

LOCAL BITS

7th September. TARMAC.

Early saturday morning a team of Anarcha-vandals visited Tarmac in the city's Market square, in support of the days anti tarmac demonstration. Tarmac's involvement in the building of nuclear silos, especially for cruise, has singled them out for some special treatment. Their poxy counter sabotage precautions (tall barbed wire fences, grills over the windows etc.) were easily foiled with the help of a conveniently placed fence pole. Most of the windows were smashed to the cheers of by-standers, and white paint was thrown down the front of the portacabins. The peace group later decorated the fence with ribbons, and put stickers on the fence.

Nottingham filth tried to persuade a defenceless citizen to spy and snitch for them, with promises of cash rewards and anonimity. No chance piggy - back to the sty!

August 1st - 23rd

DHSS ACTIONS 'Better class of Servant' anti-DHSS public meeting at the International community centre. Speakers included a man f from the County council welfare rights team, and a genuine claimant. Actions were discussed and another meeting planned. Although the turnout didn't exactly reflect the amount of work put into the publicity, we felt like we had some potential as a group. The next meeting, 5th August, proved to be less of a success. Many of those who were enthusiastic in the first meeting failed to turn up. Still we decided to organise a "Rally and party" against the Social security reviews (cuts). We did mass leaflets in DHSS offices and UBOs and it was widely flyposted. Still the turnout was pathetic. Radio Trent gave it airspace as an illegal demo. The police also warned us off. About 15 of us assembled in the steady rain and opted for the warm and dry if not over stimulating environment of the Centre for the Unemployed, where the workers were dumbstruck that anyone should actually want to go in there that they let us stay. We played football, drank some homebrew, blew whistles (till we were informed about the employees trying to work - not all so lucky are we ?) and wished the food we had brought was vegan.

5th September

Some claimants met with the DHSS worker's main union, the CPSA (Civil and Public Servants Association). Conversation involved the CPSA representatives apolog ising for having an unmilitant membership and making excuses for not opposing the new rulings any further than in their heads. All suggestions were turned down. Still, a strike was promised for Friday 13th, how poetic.

13th September

NO strike "Disillusioned claimants spray painted DHSS offices with slogans: "DHSS snoopers fuck off", "CPSA and claimants unite", "Strike now".

Although a DHSS strike wouldn't have been wholely beneficial to claimants, we felt that we should support it a as a positive sign of support from the other side of the glass screen. Its failure clearly leaves the ball in our court. Four million claimants DO have some collective power, we must get together and fight back. It won't be easy, but we won't take this shit lying down.

August-

Anarchists spray paint DHSS offices and unemployment benefit offices with slogans - 'Ganng up and fight back', 'Conspiracy for poverty' etc.

Porn shop in Carrington Street redecorated;-"Porn is the theory, Rape is the practice" and Co's etc.

Court buildings vandalised.

Station Street police station visited by car body-work team who set to work on parked police cars. Somewhere ther must be a filth mobile driving round with a massive @ on its bonnet. Any sightings?

12th September

Shire hall attacked. Messages of dissatisfaction were left. 'British injustice, No thanks.'

ANARCHISTS HELP BIG BUSINESSES' SCANDAL




CHARME STATE

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SMASH SOUTH AFRICAN BUSINES DAY- 30 sept '85

THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY VARIOUS GROUPS CONCERNED ABOUT THE RACIST REPRESSION IN SOUTH AFRICA AND THE CONTINUING TRADE BETWEEN BRITAIN AND SOUTH AFRICA HAVE TAKEN ACTION AGAINST BUSINESSES AND INSTITUTIONS WHICH CARRY ON THIS TRADE OF DEATH

- IN NOTTINCHAM LEAFLETS ASKING SHOPWORKERS AND SHOPOWNERS TO STOP SELVING AND HANDLING SOUTH AFRICAN PRODUCE WERE DISTREBUTE DURING THE WEEKS BEFORE S.S.A.B. DAY.

5,000 LEAFLETS WERE DI STREBUTED ON BEHALF OF THE CO-OP

WILL SERIOUSLY HAVE TO RECONSIDER THEIR POSITION ON STOCKING PRODUCTS OF APARTHEID. VOUCHERS ADVERTISING 30p OFF DELMONTE (SOUTH AFRICAN) FRUIT JUICE, AND LIBEY'S, WERE ALSO DISTREBUTED

ON THE NIGHT OF 29th SEPT. WINDOWS WERE BROKEN AT BARCLAYS HOUSE AND THE ABC CINEMA(OWNED BY THORN EMI, SUPPLIERS OF WEAPONS TO THE SOUTH AFRICAN REGIME).

BARCLAYS AND MIDLAND BANKS IN THE CITY CENTRE WERE SPRAYED WITH ANTI-APARTHEID SLOGANS, HAD THEIR CASH POINTS AND LOCKS GLUED . UP AND BLOOD THROWN OVER THEM

THE TOWN WAS SATURATED WITH FLYPOSTERS TO PUBLICISE THE ACTION AND THE ATROCITIES OF APARTHEID. THEY NAMED COMPANIES AND : PRODUCTS THAT THE PUBLIC ARE ASKED TO BOYCOTT.

LEAFLETS WERE HANDED OUT ASKING PEOPLE NOT TO BUY SOUTH AFRICAN PEOPLE THEN VISITED 2 COOPS (NEAR VICTORIA CENTRE AND COOP : HOUSE) SAINSBURIES, TESCOS AND MARKETS. THEIR WERE STICKERS PLASTERED ON SOUTH AFRICAN PRODUCTS AND TROLLIES WERE FILLED WITH S.A. GOODS AND LEFT WITH EXPLAINITORY POSTERS.


FINALLY ONE WOMAN WAS HELD BY POLICE AFTER TWO ACTIVISTS RECONDITIONED BROADMARSH COOP'S AIR WITH 'FART SPRAY' AND PERSUED THROUGH THE CITY CENTRE BY TWO STORE DETECTIVES.

WE HOPE THESE ACTIONS WILL HELP TO HIGHLIGHT THE ISSUE OF APARTHEID AND DRAW ATTENTION TO THE ATTROC ITIES IN SOUTH AFRICA. Tambo's plea to public

By Peter Hetherington The President of the Afri-can National Congress, Mr Oliver Tambo, yesterday, urged the British people to give a lead to their govern-ment by imposing voluntary sanctions against South Africa.

In an emotional speech to the Labour Party Conference in Bournemouth, he said that Mrs Thatcher and her minis-ters were clearly out of touch with the mood of the British people.

In his speech Mr Tambo said: "The masses of the British people can and must impose sanctions themselves. British people can and have impose sanctions themselves. You have the power to stop all trade with apartheid South Africa. We plead with you that you do not worry that we will, as a result, have to do without an eve-ning meal. The stomachs of those who are shot down every day are empty already. The bellies of those who pull the trigger are bulging to the point of obscenity. Stop even more lives of our feeding them. Stop giving them the strength to take people."

MORES.S.A.B. DAY

BUSINESSES in Notting ham were this week counting the cost of a citywide wave of anti-

apartheid vandalism. In a midnight blitz, a group calling itself the Smash South African Business Federation, SHATTERED windows in a bank and a cinema, poured SUPERGLUE into cash points and locks. SPRAYED slogans and threw BLOOD over offices.

The group also pla tered the city centre with anti-apartheid posters and put hundreds of "half-price" stickers on South African goods in supermarkets.

One of the worst hit was the Co-op, who were the victims of thousands of hoax leaflets advertis-

or noax leaners advertis-ing cut-price goods. In a statement, the group said: "We hope these actions will help to highlight the issue of apartheid and draw attention to the atrocities in South Africa." But Barclay's bank,

who have major interests in South Africa, condemned the action.

"We regard this as further evidence of ex-tremist militant groups who believe they can intimidate society to sup-port their views by such acts of violence," said a spokesman.

Co-op cuts all trade with SA



The Co-op yesterday became the first big British retailer to sever all trade links with South Africa. The move will eventually ban the republic's products from more than 1,200 stores and marks the retail trade's most forceful condemnation of apartheid.

The South African embassy described the move as "a foolish step ... contributing to a worsening of the situation and worsening or the situation affer not improving it. It is probably an attempt to salve certain moral anxieties that certain people have when looking at a complex situation from afar."

