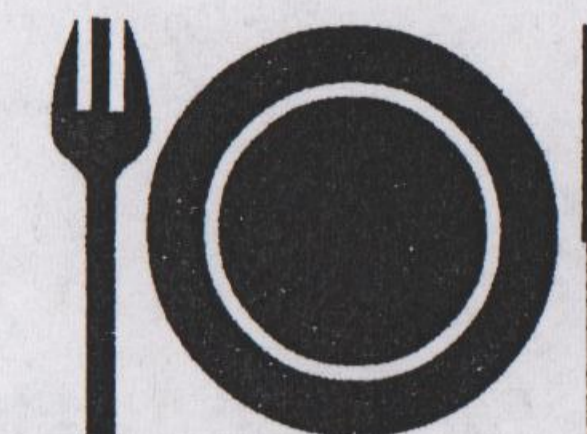

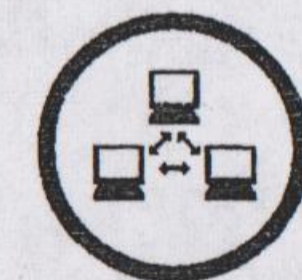
WAG

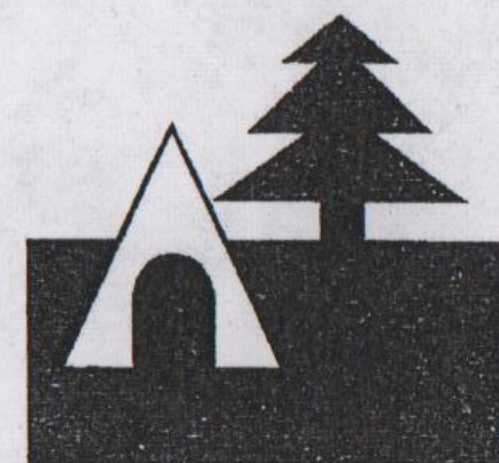
