Betty pulls it off!

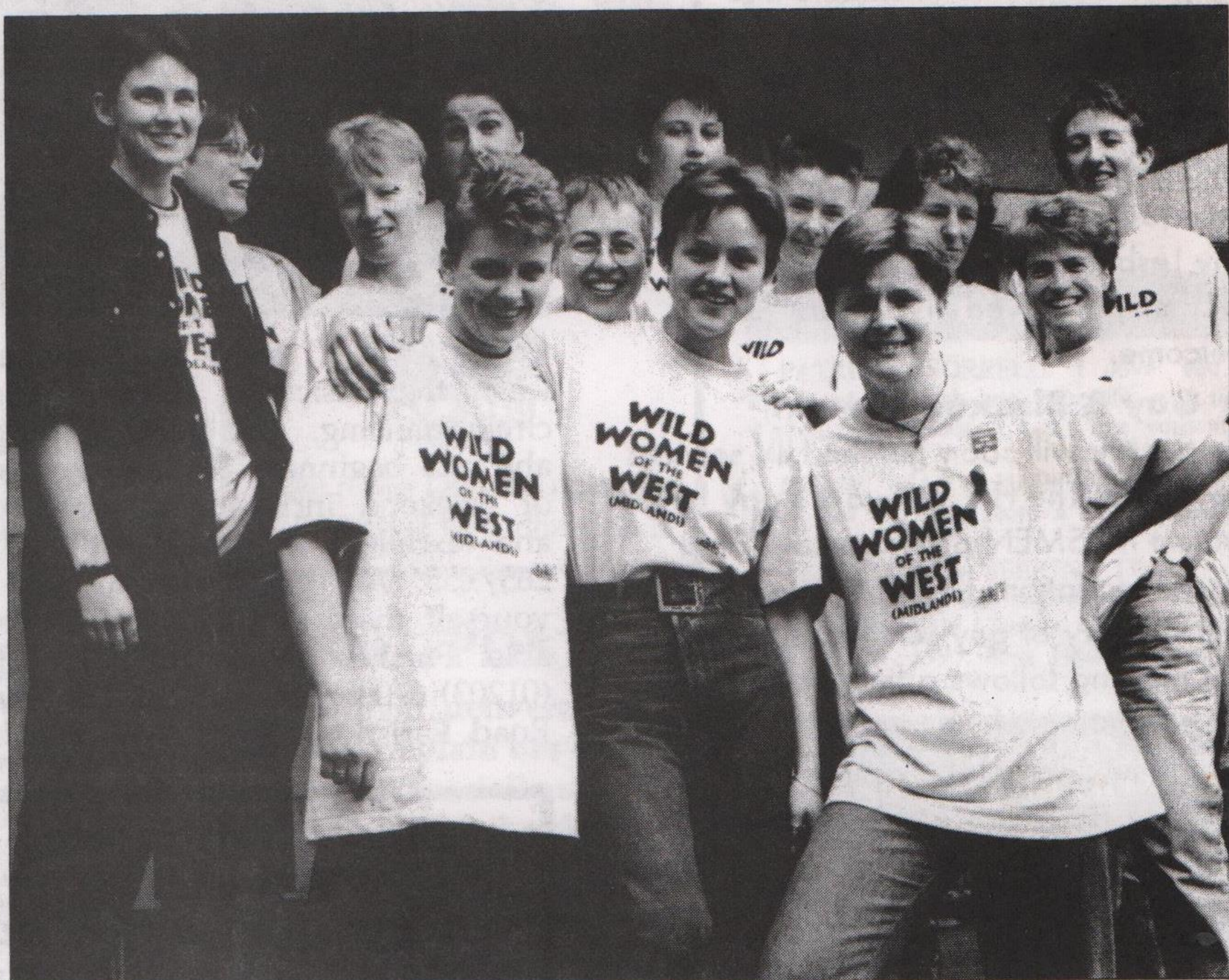
LesBeWell! Birmingham-based lesbian health project for Women who have sex with Women leaves us a bit breathless. Despite having no paid workers or premises - they meet in a lesbian friendly pub in Birmingham - they organised a very successful '95 mid-summer conference, 'Dykenosis in the Flesh', with a nationwide attendance of 120 women from diverse backgrounds, designed to give participants the chance to voice their opinions on the provision of health services to lesbians. All this underpinned by a smart and snappy bi-monthly newsletter, 'Dykenosis'. They've also produced a national Dyke's Directory, in addition to training their volunteers and providing speakers both locally and nationwide and development a resource library. How did they do it? Not without blood, sweat and tears that's for sure as their Conference report states: "Funding for the Health Day took nine months of letter writing, venue seeking, car boot sales, fundraising events, battling with homophobic printers and endless meetings until maximum stress levels were reached and the event finally happened". Culcha, Culcha, cha, cha,

