

In November, 982, there was a concentrated attempt by "Sea Shepherd", to halt the uncalled for slaughter of grey seal pups in and around "Orkney" and Western Isles. "Sea Shepherd" is a break-away group from "Greenpeace" They were cheesed off at the inactivity of "Greenpeace" in the direct-action field.

The campaign was due to start near the end of October. 5 campaigners went out checking' the seal colonies, and found that the pups still had their white fur. This meant that the hunt wouldn't start for a couple of weeks because the pelts are most valuable when they are turning grey.

"Sea Shepherd"had rented a cottage on "Orkney"from which to base their operations.

Unknown to them, on November 2nd, 300 seal pups were murdered on the islands of "Rusk Holm", "Faray" and "Holm of Farray".

On Nov 5rd, the two "sea riders"weat out with 5 campaigners in each. They spotted the hunters on the"Holme of spurness". The hunters had finished on that island. The first sea rider (alpha) had to delay the sealers boat for as long as possible so it couldn't get to another colony. The boat was escorted by 2 police launches and the "Department of Fisheries and Agriculture"boat. The alpha sea rider managed to harass and delay the hunters boat for 45 mins. till the sea riders prop. was badly damaged. They asked for police assistance, which they were given. 5 mins. later, they were arrested and charged with attempting to ram and capsize the hunter's dory*(*raft on which pelts are towed)

The second sea rider(bravo) arrived to find the crew of alpha being arrested. The hunters by this time had landed on other islands-"Huckie" and "Little green horn". Several seals were shot, as the police helped the hunters. 2 campaigners tried to stop the huntsmen from taking the corpses, by lying on top of the dead pups. Another one attempted to over turn the dory, and one threw a bucket of salt water over a hunter's gun to render it useless. All were

arrested and charged with a breach

Sea rider bravo, confronted the hunters at sea. They attempted to snag the boat's prop with a rope. A can of die was thrown into the dory, causing at least 20 pelts to be rendered valueless. On arriving back at "Kirkwall" harbour, the drew was arrested and charged. That day, the hunters killed a'total of 350 pups. Nov. 4th. With the 2 sea



riders impounded by the police, and the most experienced crew members in court, the hunters kill 50 pups unopposed on "Holme of Huip".

Nov.5th. Sea shepherd members found a skinned seal carcass on one of the islands.The hurters are supposed to skin the pups away from the islands and not to leave any corpses, so that the mother seals don't get distressed. The campaigners marched through "Kirkwall" with the carcass in a mock coffin, and leave it on the doorstep of the Department of Agriculture and Fisheries. 3 people were arrested and charged with breach of the peace. Nov.6th. onwards. With only one avon left fully operational, the remaining campaigners traveled to some of the seal colonies, and sprayed pups with dye. Nov.16th. The campaign finally ended.

LOOD ON THE ROCKS

During the cull, shops selling seal products, were daubed with anti-cull slogans, by the Animal Liberation Front. The Scottish Office and various shops were picketted.

Of the quota allowed, 1150 seal pups were slaughtered. Well below the 2000 maximum. The value of the pelts has dropped from £45 each (3 years ago), to £10-£15 per pelt. The estimated total cost of policing the cull is thought to be about £23,500. More than 3 times the profit of the hunters. This means that the british taxpayer PAID for those seal pups to be slaughtered.

Sea Shepherd now believe that the grey seal cull in british waters will soon stop, because of their direct-action campaign and the public outcry at this "traditional"hunt.

During the campaign, 18 people were arrested. 8 have already been fined (total £185). Ten more have still to appear in court in "Kirkwall" in February on more serious charges.

For 700 years, Wales has been ruled by an english government. During that time successive attempts to eradicate the welsh language and to crush national identity have failed.

Now in the 1980's the Welsh have their own to channel, their own newspapers and so on. Of course many of these operate to repress us (in our own language) in the same way as the english system represses everybody on these islands. Wales, Scotland, Cornwall etc. have an unique opportunity to regain self rule by learning from the 'Bloody Revolutions' that have occured all over the world. Just look at Ireland, this is the sort of mess that fucks up the whole idea of freedom.