The deputy secretary of the Anti-Apartheid Movement, Miss Kate Clarke, said that she hoped the move would be the first of many by stores groups. Sainsbury's and Tesco had recently indicated a policy change of instructing their buyers to seek alternatives to South African goods, she said.

THE BACKGROUND

In July 1979, after 16 years of mounting popular resistance and guerilla warfare, the dictatorship of Anastasia Somoza was overthrown by an armed insurrection of the Nicaraguan people led by the FSLN (the Sandinista Front for National Liberation)

For Nicaragua it was far more than the replacement of one government with another. Effectively it was the birth of an independent and authentic Nicaragua - a Nicaragua ruled not by Spain or later the USA and its local henchmen but rather by and for the workers and peasants of the country. It was also the birth of a most unusual experiment in "socialism" and so far a remarkably succesful one.


Despite the poverty stricken and war ruined state of the country in 1979, despite 6 years of continuous war against the <u>Contras</u> (ex National Guardsmen from Somoza's days and mercenaries backed by the USA), despite an economic blockade by the USA <u>and</u> the problems common to all Latin America of crippling debt burdens and deteriorating terms of trade with the developed world. Despite all this the 3 million Nicaraguans have made headway in the economic and cultural development of their country, there is a more equal sharing out of what little wealth there is, and the FSLN government remains very popular.

In the 1984 elections, the first unrigged elections in Nicaragua's history, the FSLN took % of the vote on a 75% turnout (though the FSLN would be at pains to point out that 'elections' are only one small part of the process of exerting democratic control). And whilst I was visiting Nicaragua in July the Rally on Independence day attracted 4/500,000 people which is 15% of the country. Imagine a demonstration in London of 8 million people, for thats the equivalent.



I came back from Nicaragua feeling inspired by what is happening there and immensely impressed by the Sandinistas as a political force. I think the 'left' in Britain has an awful lot to learn from them about what a democratic socialist society could be like, about how to involve people in controlling that society, and about strategy and tactics. For when you are trying to take on poverty, a local dictator, US imperialism, the world economy, patriarchy - and there is 3 million of you; then you have to take decisions about what to do first, who to combat and with whom to make temporary alliances, with the price for getting it wrong often being death

It was also so refreshing to see a 'left' party that is not stuck in the rights and wrongs of the Russian revolution, that feels confident in taking bits out of Marx and Lenin, combining it with Latin American nationalism, Catholic Liberation Theology and a lot of original thought, applying it to the particular reality of Nicaragua now, and being prepared to freely and openly admit when they've made mistakes. I could talk and write for hours about Nicaragua but here I'll just try to give a flavour of the place with a few examples.



1) THE STATE, PRIVATE ENTERPRISE AND COOPERATIVES - LAND REFORM

In 1979 all land was privately owned, with most of it including all the best land, in the hands of a small number of large landowners. A story common to much of the world. 6 years on 16% is state owned and nearly 40% in cooperatives, and whilst the rest is still in private hands there has been some redistribution of that from large to small peasant farmers Progress certainly but far from the conventional nationalise everything approach of many 'socialist' countries. The FSLN strategy for land reform has followed the following principles;-

To have taken over all private property would have turned a large number of peasant farmers against the revolution at atime when, under attack from outside, the last thing it needed was an internal war. It would also have turned into opponents a lot of people with considerable agricultural expertise and, has often happened in 'Socialist' countries, as productivity would have initially fallen drastically leading to even greater poverty. Much land has been expropriated, that of Somoza and his cronies, of private owners who weren't farming it properly or deliberately de-capitalising it; and some has been purchased by agreement or compulsorily. BUT private farming as a principle hasn't been attacked. As a result a major land redistribution has taken place is still taking place, but at the same time production has increased significantly.

- Meanwhile the 'Social Sector' of farming - state. farms and cooperatives - have been backed heavily by the government. In situations where it is appropriate that the farming is done on a large scale or in a capital intensive way, then the farm is state owned and subject to national planning but with a high degree of worker control of the job process. But all small scale farming developments are in the form of cooperatives and this has been the form of land ownership that has been pushed most heavily as the most desirable form.

- But cooperation can't be imposed from above. So whilst government policy is to financially and politically encourage cooperatives, nobody is forced into one; and it is the principle of cooperation that is emphasised rather than a precise form of ownership So private landowners who want to retain that ownersh are encouraged to cooperate on alesser level eg joint purchase of equipment, joint irrigation schemes etc.

2) GUNS AND POEMS - THE POLICE AND THE ARMY

"I think that Nicaragua must be the only country in the world where the police publish their poems"

The visitor to Nicaragua can't help but be struck by how militarised the place is. Not in terms of heavy armour, but in terms of how many young people there are in military uniforms and how many people have guns. It is the mark of a country that had to fight to oust a brutal dictatorship, has been under attack ever since, and is preparing for the realistic possibility of a direct US invasion. Yet it is also, out of the war zones, the most relaxed, friendly and safest country I have ever been in. A 13 year old Nicaraguan child carrying a rifle, as some do, may not have had the advanced weapons training of a Brixton policeman but his/her awaremess of what guns are for, when to use them and when not to use them, is considerably higher.

And when the police stop you in the street and ask for identification you don't feel the normal threats associated with 'authority'. Mather one feels one is talking to a comrade and equal, part of whose role is to remorselessly hunt the efforts of the CIA (and they are numerous) to commit economic sabotage and political assasination, The police and the army are trained to fight and kill but they are also 'educated' in its deepest sense to be humble and to be servants of the people. This is where artistic sensitivity comes in. Abuses of power and authority occur, the Nicaraguans have not become saints overnight, but these are treated as serious crimes in terms of punishment.

Of Nicaragua's 3 million people half are under 15. 200,000 adults (and some children) have arms and have been trained in their use. The majority are not in the armed forces or the police but rather form voluntary militias to fight off Contra guerilla attacks or the Americans if they come. Not an army but a people armed, and an indication of the confidence the Sandinistas have in the relationship between themselves and the people. Imagine Thatcher or Reagan freely handing out arms to workers ?

3) LEARNING FROM MISTAKES - THE MISKITO PROBLEM

Nicaragua is 95% Mestizo - mixed Spanish/Indian blood. But on the remote Atlantic coast region there are about 100,000 indigenous Indians, mainly Miskitos, and 100,000 Creoles who are English speaking Blacks brought there originally as slaves to work the sugar plantations. These ethnic groups, particularly the Indians, have been subject as everywhere else in the American continent, to centuries of systematic racism and exploitation. The Sandinistas of 1979 consciously espoused a non-racist policy. Yet in their early practice out of ignorance and conditioning much of what they did could be labelled as institutional racism. The Miskitos and Creoles were taught to a read and write Spanish like it or not, and generally no account was taken of specific cultural needs, Army abuses did occur and conflicts quickly arose with Contra propoganda encouraging many Miskitos to leave the country; some to take up arms but many to end up in far worse conditions in Honduras. This issue has perhaps been the revolution's biggest test of its honesty and ability to be self-critical.

In a few years there has been a major turn-around. Education now in the atlantic coast is bi-lingual; economic resources are being put into the area to compensate for its traditional under-development; and a mass consultative process is under way to devise a constitution for a regional government with considerable powers of economic self government and autonomous cultural development. Devising such a constitution is not easy for whilst the Miskitos rightly wish for less domination by the rest of Nicaragua, the smaller Indian tribes are just as worried about cultural domination by the Miskitos. And whilst the indigenous Indians have a right to greater autonomy one needs to avoid over-romanticising them as a people for some have been happy to throw in their lot with Reagan and the CIA.

When the Minister of the Interior announced the Autonomy proposals to a mass rally of Miskitos he delivered his entire speech in Miskito using not just the words but the cultural idioms too... Margaret Thatcher in Welsh or Punjabi ?



4) THE NEW NATION ... THE NEW MAN (SIC)

An independent but pro-Sandinista daily newspaper that began in 1980 carries the logo -'the new paper for the new man'. The concept of the new man has been central to the Sandinistas political project from their beginnings in 1963. The new man is selfles rather than egotistic, collective rather than individualistic, intensely patriotic yet with a strong internationalist consciousness, in particular an awareness of the need for unity amongst the Latin American peoples.

In its origins the concept owes nothing to Western feminism, but in its practice it is clearly questioning many of the manifestations of machismo. Selflessness and collectivity forged in a long guerilla war where most of the young men and women who formed the guerilla army in the early years died in the process whilst others suffered imprisonment and torture.

