5. FRIDAY - Luncheon Club, also Friday prayers (muslim)

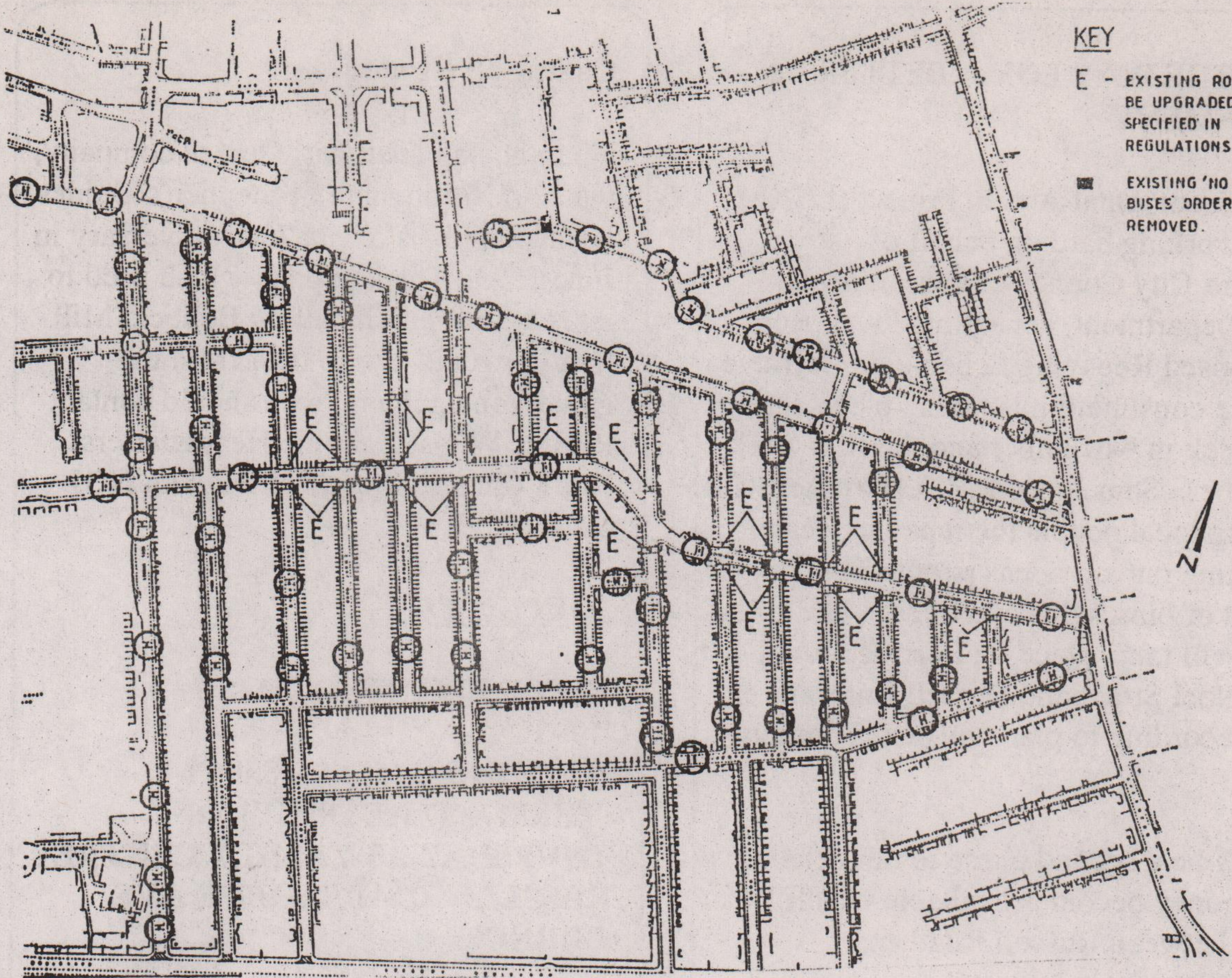

TRAFFIC CALMING

After a consultation process with local residents during last summer, the County Council have proposed the following changes to the traffic system in Forest Fields

Remove No Entry Signs on Berridge Road and Gladstone Street

Install Speed Bumps on nearly all roads to prevent vehicles travelling fast through the residential streets.

Details of work are described above. It should be completed by March 31st 1993.

