INTRODUCTION

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So you thought you'd seen the last of New Crimes, ha?Well hard luck, 'cos here we are again. Admitedly it's been a long time since the last issue apeared, and for a long time I myself thought the paper had probably gone for good, disapeared into history along with Fack, Scum, Paroxysm Fear and all those other blossoms of '81 (now watch me eat my words as all three of those papers suddenly produce new issues:). To be honest, I became disillusioned. During 1980-81 New Crimes had been developing alongside mags like Idealogically Enigma, Fack, Scum and Az, and although we used to Sound camel correspond regularly and meet at the occasional gig(by Penny. we never had the oportunity to really sit down and discuss our ideas properly. Then along came the Wapping Anarchist Centre.At first the atmosphere was great; there were some excelant gigs, some informative discusions/arguments and generally good time was had by all. Within weeks the rot had begun to set in. The bands became dificult to tell apart; in my memory they merge into a sclid wall of badly played half-baked anarchy, peace and freedom sloganeering . The audience became divided into two sections of unequal size; the people trying to clear the place up and keep it running properly, and the people who were too interested in flooding the toilets, writing on the walls and putting their noses into glue-bags to look after the place or put any work into it.Perhaps it was inevitable.What was less inevitable : was the backstabbing that started to take place; so and so had stopped speaking to so and so... 'X' band had decided that 'X' band were 'posers' ... 'Y' band wouldn't play with 'Y' band because of their 'popstar attitude' ... 'Z' band were 'sell-outs' ... I tried to stay outside of the whole factionalised 'scene' that was starting to build up(not through any sense of superiority, but because the whole thing struck me as being so..Youthclubbish, for want of a better word), but no, this was not possible. Suddenly I was a 'poser'; I'd'sold out'. Why? Had I donated all the money from New Crimes to the conservative party?Had I become a police informer?Had I joined the staff of Sounds?No, my crime was that my musical tastes and attitudes had begun to change; I bought ABC's LP; I started to like the music made by and Rockers Revenge more than that made by Dirt or Rudimentary Peni. Whole areas to which my musical sensibilities had previously been closed began to open up, but did James Brown this mean that my views on other subjects had changed?Acording to Those Who Were Hip it did, and the slanging started. My reaction, not suprisingly, was one of 'well, fuck you and your narrow minds too', and all contact with the Anarchist world was cut off. Well, almost all, I still kept up a correspondance with a few people, to whom I remain grateful, for it was them who encouraged me to start again. It was around last December-at the squated gig at the Zig Zag to be precise that I finaly decided to do another issue of New Crimes, and here, ten months later, it is. A number of the articles, for example the pieces on Operation Hardrock and Animals Film, had already been typed out, so they might seem slightly cut of date, but I felt that the details were still relevant so I let them stand without amandment. Some of the articles might seem a bit out of place for the old New Crimes, but bear in mind that this isn't the old New Crimes. I've always tried to make the magazine reflect Me, and just because some of my ideas about some subjects have changed there is no reason why I should alter that policy just because 'most fanzines' don't have interviews with reggae bands or articles about rapping. Anyway, this is New Crimes seven. I'd be pleased to know what you think. THE-ANGRY MOUNIGNAN . SPEAKS OUT: AN INTERVIEW WITH NEALE HARMER

NEALE HARMER IS A PUNK/PROTEST SINGER FROM HORSHAM, WEST SUSSEX. HE SO FAR HAS RELEASED TWO CASSETTES, BOTH ON HIS OWN 'ANARCHIST THRASH' TAPE LABEL, ENTITLED 'POLITICAL STANCE' AND 'ANGRY' HIS SONGS ARE DISTINCTIVE BY THEIR BASIC SIMPLICITY, CONSISTING OF SHORT (USUALY NOT MORE THAN A MINUTE) SHARP BURSTS OF ANGER EXPRESSED BY GUITAR AND VOICE ALONE. BOTH CASSETTES ARE ACOMPANIED BY FANZINES WHICH INCLUDE LYRICS, EXTENSIVE BACKGROUND NOTES AND FACTS AND SUGGESTED FURTHER READING NEALE ATTACKS MANY FAMILIAR SUBJECTS, EG, NUCLEAR WEAPONS, VIVSECTION, GOVERNMENT ETC, BUT HE ALSO ATTACKS MANY LESS FAMILIAR OR OBVIOUS SUBJECTS INCLUDING SEXUALITY ('BIG PENIS', 'FUCK', 'TEEN POLITICS') OFULENCE ON THE DISCO FLOOR ('DISCO BART') AND THE IDEA OF THE 'HARD CORE PUNK' ('NO CHAOS', BOVVER BOYS', 'HARD NUT'). I RECENTLY SENT NEALE SOME QUESTIONS, TO WHICH HE

REPLYED AS FOLLOWS:

'AAH SPEW,

SPIT!

G.B:WHEN AND WHY DID YOU START TO RECORD SONGS? N.H:I began writing songs in 1978, when I bought my guitar. I was inspired by the honest simplicity of various punk bands, and I thought I'd try and do my little bit to make this world a better place.

WHY HAVE YOU REJECTED THE TRADITIONAL 'BAND' SET UP IN FAVOUR OF SOLO GUITAR AND VOICE? I finally decided to go it alone because the band I was in was not going where I wanted.Whilst I agree that individuals should co-operate, I found there was no-one who really wanted to play what I did, so to avoid compromising my views, I thought I'd do my own thing. The advantges are complete frredom to sing and play what I like, and being able to rehearse when I like. There are obvious disadvantages, such as not having enough money to arange gigs and not being able to have much of a varied sound which I think can be gained from a group. I hope people will be inspired to get up and do something from my example, like I was inspired by other bands and individuals. In a group, critisim from an outside force is not as hurtful as when you're an individual; I'm no less vulnerable than anyone else, so if I can do it, anyone can. YOUR TAPE WAS ADVERTISED IN 'SOUNDS' AS BEING 'HARD CORE PUNK', YET IN A COUPLE OF YOUR SONGS YOU HAVE ATTACKED THE MYTH OF THE 'HARD CORE PUNK' . WHY IS THIS, AND WHAT ARE YOUR FEELINGS TOWARDS THE 'PUNK SCENE' IN GENERAL?

I don't think labelling oneself is a very good idea, but for the sake of people who might be interested in my tapes I call them hard core punk. I think its a fair description. To a certain extent, its rather a case of selling fridges to the eskimos-many of the views I hold will be the same as people who buy the tapes. Even so, I like to include a few songs that question the punk tradition such as 'Leather Jacket', 'Hard Nut' and 'No Smoking', because unless someone's views are questioned and thus explored they become stagnant and final. Ideas become doctrines-just another set of rules to live by. However, I'm also keen to avoid the trap that many people are now falling into, particularly the anti-anarchy brigade, of pulling down and ridiculing anything and everything to do with punk. Instead of looking at the bad points we should all be concentrating on the good points. Because a person is anti-vivisection but does eat meat thats no reason to say that his/her contribution to the anti vivisection lobby is any less worthy or effective.Because a punk wears a leather jacket with a peace sign on the back, it doesn't mean his contibution to peace marches is less valid than a vegetarians. Thats why I'd rather tackle this problem with a line like "You help kill it, buy a leather jacket" (from 'Leather Jacket') than a line like "You punks are a bunch of fucking hypocrites" (from an anarcho-nihilist zine). The only bands I agree with personally are the so-called 'Crass-axis'

----- band is worth listening to if theyeve made the effort to do a record.

WOULD YOU DESCRIBE YOURSELF AS AN ANARCHIST?

That depends on how you would define the term 'an anarchist'. I'm just doing what I can, when I can. The problemnof applying labels isn't mine Anarchism is the rejection of state control by the individual.State control applies to everyone, so no-one is truly 100% free.We can, however, free our minds and refuse to be a cog in the machine.We may have to work for a living, but we can also leaflet, demonstrate, march, or do something else to show that at least our minds are not entirely controlled.

HAVE YOU HAD MUCH EXPERIENCE GIGGING LIVE?

The only live gig as such was in front of my class at college. The set lasted ten minutes, and was met with silence apart from a polite aplause at the end. The teacher was not impressed. The few local gigs around my area are all by heavy rock bands who don't want my services-even free-because punks might be atracted to the gig. I'm still willing to support anyone for the cost of my petrol money.