Nicaragua is full of reminders of dead heroes, some of them 'leaders', most lesser known fighers. Picture on the walls; memorials in the neighbourhoods; bus stations, shopping centres and estates named after them. The dead leaders are given more emphasis than the living ones. A new nation creates its historical identity.

AND THE NEW WOMAN

It may not be called feminism but the development of the power of women has been considerable. By their involvment in the guerilla struggle young women pushed themselves onto the political scene and they haven't renounced it since. The armed forces retain large numbers of women (though they have tended to be kept out of the front line), the neighbourhood defence committees which are also the effective community based organisations, are predominantly women, and progress is being made in terms of women entering traditional male jobs. Women have a number of places in the 2nd tier of government posts, though not yet at the top, and AMNLAE, the Nicaraguan Womens Association, whilst not an autonomous movement in the Western sense since it is part of the Sandinista part is not backward in raising womens issues within the party, government and trade unions.

The government attitude is supportive, instituting changes on the economic level to do with equal pay, job discrimination, rights within the family; and very effectively banning the use of womens bodies , for advertising purposes. But also cautious, avoiding too direct a confrontation with male power. Perhaps too cautious but aware, as in all its policies of the need to maintain national unity against the all too r threat from imperialism.

Women are on the move in Nicaragua, and way in advance of developments anywhere else in Latin America. A long way still to go, but as elsewhere in the world women are changing roles faster then men

CUSTOMERS INCLUDE: ZIMBAEWE, PA IN CERIA, HONDURAS, BRAZIL, CHILE, INDONESIA, THILAND, RO UGANDA, PHILIPINES, COLUMBIA, SURINAM.... IN 1980, THATCHER ACTUALLY LIFTED THE EMBARCO FOR ARMS SALES TO CHILE, OELIVIOUS TO WHAT'S GOING ON THERE. MANY OF THE ITEMS SOLD TO THESE COVERNMENTS ARE SAID TO HAVE "NO USE" IN THIS COUNTRY. IN THE 1982 EQUIPMENT EXHIBITION, ELECTRIC SHOCK BATONS AND ELECTRIC POCKET SHOCK-PRODS WERE OFFERED TO CHILE AND SEVERAL OTHER COUNTRIES, ALTHOUCH THIS GOVERNMENT DENIES THAT THE BRITISH FORCES HAVE ANY USE FOR THEM. OTHER INCLUDE & CS GRENADES, RIOT GUNS, RUBBER BULLETS, SURVEILLANCE DEVICES, POLICE COMPUTERS ETC ETC... ALTHOUCH EXPORT CUSTOMERS ARE SCREEMED FOR POLITICAL AND STATEDIC SECU-RITY, HUMAN RICHTS ISSUES ARE NOT CONSIDERED.

THE JUSTIFICATION THAT THIS INDUSTRY PROVIDES JOBS IS TOTAL SHIT. FOR THE SAME MONEY, 80,000 JOBS IN THE ARMS INDUSTRY COULD BE REPLACED BY 140,000 JOBS IN THE NHS, YET OVER 90 HOSPITALS HAVE BEEN AXED SINCE 1979.

THE FALKLANDS WAR WAS ONE OF THE FEW OCCASIONS WHEN ANYONE SHOWED AN INTEREST IN ARMS DISTRIBUTION. WOMEN IN PRISONS

I HAVE BEEN THINKING OF WRITING SOMETHING ABOUT WOMEN IN PRISONS AND THE STYAL FREEDOM CAMP, WHICH TOOK PLACE IN AUGUST, FOR A WHILE REASONS WHY I HAVE N'T ARE BECAUSE IT'S SUCH A COMPLICATED SUBJECT TO APPROACH, AND ALSO BE-CAUSE HAVING NOT BEEN IN PRISON MYSELF. I WON-DER AT THE CREDIBILITY OF MY OPINIONS ON WOMEN'S LIVES IN PRISONS. MANY MORE 'RIGHT ON 'PEOPLE WAVE BECOME AWARE OF PRISONS IN THE LAST FEW YEARS SINCE IMPRISONMENT RATHER THAN PAYMENT OF FINES BECAME A MORE POPULAR CHOICE AMONGST POLI-TICALLY ACTIVE PEOPLE, THE REASONS GOING ALONG THE LINES THAT, 'IF'L CHOOSE TO DO SOMETHING WHICH THE STATE DOES N'T APPROVE OF, WHY SHOULD I PAY IT FOR TELLING ME OFF FOR HAVING COMMITTED THAT 'CRIME'.I'LL TALK ONLY ABOUT WOMEN'S PRISONS SINCE THIS IS ALL I KNOW ABOUT.



Women seem to get a <u>Really BAD DEAL SINCE OUR</u> PATRIARCHAL SOCIETY BELIEVES WOMEN TO BE NATURALLY PASSIVE AND BORING CREATURES WHO DO FUCK ALL ABOUT A GROTTY SITUATION. JUDGES OFTEN 'SEE WOMEN'S LAWBREAKING AS BEING BOTH A MANIFESTATION OF LACK OF FEMININITY AND A JUSTIFICATION FOR INCREASED SURVEILLANCE AND SEVERER PUNISHMENT'. IHE MAJORITY OF WOMEN IN PRISONS ARE 'IN' FOR THEFT, DEALING AND SMUGGLING DRUGS, 'LESS THAN TEN PER CENT OF CONVICTED AND IMPRISONED WOMEN HAVE BEEN FOUND GUILTY OF A CRIME OF VIOLENCE'.____ AND SURPRISE, SURPRISE IF THEY ARE, IT IS USUALLY IN RESPONSE TO MALE ATTACK OR ABUSE, IO TOP UP OFFICIAL NUMBERS THE HOME OFFICE TRANSFER WOMEN TO DURHAM H-BLOCK TOP SECURITY PRISON. IN HERE WOMEN ARE IN ISOLATION, UNDER HOURLY SURVEILLANCE MOST WOMEN IN THERE HAVE COMMITTED THE TYPE OF CRIMES I HAVE ALREADY REFFERED TO __I.E. NO DIFFER -RENT FROM WOMEN IN OTHER PRISONS.

STYAL FREEDOM CAMP

WOMEN FROM ALL OVER THE COUNTRY STAYED AT THE CAMP ____A TURNOVER OF AROUND FIFTY WOMEN , AND MANY, MANY PEOPLE VISITED. MEDIA COVERAGE WAS AS GOOD AS WE COULD HAVE HOPED __LOCAL PAPERS, RADIO, GRANADA TV AND A SMALL CLIP IN THE GUARDIAN. WE TALKED TO WOMEN INSIDE THE PRISON THROUGH THE FENCE, AND CONSTANTLY ASKED THEM FOR FEEDBACK ON WHETHER OR NOT THEY WANTED US THERE. MANY OF US TALKED TO PEOPLE VISITING THE PRISON, AND HERE ARE A FEW OF THE ACCOUNTS:



EIRSI_WOMAN:

HAD A LITTLE CHILD OF ABOUT 3 YEARS, AND IS IN HER MID FIFTIES, SHE WAS VISITING HER DAUGHTER-IN-LAW, ONE NIGHT THE WOMAN AND HER BOYFRIEND WERE IN A CLUB, AND A BLOKE STARTS CALLING HER 'SLAG', 'WHORE' 'WHORE'ETC. A FIGHT BROKE OUT AND SHE GOT 18 MONTHS, HE GETS 2 YEARS, SHE'S PREGNANT AND WILL HAVE THE BABY IN THERE END OF DECEMBER. UUT IN JAN. IF SHE GETS PAROLE. (BEING PREGNANT IN STYAL MUST BE HORRIFIC, BECAUSE WOMEN ARE NOT ALLOWED TO LIE DOWN OR SLEEP DURING THE DAY, _____IF THEY DO THEY GET PUNISHED __SOME HIDE AWAY WITH A LOOKOUT).

EIBSI_MAN:

HIS SISTER IS IN FOR LIFE __MURDER, SHE KNIFED A BLOKE IN A CLUB BECAUSE HE STARTED HASSLING HER __SHE'S BEEN IN TWO YEARS, SHE GETS VISITS EVERY TWO WEEKS (THE MAXIMUM ALLOWANCE) AND THEY THINK SHE MIGHT BE MOVED BECAUSE OF IT, __ALTHOUGH IT'S HER RIGHT.

