

On getting caught, don't get caught, plan things, prepare yourself for the worst, can you handle it? - seriously, it's not your fault if you can't - don't pressured into something that could send you down if two or three years inside will break you far more. And if you are prepared for it - do something useful. I'd be pretty pissed off being in jail for something silly or ineffective, I'd rather do nothing for a year, do some thing well planned and useful, than getting nicked every week for smashing windows when pissed out of my head. And remember, if you're not into it for some ego boost, there's no point in bragging about it, so why bother telling anyone? It sounds obvious, but it does happen.

Claiming letters are likely to get you or other activists caught or framed up and often it's obvious why something's been done, and it's really the damage that counts anyway.

It's hard putting some sort of conclusion to all this. 

stop Police Repression

This review of public order has come at a time when we see the police becoming more amd more repressive: the police attacks on miners' pickets at Orgreave,

on the peace convoy at Stonehenge, on students at M/cr University protesting about the visit of Leon Brittan, and on hunt saboteurs using direct action to stop bloodsports. Also during 1985 we saw a number of riots in inner cities which were an obvious response to police provocation.

During the trial and acquittal of those miners charged as a result of the police riot at Orgreave, the existence of a secret manual which includes instructions on how to 'incapdemonstrators acitate' revealed. This was drawn up jointly by the Assoc. of Chief Police Officers and the Home Office. Thus the increasingly repressive nature of policing is sanctioned by the highest levels of government and it is clear that senior police officers have re-written the law and are acting upon it.

Thus the public order proposals must be seen as being in conjunction with recent police practices and it can be pointed out that the law is following the lead given by the police, rather than vice-versa. The idea is to extend the existing concept of 'public order' which originally covered fascist violence and intimidation in the

1930's to cover the concept of acceptable behaviour. Everything from trade union demos to football hooliganism are lumped together by these proposals thus tarring political activists with the same brush as those who get a kick out of mindless violence.

IF THE Government's public order proposals become law, basic freedoms won in the last century to assemble, to march and to act in solidarity (to picket) - will be swept away.

Marches and Demonstrations

You could be arrested for:

* organising a demonstration without police permission;
* taking part in a demonstration which has been banned;
* ignoring police conditions, for example, laying down the route;
* ignoring police directions during a demonstration.

Spontaneous demonstrations will become illegal.

Pickets and Rallies

* Static demonstrations and pickets will be allowed only on condi-

tions set by the police - for example, location, size and duration.

* The police will be able to limit the size of any static demonstration, and say where it should take place, and how long it can last They could do this whether the demonstration was at a factory. shop, embassy, etc.

New Offences

* Ancient Common Law offences like riot will become statutory. making it much easier to get convictions in court.

* The scope of 'breach of the peace' will be widened.

* Organisers of demonstrations where police conditions had been breached would be liable to pay the cost of policing.

There will be no freedom to assemble, march or picket except on

terms controlled and dictated by the police - THAT IS NO FREEDOM AT ALL

When combined with the current para-military tactics of the police to break up demonstrations, THE NEW POWERS WILL MEAN AN END TO THE FREEDOM TO PROTEST.

On saturday 25th January this year there was a march against police repression in London intended as a show of strength against the new Public Order Bill. The turn-out was ridiculously poor: less than 500 people protesting about a bill that will affect a hell of alot more of us.


Fears that the march would be chaotic due to a decision to have no official stewards and

not to collaborate with the cops were unfounded: the march was orderly and well organised, first aid, a creche etc were available and solicitors and contingency plans were laid on. There was total overkill by the cops who turned out in force to smash the demo: 30 people were arrested shortly before the march reached Stoke Newington cop shop, when cops started laying into people who objected to being pushed around.

The march failed in its objectives because of apathy narrow-mindedness: too many people were prepared only to come along on the day and boost their already bloated egos whilst not working to make the demo bigger; too many of the groups were content to tell others to attend and not to go themselves. There is another march in London in the near future ... those wishing to take part should contact CAPR at the address below. If we do nothing now, but sit around waiting for the Public Order Bill to become law, we will have noone to blame but ourselves when we're on the receiving end of the sentences: when the long and shitty arm of the state gets even longer and shittier, and we lose what few rights we still have left,* there will be no point sitting and moaning about it. Despite the almost total media blackout imposed by the South African government, we still see many pictures on our TVs of the suffering of the black majority under apartheid. I feel' the urge to express my solidarity with those oppressed by Botha's fascist government, and want to do what I can to support their struggle... but I know that the traditional channels of protest open to me (marches, writing to MPs, joining the Anti Apartheid Movement), are at best only symbolic.

So what can we do? I am happy to say, quite alot. Firstly, we can refuse to buy South African produce, or use those shops,

businesses etc that are either South African or profit from apartheid. For a list of some of these companies, write to SMAG (see address elsewhere), with an SAE. Secondly, we can attack supermarkets selling SA products: these can be picketed or have their trade disrupted by filling trolleys with SA goods, having them cashed up, then refusing to pay for them, whilst letting shoppers and workers know what's going on and urging them to join the boycott. Another way of hitting supermarkets is to produce a leaflet on the lines of the one below which was used on the last M/cr SBAU demo. Finally, dare I say it, many apartheid-mongers' premises are screaming 'abuse me!' at Barclays, for example, have lovely walls, windows and cashpoints and what a shame if some paint, bricks, mollies etc just happen to find their way to such a deserving target ... Have fun!!!

