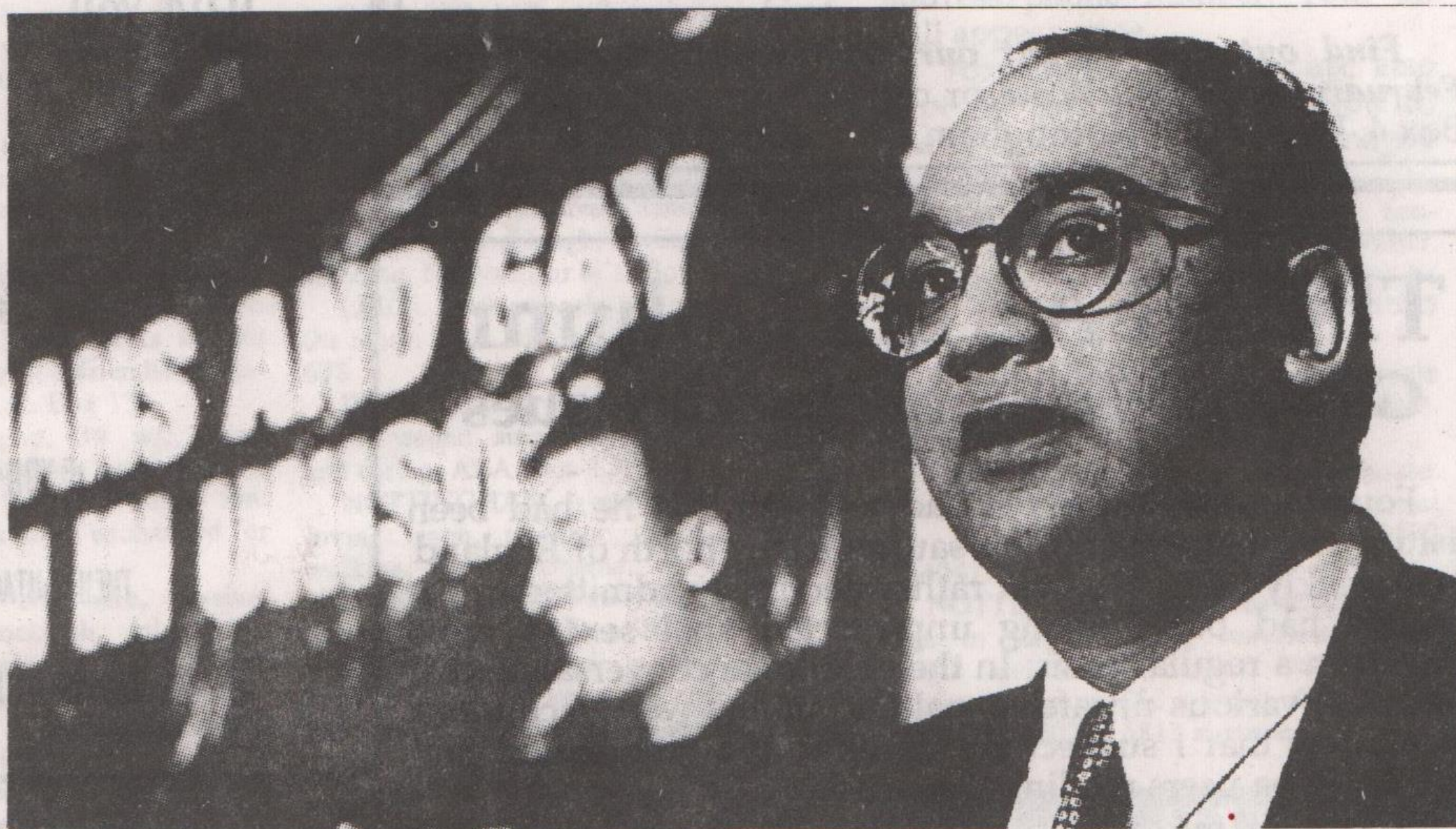

LABOUR BACKS LESBIAN & GAY LAW REFORMS

The Next Labour government will dismantle discrimination against lesbians and gay men, Leicester East MP Keith Vaz told delegates at the second annual Lesbian & Gay conference of the public service union, UNISON in Glasgow last year. Over 600 lesbian and gay delegates heard the chair of the UNISON group of MPs promise a package of reforms from a Labour administration led by Tony Blair.

