ourselves and not by white officers imposed from outside. A group of five members of the organisation went to see the white Youth Officer Mr. Edward-----.

A YOUTH SPEAKS OUT , . . continued The complete harrowing conversation we had with him is recorded on a tare. He admitted that he had the ultimate power to empel and suspend members. He admitted that there is no consultation with the members about the running of the place, abouth the decision making arraratus. He admitted having expelled the Brothers we were talking about. He admitted " that he personally disliked the brothers expelled.

He ordered us all out of his office for bringing these complaints. We are forced to conclude that Black Community and Youth must have their on Youth Centre run by themselves clone, if we want to save our children from the humiliation of having to put up with the kind of arrogant and highminded attitude of totally unsuitable Youth Officers like Mr. Edwards --

- II. While forced to go on the roads, these brithers face the RACIST Cops, are 1. "t left to be brytalised and beaten up.



This racist system is forcing us to live in these conditions, paying these people to suppress the Blacks. We must press for AN IMMEDIATE RESIGNATION OF THE YOUTH OFFICER OF THE BAFTIST MILLS YOUTH CENTRE, WE MUST IMMEDIATELY BE GIVEN THE FULL SAY AND CONTROL IN THE RUNNING OF THIS CENTRE.

BROTHERS, we must inform all Black Feople in the community about our case. We must raise support among all the brothers and sisters who make use of



ART AND CULTURE.

For Black People, art for art s sake has no meaning, infect that is true for any oppressed people. Indvisualism is a term which again is irrelevent to oppressed people. It is irrelevent because it is a luxuerywhich can not be possible for us as we have not got the price it requires. We, as Black people are systematically suppressed and exploited by a capatalist society which is accidently white. Because the socity which is standing at our backs is accidently white, we are confronted with a society, we ARE CONFRONTED WITH THE COLLECTIVE WILL OF THE SOCIETY. So our innovation in the fields of art and culture has to for revolutionary purpose, to expose the oppressor and ultimately to arouse the conciousness of our oppressed people so that they librate themselves, We librate ourselves, so that enslavement of man by man may cease for ever.

The same words will go out to our brothers who are being educated in the schools, colleges and universities of the oppressor that take care or else you may join the ranks opposite to the intrests of your own people. We must understand that as black people our destiny lies with the black people.

LET US NOT CARRY INNOCLNCE TO THE POINT OF BELIEVING THAT APPEALS TO REASON OR TO RESPECT FOR FUMAN DIGNITY CAN ALTER REALITY.

So, art and culture for all oppressed people have only one reality, they are a tool to be used for the only purpose to arouse the consciusness of the oppressed to the level of revolutionary awareness.



PAKISTAN AND BANGLA DUSH

The Lesson

Seven million people made refugees, many thousands mumbered, women raped, children and old people indiscrimately murdered to silence the cry for freedom by the people of Bangla Desh. The monstrous crime of the rulers of West Pakistan lays exposed and the collaboration of Britain and the U.S. showes the progressive people of these countries. Out hearts go out to those innocent people in Bangla Desh who are suffering in the might of combined forces of Imperialism. For Black people the lesson is obvious. (i) When big business in one country is threatened, it is always helped by U.S. and Britain

Thus we are faced with an enemy on an International scale and thus our opposition to it should be on an international scale too. (ii) The Bengla Besh people have paid the price for not having a strong foresighted leadership, their leaders should have foreseen the need of organising the people into armed and trained units


for these eventualities.