PORN = POWER = PAIN

What most men say about porn: "It's only abit of fun isn't it" "women don't really mind it. If they did they wouldn't be in the photos would they?" "People who are anti porn are

anti sex, hung up and prudish."

We are often told that porn is on open display in newsagents, cinemas and bookshops because we live in a free society. If we don't like it, we don't have to buy it. Some people even claim that our exposure to porn has given us more sexual freedom, and we are now less inhibited about our sexuality. These are some of the myths which pornographers use to multi-million their justify pound empire. The truth is

rather different: PORN DEGRADES AND ENSLAVES. Pornography is just another medium used by men to oppress women: porn treats women as passive objects, always available to pander to male sexist fantasies: porn tells us how to define our own sexuality, it distorts us and trivialises sex; porn turns sex into big business - men fork out millions to see women cast in roles which deny them any freedom.

Hard-core porn may be restricted to a minority of men, obtainable only in specialised bookshops and cinema clubs, but soft porn turns up in every major newsagents. It's on sale because men want it. We're told it's pretty harmless. But

soft porn mags and the shops I that stock them are both part of the same industry. They both share responsibility for giving women a secondary role in society, encouraging men to use sex as a power tool, a means of manipulation.

So to all you anarchists and others who think that opposing porn is some kind of denial of freedom, you're talking shit, supporting one of the most basic forms of exploitation out, WISE UP OR FUCK OFF!!!

Most people in this country have never heard of anarchosyndicalism. On the other hand, there are many who call themselves anarchists but slag anarcho-syndicalism off as"it's boring" or "we should be opposed to large scale industry because it's bad for the environment, and most of what is produced is shit anyway".

Well, first of all, for the benefit of those who don't know what it means, anarcho- syndicalism is the theory and practice of reorganising society by building a labour movement based on class struggle, a labour movement committed to the idea of workers' self management of society. Anarchosyndicalists are anarchists ie. opposed to domination and hierarchy (men oppressing women, boss oppressing worker, teacher/pupil, ruler/ruled etc) and aim towards a society without government, bosses, or any other form of hierarchy. Naturally this necessitates the abolition of Capitalism and the state in all its forms. The state is our political enslavement, Capitalism, and both need to be smashed if we are ever to be free.

Anarcho-syndicalism is a strategy to change existing society to the kind of society all genuine anarchists want, a society in which everyone is free and equal. Our strategy is to try and get ordinary people to take control of their own lives, and as most people work in factories, offices and

other workplaces we advocate workers' control. Direct action in the workplace is the most powerful means of disrupting the system because it hits the bosses' profits and worries the state. Of course, this can be backed up by resistance in the 12 communities - from support groups to rioting to squatting. But it's important to link up various forms of resistance, otherwise it's ineffective. It is important to work towards workers' control otherwise the

struggle is negative. This can only be brought about by the workers themselves, not by political parties. Syndicalism is a method of struggle that has workers' control as its aim. It is a form of revolutionary unionism that rejects the traditional trade union bureaucracies and hierarchies and also the idea of government. It is based on workers direct action against the bosses and the state, uncompromising class struggle. Such non-hierarchical workers organisations (syndicates) would be interlinked federally and would form an organisational basis from which to reconstruct society after the revolution.

Only when the workers are in control of society are they in a position to change things. The problems of pollution, environmental destruction, the mis-use of resources and Capitalist chaos generally cannot be solved by refusing to have any thing to do with the industrial system and ignoring those work ers struggling against their employers. Dropping out into a lifestyle counter-culture and eating brown rice/smoking pot isn't going to change anything. Only a mass working class movement can challenge the power of the state and Capitalism.

When workers are running industry in the interests of society then they will no longer wreck the environment, nor will they put up with tedious and boring working conditions. Industry will be reorganised to make work pleasant - this can be done by a combination of breaking it down into smaller

and more manageable units and the use of labour-saving technology, used for making life easier not increasing profits as under the old system.

So, we do not want to preserve the existing methods of production, we want to change them. But it can only be changed through workers' control. We don't want to preserve the wage system or the commodity market either - we want the free exchange of goods and Useless articles services. would not be produced because the profit motive (heavily dependent on advertising) would no longer exist. That is not to say that only bare necessities would be produced - anything that people wanted could be too. Because of the ridiculous way that Capitalism works (millions working in offices and banks, shuffling paper advertising, sales/marketing, legal professions, militarism etc.) many people would be released from their old socially useless jobs and would be available for useful work. This combined with the use of technology to eliminate many shitty jobs, would mean that the average working week could be reduced to less than 20 hours leaving people with much more time to pursue artistic or recreational activities. is not an idle dream, it is all possible in a sensibly organised society, run by the people for the people.

