Plus: some of you may have given money recently and, because the next issue is the last, may want some of it back. No problem! Just send a note saying how much you want, and we'll happily oblige.

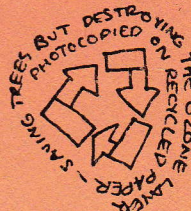