HER RIGHT. (WHILST WE WERE OUTSIDE STYAL WE BECAME AWARE THAT MANY WOMEN FROM THE SOUTH HAD BEEN MOVED UP TO STYAL AND VICE VERSA __WE WONDER WHETHER THIS WAS ANOTHER LITTLE PLOY TI KEEP PRISONERS ISOLATED, AS MANY PEOPLE COULDN'T AFFORD THE FARES.)

SECOND_MAN:

HIS WIFE WAS VISITING A FRIEND, BUT THEY WOULDN'T LET HIM IN. THE SCREWS CHUCKED HIM OUT OF THE PRISON GROUNDS FOR SITTING ON A BENCH WAITING ____ PARANOID IDIOTS.

The woman was in because of heroine, The police raided one night and she had a blow's worth on her. They did her for supplying too, so she got 2 years.

THIRD_MAN:

GIRLFRIEND'S IN 3 MONTHS FOR CHEQUESFIDDLES. SHE'S AN ADDICT, AND HE SAYS THEY GIVE NO HELP AND IT SOUNDS REALLY MARD. HE SAYS THEY STRIP SEARCH THE WOMEN AFTER EVERY VISIT.

HE SAID THAT A FRIEND OF HIS IS ALSO IN THERE, AND KNOWS SOMEONE WHO GOT HEPATITIS. SHE KEPT TELLING THE SCREWS SHE WAS ILL AND THEY WOULDN'T BELIEVE HER. HEY SAID THAT IF SHE HASSLED THEM ANYMORE, THEY'D PUT HER IN SOLITARY. FINALLY, WOMEN FROM HER HOUSE COMPLAINED, SO THEY PUT HER IN A PRISON HOSPITAL.





OUTCOME

WE GOT MUCH SUPPORT FOR THE CAMP; VISITS, FIRE WOOD, MONEY. IO BEGIN WITH IT SEEMED THAT THE PRISONERS WANTED US THERE, AFTER ABOUT THE SECOND WEEK HOWEVER, WE LEARNED THAT WOMEN WERE LOOSING PRIVELEGES (SUCH AS BEING ALLOWED TO SIT OUTSIDE TO EAT IN THE SUMMER, HAVING EXERCISE AT WEEKENDS) AND SOME WOMEN WANTED US TO LEAVE COMPLETELY. WHILST I WAS AWAY THE DECISION WAS MADE TO DISBAND THE CAMP. IT WAS A VERY DIFFICULT DECISION TO MAKE _____ WE COULDN'T BELIEVE WHAT THE AUTHORITIES WERE SAYING (OBVIOUSLY THEY DIDN'T WANT US THERE) BUT THERE WAS NO WAY OF TALKING TO WOMEN DIRECTLY. CORRESPONDENCE WITH AN EX-CON AND A WOMAN STILL IN THERE REVEALED THAT THE FORMER DIDN'T LIKE WHAT WE WERE DOING AT ALL. AND THE LATTER BELIEVED THEY WERE THE MINORITY INSIDE WANTING US THERE. BUT EVEN INSIDE THE PRISON. COMMUNICATION BETWEEN WOMEN IS DIFFICULT. WE ALL STILL FEEL PRETTY CONFUSED ABOUT WHAT TO DO, THE IDEA OF THE CAMP WAS TO TRY AND SUPPORT WOMEN INSIDE. AND IF THEY WERE GETTING AN EVEN WORSE DEAL BECAUSE OF US, THEN WE HAD TO LEAVE. SOME OF US HAVE DECIDED TO WRITE TO WOMEN IN PRISONS, AND TO KEEP IN TOUCH WITH THE 'WOMEN IN PRISONS' GROUP - AN ORGANISATION BASED IN LONDON, CONSISTING OF A GROUP OF WOMEN SOME OF WHOM HAVE BEEN IN PRISON. WE WOULD ALSO LIKE TO DO SOME MORE DIRECT ACTIONS BUT WANT TO THINK CAREFULLY ABOUT THE POSSIBLE IMPLICATIONS THIS MAY HAVE FOR WOMEN INSIDE.

In the last issue there was a series of articles which all had a common link that is a serious problem to all of us.

The troubles with Mushroom, the problems of the Nottingham Video Project and the stateoof the Nottingham Unemployed Centre all have one thing in common. When your "alternative" becomes your sole means of survival in economic terms you fight like hell to protect it, whether it's doing what it set out to do or not.

Mushroom people feel threatened by legitimate criticism. The NVP are threatened because they took government money - and what the state giveth, the state taketh away. The unemployed Centre also has to jump through hoops to keep its workers pay packets secure.

This economic threat exists from day one of setting up anything like this and it is a real danger. People involved spend as much time securing their future livlihood as they do serving the needs they were set up to meet. The situation with the NVP is a fine

The situation with the NVF is a line example. They must have ppent more time and money lately trying to keep their own jobs than making films. As a founder member of a video group that has been running for nine years now without any funding at all, apart from running training courses, I know we will still be going when NVP is finally gone. The community we serve will still have our skills and equipment available at the same price - free when NVP work workers are signing on again and blaming Thatcherite economic stringency for their fate.

Maybe in some super socialist state money would shower down on these good and worthy projects without a single string attached. But pigs will fly first. Anyone who takes state money for something that cannot exist without it should accept that it can go easier than it came. When it goes the network and structure should still be there so something can carry on. The trouble is that to justify the wages they recieve the people involved have to show that "ordinary" people are incapable of organising or carrying out a task without their "expert" help. Look at the Unemployment Centre. All the paid masters and mistresses of that place only serve to reinforce the idea that the unemployed are inherently incapable of organising themselves. Unemployed Centres should be run for and by the unemployed, not staffed by self seeking wage slaves who have a totally different set of objectives , chief of which is that friday Pay Day keeps coming and in defence of which they will compromise and keep in with the paymasters all the way down the line.

They live off the backs of the unemployed and then expect the unemployed to run and help when their jobs are threatened. Like asking a dog to welcome fleas really.

4 people from Nottingham and one from Peterborou travelled up to the Faslane Peace Camp on Sat. 15th September, ready for the blockade of the Polaris submarine base, due to begin at 6:00am the following day.

The blockade acheived as much as it could do with the number of people there (150 at any one time - people came and went during the 12 hours of blockading) and the bases operations were severely disrupted.

The civilian workers (the ones that clean the sailors boots) had been given a days paid holiday in anticipation of the action. Only the most determined construction workers went throug the blockade, as well as lots of sailors who looked like they'd rather drive over us instead of waiting for the police to clear a way.

The two most noticeable things about the 3 days we were there were what a wonderful Peace Camp Faslane is and what bastards the Strathclyd police are. I was determined not to get arreste (it's a long way to go for a fine for sitting in the road) so I stood by and watched people from all over England and Scotland getting dragged by their hair, sexually assaulted and flung into vans. Apparently English police say, of dealing with football crowds, "we should do it like the Glasgow lads - they don't mess about".

It was a joy to return periodically to the camp - it's really organised, cosy and friendly, and there was hot food continually on the go. Right through the night people worked to find where the 70 arrested had been taken, and vans were sent to pick them up from all over the Strathclyde area. In cases where addresses given were not satisfactory, people were held over and appeared in court the next day. It looked like a few would get remanded to begin with, but the judge was appeased and after a lengthy "goodbye" session outside the court everyone got packed off home safely..

bits of news from ... MOLESWORTH.

Early in September, a group from Nottingham went down to Molesworth to help with the Brave Defender exercise. They took down roadsigns to the base and redecorated the roads with lots and lots of slogans. A well-known member of Forest Fields Peace Group and the Labour Party, who also happens to be a landlord with a passion for evicting his temants, must be thanked for the brightly coloured paint he unwittingly supplied. Thank you, Mr. Aziz. The police were less helpful. They interrupted the road redecoration and arrested two people who had paint on their hands. These two women were strip-searched and held overnight for court the next morning. They were then released on bail on condition that they don't go within five miles of Molesworth or Alconbury. (Ha ha.) To make sure they don't go anywhere, the police kept their coats and wouldn't give them back - evidence, they claimed. Three weeks later, one of the women was in court. There, she was told that the amount of damage she'd caused was worth over £600. Meanwhile, the dog who'd come down with her non-violently resisted being dragged out of the building. The case was adjourned "so that justise could be seen to be done".