Section 28, which limits local authority support for lesbian and gay tax-payers, will be repealed within the first year.

Lesbians and gay men will get the right to pass on their pensions to their partners, soldiers will no longer be hounded out of the military because of their sexuality and anti-gay indecency laws will be revoked. (Continued on page 3)



SHEFFIELD CHURCH 'LYNCHES' PREACHER

A young Sheffield trainee minister has been forced to resign following a sustained campaign against him by officials of the Wesleyan Reform Church. Paul Webb (pictured below) aged 23, is the victim of a witch hunt against gays within the church. He was asked to resign when his pastor, David Armstrong found out that he was gay.

Paul has preached and given communion at the Grimethorpe and St. Mary's Gate Wesleyan churches in Sheffield where congregation members are said to be "upset and in a state of shock". Said Paul: "I told my Fellowship four years ago that I was gay and no-one made a fuss. But, at the time, none of the church officials knew."

Paul won many friends in the church with his musical and preaching ability, said: "I don't know why they have to poke their noses into other people's lives. If they were happy with my preaching before, why does this make any difference?"

An official of the Wesleyan Reform Union said: "Like any organisation we have rules and if someone agrees to those rules and then breaks them there are consequences".

The HEALTH Column Gay and Bisexual Health Issues

Four months ago my friend told me that he had been visiting the 'network of Gay saunas in the north of England' on a weekly basis. He then rather nervously admitted to me that he had been having unprotected anal sex at these saunas on a regular basis. In the emotional conversation that followed, various unsafe sexual encounters were recounted; encounters that I suspect are familiar to a sizeable proportion of sauna users reading this article.

Although my friend had 'planned ahead' and taken condoms with him to the sauna, they were not used and remained at the bottom of his duffel bag, inside his locker.

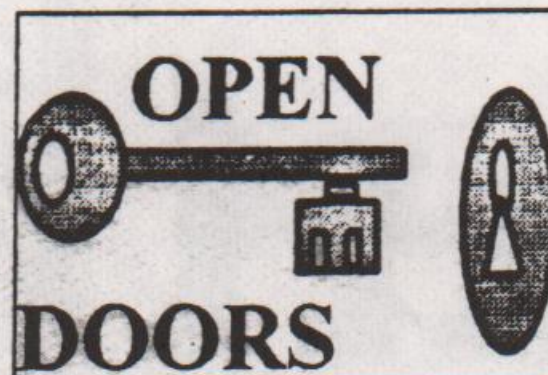
One of the obstacles to having protected anal sex in saunas (presuming that free condoms and lube are not available in darkrooms) is that locker areas and 'sex areas' are often in separate parts of the building. Emphasis is placed on 'disciplining' oneself in the darkroom not to have anal sex before you have trotted to the locker area and back to collect supplies of condoms. My friend felt unable to 'stop in midflow' in this way, and this resulted in him having unsafe sex. There were no condoms available in the darkroom of this sauna.

Both as an HIV worker and as a sauna user I have talked and negotiated with several managers of Gay Saunas in central and northern England. The management of one of these saunas believed anal sex occurred only "now and then". A correlation was made between a small number of condoms being left on the darkroom floor and a low incidence of anal sex. In this particular sauna a jar of condoms supplied by HEAL was kept out of sight beneath the counter. There was no sign to inform customers of their existence. The sauna owners "did not want to draw attention to sex happening" because of fears of a police raid.

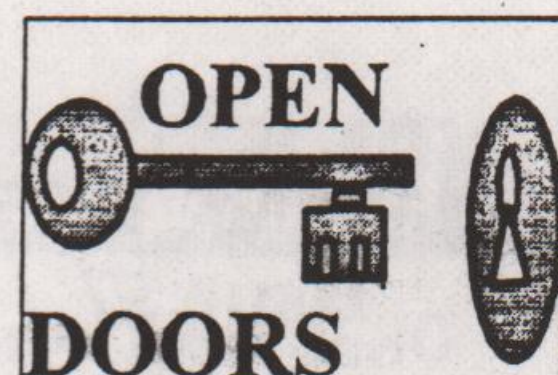
In my experience it is not uncommon for some sauna managers to actively discourage men from taking their own condoms into sex areas. In this situation there is a dilemma; is the answer to encourage punters and HIV organisations to pressurise saunas to start placing safer sex materials in darkrooms?, which potentially could take months or years to achieve, or do we find ways of dealing with the immediate realities of condom free darkrooms?

