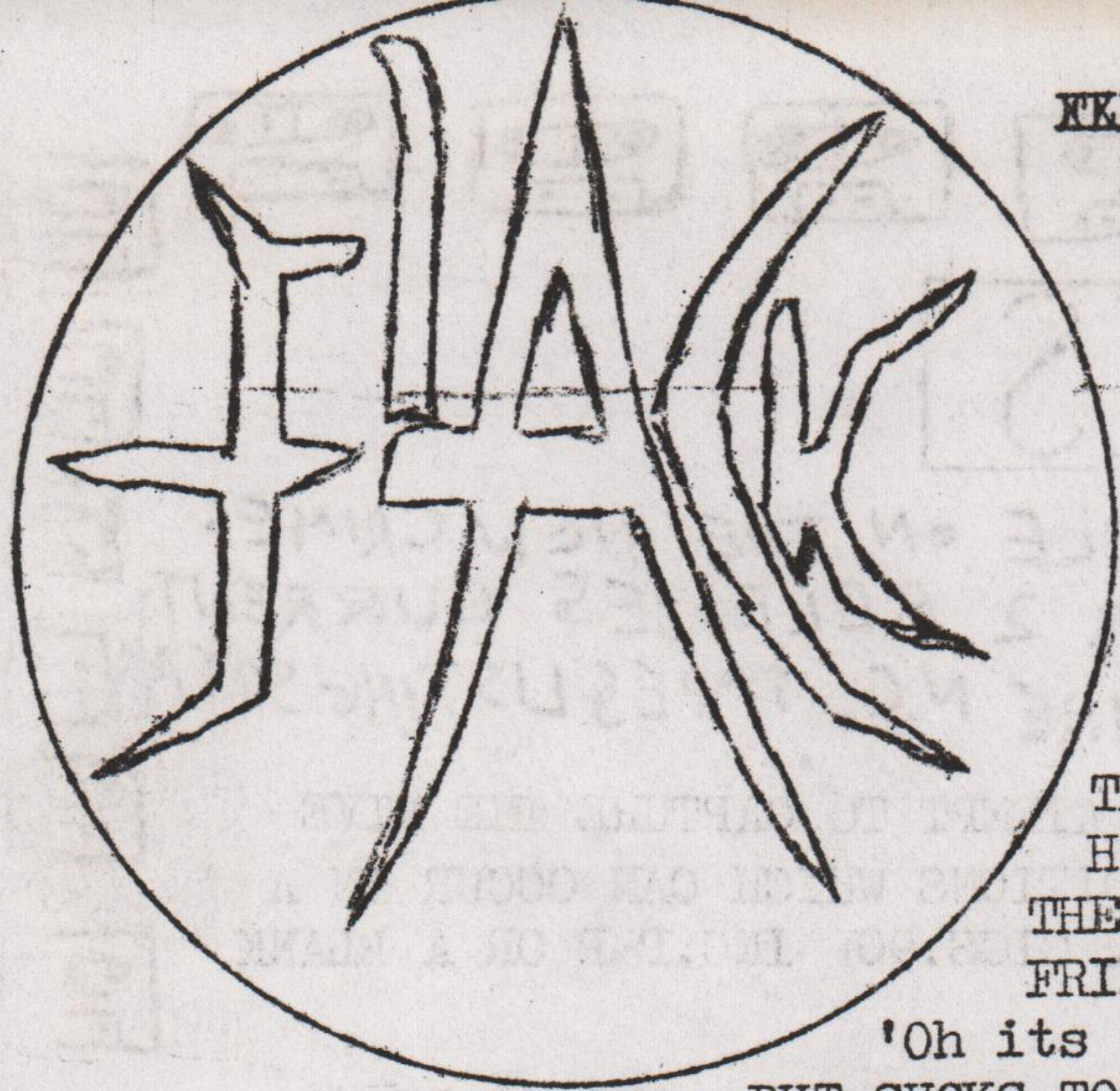

When you have been given the go-ahead you can record the track to be put on the record. You can record it where you like, depending on how your resources go, though it would obviously be best if you recorded it in a studio. In order to fit all the tracks on, the longest the track can be is just over 3 minutes. Then, probably around mid December, I will ask you to record the tracks and the money together. Incidentally the money will help pay towards what parts of the album I can't afford. Right then, so now you've got your track on the album this is where you get your money back. When the album is completed, hopefully next easter, you get 20 copies of the album free. Selling at just £2.50, sell just 15 and you will get your £40 back. This is not all: As well as appearing on the initial album, a follow up album shall be made, which you may also appear on at your discretion, this time absolutely free! 
I FOUND BLACK FLAG'S SET A BIT OF A DISSAPOINTMENT I MUST SAY, THEIR SET WAS MESSY AND INCOHERENT, AND ANY ENERGY THEY DID HAVE WAS DISIPATED BY THE ATMOSPHERE IN THE FOCUS YOUTH THEATRE, WHAT WITH THE AUDIENCE SITTING ABOVE THE STAGE IN CHAIRS. A PITY, BECAUSE BLACK FLAG HAVE SOME EXCELENT LYRICS (SOME ARE PRINTED ELSEWHERE IN THIS 'ZINE) WHICH DESERVE TO BE HEARD.

