


A NIGHT TO REMEMBER Bob Cann Box E 32 pages A5 landscape £0.60


THE LAST WAR George Barrett Pirate Press 66 pages A5 £1.70

FREE SCHOOL The White Lion Experience Nigel Wright 76 pages A5

The White Lion Free School opened in 1972 in Islington, North London and is Britain's best known and longest surviving free school. Surprisingly this is the first attempt at analysing its success or





Superb, thick (162 pages, spined), glossy magazine, featuring a mixture of art, comics, collage and prose (fiction and non-fiction).

POSSESSED £1.00 (*AK)

An anarchist journal from Seattle tending more toward art, collage, poetry and prose than analytical articles (though the latest issue includes an excellent article on women in prison). Strong ecological stance.

AGAINST SLEEP, AGAINST NIGHTMARE £1.50

Situationist influenced magazine, similar in some ways

to our very own Here and Now.

RESISTANCE £1.50

"Covering militant autonomist, anti-imperialist, national liberation, feminist and anti-nuclear struggles in advanced capitalist countries." This means in practice much coverage (such as printing communiques) of the European armed guerilla groups (CCC, RAF, Red Brigades etc), which has brought Resistance much criticism.

ENDLESS STRUGGLE 75p (*AK)

Excellent Canadian magazine, originally emanating from the punk underground.

ANARCHY: A Journal of Desire Armed £2.00 (*AK)

Perhaps the best, certainly the most regular, of the American periodicals. Carefully produced, intelligent and thought provoking material.

THE MATCH! £1.50

Beautifully printed and illustrated, in full colour. The bastion of individualist and atheist anarchism.

COVERT ACTION INFORMATION BULLETIN £4.50

Superb analysis and do-

cumentation of the CIA and right wing, covert activities in the States and elsewhere. Current issue (32) is the best yet.

KICK IT OVER £1.00 (*AK)

Another excellent Canadian periodical (quarterly), with the usual mix of news, articles, essays and reviews, specialising in in-depth articles and with a strong feministe and ecological slant.

OPEN ROAD 75p (*)

Best known Canadian anarchist newspaper. Good news coverage and reviews section.

HOMOCORE £1.00

As the title suggests, a magazine for homosexual/lesbian punks (though the appeal is far wider). Written by anarchists.


FIFTH ESTATE


