





FOLLOWING ON FROM A WORKSHOP ON VIOLENCE IN MEDICAL PRACTICE AT THE RECENT LEEDS CONFERENCE, THERE WAS A GREAT DEAL OF INTEREST EXPRESSED IN EXPLORING THIS SUBJECT FURTHER. THE GREAT DEAL OF WORK HAS BEEN GOING ON SINCE NOV. AND AS A RESULT A NATIONAL CONFERENCE WILL BE HELD ON THE WEEK-END OF TAPRIL 11TH-12TH 1981 AT COTTESHORE SCHOOL, DERBY RD, NOTTINGHAM. THIS CONFERENCE WILL EXAMINE AND CONFRONT THE WAYS IN WHICH THE MEDICAL, 4 PSYCHIATRIC PROFESSIONS ABUSE WONBEN, AND WHAT DO WE SEE AS BEING THE ALTERNATIVE WE WOULD BE GRATEFUL TO HEAR FROM ANY WONBAN WHO HAS PAPERS OR IN FORHATION ON THE SUBJECT EVER THU SHE HAY NOT BE ABLE TO COME TO THE CONFERENCE ITSELF.