Sheffield Womens' Cultural Club celebrates its first year in business. Outright! spoke to Roz Wall, member of the Management Committee and one of the founding group of women. "A year on, despite the lack of a secure funding base we are managing to hold our own, due very much to the tremendous support from women in Sheffield and elsewhere through various fund raising initiatives. Women know the Club is somewhere they can feel secure and free from hassle."

The Club now has a huge membership and its exhibition space is booked solidly into 1997. At the outset, the Club applied for a Department of Environment Grant but were told they were "not an appropriate organisation for funding". At last, they have recently been awarded small grants from Yorkshire and Humberside Arts, but still no regular City Council funding, apart from a refurbishment grant. The Culture Club is a lesbian & child-friendly space, open to women wherever they live and visitors' memberships can be arranged at the door.

POLICE SUPPORT CONFERENCE

Many police forces in the country have responded favourably to an invitation to attend the first ever national conference on policing the Lesbian & Gay community, which is to be held on Saturday 10th & Sunday 11th November (NOT 28 & 29 October as previously announced) in Manchester Town Hall. The event will provide the first opportunity for local Lesbian & Gay policing groups to meet and share experiences & ideas. Their 'Review of Progress' report covers two years up to April 1995 and makes illuminating reading, sometimes indicating a progress of two steps forward one step back, an example being the inevitable major clashes that would occur over the issue of cottaging on which police believed they had a duty to act on often spurious 'complaints of local residents'. During the early meetings trust had to be achieved on both sides which led to a joint agreement that written Forum minutes could be taken.

What appears most remarkable is that despite a national backdrop of escalating violence and assaults mounted by various Police authorities and wastes of ratepayer's money around the country, the report gives the picture of a Forum on course and that has "held together despite acrimonious wrangling".

There has been some confidence established in the police which led to them receiving vital information which led to the conviction of three men for gay bashing at a local cruising site. Some police officers have now come out to their colleagues. Some of the training exercises are now used by National Police Trainers Conference. Other forces have emulated Leicester including Northants and Derbys

For the future the Forum foresees the need for increased LGB community representation especially from lesbian and black groups, formal backing from the Police Committee and better police training, for instance around same-sex domestic violence issues.