In other words, don't expect Flaid Cymru or the s.n.p to give you that freeddm. They may help preserve Welsh or Scotish culture, But-the people will still be instruments to be used by a new authority. The answer is real self pule for each individual - freedom to do what you like, as long as it doesn't infringe on the freedom of others. By averting the 'Bloody Revolution' we will have real self rule.

The cultures and languages of Wales, Scotland, Cornwall etc. will develop naturally. English as a second language would be useful but we would all have our native language - it is ours - it is mine and it is yours!

English socialists, and even English anarchists often fail to understand different cultures. But with different cultures we will learn to respect the the cultures of others, and thus also learn to respect other individuals. There heed be no "superiority" as has been the case with the Inglish rulers. Walks has shown the way towards a peacefull world on many occassions but we must act fast and show the way towards freedom for each individual, before a ruling class emerges who want Welsh independence and people will then say that the language is safe and that everything is ok. Welsh is a beautiful language. one which has always represented a resistance, it must therefore now be carried further as a resistance to all authority and not only the English government, if it is to develop naturally. The same goes for the other Celtic cultures, countries and languages.

The answer is self rule - but beware of politicians. Their answer is self rule and "we rule".



The industrial nations and the poor countries dominated and exploited by the industrialised nations all rely on the growth economy. This means that industrial production must always increase, ie, the numbers of fridges, cars, stereos, dog food, nuclear power stations, tv s, psychiatric hospitals. produced has to be constantly increasing.

On a finite planet, this is of course impossible, as there is only a small amount of resources such as coal, oil, tin, iron, alluminium etc. The most widely used resources are almost completely used up. Some will have totally dissapeared within ten years. Pollution is constantly increasing and reaching unbearable limits. If things continue the way they are going, society (I avoid the use of the word "civilisation") will a completely collapse, leaving only chaos.

In order that production increases, people must be persuaded to buy more. The two main methods are advertising and planned obselesence.

Advertising methods include the tv, (not just the adverts)cinema, papers, magazines, books, radio, billboards, shop displays, salesmen etc. This business in itself makes use of such emotions and activities as sex, vanity, pride, appearing to be rich, the urge to conform. We are constantly being assaulted by adverts which tell us we smell, we are usly, a semilitum off, poor, unhappy, odd, abnormal, shabby, and unsuccessful in life.

- Planned opselesence is a subtle technique, which manufacturers use to keep up a steady or increasing demand for their products. Products are built to break down after a specific time. Usually a small important, innaccessible, unreplaceable part. Technology has a major role in todays society. In fact, our society is based on technology. Technology, contrary to what we are alwats told, is not politically neutral on any scale. This makes it a very power full weapon of exploitation and the lust for power. For example, workers in Britain, work when it is convenient for the machine they work with. They are an extension of the machine. This causes many problems of alienation and boredom. Covernments are increasingly being influenced if not run by a small centralised technical elite who do not neccessarily have to be part of the elected government, eg. the nuclear power lobby. the moment in the U.K. (and other European countries) there is overproduction of electricity yet the government wants more nuclear power stations. The major reasons for this is to drastically reduce their dependance on the militant coal miners for energy and put power into the hands of a small elite. The other major reason is to provide plutonium for nuclear weapons. Only recently a senior research scientist, Dr Ross Hesbeth, at the Central Electricity Generating Boards Berkely Laborities in Glouscestershire, claims , that because he Traised question: about the use of civil plutonium in nuclear weapons, he has been / isolated, summarily dealt with by a "kangaroo court" and removed from his work. All this complied with the increasing loss of personal freedom and privacy brought I about by incleasing sophistication of information retrieval, processing technology and 'techniques, 14, computers etc, makes George Orwells predictions about 1984 very frightening.



Suchoku.

The paintings reproduced in this fanzine were done in imitation of the Chinese style of painting. Rather than oilpaints being used to paint landscapes (as in Western style painting), waterbased inks were used. This painting in ink (or Suiboku) was greatly influenced by the art of calligrapy (style of writing).

There are several major differances between Suiboku and western style painting. Many Chinese paintings were done using a limited amount of colour. This meant that more emphasis was placed on the brush strokes to depict the shape and form of an object rather than using colours to do this. In Western art, a landscape would be painted in a true perspective and have a fixed vanishing point. Chinese landscape has none of this. Instead each rock, hill, or tree would be drawn to show its most ideal aspect.

