VIETNAM - The warning of Ban Thach

On August 22nd and 23rd, American bombers attacked and destroyed a hydro-electric plant at Ban Thach, 80 miles from Hanoi.

This represents a further and significant escalation in American strategy. It is the first target of this type that has been attacked in North Vietnam.

If the Americans bomb the Red River delta dykes, upon which the country's rice crop depends, (and it is widely reported that this is under consideration) millions of peasants will die from drowning, famine and disease.

In 1946 the former Nazi ruler of the Netherlands, Dr. Seyss-Inquart, was hanged at Nuremburg for war crimes, including the deliberate flooding of areas in Holland!

VIETNAM concerns YOU.

Britain was a co-chairman at the 1954 Geneva Conference, which imposed a ban on the introduction of foreign troops in Vietnam. Mr. Wilson's blatant support of American policy is in direct contravention of the Geneva Agreement.

Your action is required to prevent further escalation towards the bombibg of the dykes.

You can protest to your MP and write to Mr.Wilson, urging them to disassociate the British Government from the American action, and to call for an American withdrawal - the first step towards ending this needless slaughter.

VIETNAM - The Americans' Dirty War

More than 100,000 American troops are now involved in Vietnam.

Over 160,000 Vietnamese are dead.

This includes thousands of peasants - farmers, women and children, victims of napalm and other monstrous perversions of modern technology.

American intervention, we are told, is in support of the South Vietnamese Government against the action of the National Liberation Front (Viet Comg) who are assisted by North Vietnam.

Encouraged by the U.S.A., the tyrannical Diem regime and the military governments which followed have consistently violated the terms of the 1954 Geneva Conference by refusing to hold free elections in fear of a communist victory.

It is evident that the U.S.A. in its fanatical fear of communism is prepared to exterminate the Vietnamese people rather than allow them to determine their own future.