THE SINIX, HOWEVER SEEMED FAR MORE SUITED TO THEATRICAL ATMOSPHERE, PLAYING IN A GLOOMY HALF-LIGHT PROVIDED BY A COUPLE OF LAMPS ON THE STAGE WHICH LENT THEM AN ALMOST EERIE AURA. THEY DID A COMPREHENSIVE SELECTION OF THEIR SONGS, INCLUDING 925 AUSCHWITZ, MAUSOLEUM, DECADENCE, ANIMAL AND MANY OTHERS INCLUDING A COUPLE OF NEW PIECES, ZULU (H BLOCK) AND NAUSEA... THEIR LAST NUMBER, EXCOMMUNICAT ION DISINTEGRATED INTO A SPONTANEOUS ORGY OF NOISE WHICH CULMINATED IN THE ~~X~~ BAND COMPLETELY WRECKING THE STAGE A LA THE WHO, ALTHOUGH I DON'T THINK ANYTHING WAS SERIOUSLY DAMAGED APART FROM ONE STAGE LIGHT WHICH WAS SHATTERED. I PERSONALLY FOUND THIS ENDING A BIT TOO MUCH LIKE 'ROCK THEATRE', SOMETHING A GROSS OVERWEIGHT HEAVY METAL BAND WOULD DO, BUT ALL THE ~~SAME~~ SAME IT MADE A LIVELY

PIGS FOR SLAUGHTER IS AN EXCELENT LITTLE MAGAZINE PRODUCED 'FOR ANARCHIST PUNKS', A RATHER SILLY CLAIM, AS I THINK IT WOULD BE OF INTEREST ANY ANARCHISTS, AND TO ME 'PUNK' IS JUST ANOTHER TRIBE, ANOTHER FASHION. IT IS INTENDED THAT PFS SHOULD APPEAR REGULARLY (EVERY 2-3 MONTHS) GIVING NEWS AND VIEWS FROM WITHIN THE ANARCHIST MOVEMENT (EG. THE ANARCHIST CENTRE) AND ~~XX~~ ALSO ON ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ WHAT THE STATE IS UP TO WITH ARTICLES ON RIOT CONTROL TECHNIQUES ETC. FORCING ANOTHER PERSON OR GROUP OF PEOPLE TO DO SOMETHING...THOSE WHO EMPLOY VIOLENCE TO ACHIEVE THEIR ENDS MAY GO BY MANY NAMES, COMMUNISTS, FASCISTS, CAPITALISTS BUT ANARCHISTS ARE NOT ONE OF THEM....NB. BY VIOLENCE I MEAN VIOLENCE AGAINST OTHER PERSONS, NOT PROPERTY) AND THEIR IDEA OF FORMING A 'PUNK ARMY', WHICH IF YOU ASK ME ENOUGH OTHER PEOPLE HAVE ALREADY TRIED TO DO...LOOK AT THE SO CALLED 'OI OI' BRIGADES FOR A GOOD EXAMPLE OF THE TOTAL PATHETICNESS OF PUNK ARMIES....