October 3rd was the date set for a High Court eviction attempt of the Peace Camp, which has been at Molesworth for years now. Campers there are worried that they too are being "zapped", like the women at Greenham. They have been experiencing headaches and general feelings of unwellness whilst near the base; these symptoms disappear when they walk away from the base; these symptoms disappear when they walk away from the base and return as they approach the perimeter. (Maybe now that it's happening to men too, people might start to take the sapping seriously.) Nobody knows how zapping is done, but it's a very threatening new way the state is trying to control us, and needs investigation. Meanwhile, Rainbow Warriors are planning to return to Molesworth.

Well-informed sources tell us that construction work inside the base will begin in November. The Wing Headquarters with two storeys above ground and four storeys below ground is planned. It is thought that the Missile Command Post is to be moved from Greenham. Nolesworth/Alconbury is more central and has no common lend, which is notorious for harbouring peace protestors, surrounding it. The courts' treatment of protestors at Alconbury and Molesworth supports this line of thought - first we have the Alconbury Nine trial and the Rainbow Fields eviction, now we have people being charged with heavy amounts for criminal damage. They are the kinds of amounts which will entitle protestors to crown court trials something that the police have always tried to avoid at Greenham, but at Molesworth they don't seem to give a shit. They very definitely want to scare people away.

Now that there is little doubt that the main construction work at Molesworth will begin in November, the Cruise Resistance Campaign have called for a blockade of the base 48 hours after work has begun. The details have not been finalised, but if you are interested in the action please contact Melisza, daytime 606302

CND-learning slowly

A hard lesson in realpolitic for those liberal optimists in CND - who think that lemming like martyrdom in the courts will eventually change the hearts and minds (and thus the decisions) of the magistracy - has now been served. Documents from Lord Hailsham reveal that all those wishing to become magistrates, will from now on be asked whether or not they're members of CND. This will prevent the embarressing situation of magistrates being nicked on demonstrations from recurring. Already two have had to leave the bench because of this. Kath Cripps, from Derby a magistrate for five years and Catherine Thackery, a magistrate in Huddersfield (nicked at Greenham), eleven years on the bench, were these two unfortuanates.

Famine gang's SAS

attack on food store

HOODED raiders have carried out an astonishing SAS-style assault - on a local food mountain!

The group — calling itself RAID AID — broke into a giant grain warehouse eight miles from Nottingham.

They sprayed slogans protecting about the Ethiopian famine before escaping with a sackful of wheat. And following the attack on 3.5 May night, a sample of the grain was delivered anonymously to the Trader — together with this exclusive picture. TSU

Also enclosed was a press state-ment which read:

"Raid Ald is protesting to show how ittle the Government cares about the needs of people when they can stock-pile grain to make money while pre-tending they are concerned about famine."

Tamine." Police were this week investigating the break in at the Midlands Storage depot in West Hallam where -- as the Trader revealed only last month --39,000 tonnes of grain is being hoarded. Warehouse manager Ter-ry Drummond said. "The whole thing is now in the hands of the police. It's a very emotive issue -- so I don't really want to com-ment. I'm just a warehouse keeper.

"Hypocrisy"

"But why these people should want to damage the building I don't know — it doesn't do any good."

A spokesman for Raid Aid said further samples of grain would be sent to MP's.

MP's. "We want to highlight the hyporisy of these food mountains," he added.

There were ten of us involved in the action, some of whome had watched the place before hand and sussed it out as best we could.

We went over the plans at about 2.30am. and after the queue for the bog disappeared we went on our way.

When we got there all was quiet, so we jumped out of the van and ran towards our target. Going in over the stream, we split into two groups, one to spray the front of the building with slogans and the other to get the grain. The van went away about a mile and we kept in touch by C.B.. Though we went equipped for World War 3, we needed nothing since they left a door open and there was even a ladder running up to the grain.

So, after a few 'photos and bags of grain, group one made it's way back. At the front photos were taken they joined the others. SEPTEMBER 4. 1985 the spraying was going well, after a few more

We called the driver and went our way home, back to the safety of our Radical Ghetto.

It went really smoothly and seemed too easy. We were expecting guards and dogs but saw no success, maybe there will be a few more actions NOTINGHAM MP's were left fuming this like it.

CERTAINLY WE WANTED TO BRING THE EXISTENCE OF THIS PARTICULAR GRAIN STORE, TO THE ATTENTION OF THE WIDER PUBLIC. AND, YES WE WERE MAKING PROTEST AT GOVERNMENT INDOLENCE IN THE FACE OF MASS STARVATION. BUT, KNOWLEDGE OF 'FOOD MOUNTAINS' IS COMMON ENOUGH, AND THE LACK OF ANY REAL SUSTAINED GOVERNMENT ASSISTENCE HAS ALREADY MET WITH WIDESPREAD OUTCRY AND CONDEMNATION.

WE WANTED TO DO SOMETHING MORE THAN THIS. FOR THE QUESTION I IS NOT SIMPLY ONE OF MORE GOVERNMENT ACTION. IT IS A FACT THAT ALL STATE AID IS A POLITICAL TOOL, AND THIS ISN'T MERELY IDLE LEFT-WING JARGON BUT IS ACCEPTED EVEN AMONGST THE RESPECTABLE CHARITIES. AID IS DIRECTED WHERE IT BEST SERVES THE INTERESTS OF THE DONOR - IT IS USED TO FURTHER POLITICAL, AND NOT HUMANITARIAN, ENDS.

O.K., SO IT IS TRUE THAT GOVERNMENT HERE AND OTHERS ELSE-WHERE IN THE INDUSTRIALISED WORLD, EAST AND WEST, HAVE DONE SHAMEFULLY LITTLE, AND WE SHOULDN'T CEASE IN GIVING THEM ALL THE FLAK AND SLAGGING THAT WE CAN.

BUT THIS IS NO STRATEGY FOR CHANGE IN ITSELF, AND E SHOULD BE NAIVE IF WE EVER WE THOUGHT IT COULD BE. IF STATE AID IS DESIGNED AND USED TO FURTHER POLITICAL AND STATE INTERESTS, THEN ALTHOUGH POPULAR PRESSURE MAY INDEED SUCCEED IN ALTER-ING THE FRINGES OF AID POLICY, IT CANNOT EVER POSSIBLY ALTER IT'S ESSENCE.

ONLY WHEN ORDINARY PEOPLE ARE IN CONTROL OF THIS EARTH'S NO! RESOURCES CAN WE HOPE FOR AN EGALITARIAN AND FAIR SHARE OUT, ACCORDING TO THE PRINCIPLES OF MUTUAL AID AND SOLIDARITY.

ISN'T THAT SOMEWHAT OPTIMISTIC AND UTOPIAN? I DON'T THINK SO. TAKE LIVE AID. THERE IS ONE THING THAT CAN BE DEFINATELY SAID% IN FAVOUR OF THAT PROJECT - IT SUCCEEDED LIKE NOTHING ELSE IN PUTTING THE QUESTION OF GOVERNMENT AID FIRMLY ON THE AGENDA. PEOPLE COULD NOT BUT BE MOVED BY THE FACTS, AND AWARE OF THE FACTS THEY HELPED (THO' IN THE ONLY WAY THEY KNEW HOW - BY GIVING CASH). AND OF COURSE THERE WAS THE ADDED BONUS OF BAD PRESS FOR THE GOVERNMENT IN THE PROCESS.





RIOTS SPREAD TO NOTTINGHAM


LATE ON SATURDAY NIGHT AFTER GOOSE FAIR HAD ENDED, ABOUT 100 YOUTH'S BROKE 18SHOP WINDOWS, LOOTED A HI FI SHOP AND SET A CAR ON FIRE IN THE AREA BETWEEN HYSON GREEN AND ILKESTON RD. THÈRE WERE NO ARRESTS DESPITE 700POLICE BEING ON DUTY IN THE AREA FOR GOOSE FAIR.

THIS HAD FOLLOWED A PERIOD OF ABOUT A WEEK WHEN RUMOURS OF PLANS FOR A RIOT HAD BEEN CIRCULATING, AS WELL AS REPORTS OF LARGE NUMBERS OF POLICE BEING PREPARED AND READY FOR A RIOT. TWO MOMEN WHO WERE IN HYSON GREEN ON WEDNESDAY NIGHT WERE TOLD BY A GANG OF MEN TO GET OFF THE STREETS BECAUSE THERE WAS GOING TO BE A RIOT.

