## Have your say about changes to your neighbourhood!

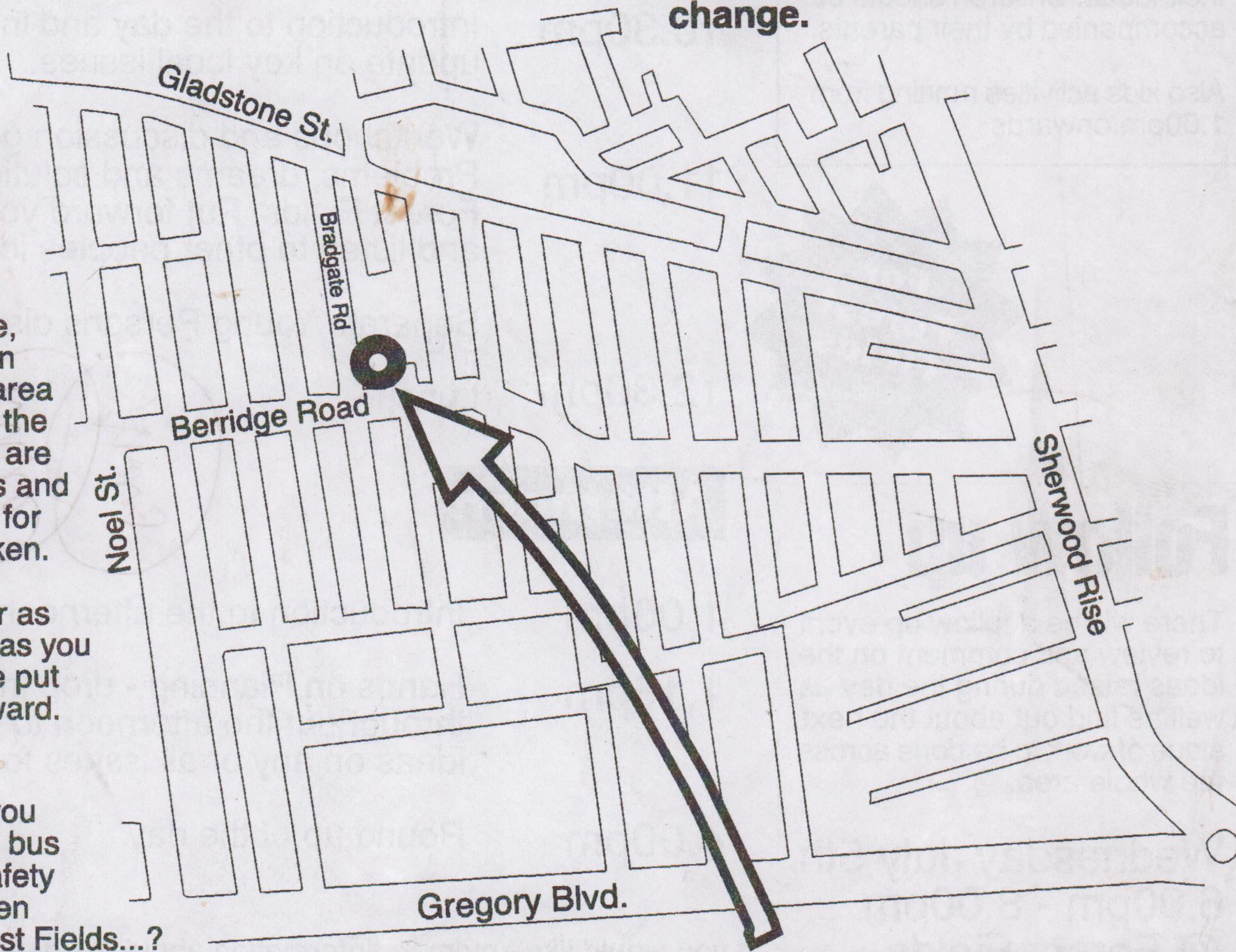

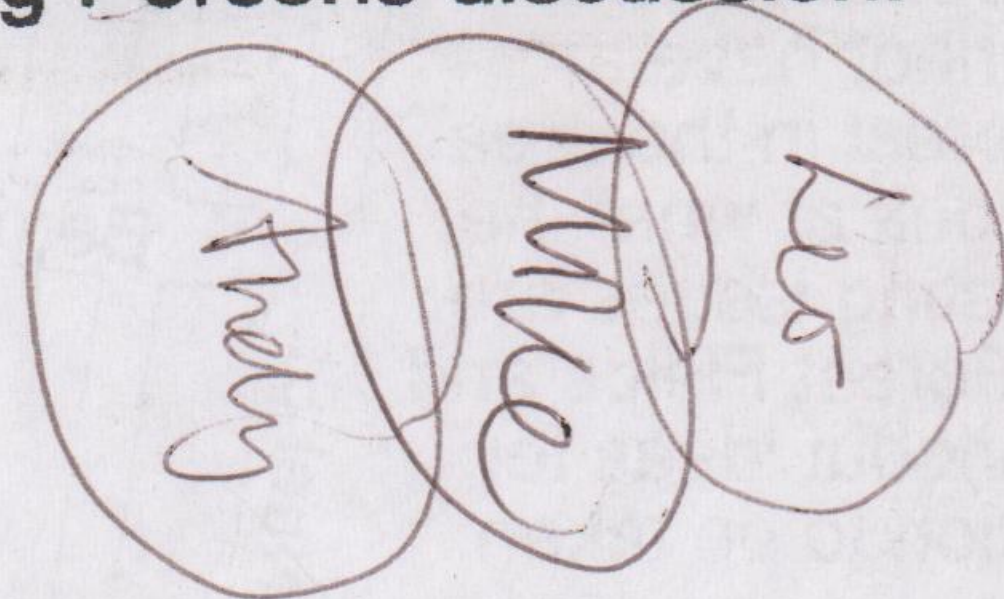