DESPITE THESE CRITISMS, WHICH ARE NOT MINOR, PFS IS AN EXCELANT 'ZINE AND I WOULD HIGHLY RECCOMEND IT. 15P FROM BOX 7, 182 UPPER STREET, LONDON N 1.

RECORD REVIEWS

I HAVE RECIEVED A FAIR AMMOUNT OF CRITSISM FOR INCLUDING REVIEWS OF RECORDS IN NEW CRIMES, THE MAIN ARGUEMENTS SEEM TO BE THAT THE 'ESTABLISHED MUSIC PRESS' REVIEWS MOST SINGLES AND LPS, AND THAT REVIEWS IN FANZINES ARE GENERALLY WAY OUT OF DATE BY THE TIME THEY ARE SEEN. IN FUTURE, THEN, I AM ONLY GOING TO REVIEW RECORDS WHICH I CONSIDER IMPORTANT OR WHICH HAVE BEEN OVERLOOKED ELSEWHERE. Or I like, ha ha

ZOUNDS: DEMYSTIFICATION/GREAT WHITE HUNTER (ROUGH TRADE)

I didn't like this at first, it seemed to sound like 'power pop', but a few more plays made it grow on me. It opens with a discordant strummed guitar which leads into an energetic and melodic song in a similar vein to their Crass records EP. I hope as many people buy this as bought that record, as it would be a shame for people to think of Zounds as nothing more than 'a band who had a record out on Crass'. Incidentally, did you know that Zounds is a word meaning the Shakesperian equivalent of 'fuck off'? Amazing wot you can learn in New Crimes ain't it?

FALL OUT: CONSCRIPTION EP

Fall out are, I believe, 6 Minute War reformed, if I am right this is the third ep they've managed to bring out at absolute minimum cost, and it's also by far the best. They've got a lead guitarist now, which improves their songs no end, especially on 'Laughable Attack', a vicious attack on Crass which I disagree with, although it's good to see them saying what they really think rather than what they 'should' think, and on the title track. With 6 tracks for 75p (nearly 13 minutes of music) Fall out are proving that alternatives to the rip-off companys are a reality. MAKE MUSIC NOT MONEY.

FLUX OF PINK INDIANS: NUE SMELL (CRASS RECORDS)

Three songs, Tube Disaster, Sick Butchers, Background of Malfunction as well as 2 poems. Opens with Nue smell which literally explodes into the Crass-like Tube Disaster, an attack on the people who stand around watching accidents/think that the SAS shooting other human beings is entertainment... Sick Butchers has a psychedelic sound and is an attack on eating meat. Penny Rimbaud has done an excellent job of production on this disc which makes the versions of these songs on their demo tape sound flat by comparison. Also has an excellent cover telling you all you've ever wanted to know about nuclear power, vegetarianism etc. Pay no more than 75p as usual, although it's worth a lot more!

PETE FENDER: FOUR FORMULAS (X-NTRIX)

Pete Fender used to be with the Fatal Microbes (famed for giving the obnoxious Honey Bane her first break), and this is his solo single on which he plays all instruments. 'promises promises' sounds modish according to Gary of the Get, and ~~an~~ early Buzzcockish according to me... 'Lonely Homicide' reminds me of the Jam, 'I'll Never Believe You' is the Buzzcocks meets the Sex Pistols, whilst the final tune, 'Nothing To Say' sounds like....

....THE BUZZCOCKS!.... A good record, get it if you can.

SWELL MAPS: WHATEVER HAPPENS NEXT (ROUGH TRADE)

Half crap, half brilliant, the retrospective LP from the Swell Maps, a band I've always liked. Good tracks include Read About Seymour, Midget Submarines, Most of side 4 and others. Definately worth £3.99 for a double LP.