THERE IS NO DOUBT THAT THIS RAMPAGE WAS A RESPONSE TO THE LARGER RIOTS TEARING AT BRITAIN'S CITIES, AND ALTHOUGH THERE WAS NO TRIGGEREING INCIDENTS BETWEEN PLOICE AND LOCAL PEOPLE WHICH WERE COMMON TO THE HANDSWORTH, BRIXTON AND TOTTENHAM HICTSOF THE PAST WEEKS, AND NO SPECIFIC REASON FOR NOTTINCHAM'S YOUTH TO LET LOOSE, THE GENERAL GRIVENCES THAT SHOULD RELEASE THIS ANGER WERE OBVIOUS. WHATEVER YOU THINK ABOUT THE MERITS OF SUCH VIOLENCE AS HAS BEEN SEEN IN LONDON, LIVERPOOL, BIRMINCHAM, NOTTINCHAM AND PROBABLY ALL OVER BRITAIN, WE MUST ALL AGREE THAT THE FAULT AND BLAME LIES WITH THE PRESENT POLITICAL, SOCIAL AND ECONMIC RECIME.

TELL US LIES ABOUT THE MINERS - DAVID DOUGLAS.

A fayourite pastime amongst lefties in the Carlton - 'Name that Issue' - consisted of the naming of issues arising out of the miner's strike, it starts "well, what interested me most about the miner's strike was..." Well here is one of the more obvious - the role of the Media.

The pamphlet provides a'glimpse of the monumental distortion by the media of the facts of our recent dispute'. In comparing these facts with the media coverage of them he opines that the media is a "manipulative tool of the ruling class". which of course directly contradicts its pretence to be independent and liberal

Coverage during the dispute was shot thru' with half truth and distortion. T.V commentators acted, not as impartial observers, but as advocates encouraging the split. Witness the unbalanced emphasis given to the 'Back To Work' movement, where "five new faces" makes headline news and is hailed as an indication of imminent collapse.

The presentation and the language used played a vital part in marginalising the Miners. "Pickets are thugs, a picket line is a mob. Scabs brave picket lines', tho' pickets never brave the police lines." Language reflects political values. So, when T.V. reportage was perceived as the reality, the common understanding of the dispute incorporated just those values and attitudes.

The dispute presented was as a caricature. The N.U.M. wanted a meal ticket, but the N.C.B. preferred to have an efficient public service. Which side would you be on ? From the start it was "Scargill's strike" and he became "a hate object - an identifiable enemy in an incomprehensible struggle. Everything becomes clear, there is not too much to think about, it is a dispute about personalities, not issues or% causes or sides or classes. An individual popularity poll with the media as the social clapometer."

In altering fact, playing down the effects of the dispute (eg. the faltering pound, the voltage reductions, the power cuts, the fact t that Notts production was 40% down despiteeit's 'working normally'), ignoring Maggies backhander to the Mines supply and retail industry to keep it quiet, in minimising the support from other workers and from the Rank and File of the N.U.M. itself (eg. the 60% Barnsley winders vote supposedly a "Revolt In Scargill's Ranks" was only 60% of a meeting of II, of whome only 2 temporarily crossed picket lines), in doing all this the media's mask was torn away and it's true purpose revealed...it waged a war of propaganda, on behalf of the Ruling Classes, against the mine workers.

There are Good Guys and there are Bad Guys. Consider Brenda Story. A wheelchair bound miner's wife, attacked by scabs. She was nearly strangled whilst her house was wrecked. One instance amongst many ignored by the media for not fitting in comfortably with their image of scabs as the Good Guys. And then the police. Bobbies facing hordes of deranged strikers in defense of all that we hold dear. Despite a Tribune dossier on police infiltration, despite the numerous reported cases of police violence and intimidation and despite the unprecedented rise in police powers: the independent liberal press raised few objections. Film of Gasgoine Wood (and more notably of Orgreave, shown during the recent riot trial) was purposefully altered to give the impression that it was the pickets who started the trouble and not the other way a around. And yet the undeniably partisan and political police force remains in the public eye ... 'Bobbies on the Beat'.

Too brief to really do the subject justice, it falls too easily into 'Conspiracy Theory'. The behaviour of the media then, and more recently the Real Lives case and the revalations of about the vetting that occurs within the B.B.C. could give a sound basis for that conclusion, the reality is, I fear, more complex. Nevertheless he does succinctly illustrate that bias. And this, he says, is something less commonly accepted than many on the left tend to assume. It leaves then with that recurring problem, requiring a great deal of thought - how do we develop our own alternative means of communication with the wider public.



NOTTINGHAM WOMEN AGAINST PIT CLOSURES: CAMPAIGN FOR COAL PUBLIC MEETING, 14th SEPTEMBER

If only the presence of the ubiquitous paper sellers were some indication of public interest. Alas, no. For despite all the effort that must have gone into organising this meeting, the hall remained all but empty. An unfortunate pity, it would have been well worth anybody's attending. Chaired by Gwen MacLeod, the speakers included Peter Heathfield, N.U.M. President, who gave an impressive address, local hack Paddy Tipping, Ann Suddick, National Chairperson of W.A.P.C., Edmond Derby, Safe Energy Campaign and someone - whose name I forget from N.U.P.E.

Three themes dominated - the effect on the local community of industrial closure, the future of coal and non-nuclear energy policy and unity within the National Union.

We heard of the decay and desolation that had been Corby's lot, despite Enterprise Zone Scheme investment of some 500 million pounds, since the Steel Plant closure in 1981. Worth bearing in mind; since Notts with it's "I'm alright Jack" attitude is less secure than some would think. Doubts were cast about the future of both Babbington and Bentinck. The N.C.B. employs 40,000 in this county, each mining job, so it was estimated, supports 3 others elsewhere. Job losses in the mining industry would not only have dire knock-on effects for. the other sectors of the local economy." But the loss of rate value would inevitably mean massive cutbacks in service provision.

The expansion of our coal industry, not only providing security for local communities, but for the next 200 years could be the safe alternative to nuclear development, which at present accounts for less than 20% of our energy production. Furthermore, it would release resources and give time for research into and development of alternative forms of energy, at the moment woefully neglected. With Combined Heating Schemes (where hot water from power stations is piped to estates, factories and schools, etc) and Community Heating Schemes (smaller with fewer ecological problems), energy conservation would be integral to a co-ordinated, efficient and cheaper system. But no: Government is hellbent on nuclear energy, and the motives, argued Edmond Derby, are political.

But, of course the grand theme, predictably was unity. Unity in the National Union. As Spencerism had been dashed by the 30's recession, so this latter-day version would face a similar fate. Though backing fully this call for unity, doubts have to be cast upon the argument given. The situation has changed so drastically since the 30's, when over 1 million worked in the pits. Is it not within the realms of possibility, that given the next recessionary downturn, the National Union and not the breakaway, could fall? One hopes not, but let us remember which are the areas giving strongest support to the National Union.

At the end of the day, two big criticisms. Firstly there was the inevitable rally call for a new Labour Government. Kinnock, undeniably opportunistic, slick and calculating, whose behaviour during the Strike was deplorable, would probably welcome weakened and less militant unions, the likely upshot of Thatcherism. (And N.B. his attitude to the recent T.U.C vote on sequestration and sacked miners). For they would be less troublesome for his corporate strategy. Perhaps they'd even accept the 'Incomes Policy' Labour leaders aren't going to implement, in return for some breathing space and their old room in Whitehall. The fixation of Farliamentary office stays, their definition of what constitutes political action remains as poor as ever. Secondly, we must criticise the way in which the work ethic still dominates the outlook of the T.U.s. 'Real jobs', '40-hour weeks' do give greater security it's true, but let us not forget that this is security through exploitation. Unions have to recognise the potentialities that exist now for approaching the issue of work in new ways. Their horizon requires more breadth, their imagination is in need of a dust-down.

It would have been good to have seen a few more Anarchists there. Aren't they in possession of broad horizons and dusted imaginations? Perhaps an impossible demand. You see, Unions are still "patriarchal bastions of hierarchy and workerism" aren't they (a mouthful of cliche that). And we can forget the miners, now that their struggle has taken a less immediately rebellious turn, and now that the hippies, closer to our hearts, are being trashed instead. And would we, believers in the leisure society, campaign for work? Never. That those suckers ultimately pay for our dolecheques and arts centres is brushed aside as an irrélevancy.



