

Have plenty of rest over this summer—this autumn is going to be pretty busy.

Coming up is likely to be: the repeal of the gay criminal offences in a new comprehensive Sexual Offences Bill; the reintroduction of the Civil Partnership Bill; the repeal of Section 28 in a new Local Government Bill; a new comprehensive Equality Bill to be introduced by Lord Lester and the publication of a draft regulations on sexual orientation discrimination.