YOU HAVE WRITTEN SONGS COMMENTING ON VARIOUS SUBJECTS INCLUDING VIVISECTION, WAR, SEX-ISM, TRIBALISM, SEXUAL ROLEPLAYING, VEGETARIANISM, VIOLENCE ETC. DO YOU SEE THESE AS SEPARATE XXXXXXXX ISSUES OR AS SYMPTOMS OF A LARGER PROBLEM?

I see all these as symptons of one problem. Call it what you like. 'Normality', 'life', or of course 'the system'. Unless people ask 'Why?' it will never change. Tribalism divides and rules. War divides and rules. Sexism, racism, speciesism divide and rule. The people at the top, in control, are all kept there by a delibarate or unconcious manipulation and perpetuation of 'normality'.

WHAT ARE YOUR FEELINGS ON CND?ITS SEEMS TO BE CURRENTLY FASHIONABLE AMONGST ANARCH-ISTS TO ATTACK THE CND ORGAN SATION, BUT WHAT ARE THE ALTERNATIVES?

CND is not perfect, but as long as anarchists are well aware of the organisations shortcomings, I think its a worthwhile cause to support, The world would be a bleaker place without CND, because there would be no equally effective alternatives.

IN WHAT WAYS DO YOU THINK WE CAN EFFECT CHANGE IN THE SOCIETY IN WHICH WE LIVE? CAN CHANGE COME ON A MASS SCALE OR ONLY ON A PERSONAL LEVEL?

Social change can be implemented in two ways. The first is by a change of government, the best alternative being the Ecology Party. The second is by people taking charge of their own lives and rejecting the government. This could be in the form of a riot, or just a massivev "NO!" by 99% of the population. Ultimately, I would like to see people living lives which are as freeeas possible-free from advertising pressure, free from sexual pressure, parental pressure, social pressure etc. This process of social change would undoubtably take thousands of years-one only needs to walk through a city and see all the housewives and businessmen to realise that 99.9% of the population aren't looking for alternatives. We havn't got the time for social change-nuclear war could occur today. It is today people are starving. Therefore I would reluctantly conclude that the best step in the right direction would be to vote the Ecology party into power. To anarchists this might seem like a cop-out, but under the Ecology Party (which advocates agriculturalism , decentralisation etc) we would all be in a better position, compared to now days, to work towards a state of mx mutual co-operation-ie, anarchy. To attempt anarchy on a large scale today is impossible its like running before we've learnt to walk. It can work on a personal level-an example can be a blue print of future hope. Proof that this outlook is viable can be

YOU CRITISISE DISCO'S AND 'DISCO MUSIC' BECAUSE THEY ENCOURAGE IN ESCAPIST, OPULENT LIFE STYLE. WHAT DO YOU MEAN BY OPULENCE? SURELY ISCAPISM CAN BE A GOOK HING TO A CER-TAIN DEGREE?DO YOU AGREE?

Oppulence is unnecesary wealth. To overeat at a banquet, while people are starving in other countries, is obscene. Escapism helps acceptance of the horrors of their reality "Go down the pub and forget the working day". Drug yourself. Desensitise your emotions, Turn on the TV. Headache pills. Cosmetice. Escape. Create a problem (stress, cancer, riots). Then solve these problems-making money in the process (valium, research, war). Disco is spothing. It asks no questions. Go on holiday and forget your job. Forget the starvation Forget nuclear war. Dance don't rigt. I suppose going to a punk gig is a form of escapin but at least there's a caring message in the music. Heres a quote from a middle aged man fknow; "Dp you know what I'm going to do if the bomb comes down? I'm going to buy a bottle of whisky and get pissed out of my brain."The dreadful thing is that he I proabiv be blown up a happy man. It isn't made easy for you if you don't accept their arugs. WHAT DO YOU ENJOY ABOUT LIFE (EG, HOW DO YOU SPEND YOUR SPARE TIME WHAT MUSIC DO YOU

Tlike all sorts of music, particularly pank of course. I don't get any free time because I spend it all on writing and releasing songs, writing statements, leafleting, organising the local animal rights group that we we just set up going on demos, etc. I do sometimes go to the cinema, and if there's a particularly good documentary on TV I'll watch it. It can get tiring, but if I din't want to do it, I wouldnt. WHAT SORT OF FEEDBACK DO YOU GET FROM YOUR WORK?

Everyone I've sent a tape to has written back to me saying they like what I'm doing. It's very encouraging to recieve letters from people who've made the effort to reply. Two people have gone vegetarian partly because of my song 'Eating Arimals' Obviously they were influenced by other people as well, but to get letters saying that I helped ibfluence their descision makes it all worthwhile. Others have written back and told ma that they've written off to various animal rights groups and have fiven out antivivisection leaflets or whatever, which has got to be a possitive step to take.] Obviously I get critisisms, which serves to strengthen my own ideals, but on the whole, peoples reactions are very favorable. riterrotic del

FINALLY IS THERE ANYTHING ELSE YOU'D LIKE TO SAY?

Punk was a chance for people who cared to break out from tradition. It was a chance to question, to ask why. It never threatened the status quo, but it did raise the questions. Many people saw it as another uniform or another way of shocking the parents. Hence, the system was confronted by mohican haircuts and leather jackets. The Sun informed the publie that they were shocked. The Sex Pistols swore on TV and their album went to number one Anarchy and chaos was anounced and toilets were smashed nation wide every saturday night The music press tidied up the rough edges and put punk into little jars labeled 'Streat Level', 'Hard core', 'Oi', 'Herbert' Punk, which was born as silly clothes and posing at the Roxy, became a 'working class rebel' intertainment. Entertainment. No thoughts just well meant slogans which inspired the audience to do little else but be aggresive and to buy another beer. From the manipulated mass novement there were outcasts. These were people who still chose to ask why, and were not content with the excuse of "you don't have to ask why now, we've got punk". The individuals who were not/content with anything less than 100%.

They ceased to be the audience, and started to write their own fanzines, play their own songs.While the masses pogoed to their entertainment, the individuals gave out leaflets, painted walls, liberated animals, printed questions, wrote letters, glued locks, vandalised banks and army recruiting centres

ANARCHY, VIOLENCE AND FREEDOM?ONE WET ARSED PACIFIST' REFLECTS ON THE ANARCHIST YOUTH FEDERATION AND THEIR PROPOGANDA AND TACTICS

A fairly new current amongst what might be generally termed the 'new anarchist movements which has sprung up in the wake of the short lived Anarchist and Autonomy Centres and the meetings of people and ideas that went on there (when everyone WHIMM wasn't too stoned or pissed), is that of the 'militant Anarch-THIN ists, most notably exemplified by the self-styled Anarchist Youth Federation, This current seems to have arissen as a reaction against thoughtless and passive acceptance of Crass' 'Anarchy, Peace and Freedom' slogan adopted by many punks who seem to view the aforementioned band as just another pop group and their philosophies as just another fashion to follow.

Instead the AYF have drawn their inspiration from historical Anarchist currents and organisations, such as the CNT and FAI, the syndicalist Anarchist controlled unions who played such a major part in the Spanish civil war, and, more recently, from groups like the Angry Brigade, who were active during the early seventies.

The new 'inarcho-militant' movement has many positive aspects, especially with their Direct Action aproach towards opening up. squats, setting up housing co-ops, printing magazines and leaflets, graffitting and getting involved with animal liberation, eg, taking direct action against butchers and furriers such as gluing up locks etc. However, throughout the philosophies of the new militants there is an aggresiveness and dare I say machismo which I personally find disturbing ... The following are all quo tes from Militant Anarchist literature: "(ANTICLERICALISM) IS A MARVELOUS OUTLET FOR THOSE PUNKS TOO COWARDLY TO BREAK THE LAW ... "(1) "THE ONLY LANGUAGE POLITICANS UNDERSTAND IS THAT OF MOLOTOVS AND BURNING POLICE VANS" "OUR ENEMY, THE STATE, IS VAST AND FORMID-ABLE, THUS THE BUSINESS OF REVOLUTION IS SERIOUS"(3) ". THUSE WHO ARE WILLING TO CHALLENGE THE STATE AND WORK FOR IT'S DOWNFALL, THESE ARE THE ONES THAT HAVE EARNED THE RIGHT TO CALL THEMSELVES .: NARCHISTS" (4) (my underline) "OUR MESSIGE TO THOSE OF YOU WHO WISH TO PRETEND AT BEING ANARCHISTS IS SIMPLE: GET OFF OUR BACKS AND GO HOME TO YOUR PARENTS"(5) "IDEALS OF PACIFISM ARE OBSOLETE"(6) "BRITAIN IS HEADING TOWARDS A STATE OF TOTAL CLASS WAR"(7) "WE MUST BE PREPARED TO FIGHT WITH ALL THE WEAPONS AT OUR DISPOSAL, IE, STRIKES, SIT INS, CIVIL DISOBEDIANCE AND, ULTIMATELY, ARMED RESISTANCE"(8) There are many more quotes to be found amongst AYF/Militant Anarchist literature, and fantasies of 'Direct Confrontation' and 'armed struggle' are even being enacted by 6

