

SOUATTHELOT

Squatting is one of the oldest forms of direct action people can take in providing themselves with the most basic need - a home. Ever since there has been landlords willing to rip people off, there have been people who have refused to be ripped off. Howadays squatting is still an effective way of providing housing for people who are either desperate for somewhere to live, or who reject the idea that a landlord can exploit them.

Just take a walk around your town. How many empty houses are there? And how many of them have been empty for months or years? Then take a look around the council estates, blocks of flats etc. and see how many families are crammed into inadaquate housing while in other parts of the town houses are deliberately run down because their owners can't be bothered with them or want them to become part of some sort of 'Housing Action Area', which means that originally working class areas are bought up, renovated and sold off at prices well above their original value. Meanwhile, the waiting lists for council properties grow, while the councils themselves throw thousands of pounds in 'Government Urban Renewal' away on useless renovations of their properties, with a token negotiation with the tenants and little consideration of what the actual needs are.

The squatting movement has helped draw attention to all these problems, through mass squats, demonstrations and publications. Squatting can be one of the most direct political statements anyone can make, but also it's great fun! An active squatters group can also encourage people who would not normally take such a step to become more involved in their own destiny, and become more aware of how much they and other people are ripped off look at the grotty house we pay for when them up the road have that lovely detached house for nothing. Of course it can have its drawbacks, like eviction and harrassment, but an organised support group can help alleviate such problems, if only to show that other people have been through the same thing but can still come through smiling.

Squatting is not only for people desperate for a home, either. If you were to leave your rented accommodation just because you wanted to squat, that would free your place for use by someone who needs somewhere but isn't prepared to take a risk with squatting (yet). Squatting doesn't always have to end in eviction either - sometimes 'licence' agreements can be arranged with the owners of the properties which allow you to stay for a token rent; most short-life housing in cities is an end product of a squatting movement in those areas.



Just how dangerous it is for men to hide their feelings can hardly be better illustrated by the state of the world today. If the bosses of multinetional companies stopped to consider the consequences of their actions for the people, animals and earth they exploit, how could they not break down and cry? If arms dealing governments had consciences wouldn't they pack it in as a bad job and go off and paint pictures or write poems instead?

It may seem hard to understand the destructive and hurtful acts of many men, but maybe it shouldn't be so surprising because indoctrination from birth is a very powerful thing. What pleasure do blokes get from fighting each other, or from raying or harassing a woman? Surely none at all. It's all pretence and show, we're not meant to be open and honest about our feelings or let our emotions show, or even feel pain. We're tough and hard and serious. Not only is this bad for the women treated as objects and possessions, it dumages us too. If, we can't cry we've lost a valuable, perhaps essential, emotional outlet. If we pretend we can't be hurt we'll probably end up hadly injured like the football fans in hespital after their latest fight, or equally, like the tough punks who push everyone around the dance-floor at gigs.

Hurting yourself may seem stupid (mainly because it is) but other consequences of indoctrinated male values are far worse. Rape, often still thought of as an act of lust, is in fact an assertion of the male dominance of women. A way of showing who is boss, who is stronger. Just what are rapists scared of, and why can't they come to terms with it? Because they're not meant to, the answer is to use violence to gain respect. These values work at all levels of society. We can learn it at school where teachers gain the respect of their pupils by the use of violent punishments or threats, teaching their pupils that this is how you get to be boss. Usually only boys recieve corporal punishment and you have to try your best not to cry afterwards - the pain gets shut up inside, maybe for years until there's a chance to get your own back, perhaps on your children or wife, or a woman on her own.

I remember at school in the first year when we used to get bullied by fifth year prefects, we said we couldn't wait to be fifth years when we could do the same and get our own back. But get our own back on who? The fifth years in question had long since left, so the cycle continues, the first years we bullied said to sach other...

The answer? Well you tell me...but abolishing corporal punishment and prefects might be a good start! Along with realising our own fears and weaknesses as men, realising that we're all just flesh and blood and feelings. It's an ongoing thing, but the sconer we start to challenge and redefine our prescribed roles the betver. We'll never be perfect, but the struggle is what life is all about, and if we can't change ourselves, what hope have we of changing the world?
