



Some Government MPs are putting pressure on Prime Minister David Lange to change the way Security Intelligence Service interception warrants are used.

Labour came to power with an open government policy which promised, among other things, to repeal the parts of the New Zealand Security Intelligence Act which had the Prime Minister rather than a High Court judge issuing interception warrants.

Mr Lange now refuses to discuss the matter.

His only comment was written across a list of questions on the subject which had been given to him: "I do not intend to comment on these matters again. All have been covered previously".

The civil liberties section of the open government policy says that "Labour will repeal those portions of the New Zealand Security Intelligence Act which authorise the Prime Minister — rather than a High Court judge — to issue an interception warrant".

Now the Labour caucus justice sub-committee is pushing for the change to be brought in.

Mr Lange met the subcommittee on July 24, and the issue has been put on the Government caucus agenda.

Subjects put on the caucus agenda move slowly up, and caucus simply hasn't reached the SIS question yet.

The caucus sub-committee is chaired by Eden MP Richard Northey, and its membership includes left-winger Helen Clark, MP for Mt Albert.

Mr Northey said that the impetus for a change to the issue of interception warrants came from the subcommittee.

Progress

He said that "before the next election you would want to see some progress on it", and that Mr Lange did not "see any particular problem" with having the warrants issued by a judge.

Just when the change will come though is uncertain. Sources say some members of the sub-committee "are in a hurry" to have the law changed.

They see the measure in the manifesto and are asking why the change has not been made.

But Mr Lange is said to want to wait for quite some time before making a change.

"Given a second term he might be relaxed enough for it," said one Government MP.

Labour would like to en-

sure that the SIS is strictly an anti-terrorist organisation, and before the end of the year New Zealand will have been visited by the Pope, Indian leader Rajiv Ghandi and Israeli Prime Minister, Shimon Peres.

All three are prime targets for assassins, and the visits will be an oppor-

tunity to monitor the effectiveness of the SIS.

It would give Mr Lange, the Minister in Charge of the Security Intelligence Service, time to assure himself that he is happy with the SIS as it is.

It is also not definite, if a change does come, that the job of issuing warrants would go to High Court

Caucus might want a higher authority, and give the task to Court of Appeal judges, or have the issue of warrants subject to endorsement by both the Minister in charge of the service and a Court of Appeal judge.



The latest in the non-sexist language list

A group concerned about women's rights is urging writers to rid their prose of sexist stereotypes by refraining from such words as "kingpin", "weatherman" and "coed".

A four-page "guide to non-sexist language" from the project on the status and education of women provides a long list of dos and don'ts for the nondiscriminating writer.

The project, run by the Association of American Colleges, advises authors, "breaking away from sexist language and traditional patterns can refresh your style".

"With a little thought, you can use accurate, live-

ly, figurative language in your classrooms (and) publications . . . and still represent people fairly," it

The project offers general rules for non-sexist usage, such as using plural nouns and pronouns, alternating male and female pronouns or using them both in a text, such as, "to the best of her or his ability"

Its forbidden list, (and suggested substitutes), in-


Businessman (executive), cameraman (photographer), craftsman (craftsperson or artisan), draftsman (drafter), fireman (firefighter), headmaster (principal), kingpin (key person or leader), manmade (manufactured or handmade), night watchman (night guard), policeman (police officer), salesman

(salesperson or sales agent), sportsmanship (fair play), statesmanship (diplomacy), weatherman (weather reporter or meteorologist).

It frowns on such words or phrases as: male nurse, authoress, aviatrix, coed, maid and waitress. In their place, it offers such unisex substitutes as: nurse, author, aviator, student, housekeeper and waiter or "wait person".

In the project's book, there should be no mention of the "founding fathers", and no one ever went on a "maiden voyage". Instead, children should learn about the "pioneers, colonists, patriots, forebears (or) founders", and ships go on a first or premiere voyage.

"Man-to-man defence" also draws a flag from the project. It suggests "one-to-one" or "player-to-player" as substitutes.



















Judge Callander's patience was no doubt sorely tried by the laughter of the group and the whole incident.



Blast kills punk

Computer centre shattered

Police believe a tattooed punk rocker died when the bomb he was trying to plant at the Wanganui computer centre exploded early today.

The bomber, believed to be about 20, died instantly.

Parts of his body were scattered up to 65 metres away by the blast, which destroyed the armoured glass main doors of the centre.

Police have not yet identified the man, but say his facial features are distinct and among the remains they have an intact finger.

Among the debris scattered for some 30 metres by the blast, police found a red waterproof carryall with the remains of a detonator and a battery pack. Police say this suggests the bomb was electrically set.

Detective Senior Sergeant Rob Butler said police believed the man arrived in Wanganui by bus yesterday. They had been told a young man dressed like a punk rocker had boarded a bus saying: "I'm going to Wanganui to do something frightful."