some aparently, including "The attempted fire bombing of the 'Boy' clothes shop in Kings Road"(9), "Vandalism of a West London electoral registration office"9X (10), "The sending of a fake letter bomb to the Bolton Clothes store 'The Alien'" (this, aparently was because they incorporate a circled 'A' in their logo Is this the price heretics must pay for d desecrating a sacred symbol?), "The damas ging of 50 , expensive cars in the Islington area" (did they bother to find who these 'expensive cars' belonged to?), "The sending of threatening letters to The Economic League, Industrial Research and Information Services, & The United Industrial League"(11) and the disruption of the CND demonstration in October 1901 (not simply the heckling of political opportunists as reported in New Crimes 6, but also "the woman representative of YCND who was told to "Fuck off back to Hampstead", "performing groups who were ushered out with shouts of "boring", ' and Oxford Mothers Against The Bomb, whose "banners we hauled down" and so on). (12) Basically the message seems to be that

violent confrontation with the state is not only inevitable, but actually desirable

and those that disagree, for whatever reason, share this view, are nothing more than 'wet arsed pacifists'(13) who deserve to be silenced. This is a generalised view that I do not like, and it is this objection that has led me to write the following reply to some of the Anarchomilitant's propoganda:

In a nutshell, perhaps you'd better stuff your fantasies of revolution as revenge and yout dreams of molotov cocktails and cop-killing back into the bomb making manuals and comic books in which you found them before somebody gets hurt.

"Britain is heading towards a state of total class war" ... Bollocks. The atmosphere in post prince William, post Falklands Britain is about as revolutionary as the Mail On Sunday's editorial column. Do you really believe that the great majority of British people even understand the true meaning of Anarchism let alone sympathise with Anarchist ideas? If so you must be very naive indeed. If mr. and mrs. Average were to read any of your 'Militant' propoganda or see the results of your 'Direct Action' such as burnt out boutiques or the YCND representative having her right to free speech silenced because of her middle class accent, it would confirm the image that Ravachol left to the movement in most peoples minds; that . Anarchists are no more than a bunch of fanatical bomb throwing cranks and lunatic minded terrorists.

What if your desired armod confrontation with the State' becomes a step nearer to reality, and a militant Anarchist takes it upon himself to shoot a policeman or blow up a police station?After all, that would be the next logical step, wouldn't it? If the death or serious injury of one police officer was to occur as a result of 'Militant Anarchist' activity every single Anarchist, socialist, libertarian, communist, left-liberal or politically unorthodox union member would be harrased and hounded, and many would be locked away. Every slightly left-ofcentre journal would would either be scrutinised or banned outright. Every left wing bookshop would be raided, and many closed down. It would be the biggest clamp-lown and witch-hunt seen in this county, and what would have been achieved Wothing, because the whole thing would happen with the blessing of the great British public. For Anarchists to advocate or employ

violent methods, particularly of a terrorist nature, is to do no more than play into the hands of the State, not to mention to contradict one of the basic philosophies in which Anarchists supposedly believe. Anarchists, who explicitly or impli-LAN OD citly believe that people are basicaly decent and good underneath, argue that they have the right to self-determination, the right to live their lives in the way that they choose, free from external coercion. Therefore Anarchists must accept that others must also be free to live their lives in the way they wish to.Violence is a negation of that right to self-determination, as involves forcing another person or group of people to behave in a way that you desire them to. The State un-11020 derstands violence, and commits far more acts of violence on every level than Anarchists could possibly hope enolt. to combat by conventional(ie, violent) methods. It is the State who control the army and police. It is the State that have the guns and tear gas canisters. It is the state that has the hand grenades, riot shield, protective clothes and batons. It is the State that controls the mass media; the newspapers and television. It is the State that mas the mental hospitals and prisons which is at this very moment commiting acts of violence against those who have stepped beyond the boundaries of what The State decrees is sanity or legality. It is up to Anarchists therefore to challenge the State in ways that present alternatives to the age old traditions of

eccesion and violence.

Even the most despotic and tyrannical of governments or systems would find it impossible to function without the support of the majority of its subjects.Why,then do people support the State and all the horrors such as exploitation, poverty, corruption and inequality that go with it? There are many reasons, and not just

because, as many fanzines would concietedly have it, everyone is a self-centred shit or has been brainwashed (the fanzines to which I refer somehow believe that they have managed to escape the brainwashing process). Many people are genuinly unaware of the true nature of the State, whilst others do not want to know and will hide from the truth. Many others do not agree with the State, but having no knowledge of non-authoritarian political systems see no other alternative but to vote for 'the other party' at the next election. People have their own lives to get on with; perhaps family commitments prevent them from being activly opposed to the State, or perhaps they feel too alone, isolated and scared to act.

It is the fear, ignorance and isolation of ordinary, normal people that keep the

State in power, therefore if Anarchists are to change society for the better this is where they must work-with people. To educate and inform those who don't know, to confront those who won't listen, to show solidarity and unity with those who are alone . Anarchistsmust work to prove that society can exist without government and that the alternatives, based on trust, co-operation and mutual respect are in fact better than what exists today. There are many, many levels on which to work, by campaigning on issues which effect the community, such as housing, pollution, transport etc, or on wider issues, such as disarmament, enimal liberation, womens rights, gay rights and so on.Get your views accross:Form a band, print a leaflet, start a fanzine, demonstrate, talk to people.Better still, work directly to get things changed. If you don't like the chemically corrupted and over processed food sold in the supermarket, try to establish a means of growing and distributing - wholefoods. If you don't the way you are housed or are not sattisfied with the way the council are treating you or your nieghbors, form an alternative housing association, not to 'influence the councilors'but to take direct action, such as opening up squats or taking over and renovating derelict property. If you own a car or van why not try to provide an alternative to the disgrace that is called public transport, offer lifts to the old or disabled people, or if you are a woman car owner why not follow the example of a London based group I recently read of and start a cut price taxi service

otherwise be too afraid to go out at night due to the threat of male violence. If youre tired of reading newspapers that mis-report local happenings according to what the vested interests of what the Ascosiated Newspapers Group syndicate wants you to MAXX hear, start your own local newspaper reporting the facts as they really stand, print it on a duplicator and make sure the local people have access to it(eg, try and get newsagents etc to stock it) (a good example of such a local newssheet is the Hastings based Poison Pen, which the Hastings Anarchist Group manage to produce every two weeks). These are just a couple of suggestions, when you think about it the possibilities are endless, there areso many fields to work in, food, housing, politics, art, transport, religion, entertainment and so on. Maybe some of the ideas I've outlined above seem a bit impracticable or too much like hard work, but if there are several of you involved they could all be made to work. Besides, if you believe in Anarchist ideals strongy enough to want to throw bombs at people the least you could do is to try and make your ideals at least a partial reallity within your own community. It must be said though, that however hard you are working to change society or whiting publicize anarchist ideas and alternatives the majority of people will probably not take any notice until their own life is affected, and only then will things begin to change on a large scale. If you have been active beforhand in your community perhaps there will be more chance of such changes taking place without resorting to violence, there have been many examples in history of massive movements of non-violently acting people bringing about major social changes, lets look now at a few examples: of people marched over 240 miles from XX Ahmedabad to Dandi to protest against the government's imposition of a tax on salt, a basic human neccesity. More and more people joined the march on the way, and when they arived at Dandi, a coastal salt. This gesture led to civil disobediance which spread throughout India, IX during which 60,000 people were arested. Next 2,500 volunteers, trained in the

service run by and for women who might Cheese and line in South Central France. In 1971 the government decided to extend the boundaries of the military camp which is located there into areas which are owned by peasents. The peasants, influenced by Ghandi's Indian example, took action in militant but non-violent forms including graffiting roadsignwith the word 'Lawzac', the constructing of sheep pens on army claimed land, holding, in 1972, a tractor pilgrimage accross France to Paris, which the guthorities, scared of the consequences stopped 100 yards short of the capital. Most remarkably and symbolically, a herd of sheep was brought into Paris in the middle of the night and set to graze beneath the Eiffel Tower where press and police discovered them in the morning! Eventually the peasents struggles were rewarded, and the authorities were forced to abandon their plans in 1981.