TO THE BASH THE RICH MARCH ON HAMPSTEAD MAINLY OUT OF CURIOSITY. ALTHOUGH I HAVE MET CLASS WARRERS AND READ THEIR PAPERS REGULARLY. INTERESTED TO SEE WHAT ONE OF THEIR EVENTS I WAS BE A GOOD IDEA TO BASH THE RICH, THEY'VE BEEN BASHING US FOR LONG ENOUGH.

Arrived in Hampstead in time for a wick pint before setting off for Chalk arm tube. There we were herded up to a aved area behind Primrose Hill station. fter a quick frisking we were allowed o stand and wait. The one W.P.C. that was searching women could not keep up and I got the impression that they veren't expecting any women. We waited for more people to turn up; so far only about 200 had arrived and we felt and were outnumbered by filth. I was uneasy, worried, bored as well and pissed off that if no-one else turned up it would have been a waste of time turning up in the first place.

A couple of fags later the numbers had swollen, things looked better. It was 3 o'clock, a superint. came forwards and told us it was time to start, we told him to piss off. Someone said we'd leave at 3-30 and the pigs sychronised their watches.Being "Revolutionary Anarchists" we took off at 3-15. Some more joined up as we went up Haverstock Hill towards Hampstead and looking back at the crowd I guessed that there were about 1,000 people there. There still seemed to be far too many filth about.

We marched and chanted.Filth were spaced a few feet apart and exchanged verbal abuse with us. There were a few arrests-don't know what for, I was at the front and they were picked out from the back.

After more chanting and marching we came across the thin blue line that was going to keep us out of Hampstead.

They sealed off Haverstock Hill just past Belsize Avenue. We stopped, we started, we faltered. They wanted us to go down the Avenue; we didn't want to go. We tried going forwards, people got nicked, we retired. They couldn't force us round the corner and we couldn't force our way anywhere. There was stalemate. Not that the filth minded they were happy to stand and watch. We started to get bored. No-one seemed sure what to do. By this time we were packed fairly close together and looked like about 500 people.

We tried half-hearted charges front and rear and at one point ended up charging in a circle. We moved to the back in the hope of breaking out of what was now a cordon around 3 sides of the crowd. No chance - the only way they'd let us go was left. People looked lost & unmotivated. At one point someone shouted 'All those who want to go left. shout "Left"'. Amazingly no-one shouted 'fuck off', lots of people shouted left. The filth wanted us to go left round in a circle and back to Chalk Farm tube, they'd said so when we were talking to them at the front. 'All those people that don't want to go left shout "No"' came the next instruction.I shouted no, not wanting the Left 'vote' (left wing?) to win. Noone knew which shout was louder- still no decision. Suddenly a few people at the front shouted left and we moved off down Belsize Ave.We moaned and marched on. Round the corner was rows



of flats and houses, exactly where we didn't want to be.We were in the middle now and a lot of people were bemoaning the left turn.

If we could have done, we should have abandoned the march and dispersed while we were waiting up on Haverstock Hill.Someone had suggested this after the charges had failed but it didn't get much response. Personally I much prefer not even being able to see a cop than abusing, spitting at, kicking or formation rucking with them(pointless exercises in bravado) and once it was obvious that we were going to be contained we should have tried to lose them. Even if it achieves nothing else at least then they don't know where 500 "Revolutionary Anarchists" are. If you can't march where you want what's the point in marching?Moreover, if you only march where THEY want you to, what's the point in marching? If you can't walk, run.

'Bash the Rich' had turned into ritual square bashing. Without realising it we walked into another diversion. People started turning left, a handful (perhaps 3) of filth prevented us from going straight on. Suddenly we saw a golden opportunity to leg it. We started shouting, people realised they could do it. I saw that a couple of people from the front who had turned the corner had managed to run off. By the time we got there the filth had run round and tried to seal it off. We limked arms and tried to push it. The crowd seemed hesitant. The filth started nicking people, trying to shit us up. They nicked me and another Notts comrade first so I don't know what happened after that. Not much, probably. We were sat in a transit about 30 yards in front of the crowd, in front of the control unit. After about 2 hour they transfered us to the Mobile Cells that were following the procession. Then we were taken to Albany Street police station. We were 2 or 3 to a cell,didn't look like many people got nicked.

We got out about 8 o'clock. They cautioned everyone except those nicked on more 'serious' charges (about 7 people, I think)



Class War is exciting! I'd love the chance to take out my frustration on a lone copper or a 'Hooray Henry'! Rioting is daring and fun! And radical! They've even got a regular, national paper so you don't suffer from those 'all alone against the rest of the world' blues. It's a brash rebellion that doesn't take shit from anybody (least of all the other meely-mouthed reformists within the **A** movement!)

I suppose the basic idea is that the more noise we make, the closer we are to revolution. Class War are certainly noisy, but seem to understand little about revolution.

Being ever critical of the amount of time the 'broad left' spends ripping itself to shreds, I'm not convinced of the constructive value of writing this piece. However Class War has the potential to drain the energy of very determined, thinking people involved with it, into angry but impotent and dangerous gestures, leaving them tired, disillusioed and probably in prison! It refuses to see how limited and short-sighted it is, and will rush around furiously before dropping down dead.

Class War remind me of an anarchist Boy Scouts. There is even a comparable hierarchy, with ample opportunity for the egos of the 'organisers' to be pushed dangerously to the fore (The state loves leaders)

To give them their due, they are organised and have a sense of purpose. The approach is to receignize the enemy and to go out and attack directly. They know the kind of world we live in is disgusting, but do they have any vision at all of how they would really like to live? Their approach is neither optimistic nor constructive. It is a cynical process that assumes that by destroying the rich and powerful you rid yourself of the problems of wealth and privilige, and every one not fighting on the same lines is the enemy.

This approach is also simplistic and naive, it aim itself at the symptoms of the established order. Hampstead? Henley? These are not the wheels of capitalism, they are simply how the rich show themselves off. To attack them is an important symbolic gesture, but Class War seem to beleive that by frightening the rich at play they are somehow making their overthrow more imminent. Do they really believe the powerful are scared of them? The rich despise and patronise the discontented poor. They will, at their most peeved, simply have us locked up if we make ourselves obvi obvious as individuals. It is important that they know how much we hate them, but we can't fight% them openly, on their terms. Class War also think that violence is fun. They tare macho thugs. Violence is disgusting and the lowest form of communication. In many cases it is unavoidable, the state takes most other rights of change and protest away from us. But to glorif glorify or enjoy it is to be like generals and politicians. Class War's attitude to violence is laughable in any case. Sticks and stones against the state?? If they're serious why aren't they di discussing workable strategies of armed conflict?


You can't beat the state by confronting it so blatantly, it will just crush you. To Class War the poor are baton fodder, as though rioting in Handsworth is going to change the system. Rioting killing police etc is a symbol of a desire to live differently to how you are being forced to. But if the state thought riots (in the form we know them here, 'ith people destroying their own communities) could acheive this change, it'd clamp down harder on them instead of dismissing them. (See South Africa. That isn't haphazard rioting, it's a conscious attempt at insurrection, by people who really understand the <u>structure</u> of state oppression)


Class War operate in a way that assumes that it is the first truly radical method. They show no knowledge or respect for the history of their own movement, as though a historical context is simply intelllectual bullshit. Class War didn't invent Anarchism and they're not the only organised anarchist resistance (even if they're trying to claim Stop The City as their brainchild). They talk about the poor, the working class, the downtrodden etc 'rising up' but arrogantly ignore a century of anarchist writing on the subject. Neither are they internationalist - not because they think struggles abroad are not important but because they seem to have a kind of fear of an 'intellectualization' they think goes hand in glove with writing about struggles outside their own field of experience. The kind of anti-Right wing confrontation they seek has and is being experienced world wide (like the Spanish Civil War, the Russian Revolution, Nicaragua etc. etc.) Class War appear to arrogantly ignore any lessons that can be learnt from what is our history just as much as it is the state's.

They continually equate left wing with right wing politics, somewhat insultingly to the people of N. Ireland and, El Salvador etc. even if the left in this country is mainly a middle class powertrip. It is a popular joke amongst British @s that left wing groups spend more time slagging each other of off than they do attacking the right. So how is a Class War joke about killing pacifists a construct -ive alternative to this.

I am not a pacifist myself but to conclude I will say I am not part of an anarchist movement that glorifies violence above the ends it can achieve. Class War are a phenomena I would rather ignore, but if their narrow minded, divisive male attitude -s are influencing more and more people, I feel they should be made to consider and respect the Anarchist movement, past and present, as a whole.