Sergeant Butler said freshly painted grafitti had been found in a public toilet opposite the computer centre. It

was believed to have been painted by

The grafitti reads: "We have maintained a silence closely resembling stupidity." This was followed by an anarchist sign and the words: "Anarchy peace thinking."

The message was all in large capital lettering and written in black paint from an aerosol can.

A black paint aerosol was found among the debris outside the centre after the blast.

Mr Butler said a fresh tattoo on the upper part of the man's chest said: "This punk won't see 23. No future."

Police were today trying to establish a motive for the bombing, to identify the dead man and to find out if anyone else was involved in the venture, said Mr Butler.

The type of explosive used has not yet been determined.

The bomber was wearing a souwester, a light cap and a fawn showerproof overcoat over dark trousers, and tramping boots with steel caps. He had a dog-collar choker round his neck.

The force of the blast shattered the armoured glass doors at the main entrance of the centre and windows in a nearby veterinary clinic.

Two security guards inside the centre who were standing 4m away from the blast were blown off their

One of the guards told police he saw the man approach the entrance and bend down. As the guard reached to activate a remote speaker in the foyer and ask him what he was doing, there was a flash and an explosion.

A policewoman who saw the man in Wangamii two weeks ago said she particularly remembered him because he was wearing safety pins with razor blades attached in his ears.

No ears were found among the remains today.

Police superintendent Bryan Dean said he had never before seen a body so mangled.

Mr Butler said police knew the identity of punk associates of the man where the bus originated from last night. He would not name the town.

In Auckland today tattooist Mr Merv O'Connor said it was possible he had tattooed the blast victim. Mr O'Connor said he had tattooed similar wording on a dozen punk rockers.

The chairman of the State Services Commission, Dr Mervyn Probine, said extra security precautions had been taken at key Government installations.

He added that even had the Wanganui centre been destroyed, there were contingency plans which would enable the system to be operating again in a matter of days. Duplicate computer records were held elsewhere. The Minister of Police, Mr Couch, said inexperience probably caused the death of the bomber.

He said the death could have been a

case of suicide or a case of inexperience ... "I believe it's inexperience that caused his death."


A State Services Commission spokesman said the Wanganui Centre was designed to resist a blast similar to the one that occurred this morning.


The commission's computer services division assistant general manager, Mr Bill Whittet, said the design may have saved the life of two security guards who were just metres away when the explosion occurred.

Although the main armoured glass doors were shattered by the blast and the guards blown off their feet, the armoured glass around their cubicle in the fover was underwaged

Mr Whittet said all but essential staff needed to keep the computer centre running had been asked to stay home today "to keep them out of the way of the police and Ministry of Works staff who are rebuilding the foyer of the building.

Today's blast was the first incident at the controversial computer centre since a petrol bomb was thrown at the building prior to the Springbok game in Wanganui last winter. The cocktail did not go off and only burnt a shrub. NEIL ROBERTS 18 NOVEMBER '82 WANGANUI, NZ.

A VICTIM OF NEW ZEALAND'S ABSURD CENSORSHIP LAWS



am 44 years of age, a N.Z. citizen. I am a qualified accountant (A.C.A.) and a member of the N.Z. Society of Accountants. I am a law-abiding citizen. I have never been convicted

of any crime. In fact I have never been inside a court. I have one instant fine for exceeding the speed limit and perhaps two or three fines for parking offences.

I have a personal interest in erotic material which affects no one else as I do not pass any such material on to others. I believe that, at my age, I should certainly have the maturity to deal responsibly with such material.

Given the foregoing, I was severely shocked by an incident which occured late last year. I still find it hard to believe that, in New Zealand, a government department has such wide powers—and can employ such terrifying tactics—in relation to the suspected importation of erotic material, especially when this material, being a single video cassette, was obviously for my own personal use and not for supply.

At approximately 6pm, shortly after I had arrived home, 3 customs officers arrived on my doorstep and said they wished to discuss a Kings Cross newsletter addressed to me which had been intercepted in the post.

I arranged for my wife to take my children to another part of the house.

Then they explained that they had intercepted an empty video container and

that they believed the tape itself had been sent separately at an earlier date. A search warrant was waved at me and I was told that if I did not present them with the tape they would carry out a search of my house there and then.

To my questions regarding what my rights were and what the implications might be, they were very evasive.

Obviously, I wished to avoid a search being carried out in the presence of my children, so I agreed to furnish them with the tape. When I went to get it, I was accompanied by one of the officers who wanted to check to see if I had any other tapes as well.

I was then asked to provide a written statement. It was implied that they would not leave the house until they had this. At this stage they had been in my house for almost two hours and we had still not prepared our evening meal. I wanted them out. I gave them a statement, much to the later distress of my lawyer.

I feel that in such a climate, any New Zealand citizen must hold a grave concern for his or her civil rights — to say nothing of the waste of taxpayers' money used to employ three senior customs officers at overtime rates to track down what could only be an isolated misdemeanour.