Observing the fruitlessness of the violent retaliation against Russian troops by the people of Hungary when their country was invaded by the Warsaw Pact in 1956, the people of Czechoslovakia decided, when their country was invaded in 1968, to reject violent action in favour of such nonviolent tactics as non-coperation, removal of roadsigns, continual production of underground newspapers and broadcasting from outlawed radio stations, sitting down in front of tanks, explaining their views to Russian troops (who had been told that they were liberating the nation on the peoples behalf) and so. The effect was that the invading army was bewildered and demoralised, and it took them 6 months to establish their order, wheras in Hungary they had been able to put down prasticly all oposition in very little time and with many more casualties on both sides. Aparthied is the name given by the South African government to the system based on racial segregation which currently operates in that country. Under aparthied, two racial categories are officially recognised, whites and blacks, the latter category includes African, Indian and 'coloured people' (ie, of mixed

origin). Every aspect of life is seperated between whites and blacks, they must live in seperate towns, be educated separately, have seperate health care, use seperate busses, trains, bars, restaurants, cinemas and even sit on seperate park benches. In every case the facilities for white people are far superioir to those used by blacks.

For the whites, aparthied means 'the good life'; high living standards, power and priviledge, but at what cost to the black population?

The South African economy is dependant on its black work force, in fact the entire aparthied system is built around exploitation of cheap black labour.Workers must toil in the factories, fields and mines under slave-like conditions for the most miserable of pittances as the wage scales bellow demonstate;

FARM WORKERS.AVERAGE WAGES IN 1976 (DEPT STATISTICS, PRETORIA) WHITES:£70.00P.W BLACKS:513.00 PW (NB.PW=PER WEEK.) Working conditions are appaling by any civilised standards, between 1936-66 19,000 men,97% of whom were African have bwen killed in mines, an average of 3 deaths per shift.Living conditions are not much better.

Blacks must live in either the poverty ridden slums that surround the affluent white towns, or else they are forced to live in the over crowded and barren 'homelands' of Bantustans, the only places where Africans are recognised as having the right to live officially, despite these areas taking up only 13% of the land in South Africa(Africans however constitute 70% of the population).Basically the Bantustans are a dumping ground for what the white economy considers 'superfluos apendages', widows, the old, retired people, and the unemployed of all ages.Oficialy the Bantustans are independant of the government and ruled by tribal chiefs, yet these chiefs are chosen by and are in the pay of the government, consequently the Bantustan's state of independance' is a total farce, represion is just as common as anywhere else in South Africa. Disease and poverty levels are high, acording to the World Health Organisation as many as 50% of babies born in the Bantustans do not reach the age of five.

Because blacks are not recognized as baring the might to meta, they have no logal. means of changing their situation. Protest and dissent, from white students as well as blacks, has been brutally repressed by the government. In 1942 strikes were declared illegal, but despite this the African Mineworkers Union called its 75,000 members out in 1946 for a ten shillings a week wage. The brutal represion which followed showed that the government had no intention of recognising black trade unions.

On March 21st 1960 police opened fire on peaceful anti-pass law demonstrators killing 69 people and wounding a further 188. Following this a state of emergency was declared, leading to the detention of over 20,000 people. Torture of detainees became common place, and between 1963-197? as many as 47 political prisoners have died in custody including Steve Biko.

A peaceful demonstration against the Bantu education system staged by Soweto schoolchildren in 1976 was also fired on by police, and many hundreds of children workers, and students who continued to protest lost their lives over the days that followed. This sparked off the largest and monthidespread anti-a farthied demonstations ever.Africans, Indians, coloureds, and some diffices (mainly students) joined together to march for black demands. By the end of the year an estimated 1000 people had been killed by police bullets, and many thousands more had been mained or injured. Despite this, the struggle has continued and as continuing boday.

Perhaps your attitude as you read this has been "Well, it shall very terrible, but what can I do-Its all happening so far aver from me", true ball perhaps it is worth remembering that Britain has very considerable trade and basiness links with South Africa, 23% of South African imports are from Britain, and 30% of their exports are shipped over here. If foriegn trade which fuels South Africa's economy were to be withdrawn the foundations of aparthied would be seriously damaged, and perhaps collapse entirely. The first step towards achieving this end that we can take is to boycott South African products. Don't buy Cape fruit. Pay attention to the 'country' of origin' labels when you are shopping in the supermarket. If you have an acount with Barclays Bank think very seriously about changing to another bank (Barclays control one third of all South African banking, Inform your friends, family, neighbors etc. what is going on in South Africa, and ung then to beyedt the products of aparthied as well. It may not seen alot, but it is the least anyone can do if they feel that aparthied must be defeated, and you will be aiding the freedom fighters in South Africa who are combating directly and at a moch higher Rel cost than simply giving up a tin of fruit a week. IN OCTOBER THIS YEAR THE MILITARY/GOVERNMENTAL ESTABLISHMENTS WILL BE STAGING OPERATION HARDROCK, A REHEARSAL OF THEIR 'CIVIL DEFENSE' CONTINGENCY PLANS SHOULD BRITAIN COME UNDER A NUCLEAR ATTACK, OR PERHAPS MORE SINISTER IN ITS IMPLIC-ATIONS, SHOULD DOMESTIC CIVIL UNREST START TO BECOME A THREAT TO THE ESTABLISHED ORDER. IN SUCH A TIME THE COUNTRY WILL BE SPLIT INTO SEVERAL REGIONAL SEATS OF GOVERNMENT (RSG'S), EACH WITH TOTAL AUTHORITY OVER THEIR RESPECTIVE AREAS. MARTIAL LAW WOULD BE DECLARED, WITH ORDERS AND INSTRUCTIONS BEING ISSUED BY NON-DEMOCRATICALLY APOINTED REGIONAL COMMISIONARS STATIONED IN UNDERGROUND BLAST PROOF SHELTERS. THE GENERAL PUBLIC WOULD BE ORDERED TO STAY PUT. ROADS WOULD BE BLOCKED OFF TO ALL BUT MILITARY OR POLICE PERSONNEL.REFUGEES WOULD BE SHOT ON SIGHT.FOOD, WATER AND MEDICAL CARE WOULD BE RATIONED TO 'THE FITTEST', IE, THOSE MOST ABLE TO HANDLE A GUN. IN THE WEEKS PRECEEDING SUCH AN ATTACK ALL'SUBVERSIVES' OR 'POTENTIAL

SUBVERSIVES (WHATEVER THAT MEANS) WOULD BE ROUNDED UP AND SHOT WITHOUT ANY FORM OF TRIAL. IF YOU ARE READING THIS IT IS QUITE LIKELY THAT YOU WOULD BE CONSIDERED A 'SUBVERSIVE'

THESE PLANS REVEAL THE LENGTHS TO WHICH THE STATE WILL GO IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN ITS OWN POWER, AND SHOW THE SINISTER REALITY WHICH LIES BEHIND OTHERWISE LAUGHABLE 'CIVIL DEFENSE' PAMPHLETS SUCH AS 'PROTECT AND SURVIVE', AND ADVISE SUCH AS "WHITEWASH YOUR WINDOWS AND HIDE UNDER THE STAIRS" AND "PEEL AND SCRUB POTATOES THOROUGHLY TO AVOID RADIOACTIVE CONTAMINATION" APART FROM USING HARDROCK TO REHEARSE THEIR OWN SICK TWISTED WARGAMES THE GOVERNMENT INTEND TO ALSO USE IT AS A PROPOGANDA EXERCISE IN ORDER TO ... CONVINCE THE PUBLIC THAT A NUCLEAR WAR IS THINKABLE AND EVEN WINNABLE.

