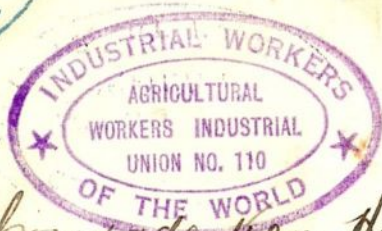

W. evokes no remote response. when I am convinced beyond any doubt that men will still ignore me and ignore the "class struggle." Well Ken. what's left

only to go to the quarters where my services will bear fruit. I will not go into details here. That can be performed more clearly in personal contact. In a way I am glad to be going back to London. to be amongst men who act like national humans and not like ignorant fanatics or worse.

When I'll arrive I do not know. I am going to a job in Beekton Gas Works East Ham. F. W. P. J. Rollings is trying to fix me up with work, lodgings etc. I shall call at your add sometime within the next week or fortnight. all beign well.

However I now write you an article for the next issue of D. A. and I trust it meets with your approval. you need not worry about the effects to myself as I expect to be away out of this accursed Fascist Stronghold or is it Stranglehold.

"Go to it; Ken. and improve upon it or do to it whatever you deem essential to Anarchism.

I hope to have a cup of tea soon with you. it's time we had another cup Ken. Salud, Revolutionary Meetings
