
AN AVERAGE MARINE GIRL AUDIENCE





ANIMAL AID is a group dedicated to campaigning for the total abolition of all experiments on living animals. We feel that vivisection is the worst of the many ways in which animals are abused in our society

Unlike some of the large established animal welfare societies concerned with the vivisection issue, we make no distinction between medical and nonmedical experiments. In our view cruel experiments on defenceless creatures can never be justified.

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
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