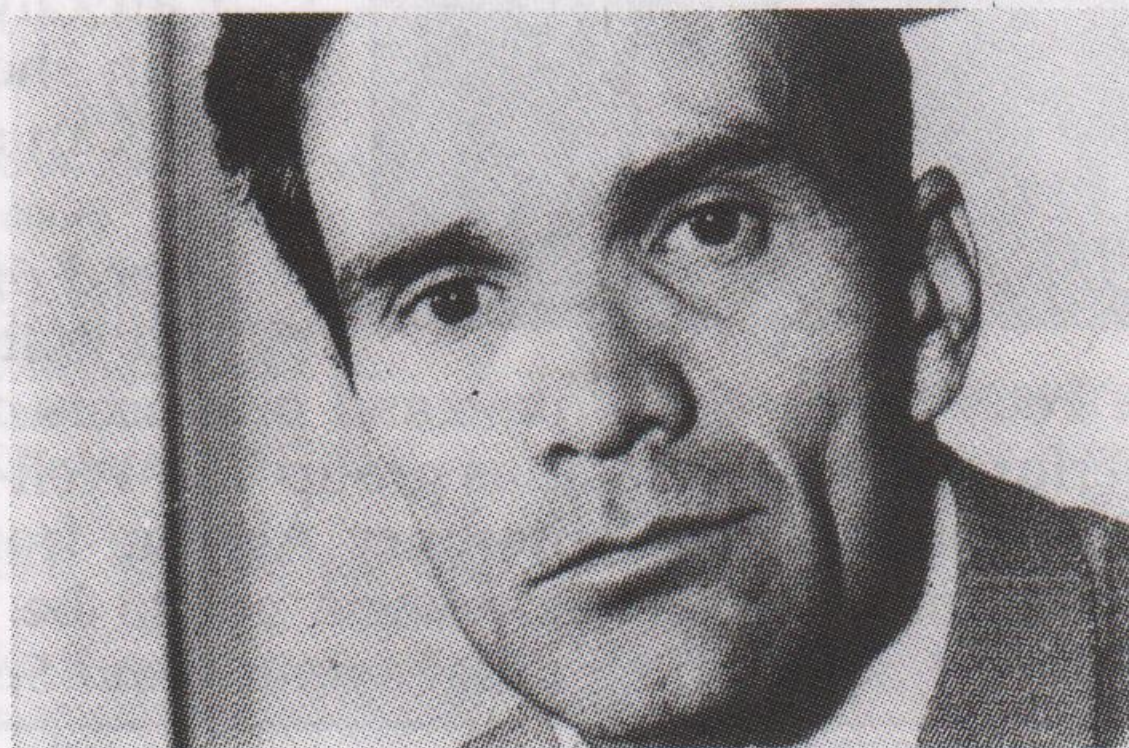

Gay Italian film director Pier Paolo Pasolini (pictured) was murdered twenty years ago on 2nd November 1975.