As a point of interest, my friend has started to wear special keyrings stuffed with condoms and lube on his wrist when he visits saunas. He often hides them from sauna managers.

NO GOING BACK

Michael Brown, the Conservative MP for Brigg and Cleethorpes and a former Government whip, came out as gay following the Tory Party conference last Autumn. He resigned his position as a Government whip after the 'News of the World' alleged that he had a relationship with a student who was under 21. Following a gay Tory fringe meeting when he 'sat on the fence' about his sexuality he made a clear 'coming out' statement several weeks later at the reception where he presented the Mike Rhodes Award to Angela Mason of the Stonewall Group. He said he now recognised that there was "a responsibility to give inspiration to others". Michael Brown joins Chris Smith, (Labour), as the second out gay MP in the current Parliament.

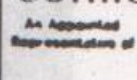

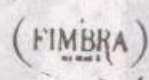

But Mr. Vaz questioned Labour holding a free vote on an equal age of consent. "I believe you can't have a free vote on discrimination," he said.

In the wake of the Commons defeat in the age of consent vote last February, Mr. Vaz met the national lesbian and gay committee "for a heart-to-heart about how some of my colleagues frankly got it wrong."

"It is a basic principle of human rights that everyone should have equal treatment. The Tories have failed to tackle the particular forms of discrimination that lesbians and gay men face in their daily lives," he argued.

"Their policies and public statements have actively encouraged the growth of discrimination and prejudice," the Labour MP said.

Good news from London, Derek Beackon, member of the British National Party (who promote the recriminalisation of homosexuality) failed miserably in his attempt to regain a council seat in a local authority by-election in Tower Hamlets, last month. He came third behind Labour and the Liberal Democrats in the Tower Hamlets Council Election, whilst a Tory candidate dragged into position with a mere 42 votes. Beackon got 562 votes and Labour's Michael Keating celebrated with 1,457 votes. There was a high Anti Nazi League profile who managed to outshout the BNP supporters as the results were announced.

