THE 9th. INTERNATIONAL ANTI-MILITARIST MARCH FOR 1984.

We decided to go to the coordination in Freiburg in South West Germany on the 3-4 March. It took us only one day to hitch ther arriving late on friday night. On saturday we numbered about 25 people from Germany, Belgium, Holland and Italy. The discussion began with questioning why so few countries were represented, especially from the south and why women were

so outnumbered (20-5). This was also asked in Brussels why when we were so close to Britain did only 10 people feel that it was important enough to come. The only answers that could be found were that the water is still a psycholocical barrier, people haven't woken up to the strength to be found in international action, or lack of info.

On 2nd June, 5 Bristol comrades went to the 'No to Botha'demo. From the start it was a tightly managed, and extreemly well controlled demo. There seemed to be no chance of protest . We reached Trafalgar Square and waited as the other 'anarchists' rushed off to see a gig in Jubilee Gdns. Black people around the Mangrove Community Association float stopped the march and made an attempt on the barriers, but were forced back. The march started to move off again but the police attackedand halted the marchwhilse they used snatch squads to grab black people. Most people where we were stood together and helped repulse the police and intervened to stop arrests.

Eventually the march moved off again with a great sense of unity (?)

When we reached Downing Street the march was chann eled between barriers 10ft apart . The police piled into us indescriminately beating and kicking black people - this was an unprovocked rascist attack black and white stood firm and resisted . The police were unable to make many arrests due to the level of resistance.

Black people face rascist attacks and violence from the police every time they orginise. For me, all illusions about the police and white middle class ideas of protest were swept away in a welter of boots and fists from the filth in uniform. Black and white stood firm and resisted together.





A police car patrols the area and a policeman is chatting to a young ' 'criminal', who is on his way to court. A young woman sits outside the Bus Station, homeless. All eyes are on her the policeman and criminal are discussing her, they reckon she is pretty, the officer explains that he would give her one in the back of his car, but it's a bit risky for his job. 'Criminal' understands. Woman notices them, waits till a car is in the area, she then picks up a bottle and throws it at the car its occupiers leap out towards her, and 5 policemen move in, and drag her to the station.



As we know, the police force is both sexist and racist. The recent 'clean up' of prostitution in St Pauls has resulted in several black pimps receiving heavy sentencing on the evidence of many, many young women. Their evidence has been vital, but apart from promises of police protection, these inexperienced and confused girls have been given little help from any direction, even though the police and social services are obviously in cahoots over this one.

The witnesses are cought between the brutality and exploit ation of a life dictated by pimps, and their chance to break free, and test ify against their 'pr -otectors', knowing full well how the courts and prisons will use them. It is interesting to note here that the prof essions are well represented amongst the punters in St Pauls.

Although you'd expect thepolice force to have very sophisticated phone tapping equipment, they seem remarkably coy about admitting to anything. However, it has come to our attention that various businesses, (who, needless to say, are worried by the waste of world resourses etc), such as banks, insurance companies etc have been installing equipment to moniter the phone calls of employ. ees. Of course this equipment too, (like that of the police force), is far from sophisticated and can merely record calls, and the mum-

ber dialled, and the distance, and the length, and work simultaneously on every phone in a modern office (quite a few). 