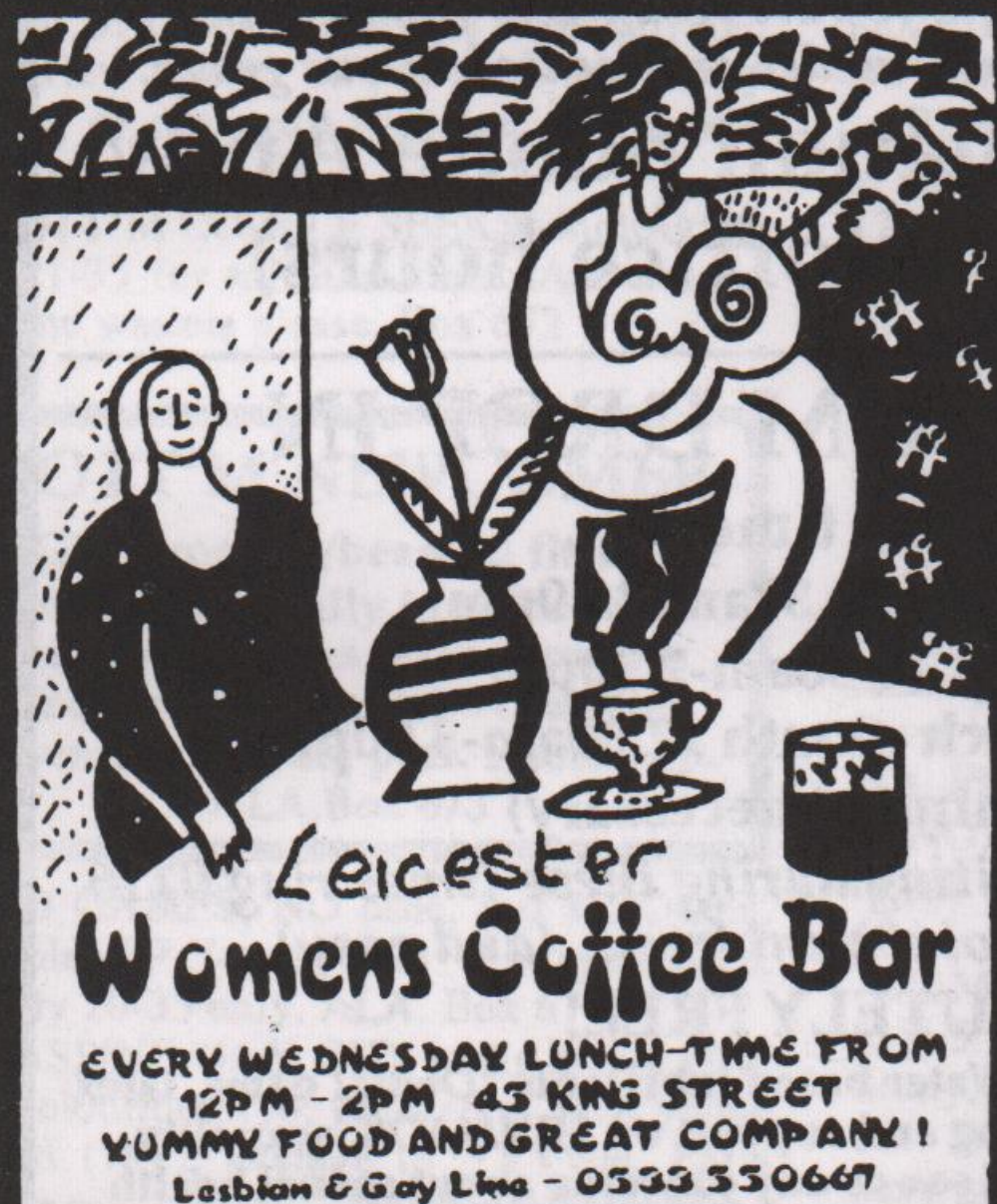

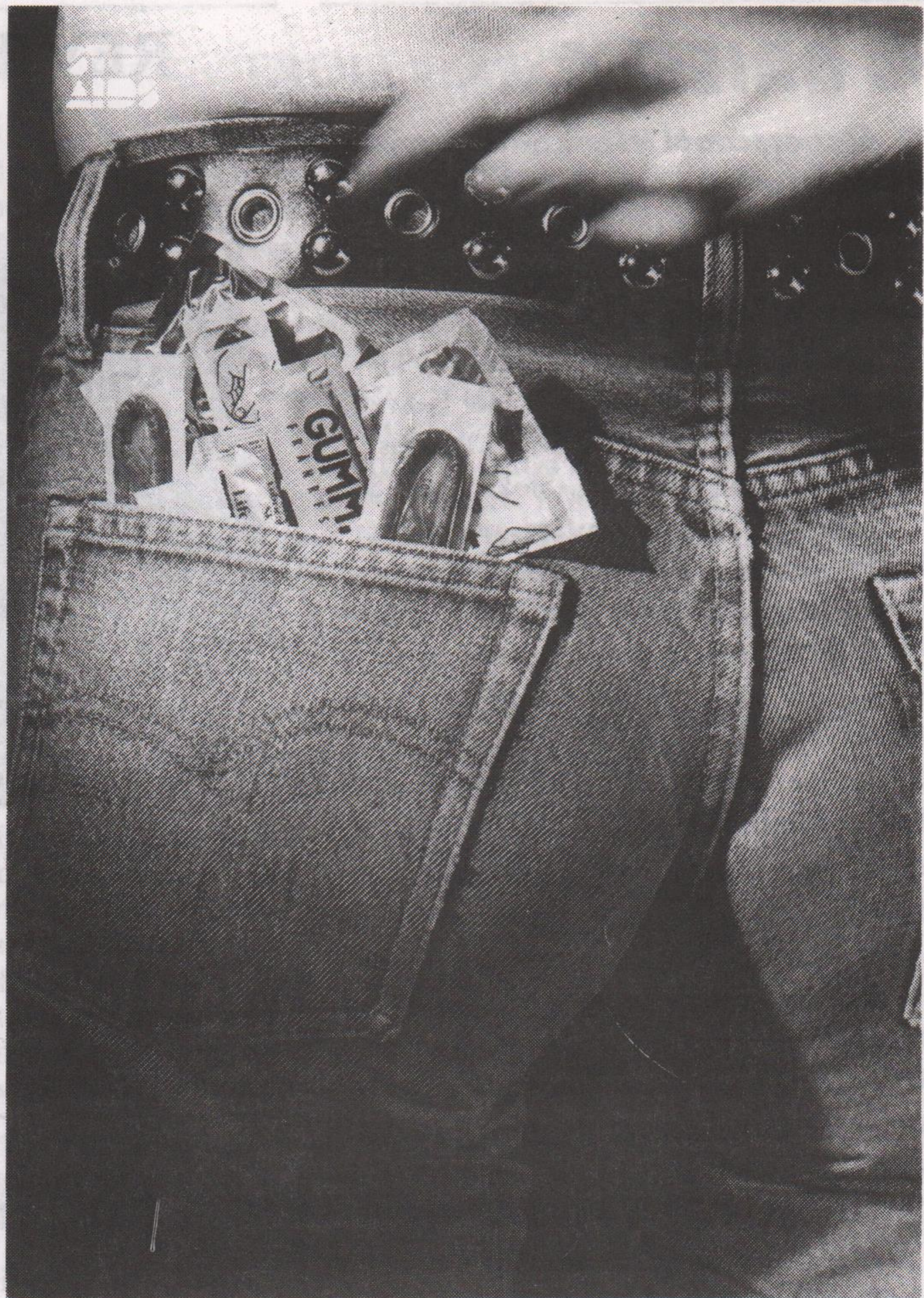

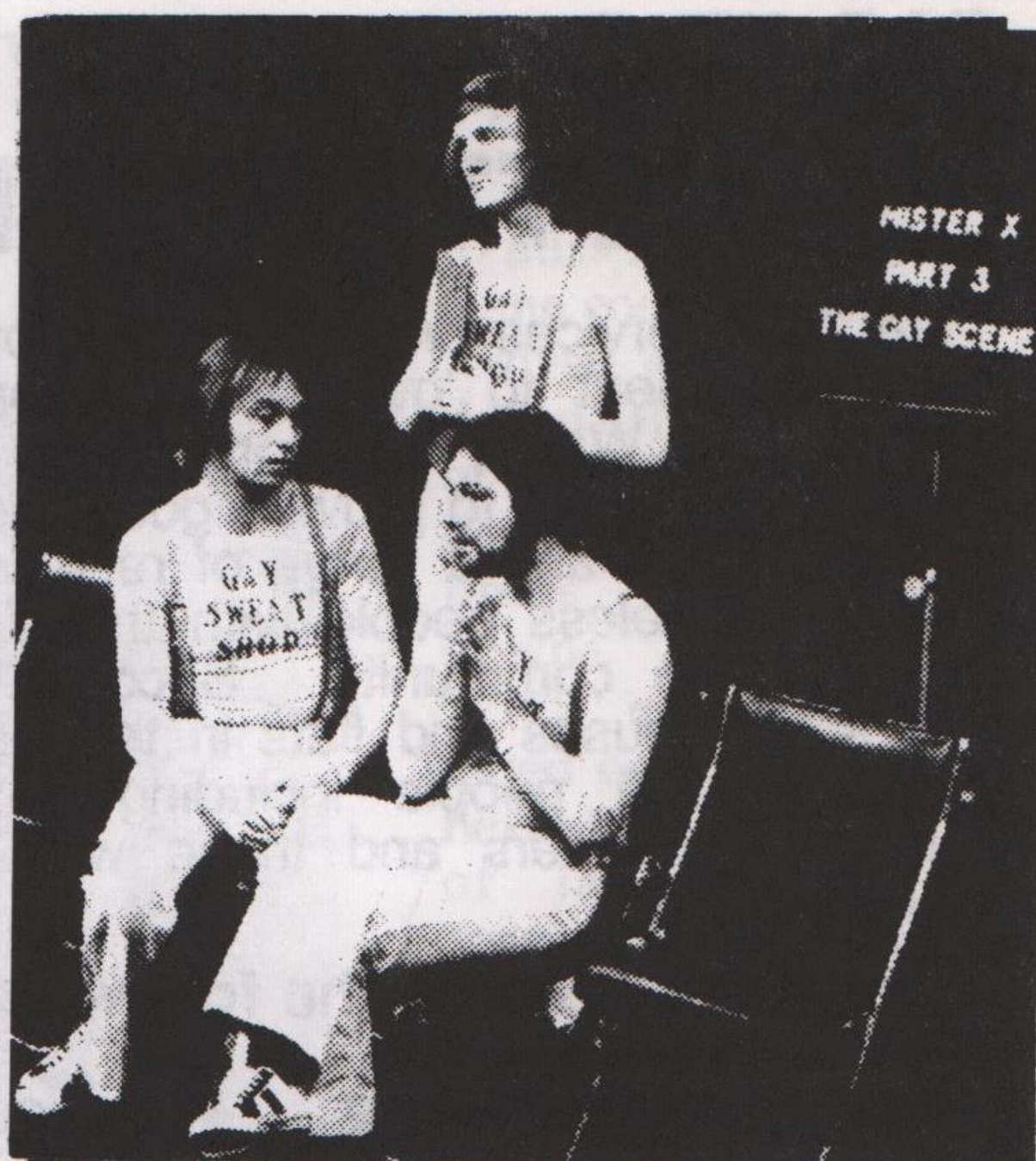
YESTERYEAR 20 YEARS AGO

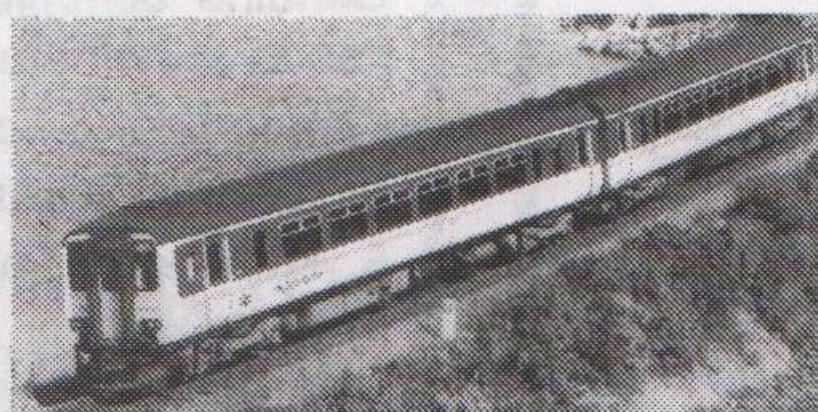

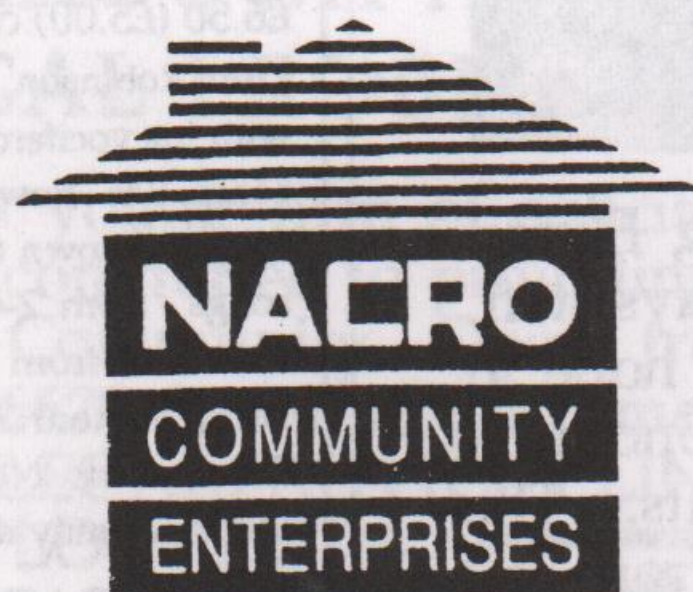

Raising the Roof!

Last month we featured several housing associations specialising in housing women. This month we look at a housing association which works with women and men.

Nottingham People's Housing Association is a hostel project for single people and couples without children who are homeless or threatened with homelessness. Set up in 1985 it provides fully furnished, temporary supported accommodation.