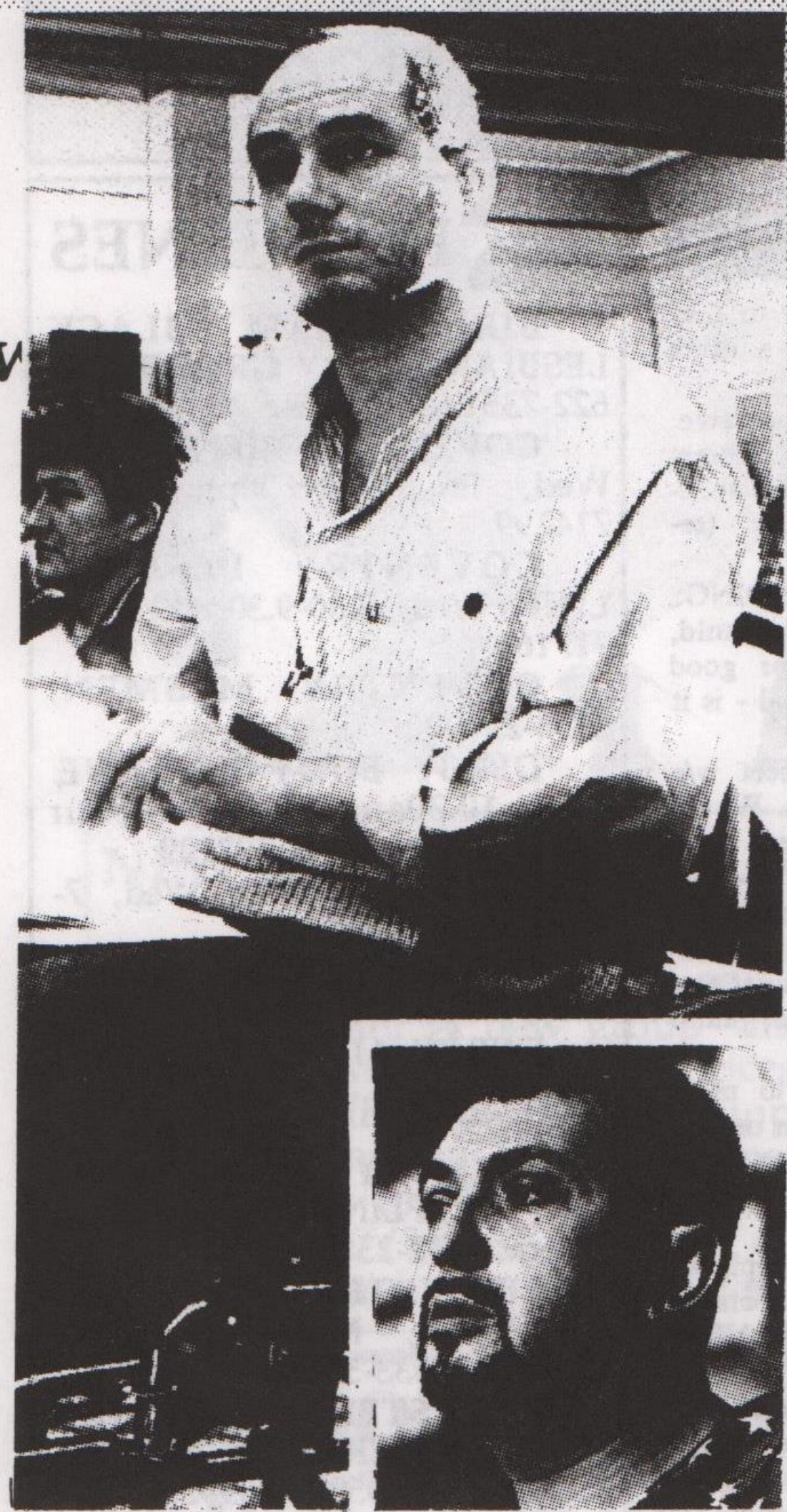
SOS BLESSING

Andrew Milton, newly elected Liberal Democrat Councillor for Sheffield City Council is becoming increasingly worried about Sheffield Council's commitment to lesbian and gay rights. Despite an equal opportunities policy mentioning sexual orientation, action seems to be slow in happening - a prime example being a leaflet offering advice to lesbians and gays suffering harassment in housing. 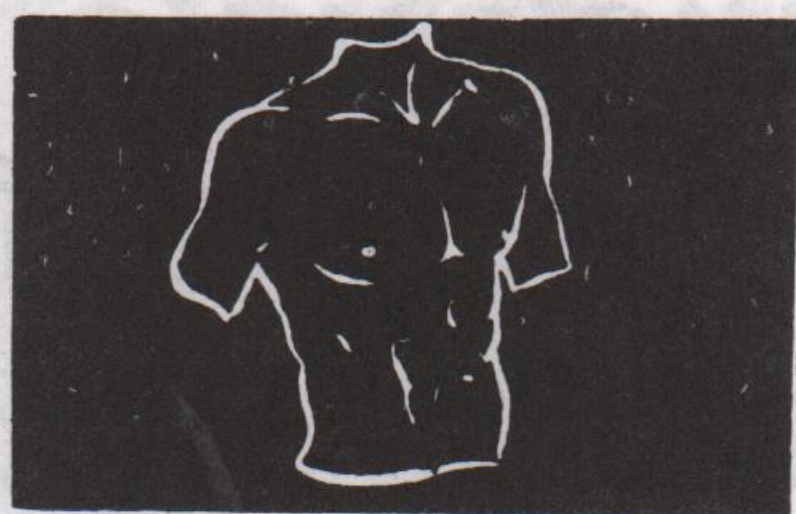

CHESTERFIELD ARRESTS

Two Chesterfield men were arrested by police and remanded to Leicester Prison pending charges arising out of a police raid on Mr. Sandell's home in Higham last October. Police took away a number of videos and photographs and charged Brian Sandell with 'conspiracy to incite gross indecency between two men' and of 'possessing obscene photographs' and a quantity of 'hardcore' videos. Brian Sandell, 58 and Glyn Crowder, 34 of Chesterfield had been brought before Chesterfield Magistrates Court on four occasions to face charges, but on each occasion were remanded back to prison, as police asked for more time to dig for evidence. However, following their fourth court appearance they were released from prison to stay at specific addresses other than their own. Their fifth court appearance will be on 23rd December when they are to appear at Chesterfield Magistrates Court. Brian has asked OUTRIGHT to pass on his best wishes to all members of 'Accents' and wish them a happy new year and looks forward to seeing many of them again shortly.