FAB NEW CRIMES TOP 5! CRASS: PENIS ENVY (CRASS RECORDS)

~~xxx~~ Record charts are boring so I'm putting in a chart of my favourite animals.

Great advances both musically and lyrically, some songs even read like poetry... "THE LIVING SEARCH FOR THE LIVING AMONG THE DEAD

~~WHEN DID YOU FORM~~ WHAT GAVE YOU THE INITIAL INSPIRATION TO FORM THE POISON GIRLS?

R.F: Basically it was at the end of '76. Me, Lance, Vi and various others had been working together for a couple of years on various projects and it became clear that being in a band was possible again, like it hadn't really been possible before, well, the Sex Pistols I suppose. It was like a real, live and energetic means of communication.

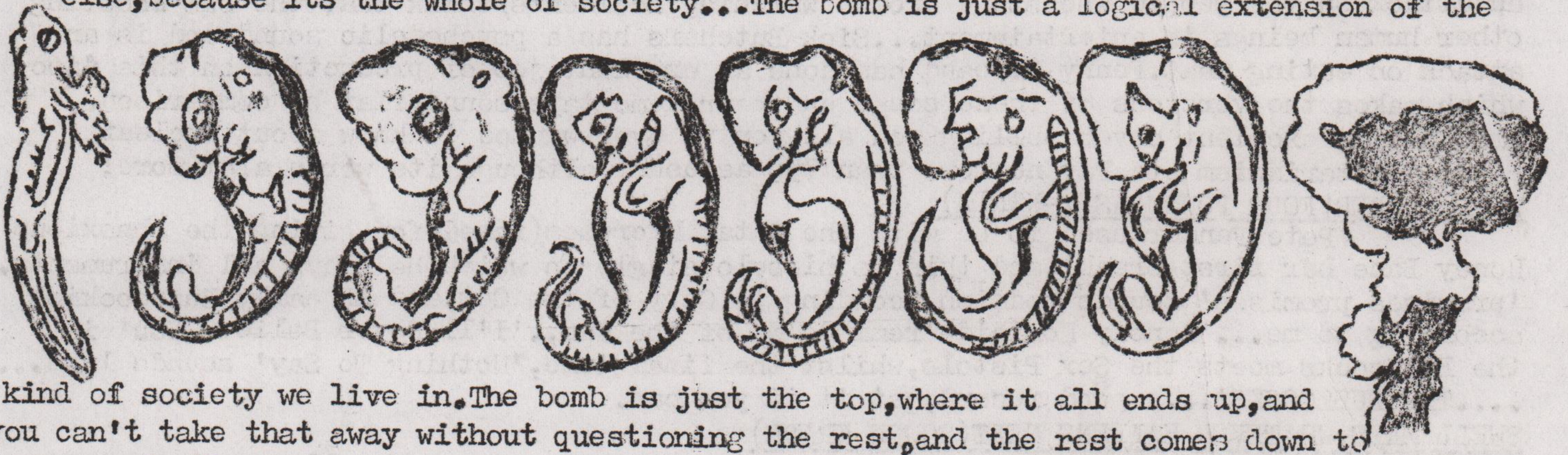
WHAT WERE THE OTHER PROJECTS YOU WERE INVOLVED IN?

R.F: We did a theatrical production called 'The Body Show', it was to do with sex roles and conditioning. Sexpol basically.



ALTHOUGH THERE ARE OBVIOUSLY SIMILARITIES BETWEEN CRASS' IDEOLOGIES AND YOUR IDEOLOGIES, YOU SEEM TO TREAT A SUBJECT IN A MUCH MORE INDIVIDUAL AND PERSONALISED WAY WHEREAS THEY WOULD GENERALISE MORE. DO YOU AGREE WITH THAT STATEMENT?