On Saturday 26th October the sheep will be out in re again. Yes, it's another CND demonstration. force again. This one, surprise surprise, will be centred at Hyde Park, and is planned to be a circular march linking the US and USSR embassies. Some of the features of this no doubt enthralling demonstration will be a 4 minute die-in, a 4 minute sit-down, a 4 minute vigil .. what tokenistic fun!

It is obvious that CND will not solve the problem of the world's nation-states possessing the power to destroy everything. It is tightly linked to a political party (the Labour Party) which is responsible for helping to arm this country, is only concerned with the symptoms of the disease rather than the disease itself (why are nuclear weapons stockpiled?), and is determined to maintain a 'respectable' image. Further-more, CND does not oppose conventional, bacteriological or chemical weapons - they all kill people too, don't they? Added to this is CND's belief in parliament (real democracy: 12 ticks a lifetime) and its refusal to recognise the everyday war that millions are fighting each day (poverty, racism, exploitation etc).

CND is nothing more than a middle class organisation that allows people to vent their justifiable anger without that anger doing any damage whatsoever to the It is time that people's anger did have a system. genuine impact - let's make October 26th a day for anger! There are many things that can be done; such as heckling of speakers (why should we quietly accept some fool telling us to vote Labour/join CND when we all know that it won't do any good?) and direct action Neither the US nor the USSR embassies should be left standing - passively saying "stop" will not worry them. And don't forget that all the cops will be concentrated at the CND demonstration, leaving the rest of London relatively unpoliced (eg the City of London?). We must actively demonstrate our anger. But we should not forget the importance of communicating with people (eg visual presence, leaflets, banners, papers etc).

Perhaps 26th October will be a bit more exciting than the typical CND demonstration . . . but it's up to all of us to ensure that this happens.

FRANKFURT : The crew of a Soviet tank lost on manoeu-vres in Czechoslovakia sold it to a pub owner for two cases of vodka, and were found sleeping it off in a forest two days later.

The tank could not be found. The authorities later learned that the pub owner had dismantled it and sold the pieces to a metal-recycling centre, the Frank-furter Allgemeine' Zeitung coid in its weekend edition. said in its weekend edition.

The incident was reported in an article by Ota Filip, a Czech emigré author at his home in Munich, he said the episode occurred during Warsaw Pact manoeuvres in the autumn of 1984.

Mr Filip's story, quoting a report by police in Bohemia, was that a four-man tank was that a four-man tank crew participating in ma-noeuvres got lost as darkness was falling in cold, rainy, foggy weather. The crew was running out of vodka, since rations had been cut as part of a government campaign against alcoholism.

At about nine in the eve-ning the tank drove into a village where the only pub was still open. The crew parked it in a shed behind the building and walked into the pub as the proprietor was about to close.

The crew had money for only one bottle of vodka, but at 11.15 was spotted leaving the pub with two cases and more than 6.6lb of herring and pickles.

The crew was found slum-bering in a forest two days later. The soldiers told local authorities and Soviet military police they did not know what had happened to the tank.

Ten days later the head of a metal-recycling centre said he had bought a large amount of high-quality, sawed-up steel from the pub lican. Investigators found the shell of the tank in the shed behind the pub.

The proprietor told the au-thorities he had acquired it for 24 bottles of vodka, with herring and pickles thrown in "as a gesture of comrade-ship." — AP.

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
A recent decision in the Court of Appeal has reinforced advice which Head Office has given parties for many years.

Posters advertising the British Union for the Abolition of Vivisection were flyposted on empty

shops in Derby. Derby Council prosecuted BUAV under the Town & Country Planning Act 1971 which allows a prosecution against the person or body benefiting from the advertisements, as well as the actual person sticking up the posters. Derby magistrates accepted BUAV's submission that they did not authorise the illegal bill sticking, had no knowledge of it, and did not agree with it.

Derby Council appealed, pointing out that they had written to BUAV'S head office, ordering them to remove the posters. BUAV's failure to do so made them liable to conviction, because flyposting was a 'continuing' offence in law.

Mr Justice Mann said there were good policy reasons why the offence should be construed as 'continuing'. It gives the local planning authority an opportunity to secure the removal of flyposted bills by those whose business is advertised rather than at the expense of the ratepayer. The Court of Appeal ordered Derby magistrates to reconsider the case.

THE LATEST ON THE SHADOWS PROJECT IS THAT EIGHT PEOPLE, WHO WERE ARRESTED ON AUGUST 6TH, HAVE NOW BEEN GIVEN SUMMONS TO APPEAR FOR A BIND-OVER. THE PEOPLE ARRESTED WERE PAINTING SHADOWS ON THE PAVEMENT TO POINT OUT THE REALITY OF HIROSHIMA AND STOCKPILED WEAPONS. IT WAS A GRIM REMINDER OF HIROSHIMA AND NAGASAKI, WHERE PEOPLE NEAR THE BLAST WERE VAPOURISED AND ALL THAT WAS LEFT WERE SHADOWS ON THE ROADS.

ELEVEN PEOPLE AND A DOG WERE HELD FOR UP TO FOURTEEN HOURS IN SHITTY CONDITIONS ON AUGUST OTH, THE POLICE WERE PHYSICALLY AND VERBALLY ABUSIVE, TWO PEOPLE WERE CHARGED WITH CRIMINAL DAMAGE, EVEN THOUGH THE PAINT USED WAS NON-PERMANENT (THIS CHARGE HAS NOW BEEN DROPPED) AND "BREACH OF THE PEACE".

IN ALL, TEN PEOPLE ARE NOW APPEARING IN COURT. ONE PERSON HAS NOT BEEN SUMMONSED.

PEOPLE WERE SO PISSED OFF WITH WHAT HAPPENED AT THE POLICE STATION THAT A DOSSIER OF PEOPLES EXPERIENCES WAS GOT TOGETHER. THIS WAS SENT TO LOTS OF PEOPLE, INCLUDING THE MEDIA. AN OFFICIAL COMPLAINT ABOUT THE TREATMENT ONE WOMAN AND THE DOG RECEIVED WAS MADE.

THE POLICE TOOK THE DOSSIER SERIOUSLY, AS AN OFFICIAL COMPLAINT, AND SENT IT TO THE POLICE COMPLAINTS AUTHORITY IN LONDON. "MINOR" INCIDENTS ARE USUALLY DEALT WITH LOCALLY.

THIS ALL GOES TO PROVE THAT YOU CAN'T MAKE A COMPLAINT AGAINST THE POLICE AND NOT GET ANY HASSLE. (JACKIE BERKLEY'S COMPLAINT WAS A HORRIFIC EXAMPLE.) THE SUMMONS WERE ISSUED JUST OVER A WEEK AFTER THE DOSSIER WAS RELEASED TO THE MEDIA AND FIVE WEEKS AFTER THE ARRESTS.

HISTORY IS A DRUG.

History is a number of other things too, but history is a drug, addictive in most cases. Physical damage is limited except for the odd case of scholar's silicosis caused by too much blowing dust off ancient books. The real damage is intellectual. The subject

would rather live in the past than change the present. The symtoms are obvious: the retreat into womb-like book lined rooms; the necrophiliac delight in skeletons in cupboards; the preference for the finished perfection of the

dead and gone. I know all this because I've done many lines of history. When I started to write my book on the British Anarchist Movement in 1974 it was already obvious that the high tide from student revolution (1968) to miner's strike (1972) had slipped back and the institutions had re-established themselves. Everyone had explanations but nobody knew why.

So, I retreated from the area of agitation to the area of cogitation. I went back to my poli-tical roots and made a new world for myself. But understand: I didn't invent a damn thing. Every statement of fact has a source. Every opinion of mine of these facts is clearly stated to be an opinion. But I chose what was important. I still believe my choices to be right But it is I still believe my choices to be right. But it is my version.

my version. The "real" world of the time may be guessed at from any reading of the newspapers, of the magazines, the books, the letters, the accounts of trials that survive the period. On the same page as an anarchist trial are accounts of strikes, suicides and society divorces. Gold is discovered in one place, some missionary disappears in another.



Lesson 3. Radical communities, no matter how ghettoised, are a source of strength and creativity. Protect them as best you can.

Lesson 4. Whatever we take from history we owe it nothing.


Sunday, it rained. We got wet. We packed up, cleared off, and caught a bus back to town, where one happy camper nearly knocked himself unconscious falling off the bus.
