

STATEMENT ..... ON EVERYBODY'S BEHALF ..... There are now thousands of people, tens of thousans even, who regard themselves as 'left' or as 'underground' or as 'revolutionary'. They know themselves to be powerless. Every so often they protest at arbitary dictates by the Silent Majority rulers. They know their protests mean nothing. Meetings, However militant and advanced the ideas expressed, are as little effective as those held in a pub bar. Wet these same people, at work, represent an enormous factor - stronger perhaps than the TUC itself. In every shopfloor dispute one looks around for allies, for other militants. If only one did not have to look. If one accepts the idea of WORKERS CONTROL and WORKERS COUNCILS cutting out state control from above, then form the embryos now. Just get to know, at any meeting, four others of a trade. Meet them occaisionaly. See to it that at some time each of the five tries to form a group of five in his or her ACTUAL PLACE OF WORK. There you will have the framework of militants all over the country, all believing in workers councils, all believing in militantaction. TRY IT AND SEE FOR YOURSELF .... WORKERS COUNCILS ...... OF ALL WORKERS WILL BYPASS POLITICAL ACTION AND DESTROY CAPITALISM.

Times are getting tougher, Keith Joseph, secretary of state for the Social Services recently brought into force an order which from now on will cut the maximum amount of income that can be ignored in computing suppliementary benefit payable to strikers. This will now only be a instead of 24.85 as previously. The Industrial Relations Act has banned unofficial strikes - this drastic cut will virtually strengthen this Act. Strikers will feel less determined to stay out - lack of food because of little money means less willingness to fight on for their demands. For married men this will not be so bad - their wives will still be able to get assistance. It hits hardest at the younger married workers and all those still to be married some of whom are the more militant in industry.

The order also cuts benefit by £2.30 instead of the present 95p for those men disqualified for dole money because they left of their own accord, were dimissed for misconduct or refused with out good cause to accept the offer of a suitable job.

This will not only make it generally worse for the unemployed, it will hit hard at the people sacked because they militant - this order will obviously make would be trouble makers think about the prospects of almost complete destitution before they ask.

Besides this, there's a lot of difference between what the employment exchange think is a suitable job and what a worker thinks is one. "The supplementary benefits commission will still however have the power to prevent individual hardship arising through the operations of this rule" ...... oh yeah ..... tell that to the thousands of pensioners who die every year from stavation and lack of heat ..... tell it to all those other poor bastads who pack Circus House and the other M.O.S.S. buildings every day.

# the right to work - demo.

There have recently with the climbing level of unemployment, been a large number of demonstrations over the right to work. The Labour Party, the Communist Party and most of the rest of the left are bellowing whole heartedly in favour of this - I deplore these sentiments. What in fact the slogan 'right to work' means is please don't be so unkind to Mister Bossman, give me job back so you can exploit me some more.

At first the U.C.S. work in seemed a very important event - it was imagined that the Clydeside workers would take over and run the shippards - real workers management. However, the workers have been sold out again and have sold out themselves, the work - in is merely a token - the fabric of capilist society has not been broken through. Although the idea of the 'workers takeover' is spreading through England it is regarded by most workers at the mement as merely a protest against unemployment and not a step towards a new society. Perhaps this will develop soon, we do not know - at least the idea is now actually being entertained whereas even one year ago it would have been regarded very warily.

For us, workers management and workers councils are only a step on the road to true freedom. Hile obviously we spread such ideas as much as possible, we do not wish to see a static society. Instead we envisage a system which is constantly changing in its modes of neighbourhood and production organisations. If we look at the number of goods produced in this country and throught the world for which there is an artificially created need then we see how dangerous it is to advocate something like 'the right to work'. People are now clamouring for work which fifty years ago they would have refused to do. If a car - plant or a Coca Cola factory was taken over by workers, how significant would this be—not at all. In France in L968 when various factories were taken over and run by the workers it was an interesting fact that it was only those factories which were considered truly necessary to peoples real needs.

In a free society the ammount of work would be cut down - more than that WORK would take on a new meaning - whereas now it has unpleasant connotations it will take on joyful and creative ones; how much difference between working for a remote boss - who denies any say in the running of the job which is unneccessary anyway - and working with other people for a community on constructive tasks, How many jobs in this society are created by an artificial need promoted by businessmen? Very many-everything from vaginal deoderants to that extra car. Have you ever thought that automation could tackle those unpleasant but necessary things like sever - cleaning.

We should not ask for the right to work in arms factories, we should get rid of both the bosses and arms factories.

The situation in Brighton has been getting increasingly worse over the past I2 months ..... there is now a situation where nearly one third of the labour force is out of work in Brighton and Hove ..... all the factories have laid off workers left right and centure, and now many off these same people are going back to the same factory on one of the governments semi-skilled and skilled training courses .... so what's all this madness them.

