

GAY MEN TARGETED BY HEALTH AUTHORITY

In a unique collaboration, Warwickshire Health Authority has commissioned the gay and bisexual men's health team MESMEN to consult with local gay and bisexual men and women in

throughout the venues county. The Chief Executive of the Health Authority Michael Marchment, will attend a series of countywide public meetings in Rugby, Nuneaton, Warwick and Stratford during the first two weeks of July. Michael Gilday Landlord of The Antelope in Warwick said: "The current policy has statements which are inaccurate, misleading or pointless; it doesn't mention gay men, obviously a target group and therefore we've been lucky to get our points across."

John Taylor, MESMEN coordinator, said: "We welcome the opportunity for local gay and bisexual men to make changes to a strategy that largely fails to meet their needs. We hope lots of gays will contact us and have their say."

BOYCOTT ZIMBABWE

150 delegates at the Annual Conference of the European Forum of Lesbian & Gay Christian Groups meeting in Oslo, Norway urged the World Council of Churches (WCC) to reconsider plans to hold the 1998 General Assembly in the Harare, Zimbabwe. The European Forum was alarmed to hear of the hostile attitude of the Zimbabwean President Robert Mugabe towards Lesbian & Gay people. Delegates felt that the WCC, whose headquarters are in Geneva, should not appear to condone such attitudes by meeting in a country that failed to respect the sexuality of citizens or visitors and which could not guarantee freedom of association and expression to all. A unanimous resolution on behalf of groups from 16 European countries urged the WCC to relocate its meeting to South Africa in view of the new constitution which

offers protection against discrimination to Lesbian & Gay citizens.

The Rev Richard Kirker, General Secretary of (pictured) commented: "The host Government has refused to unreservedly and openly withdraw its homophobic policies. The ecumenical movement must resist and expose

homophobia with vigour if it is to be consistent and principled."







GET WRITING!

"You may have read in the gay press about the Law Commission's HIV recommendations, contained in the consultation paper 'Consent in the Criminal Law'", writes Richard Clarke, GayCare co-ordinator of Gay Men Fighting Aids. These recommenda-

tions urge the government to bring in legislation to compel HIV+ people to disclose their status prior to having sex. Not to do so would be a criminal offence.

"I believe that these proposals will be extremely harmful if implemented; for the following reasons. HIV+ individuals will be forced to disclose their status against their wishes, both on and off the scene. HIV+ individuals will have to disclose their status in hostile environments, often leading to alienation, and sometimes to violence. The measures will actively discourage many from taking the blood test. They will discourage HIV negative or untested individuals from taking responsibility for safer sex.

"I believe that this measure must be campaigned against vigorously. The Law Commission is a government body, and there is a possibility that these proposals may come before Parliament in November of this year.

"Please write to your local MP, urging him or her to lobby against the recommendations now, and to vote against them if and when they come before Parliament". (You may want to base your letter on the points made above).

But it's not all total bliss - Sometimes people do disagree over things, but that's life. It doesn't


may take time to feel at ease in a group of 20 or so gay/bi men. If that climb gives





WINDMILLS ON HIS MIND....

If you'd have told Geoff Dees that at thirty-something he'd be the gaffer in charge of a working windmill in Lincolnshire he'd have laughed you out of the room. Geoff, was until recently a heating engineer for a number of years in Hull until last year when the chance of voluntary redundancies was mooted at a works' staff meeting. "One day the managing director announced that he was looking for volunteers to go; well I was out the door to the personnel office before he'd finished speaking". Geoff knew he wanted to make some radical changes in his lifestyle and now this seemed the right time to

move.



regular income can be a bit daunting but then things began to happen as if it was all part of the plan. The Lincolnshire Wolds delivered up a rare opportunity to take a lease on a working windmill. "Through a mutual friend I got to hear that Alford Mill was becoming vacant and things moved on from there" and then in January this year the lease was signed, and Geoff moved in in March. The bleak winter months are not the best times to reflect on decisions made.

"In a way, signing the lease was the easy part - it's only when I arrived and began unpacking that the reality of what I'd done hit me and I shook with fright", he laughs his face now wreathed in smiles remembering that almost-forgotten

experience. Somehow self-doubt began to get the better of him at that time. "It was hard to see the potential that was there

until I got rid of the fear and doubt", he adds. Which he ultimately did of course.

But in the process, for the next couple of months, all lines to Hull were permanently engaged, no doubt accounting for a fair share of BT's fat profits. But as the weather improved so did Geoff's morale and he began to learn how to maintain the



machinery along with the intricacies of grinding and bagging not to mention selling cream teas. "My knowledge of basic machinery was quite useful so I soon cottoned on". As March gave way to April, and visitors began to arrive, he had a chance to try out some of his own ideas as well.

Now, nearly four months on and Geoff knows he made the right move. But he's no slouch and is probably busier than he's ever been, but working for himself, with people coming from far and wide, to sample one of only three working windmill in the region. Like Geoff, the Mill is a hard worker and the slightest excuse for a breeze is music to its ears, and the sails slicing into the wind can be seen for many miles.

Geoff still heads for Hull from time to time to see friends, but before long he's itching to get back to the big skies, open country and fresh air. Well wouldn't you?





WHEN HATE COMES TO TOWN

Community Responses to Racism and Fascism

With the continuing problem of racial harassment and violence towards minorities escalating, John Heppell, MP for Nottingham East and the Searchlight Education Trust (pictured) sponsored the East Midlands launch of 'When Hate

Comes to Town - Community Responses to Racism and



Fascism' earlier this summer. Speakers at the packed lunchtime meeting at Nottingham Council House heard Ruth Levin, author of the book and Mel Read MEP speak of the importance of taking up the struggle against this pernicious evil.

The meeting was chaired by Milton Crosdale of the Racial Equality Council. This book represents a major new resource that will enable individuals, groups and organisations to formulate their own effective and appropriate responses to deal with racism in all its forms. It

contains contributions from a range of organisations and individuals with expert knowledge, including lawyers, MPs, teachers, youth workers, trade unionists and historians. Among organisations represented were workers from the Leicester Lesbian, Gay and Bisexual Centre.