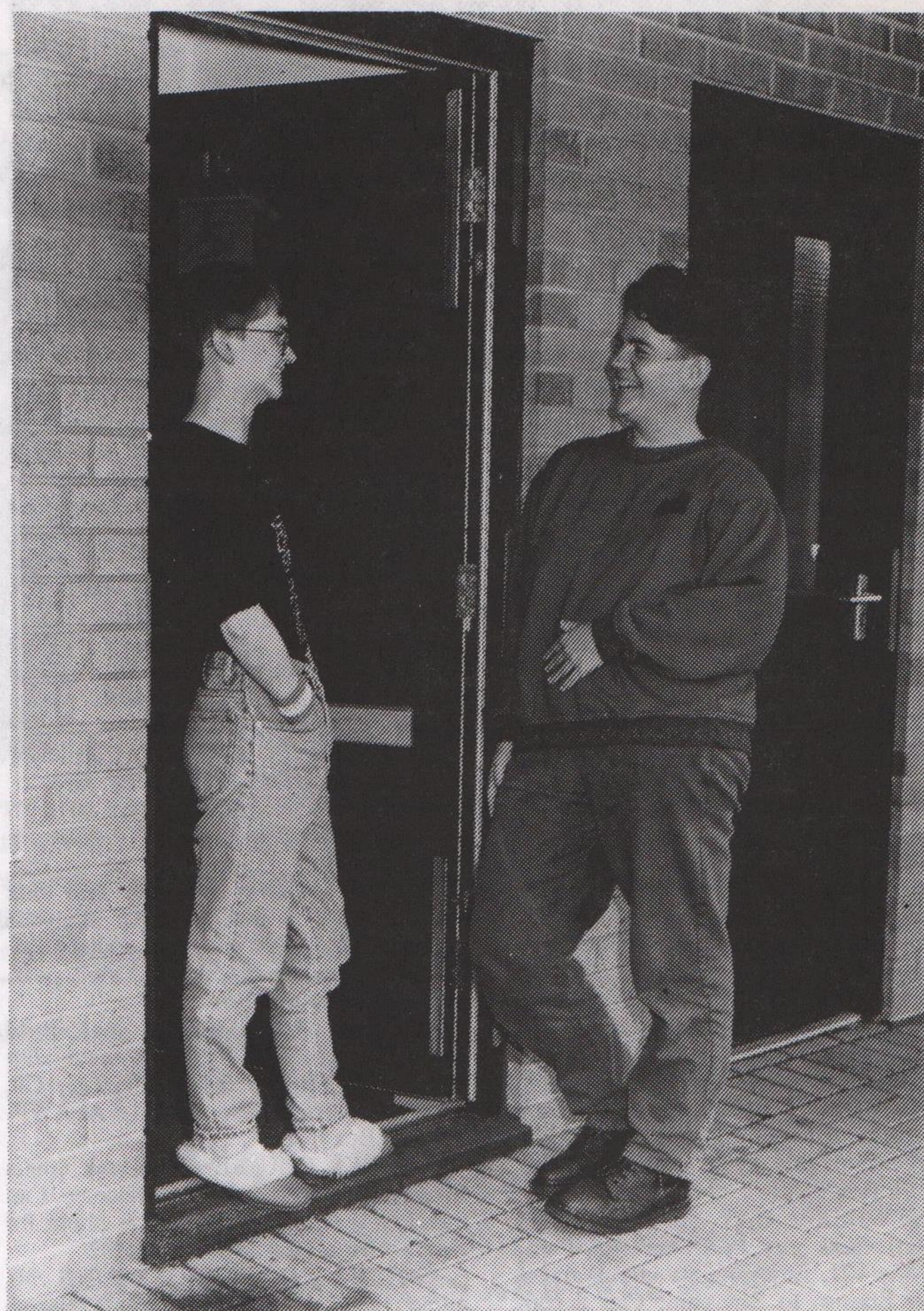
NPHA has a working commitment to help stop unfair discrimination and disadvantage towards a whole range of people, including Lesbians, Gay Men, Black people and People with Disabilities. When someone moves into their accommodation they are allocated a Housing Support Worker, whose aim would be to provide help and advice without being intrusive; enabling a resident to move on to more permanent accommodation when they are ready, the average length of stay being from 6-18 months. Whilst most of their accommodation is in shared houses, they do have a few self-contained flats (mainly for single women). They usually house same-sex couples in separate bedrooms in the same house, and they have a hostel for gay or bisexual men. Security and confidentiality are watchwords for NPHA - all their units have payphones, are near bus routes and have external lighting.

What better then for two residents to have their say:

Gerry became homeless when his relationship of six years ended. "I was rehoused within three weeks of acceptance by NPHA. I feel secure living in the Gay Men's house, and have just been offered a permanent tenancy in a council flat", he said.

Alan found the accommodation very spacious and modern in a good location. "I found the support offered very helpful" he said "and my worker was extremely caring".

Are you entitled to more benefit?

On account of the fact that Social Security law does not recognise lesbian and gay partnerships, certain circumstances can result in lesbian and gay couples who live together being better off than heterosexual partners in similar circumstances.

For example:

1. Lesbian and gay partners living together can claim separately for Income Support.
2. Lesbian and gay partners in a number of circumstances are able to obtain Housing Benefit for their partner who is sharing their accommodation with them.
3. Where there is a commercial arrangement between individuals, as in example 2 above, where one partner is receiving the middle rate care component of Disability Living Allowance and no-one is receiving invalid care allowance in respect of them, they are able to receive an additional premium of Income Support called the Severe Disability Premium amounting to an extra £35.05 a week.
