Dear Comrade,

The progress made by the Syndicalist Workers Federation, since its formation in August last year, has justified the view then expressed - that the situation in this country was more than ripe for syndicalist organisation.

Firm contacts with militant workers in different industries have been established, particularly among dockers and textile workers, and the future prospects look encouraging.

Our work has suffered greatly, however, from the lack of printed propoganda material and, particularly, from the impossibility of publishing a printed DIRECT ACTION. The duplicated issue we have brought out at monthly intervals has done good service, but it has been no real substitute.

With commercial printing costs at their present level - and they are constantly rising - it is out of the question for us to go to a printing firm with our paper. After long discussion of this problem, we have decided the only solution is for the S.W.F. to buy its own printing press.

To do this we must raise at least £100. We are therefore appealing to all comrades to help with the biggest contribution possible. We do not anticipate that it will be possible to raise the cash necessary for some time and, for this reason, all donations received will be banked and not touched for any other purpose.

We hope we shall be able to count on your support now, as we have in the past.
