## CHRISTMAS RECYCLING!

Christmas can be the time when we waste the most, with all the paper, cards and trees purchased in the festive season. Groundwork Greater Nottingham's recycling events on 4th and 5th January offer an easy way for you to make a 'green', start to the year, by turning your trees into valuable garden mulch - and helping to reduce the strain on landfill sites. A series of other recycling events - for both trees and cards - are also being organised in the area.

The two events being held by Groundwork Greater Nottingham are as follows -

- \* Saturday 4th January (10am-4pm) at B&Q, Derby Road, Eastwood.
- \* Sunday 5th January (10am-4pm) at Sainsbury's Homebase, Castle Marina Park, Nottingham.

These events are being supported by Nottinghamshire County Council, Nottingham City Council, Biffa Waste Services, Sainsbury's Homebase and Action Earth (supported by the Department of the Environment). New support has also been enlisted from Broxtowe Borough Council, B&Q (Eastwood) and Access Now.

At both sites the general public are invited to bring along their Christmas tree, watch it being chipped on site and returned to them as a bag of mulch for the garden. Christmas cards will also be recycled at both events as part of the Greenwood Community Forest scheme.

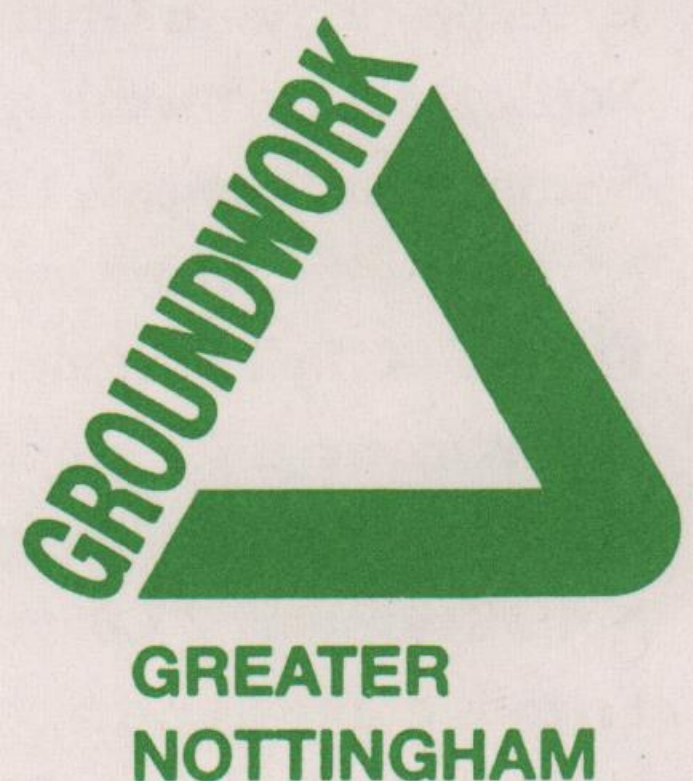