GRAHAM: CAN YOU TELL ME A BIT ABOUT HOW YOU CAME TO FORM THE GROUP? CAM: I used to go in this pub called the Cambridge up the West End, and that's where Fish Eye (A founder member of the group) used to go. Everyone used to talk about him, but I didn't know him, y know, he was the person you had to know. Anyway, one day I was sitting in there, and he was sitting next to me, I didn't know it was him, all I noticed was that he was barefoot, anyway we got talking to somone else about ska records and at the time, 1979, I was into ska music, so I asked if I could come round and listen to his tunes, so he showed me his tunes, then he asked if I could play rythm guitar, and at the time I was looking for a keyboard player to form a band with, so I said yeah, and went along to see his band at Shepards Bush. At the time they were called Jah-Son And The Argonauts, and they were bad, y'know, it was just a noise, but I thought I'd join just for the experience, anyway I went to the rehersals, which were like just macking about really. We did another gig in Shepards Bush, and we did six numbers. I knew the chords roughly to about three of them, and it just ended up with alot of noise and jumping around, but it was really fun, because no-one knew who we were or expected anything of us, so we could just do what we liked. After a while we did some recording, this guy put up a load of money so we did this recording which we released, and well, really we wasn't ready for anything like that, y'know I'VE NEVER HEARD THAT RECORD, BUT A FRIEND OF MINE BOUGHT IT FOR 20p SOMEWHERE, AND HE SAID HE DIDN'T THINK MUCH OF IT ... (langhter)We never did get any money back from that Anyway, you've heard what we're like now , and we're nothing like that. It's a pity because people probably still judge us from that record. From then we've changed so much, we've had two drummers, two keyboards, three bass players, and a saxaphone player. Also Fish was the singer then, and he's Greek, right, and his singing sounds great with greek music, but it wasn't right for us, so he went to Greece for six weeks, during which time I took over vocals, and it was real hard, but when

he came back I had to tell him that I'd been singing, and that I was going to carry on singing, and thats a real hard thing to do, y'know, 'cos it was Fish who introduced me to the band, if it wer'nt for him I wouldn't be their in the first place, then I come to him andsay, look, I'm taking over your place ... but you've got to do them kind of things if you want to make things, y'know.

But Fish is a member of the band we couldn't do without, not at this stage, like we could change the drummer or something, but not him, he's a part of the band, he's from the bands roots, and if you take the roots from the tree you kill the tree.... ARE ALL THE MEMBERS OF REBEL TALKOVER RASTAFARIANS?

Well, I don't know how Lorraine (keyboards) checks things... Fish Eye is like ... He has an International view, y'know what I mean ... Everybody has their own views, they've got their own character and their own way of thinking, but then again you could sy all the band are Rasta.. Fish Eye don t call himself a Rasta, but I say he is a Rasta, because every man who have love in his heart and go around doing the right thing is Rasta ... THAT IS WHAT YOU BELIEVE RASTA IS?

Every man has his own definition of what kasta in, but that is what my view is, that is how I check it, anyman can be Rasta. Then theirsalot of men who wear locks or whatever, and they are not Rasta, they go around causing trouble, stabbing people or whatever, and people check them, and say "They are bad, the Rastas", and get the wrong idea. They look at a Rasta, all they see is the locks, and they think "Oh yeah, the man from the jungle, one look at him and he'd tear me apart", but then, if they start to reason with him, they'd find the man there has a peaceful philosophy and sense in abundance,y'know, they would realise that there is alot more to him ... He is a decent man, who believes in goodness, not badness. Take mugging, people think its only the whites that care, but enough Rastas care about that, too. WOULD YOU SAY THEN THAT RASTA IS MORE OF A POLITICAL THAN A RELIGIOUS THING? Is life And life is everything, see politics and them things is just a part of life, people tend to put more direction and pay more attention to just one aspect of or whatever, and the economy is part of life, the man and life, like the economy . man want to deal, right, and Inwant to give him this for something else, that is economics, now that obviously exists, but the whole system here, the whole Western world just bases itself on ecomomics, right, just money, now how can that support Life? It just can't support itself, you have to look at culture and politics and religion and everything else and see it as one sensible Life, y'know, then everyone could just live togethet, y'know what I mean? And its possible, y'know, it must be possible if people can starve and still not hurt anybody ... There are people living in total poverty, y'know, at the bottom of the barrel, with no money and no food, and still they can live in peace, then everybody can live in peace. THAT SOUNDS SIMILAR TO ALOT OF ANARCHIST IDEAS REALLY ... Well I don't know about that ... What direction would you go in ... (THERE FOLLOWS AN ARGUEMENT/DISCUSSION ABOUT THE SIMILARITIES AND DIFFERENCES BETWEEN THE VIEWS OF RASTAFARIANS AND ANARCHISTS WHICH GOES ON FOR SEVERAL MINUTES) Well, I can't see myself getting anything out of this country really, there are too many people with no goodness in their hearts, and you can talk about anarchy, but this place is so corrupt that no one can change it.As far ad I'm concerned this place has to mash up, and I don't think anyone will be able to live in this place, its finished as far as I can see. If I was English or British, or felt I was British I'd want to mash this place up now, because I would have been born in a mash up old yard, but as it is I feel I've been born in some-one elses mashed up old yard . I feel that , should be somewhere else, and THEM if when 4 get there I find that place is MAKE mashed up, then I can tear my hair out in despair, and say "where can I go?", but as it LEGALISE HERB! is I feel that I shouldn't be here When I get up and feel cold I know I shouldn't 2

be here, just a bit of sunshine makes me feel different, like, the other day a little sunshine came through my window and I felt different for the whole day, just 'cos of that, mostly its just cloud, and it never breaks, and that makes me feel bad, so I know i its not natural for me to live like this, I want to dance near the sea and swim in the water and have sunshine everyday, y'know. SO YOU REALLY DON'T FEEL YOU BELONG IN THIS COUNTRY? at this stars. Like we could change the drawner or some thing, Thats right yeah. ALOT OF PEOPLE COULD TWIST WHAT YOU ARE SAYING You mean like the National Front? YEAH, THEY COULD SAY, "OH LOOK, THE BLACKS WANT TO GO BACK HOME", Y'KNOW ... Yeah, well if they want to send me back I'll go back.... But I won't go back if I'm kicked out, y'know what I mean... I will only go back under my own determination, what I choose THATS WHAT I MEAN, THEY'D TWIST WHAT YOU'RE SAYING

Well, let them try, y'know, dread is dread, y'now, that is the thing, to be a hippy is different to be a dread, y'know, because I say "Peace and love", right, it don't mean that if a man trouble my heart I won't punch out his head, y'know, if they try to treat me bad to get me out then they are going to have more trouble than they can handle ... If they tryed to line us up for the gas chamber, well, what do you think would happen? Enough guns would just come in, y'know, enough guns would come here ..

It's like the riots in Miami, I see that as my struggle its happening in Miami and not over here; but its the same thing I tell you, I wouldn't go and fight in no Falklands war, but if somone was to come to me and say, look, we'll give you guns to go 19090 Das. Tovetsey over and free up South Africa, then you can settle there, I'd SQ.

Now, WHY wasn't I ever taught about my culture and my history?Why was I never told about Sellasie I?Why wasn't I taught about Ethiopia or Africa? I was never taught at school about any link between me and Africa. I remember people would say at school "go back to the jungle", and I'd come home and tell my mum, and she'd say "tell them you come from the West Indies, not the jungle". No-one mentioned slavery. It wasn't until I was at secondary school when someone said, "Yeah, your ancestors must have been slaves"/y'know ... No one had put it like that before, no one talked about slavery, because that is a dread thing to do t know. It's bad enough if they were englaved where they were, but to take people up and scatter them across the world like that ... thats worse than murder, its worse than genocide, because it continues on for generations, all those dead Africans, they've had their language and their culture and everything taken from them. BUT IT'S THE SAME FOR THE ENGLISH TO AN EXTENT, I MEAN AT SCHOOL WE'RE TAUGHT HISTORY IN TERMS OF KINGS AND QUEENS, NEVER IN TERMS OF THE PEOPLE AND THEIR STRUGGLES.

YEah, but it's still your country and your history that you are taught. BUT YOU'RE NEVER TAUGHT ABOUR, SAY, THE HISTORY OF THE UNIONS OR OF WORKING CLASS HISTORY . Thought any body. OR WHATEVER

Its like, I was watching 'Any Questions' the other day, and Arthur Scargil was on He was talking about how it's nearer $4\frac{1}{2}$ million who are unemployed because of all the people who don't sign on and that, and some little Tory, probably some Monday Club member, got up claiming that most people on the dole are scrounging or moonlighting, and that no-one in Britain is hard up. Now the point is that that idiot actually BEITEVED that. There are people in this country who, because of their background, are so out of touch that they've just got no idea. Now, I don't want to shoot that man, I'd rather just let his own ignorance destroy him. WOULD YOU LOOK UP TO POLITICANS OR PEOPLE TO CHANGE THE WORLD? I don't look up to no politicant. Haile Selasie is my king. Not only is he king, but he's the king of kings, the lord of lords X. Thats who they should tell you about when you are little, not some stupid presidents vor politicans. You can follow back the lines of kings and queens of England, but the line of descent of Selasie I leads right back to Solomon, but they can't see it: All them other kings and presidents were put there by

men, but only Selasie I was put there by God. HMMM ... WHAT DO THINK ABOUT ORGANISATIONS LIKE BOCK AGAINST RACISM?

