



Loans are provided out of other members savings and are repayable over one or two years at 1% interest per month (e.g. £100 borrowed over one year would be a total repayment of £106.50.)

NOTTINGHAM AND DISTRICT MENTAL HEALTH ASSOCIATION

Nottingham MIND is your local pressure group working on behalf of people who have mental health problems. MIND is independent of both the Health Authority and Social Services so you can turn to us in confidence if you want help with any aspect of your experience as a 'patient'. There are a number of ways in which MIND may be able to help you:

Drop-in-Centre - The MIND Resource Centre at 114 Mansfield Road welcomes people who just like to 'drop in' for a chat and some coffee.

Support Groups - There are a number of social clubs and support groups for people who have been or still are, patients. These are informal and usually run by the group members themselves.

Advice and Information - The MIND Resource Centre has a number of books and leaflets about mental health issues which you are welcome to use. There are also people at MIND who can help you with particular difficulties or complaints you may have about your treatment, legal rights or other issues.

Accommodation - MIND runs a hostel/bedsitters for ten people and also four group homes.

Patient Empowerment - We work to promote groups who are seeking a greater voice for users in the planning & delivery of the mental health services.

Campaigning - MIND has an important role in pressing for better services for you both when you are in hospital and when you leave. If there are things you would like to see improved or changed, let us know and we will try to help.


Education - We are involved in educating both the public and professionals about mental health.