In Suiboku painting the materials that were used also affected the finished painting. There are four basic items of equipment used in Suiboku, and they are as follows :- the ink, (Sumi), the inkstone, (Suzuri), the brush, (Fude), and the paper, (Kami).

Sumi ink comes not in bottles, but in solid sticks. To enable Sumi ink to be used, it has first to be ground on the inkstone (which has been half-filled with water) until the correct consistency of ink is made.

When using Chinese brushes an arm action rather than a finger and wrist action is used. The brush is held in the middle of the stem, between the index finger and thumb. The middle finger is placed below the index finger which enables the brush to be twirled without losing control. Using this method of holding the brush it is possible to achieve a wide variety of tones and lines. Writing was usually included somewhere in the corner of the picture. The inscriptions were not just the artists name, but they were also used to dedicate the painting to someone, or even to add a piece of poetry or description of the painting. This careful placing of the calligraphy and its relation to the artists personal seal (in red) to be stamped on the painting. Because artists used differant names(literary and cal names) the seal could bear a differant name from that which was signed on the painting.

Hopefully these few short notes should give you an idea into Suibbku.







How do we exploit the third world? We must look first to the historical background to this problem.



Today, the economic and political exploitation continues, as our consumerist society, needs to exploit and dominate the Third Yorld to survive. Even after Third World countries became independant, European and American companies still exerted a stranglehold on their covernments, economies and trade. The rich nations keep the price of Third World goods low while their own are kept high.

Multinational companies set up factories or plantations in the Third World, and employ the local inhabitants, virtually as slayes, earning next to nothing.

Take for example, the international grain trade, of which 90% is controlled by 5 Inltinationals: I merican and 3 European. These companies set up flour mills in the Whird World, and distributed free grain, persuading people to eat wheat instead of their more nutritious home produce, which was 100 times cheaper as well. Consequently grain orporations can exert great pressure on Third World countries.



There are now, probably more in ever before, more punk bands today who would call themselves, or are classed as 'anarchist'. They all strive for, or pay lip service to, that elusive eutopia, now centuries old. Although most of these bands produce admirable lyrics they are pratically, without exception, negative. I don't count vague rumours of: "yeah, @, @, and Freedom man, thats the way to be "constructive.

The latter type of comment, quickly quickly becomes bland cliches to be memorised.... then instantly forgotten. Surely, it would be much better, and constructive, for a band in one of the statements they so fondly deliver, instead of writing vague generalisations ("Until men cease to kill, there will be war"type of thing) They could concentrate on some topic, perhaps more specialised, which would contribute to the actual forwarding of a plausible future.

I feel (and do an 'anarchist' surely my view is as valid as anyone else's) that to say "Ah well, but () ems from the individual and only he/she can decide" is a cop-out, a way of evading the issue. The 'anarchist movement 'has been dogged, and shackled by a lack of concrete, plausible suggestions and ideas, which can be discussed, changed and then acted upon. With the exception of a few fanzines and periodicals (and books) and the occassional band, it seems taboo to actually discuss what a future, idealistic society would be like and actually FUCTION. You know, hopefully we might be able, one day to act out our dreams, and if all these consist of simply, "like everyone living together in peace and harmony" then it really would be chaos. Let me ask you this, if you woke up tomorrow, and all institutions , authority and oppression was gone, would you still be able to function, live your life? Mhat would you do? If you haven't got a clue , perhaps you should think about it; i mean, you never know, it worked once in Spain, where in some collectives, they even abolished money! This is not a plea for an end to spontaneity, just for a little constructive thought, not just criticism, worthwhile though it is. 
ONE woman was arrested, and 23 others forcibly removed by Police from Rosyth Naval Base, when they staged a "die-in" during Sunday's Navy Day.

About 40 women were involved in the protest, most of them from the Rosyth Peace Camp, and some from Glasgow, Edinburgh and Greenham Common.

Quietly singing, 23 of the women lay on the site of the Royal Marine Commandos display, while their fellow protesters formed a cricle.