If the people want to rock against racism. let them come ... IT ALWAYS SEEMS TO ME THAT ITS WHITE, MIDDLE CLASS PEOPLE TRYING TO EASE THEIR OWN CONSCIENCES, LIKE, AT ANY RAR GIGS I'VE BEEN TO, THERE HARDLY SEEM TO BE ANY BLACK PEOPLE r feel that , should be Well, you get all these nice minded left wing people, and they say, "The niggers are THERE ... IC tout boilt to woods alright", and they mean well, but they don't bother to actually check the black man, they Dont bother to find out what he is actually shouting about. Like, they say prejudice is wrong, but still they will look at me, the Rasta, and say "Oh, here we go, the 'Back To Africa, Haile Selasie 'bit again", and just brush the whole of Rasta, all of Rasta to one side.

They don't know the first thig about Rasta, they havn't bothered to check up or find anything out. If they can come to me and say "I did read the life story of Selasie, I did read the bible, I did reason with the Rasta, I did read the prophesies of Marcus Garvey" if they can go to that trouble and still say, "You're talking a load of rubbish", well, fair enough, let them come. But I can see glaring errors in say, Marx, and I meet enough of them people, at college and that. They dismiss my beliefs, but none of, them with their theories and that can get to the bottom of me! Those sort of 1 eft-wing people, whenever a Rasta walks into the room, they stand

back with this sort of look of respect on their faces, now, why do they do that if they think Rasta is such a joke? Why don't they just come out and say "that man is a XXX fool" if thats what they really feel?

AS USUAL WITH NEW CRIMES INTERVIEWS, I'VE HAD TO CUT A VAST AMOUNT OUT DUE TO REASON REASONS OF SPACE. HOPEFULLY THIS INTERVIEW WILL GIVE READERS SOME MORE INSIGHT INTO THE VIEWS OF RASTAFARIANS EVEN IF THEY DON'T AGREE WITH ALL OF THE IDEAS EXPRESED. (I CENTAINLY DON'T). Despite the patronage of Pauly Weller JAMMING! Records havn't had the commercial success they'd hoped for. In the case of ZIETGIEST, this is a suprise, as their records 'STOP' and 'OVER AGAIN' have all the makings of minor hits, memorable melodies, nice (if somewhat tame) white-funk rythms and a nice line in male/female juxtaposed vocals. However, I'm not shocked that THE APOCALYPSE'S 'TEDDY' hasn't launched the band into the nation's hearts. It's been rereleased and remixed so often now that I've lost count, but to no avail. Why don't the band just accept that it's basically rather a weak song and concentrate on something else?

Despite a ridiculous cover,I must confess that I quite liked THE BLOOD'S 'MEGALOMANIAC'(NO FUTURE), basically its a punk thrash with heavy metal overtones, and a nice line in anti-clerical lyrics.If you like The Ramones, Erazerhead, Aliegance To No-One etc I suspect this one will apeal to you. I've now played CROSSTALK A/V'S 'THE QUEUE'(TUFTY CLUB RECORDS) at least 5 times, and I must admit that I still can't recall the tune.I don't know,I seem to hear alot of this kind of thing on John Peel, and I suppose

someone must like this kind of thing, but personally it leaves me cold.Not a bad record, but hardly the stuff classics are made of.

LIVING IN TEXAS describe their 'AND DAVID CRIED' as 'new jazz'.Now,I'm not sure what Ormette Colman would make of that claim, but none the less, it's a rather nice (mostly) instrumental pitching a lazy sax melody over a spacey drum and synth backdrop.Maybe you'd like it too?One for YMG/Weekend fans.

CASE'S 'WHEAT FROM THE CHAFF' EP(SUS) was recently voted record of the week by Gary Bushel in Sounds, so I was quite suprised to find that I quite liked it too. A nice blend of ska, rock and punk influences together with Mathew's gut-busting vocals make this a winner.Recommended.

At last THE APOSTLES have managed to get it together, and how! Their long awaited EP BLOW IT UP, BURN IT DOWN, KICK IT 'TIL IT BREAKS' has been described by Witchhunt singer Richard as the most influential record since 'Feeding The, 5,000', lets hope hess proved correct as it s messages encouraging Direct Action and Proletarian Autonomy need to be heard. The sleeve of this 5 track EP contains a wealth of information concerning squatting, the Anarchist Youth Federation etc, although some of the bitchy comments about 'rival anarchists' (eg.KYPP, Black Flag) really ought to be dropped, they waste space, and don't serve to increase anybody's standing, least of all their own. YOU ARE WHAT YOU EAT ...

A popular myth propogated by many meat-eaters is that a vegetarian diet is boring in the extreme; "Oh, don't you get tired of eating lettuce leaves and raw carrots all the time?"...If anything I think the reverse is true, with so many meat eaters content to stay in a rut of eating a conservative diet of Meat + Two Veg day in, day out, life in, life out.

I have been a vegetarian for several years now, and consequently have tried and experimented with a very large range of dishes and ingrediants, some of which have been more interesting than others, some I've liked, some I've not been so keen on, some I've disliked totally. Here are a few dishes I have been particularly partial to; try them out. Some of the ingrediants may seem a little unusual, but you should be able to get them at your local greengrocers, or else try your local 'East & West'store (at which the chances are you'll probably discover a load more wierd and wonderful foodstuffs).None of the ingrediants mentioned are really that expensive, the most expensive thing is still less than half a pint of beer. If you live with your parents, don't just give theses recipes to mum and tell her to cook them, buy the ingrediants yourself and learn to cook them up as well; the idea of the 'good cook' is a myth, anyone can do it if they follow the instructions or even experiment sensibly. You'll be making a step towards breaking down a stereotyped role, and at the same time you might even convert the rest of the family to a healthier, cruelty-free diet. If you don't like these recipes, go and find some more. A recommended book for anyone thinking of becoming a vegetarian or who already is one is '500 Recipes: Vegetarian Cookery' by Patty Fisher (Hamlyn, ISBN 0 600 03435 6), which contains information on food values, nutrition and sauces and garnishes as well as the recipes themselves.

RIOT SQUAD: TOTAL ATTACK FROM SOUTH AFRICA I first heard Riot Squad on Bullshit 2', and, through Penny Rimbaud, was able to get in touch with their drummer J.C. They are probably the first punk band from South Africa, so are consequently treated as a bit of a novelty. They started out in an atempt to bring the injustices of the SA system to their (white) peers who seem to think that nothing is wrong with the way things are. The authorities didn't really view R.S. as much of a threat, as the 'independant scene' out there is very small, the average (black) person having more to worry about than the latest record releases. Aparently reggae has just started making inroads amongst the townships, and, despite govt. attempts to ban it because of its subversive nature), is growing fast in popularity.J.C. tells me that the govt. is sinking fast now, but want to drag the whole country down with them if possible, and that "nothing I say is strong enough condemnation of these people".



In order to spread this condemnation to a larger audience, Riot Squad made an EP called 'Total Onslaught', which is now available in Britain via Rough Trade. It features five tracks of basic punk energy, with incisive lyrics revealing the corruption ob which the South African system is based. The cover is also informative, giving a list of companys in Britain who are profiting from aparthied.

As I am one of the singers and main lyric writer of this band it's hard to remain unbiased.Basically we are a protes band,dealing with various subjects, including the arms race, animal liberation, sexism, pollution, violence, war and so on, and trying to show how all these problems are symptoms of a larger issue.

In future we'd like to expand, by both trying to develope musically and by incorporating other elements into our live set, for example, we are planning to set up a slide show for our next few gigs.

We have apeared on several compilation cassettes, including 'The Animals Packet', and have a cassette called 'Songs Of Anger, Songs Of Hope' available from the New Crimes address at the front. Examples of our lyrics are scattered about the mag, so you can judge them for yourselves.

RENT PARTY

Play music from the jazz era of the fourties, and very competantly, too.It's good music to dance to, and their live shows that I've seen have been most enjoyable. In the past they've done gigs for the local CND and Women's Aid group.

They have recently released a single (I've not heard it at time of writing), and seem to be on the verge of 'making it big'. Their appeal is similar to that of Roman Holiday, although I think they are by far superior.