And on top of that the post office are quite blatent in there campaigning for christmas labour .... they only want students on vacation .... they refused to meet a representative of the spanish workers on the marina site .... the reason given was that the spanish workers were taking away jobs which Brighton men should have had .... very true but those workers wanted to see the trades council about that very matter and try to work something out.

## Street sheet - news

The idea has been mooted that Brighton needs a weekly newspaper that is a real alternative to the Evening Argus and the combined Herald and Gazette — a newspaper that reports the facts — real ones not the fantasies of the Evening Argus — that reports the situations as they realy happen, not the way most of the underground papers would wish them to be; that tells the people of Brighton the reality of what Brighton is. There is a small group of people — very ordinary people — with no axe to grind except the truth — who are willing to produce such a news sheet: type it collate it print it and with help distribute it.

5,000 single sheets printed both sides given away every saturday would cost £8 IO, 000 would cost £15.

does anybody have any ideas on the subject raising that sought of money every week come rain or shine because it can be done and could be so easy, but news is needed WHAT IS HA PENING IN BRIGHTON?????? Is there something happening you know about and think everybody aught to know ......

RENTS in Brighton are rising rapidly - to quote one estate agent "rooms and flats in all areas have risen by up to 20% in the past year" present rates seem to fluctuate between £3.50 to £5 p.w. for dingy furnished rooms to £30 p.w. for a six roomed house in the suburbs -

and unfurnished rooms and flats are almost non - exsistant unless youve got £500 + for crummy fixtures and fittings (more often than not light bulbs and tatty carpets and curtains worth no more than £50 at the outside)

and if you don't have a bank account it'll be very difficult and

if you don't have a job forget it.

1,000,000 unemployed by christmas (and two million by this time next year) and our dedicated leaders are being convinced by a few brainless idiots that sending young unemployed workers to work in labour camps is the solution to the unemployment situation and will steady that dear old internal economy ... about thirty years ago those same brainless idiots sent that same age group out to kill each other and s ent the next thirty years gloryfying it .... and now we get labour camps and even though there is something desperate about the countryside and it's roads and cities and factories, it has also been suggestated that the labour camp 'lads' build fucking roads and hospitals - more cars to kill us with fumes and speeding steel and hospitals closing down because of the acute labour shortage in the health service (massive cuts made in the yearly budget by the tory party) ..... oh what they call this a civilised country run by wise and gifted men ..... who made heath's teeth?????

Squatting is not an illegal act - the police and the owners have no legal ight to evict without a court order: Brighton is seeing the second squat in two years except whereas the Thykeham Terrace squat concerened the Brighton housing shortage the recent squat at Freshfield Road was carried out by a registered charity, the Cyrenians, an offshoot of the Simon Community, to get hold of a place to run an 'all night shelter' for people on the road. Whilst one must suspect a little the public relations campaign mounted by the Cyrenians, one must remember that they do a job most people would not be seen dead doing.

# ALL coppers are



- Whilst agreeing with the letter in the last gutter press that all coppers are bastards, I think we should delve deeper into the matter. Why are all coppers bastards? .... possibly because of the nature of their job and the conditioning they receive in their training and through out their service. We should remember that recruitment to the police, as with the armed forces increases at times of unemployment. People join the army or the police because they wish to escape from the conditions they are living in. Prepaganda for the police stresses the pay, the conditions, the excitement of the job.
- But ofcouse, we cannot look upon the matter in a benign and completely forgiving manner. We have to take into consideration the role of the police force .... a role which for some time in this country has been disguised. The police force is one of the weapons of the state with which the people (all those who are robbed of any say in the decisions) are kept in check. This is more fully realised on the continent or in the states where we see a long record of srike breaking by the police, of countless shootings of workers. In some countries the police are so hated, as in australia or spain, that they cannot marry outside the force; one copper will marry another's daughter or sister. Examples of the essential class role of the police can be seen in the actions undertaken at the time of the general strike .... and as the english system takes of it's velvet glove, we are again witnessing this role in our democratic land. The recent trouble at heathrow airport, where the police attacked workers on a picket line, the harrasment of immigrants in nottin hill and other areas and the repression of the reformist and revolutionary groups go to prove this.
- We are libertarian revolutionaries and the ends we have in mind are not acts of unbridled violence but a free society ..... in order to achieve this the vast mass of the people must desire it. We do not wish this social transition to be a bloodbath and for this to be less likely, the subversion of the armed forces and the police is necessary. When the state tells them to go out and put down the revolution, we hope they will refuse, more than that, we hope that they will disband themselves and help in building a world fit to live in.

Our aim is to aid in the creation of a free society by any means consistant with those aims.