After refusing a request by Ministry of Defence Police that they leave the Naval Base, the "dead" women, still singing, were lifted into Police vans, taken outside the Base and released.

The women received little support from the crowds of onlookers, who shouted and jeered as they were driven away.



Once outside the Main Gates, the women began to block traffic going to and from the Base. They left, when asked to do so by Ministry of Defence Police.

One woman had been arrested within the Naval Base," and charged with committing a breach of the peace. She was later released, and the matter is now in the hands of the **Procurator-Fiscal.**

The Peace camp has now packed up, due to bad weather, lack of women willing to camp and possible eviction . by our localLabour(?)council (INFOCHTES). The ladies of the peace camp are trying to organise other things for next year. Good luck to them.

Circuses have their origins in the past, and could be described as a valuable part of Britains heritage and tradition, but this has clouded our judgement.

LJust suppose circuses with performing animals had never been thought of . Then somebody came along with the idea of a circus with performing animals. Animals doing tricks, obeying commands, playing games and dancing. The reaction would probably be one of horror and disgust.

When you were a child, you were probably

taken along to the circus. You probably marriled at the courage of the 'lion tamers', the grace of the horses, and the ize of the elephants. So, the child that circuses are normal, and an nalterable institution. But it isn't normal-the life of a circus animal is harsh and demanding. Hours, even days are spect travelling from site to site. Even if the travelling is well organised, the animals will still suffer through confinement and restriction of movement. Even at the actual circus, movement is restricted by chains.

But it is in the training that the most cruelty takes place.


- Neither Council Officials, police, or R.S., P.C.A. inspectors are allowed to watch the training without prior notice. A common argueent is that animals love doing tricks. Well, pets sometimes do tricks, but forced to do something unnatural. and difficult, infront of an audience, timed to the split second, it wouldn't. The pet would know that you wouldn't hurt it, and isn't afraid of you. An animal wouldn't stand on it's head, dance, cycle, jump through a blazing hoop because of kindness and a lump of sugar. Reported cases of cruelty in training follow-"The trainer was trying to teach a camel to rear up, by first burning the pads of it's forefeet and then sticking pins lightly into the pads, so that they . pressed deeply into the tender flesh each time it put it's feet to the ground." (Former circus worker)

> "I observed that in training, the elephant hooks are placed on the backs of the legs to force the front ones up in the air, or to force the back legs up behind, so that the full weight of the relephant is on it's front feet There was also a man holding an elephant on the floor with a hook pulling at it's ear. I have

seen the aforesaid instrument

draw blood from the elephants," (Ix circus elephant (TOOM)

"The polar" bears were in great distress and weaving furiously; the outside temperature was 85 F and these bears were cooped up in cages so small, that they had difficuity in turning around. Those trying to lie down had insuficient room to stretch out their legs except up the sides of the cages. There were no bowls of drinking water in their cages, let alone a pool of icy water in which to swim." (From a report by the deputy director of PADL following a visit to a circus training quarters)



"The lions were being cruelly treated. After the act, some of them would leave the cage with blood streaming from their noses where they had been cracked with the whip. I could not stand seeing animals treated like that." (Apprentice lion tamer)

The laws governing performing animals are ridiculous. The Performing Animals (Regulations) Act 1925 allows trainers to not have to specify how and what apparatusses they use for training, when applying for a lcence. It also safe guards the cliccus from spot checks by local authorities and police. There is no law controlling the size of cages or conditions under which the animals are transported.

The animals are often captured and taken out of their natural habitat, and taken . an area of the world which often has a different climate to that which it is used to. The circus maintain that animal acts are part of the tradition of the circus, and cannot be omitted. They are in fact relics of a bygone age of cock-fighting, bearbaiting, child labour, which were once considered traditional, but were abondoned as people became more enlightened.

Circuses have no need for animal acts. Many circuses have no animal acts, and do just as well as ones that do.

The activities of circus animals can never achieve any worthwhile goals in either education, research or conservation.

Not only dd circuses inflict an unnatural way of life on animals, they degrade and humiliate them. There has never been a greater need to protect the world's wild creatures, Now pan we possibly recognise this, and still allow animals to be exploited by cincuses.