Venues in Southend are very few and far between, the majority that do exist prefering to cater to the Heavy Metal and R'n'B audiences. Places which are willing to let other types of band play include The Grand Hotel (Personally my favorite venue in the area), The Cliff (provided all monies made go to a cause, eg, CND, Women's Aid etc), Focus, Crocs (Mainly they concentrate on 'big! bands, eg, Caberet Voltaire, The Exploited, The Alarm etc, although they do occaisionally put local bands on). It's also possible to play at the musicans workshop at the Zero 6, although they prefer R'n'B bands here. However, there have been some memorable gigs here, including The Sinyx in 1980 and the first two Stripey Zebras gigs. B. MAD Of course, it's also possible for MAX bands to organise their own gigs, eg, in rooms above pub etc, but for some reason alot of people can't be bothered to do this.

ITS THE SOUND OF THE HOT-BOX, THE GIANT SIZE SUPER-LOUD CASSETTE RECORDERS . ON THE SHOULDERS OF THE CATS ON THE STREET, LIGHTENING FAST JIVE TALKING RHYMING COUPLETS OVER HARD-EDGED, STRIPPED DOWN CAUSTIC FUNK OR DISCO BASED BACKDROPS. THE ROOTS OF RAPPING COULD BE TRACED BACK TO THE BIRTH OF BLACK AMERICAN MUSIC, WHEN THE SLAVES IN THE COTTON FIELDS WOULD IMPROVISE THEIR BLUES LYRICS AGAINST A BACKING PROVIDED OVER NOTHING MORE THAN A BEATEN UP OID ACOUSTIC GUITAR. MORE DIRECTLY, HOWEVER, RAP AROSE FROM BLACK DISCO CULTURE, FROM THE DJ/PERFORMERS OF THE 30'S THROUGH TO THE FAST TALKIN' DJS OF THE FIFTIES, WHO INCLUDED SUCH PEOPLE AS B B KING AND RUFUS THOMAS, WHO LATER BECAME WELL KNOWN MUSICANS. PROBABLY THE EARLIEST EXAMPLES OF RAPPING AS SUCH CAN BE HEARD ON THE RECORDS OF THE HIGHLY POLITICAL BLACK MOSLEM GROUP, THE LAST POETS WHO WERE MAKING THEIR 'MESSAGE' STYLE RECORDS AS LONG AGO AS THE SIXTIES. THE FIRST RAP TO HIT THE BRITISH CHARTS, NAMELY THE SUGARHILL GANG'S 'RAPPERS DELIGHT', WAS, COINCIDENTIALY, THE FIRST RELEASE ON THE JUST FORMED SUGER HILL LABEL IN '79. 1. Don't get drawn into conversation with the police, no matter how angry you might get. Even apparently innocent remarks may be used against you. You do not have to say or write anything, or sign a statement. You have the right to refuse to answer all police questions, but you may be arrested for refusing to give your name and address if the police reasonably suspect that you have committed certain offences. 2. If in doubt, do and say nothing until you have contacted a solicitor or Release. 3. If anything you aske for is refused, ask why and remember the reason given. 4. As soon as possible, make 2 full notes about what has happened. These can be used in your defence. IN ALL DEALINGS WITH THE POLICE 1. CHECK THEIR IDENTITY: Ask to see their warrant card; remember the details. If they are uniformed remember their numbers. 2. IF YOU ARE STOPPED ON THE STREET: Ask the reason. The police may search you for drugs, firearms, 'terrorist' documents or articles, stolen property(only in London & some other cities) on 'reasonable suspision' that you have any of these things in your possessionor you can be taken to the police station to be taken to a police station to be searched for these items, without being formally arrested. In all other cases it is illegal for you to be taken to a police station against your will. 3. IF YOU ARE TAKEN TO A POLICE STATION: a) Ask if you have been arrested, and if so, why? The police must give a reason. If you hace not been arrested, you are legally entitled to leave the station (except see 2 above).b)Ask to see a solicitor or a friend.c)Ask to phone a solicitor, Release, a relative or a friend. The Criminal Law Act 1977 s62 gives you the right to insist that somone be informed about your detention. ADD SOUTHVIEW HOUSH, SAL 30

You are not legally limited to one phome call.d)Ask to be charged or released. You cannot be kept at the police station indefinately.e) You can refuse to have your fingerprints taken, but such a refusal is likely to result in your being held until an order requiring you to submit is obtained from a magistrate. Forcibly taking your photograph is also illegal, f) In order to get bail (ie, released from the police station X before going to court) you will have to satisfy the rolice that you have a fixed address, 4. TF YOUR HOME IS: TONDERSED CHED .: a) The police do not need a search warrat or your permission to enter in order to arrest someone, but they should name the person sought.searches for drugs or stolen goods can sometimes be conducted without a warrant, but in all cases you. should ask the police to identify themselves and the reason for the search. b) Otherwise a police search without a warrant or your permission is illegal. Ask to see the search warrant. You are eentitled to demand the reason for the search, but barring their entry could result in a charge of obstruction against you.

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MDA (MISUSE OF DRUGS ACT)

Section 23 of the MDA gives a police officer the power to stop and search a person if and his or her vehicle, if the officer 'reasonably suspects' that person to be in possession of a controlled drug.A wrongful search is in theory a trespass(a civil wrong for which damages can be claimed) to the person, but what could be a wrongful search is uncertain. Although the Home Office, in a directive to the police in 1971 (Home Office Cicular) 133), stated that 'modes of dress or hairstyle alone should never by themselves or together, be reguarded as reasonable grounds to 'Stop and Sicarch' However, resistance to or interference with a search is a crime (Obstruction Section 23/4). SEARCH OF PREMISES

The police can only legally search your home for drugs if they have a search warrant naming your address and issued by a magistrate under the MDA, or if you give them permission to come in.A warrantt is only valid for one month but the police can baid as many times as they like during that time.All other searches, except where the police enter specifically to arrest someone are unlawful.But, the courts can and do allow illegally obtained evidence to be used against defendants, although it should be argued that such evidence is

inadmissable. The police are entitled to take away anything that they think can be used as evidence that an offense under the MDA has taken place. They can also take anything else they think suggests you have committed any other crime. The police have the power to keep the property for a 'reasonable period' while they decide whether it will be used in the case. If it is 'in the interest of justice' the court can order the return of the property A court can also order the confiscation of property of anyone convicted of a drug offence.

POLICE QUESTIONING AND DETENTION

It is during interogation by the police that harm is most frequently done to a persons defence. The complexity of the drugs laws are such that even a relatively innocent statement such as "I smoke cannabis sometimes, who doesn't?" can land you in more trouble than you this Once arrested you are under no obligation to say anything or make a statement. The police will put immense pressure on you to give information (you should ask for a pen and paper and make notes during interogation, particularly about other drug users as this is how most of the drugs squad's information is obtained. The best legal advice you can have while under interogation is to say nothing. Everything you say to the police can be used as evidence against you from the moment you first come into contact with them. You will usually only be cautioned however once you have been charged with an offence. Section 62 of the Criminal Law Act 1977 gives you the right to inform someone of your arrest, but the police can prevent your call if they think it will 'interfere' with their investigations. There is no length of time laid down in which you mustbe charged. However, if the police do not have enough evidence to charge you within a 'reasonable time' of arrest then they should release you. In practice the police may use a holding charge (trivial) to get around that dificulty. When possession of a drug is involved the police are not, according to Home Office Circular 133, supposed to chargesuspects until the drug has been analysed.

as other householders; the right to privacy the right to essential services like water, electricity (there can be problems with this), rubbish collection, postal delivary, social security, and the right to live the way you want. Of course, you will not have so much security as council tenants or owner occupiers but if you choose your place carefully you may be able to stay there for years. You are much more likely to get a reasonable place which will last if you go about it carefully and take a bit of time gathering information, but if you are really despar ate and havn't got alot of time here are a few quick hints; 1. Find a place that doesn't look too smart and is owned by the council or a housing association. 2. Get in quitely without doing any damage. Try all the obvious ways first; front and back entrances, open windows or windows that can be opened with a knife slipped into the catch. Don't try to batter down a strong front door before you have looked for another entrance. 3. Once you move in, the first thing to do is change all locks and secure all other entrances, doors, windows, skylights. Many squats have been lost by not doing this. You can put bolts on the doors and nailso on the window frames so that the windows do not open more than 3 or 4 inches. If there is one, take off the old Kale lock by unscrewing it and keep it in a safe place in case you are accused of theft. Replace the old cylinder with a new one and put the lock back on. ut a chain on the door. 4. Check that the water, gas and electricity are on or can be turned on. Sign on for gas and electricity straight away. 5. Make sure that there is someone in all the time, especially during the day, at least until the owners or council officials come around. 6. If the police, owners or council officials come round, don't open the door, but tell them through the letter box that this is now your home and you are not going to leave until the owner gets a possesion order to evict you.Don't try to squat on your own. Get in touch with local squatters. "Iways make sure that at least one or more can be guaranteed to be in at all times. This way you cannot legally evicted except through the courts.Remember, it is an offence under Section 6 of the Criminal Tresspass Law 1977 for anyone to force their way into any occupied house even though it is squatted. ONCE YOU HAVE MOVED IN, WHAT IF THE POLICE ARRIVE? Once the lock has been changed it's best to start moving your things in as