PAVING THE WAY FOR A BETTER ENVIRONMENT

Local Environmental Action Project (LEAP) has been working hard on behalf of Nottingham City Council's Environmental Services Department, consulting local people on a proposed Repaving Scheme on Berridge Road. The consultation is taking place during the last week in November and the first week in December. Sam Jones L.E.A.P worker will be showing local people the repaving design and checking out any ideas people have on placement of bins, lights and trees. The initial repaving will take place on Berridge Road between Noel Street and Russell Road and if all goes according to plan will start February 1993.

There may be a second phase to this scheme when/if money becomes available which would be between Russell Road and Windmere Road.

THE CHILD SUPPORT ACT 1991

From April 1993 single parents who get Income Support will have to tell the local Social Security office who the other parent is, that is the "absent" parent.

Forms will be sent to all single parents by Child Support Agency, a new and separate section at the D.S.S., or Benefits Agency, as the D.S.S. is now called.

These forms must be filled in and sent back within the stated time limit or Income Support can be cut, or even stopped altogether.

This is a new law, technically known as "The Child Support Act 1991". It comes into effect next April.

It gives the Benefits Agency the power to collect maintenance from the absent parent.

The Advice Centre is very concerned about the effect that this new law will have on quite a lot of people in Forest Fields.

If you get a form to fill in about your child's (or children's) parent who doesn't live with you we can advise you about how it will affect your family.