So, all that remains to be said is "get out of your ghettos" and let's make our dream a

"The truth about the man who fought his way from poverty, cared passionately for his pupils, and had his career destroyed because he dared to speak out about race problems in the classroom". This was the introduction to an article in the Daily Mail where a double paged interview with Honeyford was presented. The idea they put forward, along with the rest of the media, was that Honeyford is a darling of moderation who has been sadistically victimised by left-wing extremists. Obviously people on the left were involved in the campaign against Honeyford but his supporters go over the top in their efforts to distort what really happened.

They imply Honeyford is typically average while with in the Mail article he said, "my younger son has great trouble getting a job. I'm very critical of him. I say to him 'there's a solution, go to a shop, a factory, and say I'll do anything you want for three months without pay.' "

The major issue presented for debate was whether or not Honeyford was a racist, rather than should a racist teaching mainly Asians be ousted. To avoid jumping to conclusions, it would help to know what the man had said. This is impossible if you rely solely on TV news.

In the Daily Mail interview he says," When you get ranting savages outside your window it is frightening" referring to the picketers, and when a meeting of some Asian parents broke down, he said they displayed "the hysterical! political temperement of the

indian sub-continent", whilst not divulging the actions he may have taken to stimulate such a response.

While the media soften bigotry to strong-mindedness, most of the evidence shows Honeyford is a racist for even the most sceptical while to the more sensitive, it screams that he is a racist. Nonetheless attempts to remove him were strongly resisted in the higher channels of hierarchy. A committee set up to investigate the affair made 37 recommendations. He was offered £100,000 in pension rights and salary to retire early but instead he demanded £250,000 based on his present salary for the rest of his

working life. Then Honeyford was given a six week probation period after which a schools subcommittee gave him a vote of no confi dence and had him suspended. This upset many on the council who called on the government to intervene and set up an independent enquiry. Then a meeting of Bradford headmasters/ mistresses was held in April 85 and they decided to reinstate him. However when 7 race training officers signed a memo to a city personell officer claiming Honeyford was a known

Asian) certainly believed he was unsuitable to teach their children and felt strongly enough to stick their necks out and demonstrate publicly, despite the fack that Asian communities especially in areas like Bradford bear the brunt of racial hatred in this country.

After sustained direct action (pickets) the parents have got results. Someone they felt was racist and unsuitable was ordained to teach their children. Happily he no longer does.

He is not short of money as a result though. He got a by off of £160,000 from the council and is already reaping in the benefits of the limelight with payments for the aforementioned interview with the Daily Mail. A book of the incident may soon appear and if he's wanting to go into politics, noises from up high say that a safe Tory seat could be found for him. If not he could always crawl into an advisory post eg. at the Adam Smith Institute He's advised Thatcher before on educational issues.

It seems that the FBI Leonard Peltier agents were part of a coordinated action for there were numerous other agents in the Leavenworth area, leading to 200 of them Kansas 66048 being at the scene of the shootout within two hours. It seems no coincidence that at the same time in Washington DC pro-govt Kansas City Indians from Pine Ridge were negotiating away 133,000 acres _. of Lakota land. The govt indicted 4 Indians for the killings: charges were dropped against one and two were found not guilty. This left Leonard Peltier to stand trial. Statements were coerced from Myrtle Poor Bear implicating Leonard. She was told in not so many words that if she didn't sign a statement she would be killed. The judge, when the case came to court, refused to allow her to bring this up.



Silentnight PLC made a profit of £2.831 million in the year upto February 1985, and also has reserves of £17.612 million. In spite of all this the com-

pany laid off 88 workers at the Sutton and Barnoldswick in December 1984, and a further 52 two months later. In the process they broke an agree—ment whereby the workers would postpone a pay rise in return for no more redundancies. It was this that provoked the strike action when the management refused to grant the payrise.

This was merely the latest in a series of redundancies over the five years from 1980 which cut the workforce in all Silentnight factories by about 20%, whilst the turnover increased from £64 million to £79 million. Thus the workers were being forced to work harder in return for less job security. As a reward the management callously cheated them out of an agreed payrise, and then equally callously sacked over 500 workers that went on strike.

Tom Clarke (aka Mr Wonderful, as Thatcher calls him - Mr Shithead would be more appropriate) the company chairman, blamed the redundancies on retailers who buy the cheapest beds, squeezing the manufacturers profits. But while the poor become poorer, the rich have to accept no such cuts in income - dividends paid to Silentnight shareholders in 1985 remained the same as in 1984. It is clear that when the already over-inflated incomes of the rich are threatened by falling profits, it's the working class that has to suffer. It is not very surprising to find that Tom Clarke and his family control 51.99% of Silentnight shares. These parasites will grab as much money as they can causing ordinary working people to lose their livelihoods. This is yet another example of the injustice built into the Capitalist system, a system which the working class must overthrow before we achieve our own liberation and establish a truly just and equal society where production is for need and not profit.
