Several members of the Committ of 100, were carted out at the American Consul yesterday.

we were handled rather roughly. A group of about 10 members of the Y.C.N.I. last night formed an Action Group, the Y.C.N.I. in Rochdale washed their hands of us as they don't much care for our methods daubing factory walls and public buildings with slogans. However we will remain as members, as their social activities are quite good. We intend to bring out another journal this time for youth in general. Also mentioned was a vigil outside the remembrance gardens and an active painting campaign. With a view to coming to grips with the police at some later date when

we are strong enough, the same goes for the Civil Defence in which we hope to plant a spy.

Our journal we hope to call PROTEST.