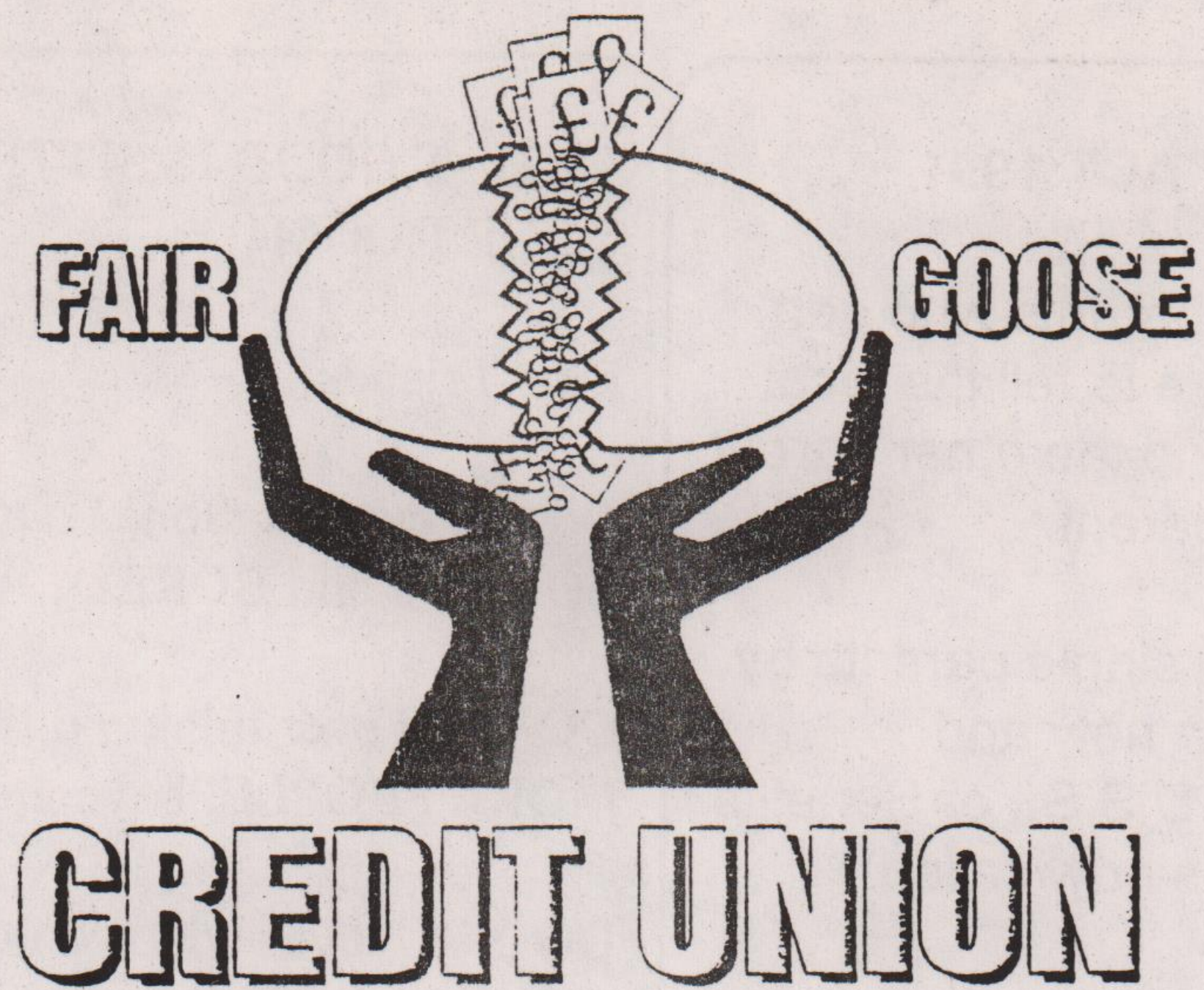

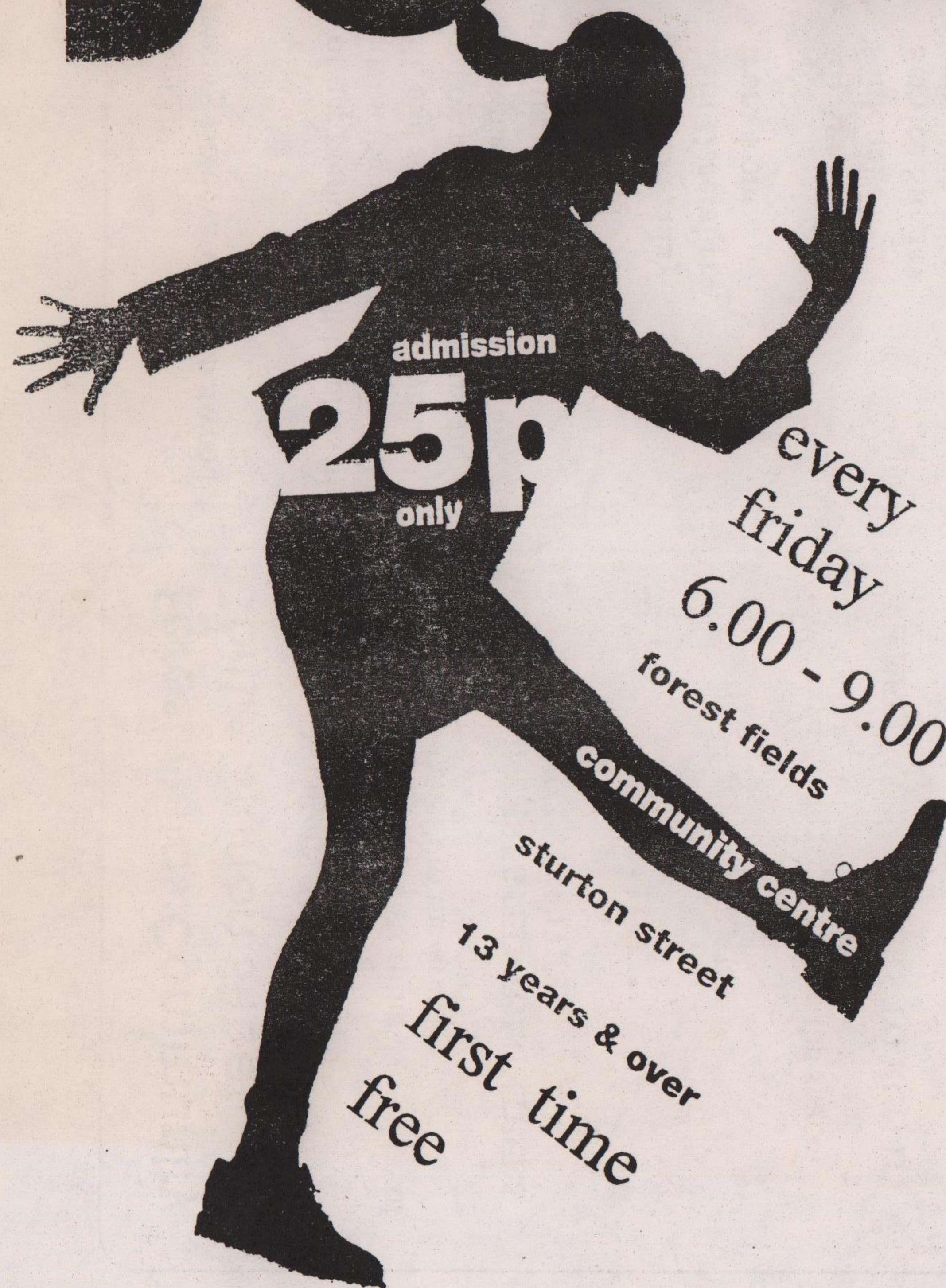