SQUATTING

Squatting is not a crime. Squatting is still legal, don't let anyone tell you otherwise. Only squatting on embassy property or occupying someones home (or intended home in some cases) could be a crime, and failing to leave is the offence, not actually Maximy occupying. If you get into a house or flat which no one else is using, without doing any damage, then you have can make it your home. You have basically the same rights 31

to arrive. Don't let them in unless you can possibly avoid it. However the police do have the right to enter a house if they have a warrant (ask to see it), if they think someone in the house has commited or is about to commit an 'arrestable offence' (most serious crime or breach of the peace. You should tell the police something like this; We moved in here to live because we have nowhere else. We did not break anything when we entered and we have not damaged anything since. It isn't a criminal matter; it is a civil matter, between us and the owners, and they must take us to court for a possesion order if they want us to leave. 'In law this is esentially the case, unless there is someone actually living in the house or there is a protected intended occupier.

Some police act as if they can evict or arrest any squatter they see. THIS IS NOT THE CASE. If the police appear on your doorstep make your presence known, but try not to let them in, if neccesary talk to them throughvthe letter box. They may say something like "all out under the Criminal Law Act". If they do, say that the house is unoccupied except for yourselves, and that if their is a 'protected intended occupier' you won't leave until you see written proof, that is, a certificate under Section 7. If they simply say "Get out, and don't be clever", you can point out that if they evict you they may be commiting an offence themselves under Section 6 of the act because they will be entering premises where someone is opposing their entry. Okay, so the Bengali and Hindu religious cults are oppresive and absurd, as is the Rastafarian garbage, but that doesn't mean these attacks on the people concerned are justified or understandable. These attacks must stop It is astounding party is not a prerequisite for solving the problem.

Remember that old Crass quote: Vicious, mindless violence, its just the same old game, left wing right wing, its all the same ... "(actually the quote is "left wing violence, right wing violence, all seems much the same, bully boys out fighting, its just the same old game-Accurate Ed.), well left and right may be similar, but left wing ideas are often not that unreasonable; in fact some of them are very good indeed, rather similar to your 'anarchy' at times? The difference it seems to me, is that non-political people are somewhat better at organising themselves into working and often autonomous groups to achieve a particular end I've been working with East London Workers Against Racism for 4 months.At no time have I ever joined a political party. FLWAR does contain communists, as well as people from the SWP, WRP and other lognies. We're not interested in discussing why one form of political dogmatism is preferable to another. We are not interested in pushing our little doctrines and preaching to the masses We ARE interested in creating a situation where people can exist and live with each other without the ever present threat of abuse based on skin colour, apearance, language etc. Is that so unreasonable?Does that make me a violent, mindless leftie? It's easy to chitisisa I've been doing enough of it so far but it is even easier to sit back and do nothing. If you're going to preach your 'anarchy' and 'freedom' then I might suggest you do something a little more constructive and active than merely preaching?Facsism must be smashed, and HARD. The way we treat each other must also be examined. Both are valid activities-but lets not sacrifice one for the glorification of the other. If we're going to work towards any form of libetarian society, surely we can learn to be aware of what is happening and CARE enough to do something about it? If you're fed up with being pushed around and abused then the answers simple: STUFF PACIFISM AND EXISTENTIAL BOLLOCKS: PUT THE BOOT IN: HARD! erroups 1110

how many 'anarchists and punks' and 'militants' will write for poxxy fanzines and spout black ink crap about this N that, to on marches and shout it all out so they can say We are all under New heavy manners", put up posters and seream 'Revolution' and yet when we have been stupid enough to assume that encouraging a few dozen of these revolutionaries to come along to one of our patrols to stop these horrific attacks on our people the response has been complete apathy IT. IS DISGUSTING. These people who buy their poxy little rags like Xtra and Black Flag, where are they when the people they claim to support and being battered to death in an alleyway in Bethnal Green? (Battered to death?Yes, no exageration. An incident occured last year which resulted in a 14 year old Indian boy being KILLED by blows to his head from a monkey wrench) You still it can't happen here? If you really desire my reasons fro anarchist-slagging, lets give an example: on our last patrols (a patrol is basically the forming of about 4 groups of 5 or 6 people walking vigilantly around areas of the city on the lookout for trouble from facsiststhugs, then literally putting the boot in on any bastards that we find, so that the local community are at least offered some form of protection) none of the people I was with were anarchists, nor were they punks, nor were they militants, they were basically people from the community who felt that flag waving rhetoric and bland, stupifying marches were not the answer to facsism on the streets. The time for action is here, and being a member of a crackpot left wing

EXAMINED': A REPLY FROM NEW CRIMES RIGHT. The problem of Right-wing violence on our streets is serious and cannot be ignored; it won't just go away whilst unemployment, ignorance and urban alienation are rife. Whilst people are suffering from these facsist attacks, and whilst the police arn't prepared to do anything but

look on or ma ke matters worse, it is going to be up to the members of the community to work out their own modes of defence.ELWAR seem, in the main, to have worked out a viable solution in the forming of vigilante patrols, and I agree with about 90% of Andy's article.Where my point of divergence arises however is the 'putting the boot in on any of the bastards that we find . Is meeting violence with more violence really going to end the problem once and for all? Probably not. At best, the problem will be put off until another day, at worst, things will just get worse. The 'facsists' (I have aplied quotation marks because I suspect that many of these thugs have no understanding of facsist political theory (otherwise they'd realise they were being used) but simply go along with groups like the NF, BM etc because of peer group presure, ie, all their mates are members, or because they think it 'fashionable') will bring in reinforcements, and the anti-facsist vigilante groups will be forced to do likewise.Very soon a situation will (and in some areas already has) arise wherin the levels of violence are far beyond what ELWAR originally set out to end, and, what is more, alot of energy that could be channeled in more possitive directions will be wasted....It's called Divide and Rule; Their are alot of people, who, despite pious claims to the contrary, are more than happy to see working -class people fighting amongst themselves while their own positions of power remain unchalenged. So what are the alternatives to 'putting the boot in'?I don't know, nor do I claim to know, all the answers. All I intend to do is put forward a sugestion which may or may not be workable. How about, instead of straight away 'putting the boot in', trying to communicate with individuad fascists? Try talking to them, explain that the pproblems that they are angry about are not caused by the blacks, the Asians, the Jews, same problems. If the numbers of Anti-racist and that those people suffer from those activists outnumber those of the facists, the chances are that they will think twice . about hitting out, and might even listen to your point of view and think about the ideas you are putting forward. If, however, they are obviously not going to listen to reason and insist upon continuing their attack, it will of course be neccesary for the . victim to be defended and for the anti-racists to take steps to defend themselves. But there are ways of doing this without necesarily 'putting the boot in'. Personaly I would suggest using the minimum amount of force possible, so that none of the partys involved is seriously hurt or harmed. This is not as ridiculous as it might sound, for there are several forms of Oriental self-defense which have their basis in this philosophy. By trying to treat you opponent with respect and care he may be more inclined to treat you with respect and start to become more open to your ideas than if you had put him in hospital or something. At least, he is not going to become further embittered by your attitude. Now, I wouldn't expect the conventional left with their attendant Nazi-bashing rhetoric to take the above suggestions seriously, but I would hope that those who claim to be Anarchists or libertarians would at least consider the ideas I've put forward, especially if they feel that the age-old values of Might Means Right, force and violence are outmoded and must be challenged. Admitedly, there are alot of factors which I have not taken into account, and I may be considered naive by people who have actually been in a situation I have never experienced at first hand, but the point is; THINK ABOUT IT.Fascism must be smashed, but wouldn't it be better to start at the roots and which it thrives?