L.B: Yes. We've been playing with Crass a long time, and there's no point in duplicating what they ~~say~~ do and say. What we want to do is relate more personal things to bigger, 'political' questions. One thing I've learned from the general political thing through working with Crass and CND is that people can say all sorts of things, and you can agree on all sorts of social and political criticisms, and dissatisfaction with the way things are, and you can end up in a position where you come to believe that simply saying those things actually makes a difference, whereas it doesn't in actual fact... I mean it makes no sense to say "Get rid of the bomb" in an abstract context, because if we did get rid of the bomb it wouldn't make much difference, because then we'd have to get rid of something else, because it's the whole of society... The bomb is just a logical extension of the



kind of society we live in. The bomb is just the top, where it all ends up, and you can't take that away without questioning the rest, and the rest comes down to how we actually live.

R.F: The personalisation of our lyrics is to do with knowing that you can only make changes in a system or structure like the family or the state or the church by actually changing the people in that structure or system... Like, the most radical thing we can do is to change ourselves and to make that change as obvious and as challenging as possible, because it is very easy just to mouth platitudes about peace and equality and freedom and I've seen that done so many times before by people who are still living in their own ways, like various right and left political groups have been run in patriarchal ways, theirs one boss who's almost exclusively male who tells other people what to do, and no matter how much they talk about freedom and equality they're still in that position of patriarchal power, and nothing's gonna happen unless they change themselves.... Really that's the basis of anarchy. Anarchy doesn't mean chaos and raping your grandma.. That isn't what anarchy is about, anarchy is about taking control over your own life, and

taking control of the structures that you take part in and reconstructing your life around different value systems from the one that you're given, and the values that your given are based around power and sanction and...shit...The shit of people who are flogged to death to produce copper or uranium or the shit you pile on other people who you see as trying to threaten your own position within that repressive structure.

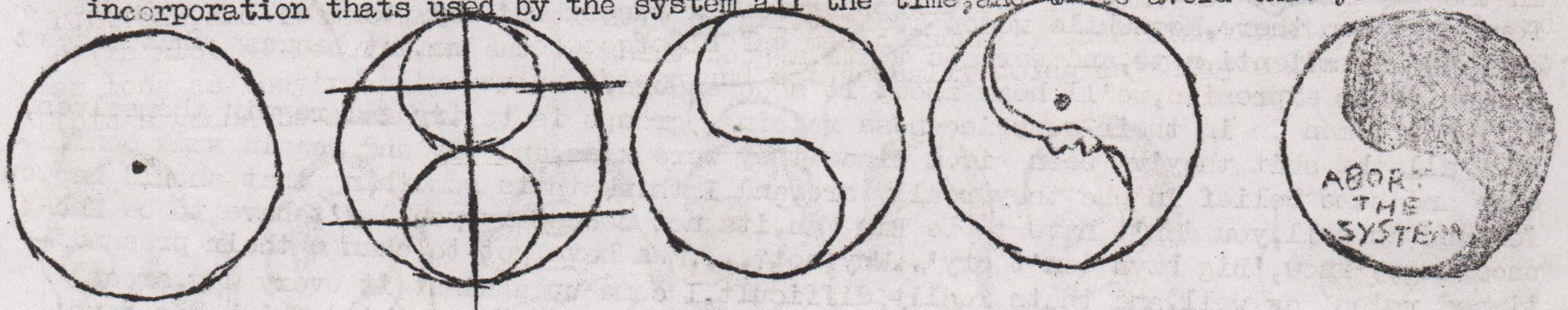
L.B: Somebody was asking us the other day why we don't try and work within ~~the~~ 'the business' why we insisted on being independant, which meant that we didn't sell as many records and reach as many people as people who've 'joined the business', and that to me is a crucial argument, that time and time again bands say that they're going to change the system, but in the end they join it, presumably under the illusion that they're going to be able to change more within it, but what happens is although what they say might be radical, what they do is not radical..

LIKE THE GANG OF FOUR, THEY SING ALL THEIR REVOLUTIONARY SLOGANS, BUT A CERTAIN AMOUNT OF THE MONEY THEY'RE MAKING FOR EMI GOES BACK INTO MAKING WEAPONS WHICH ARE KILLING SOME POOR BASTARD HALFWAY ROUND THE WORLD....

L.B: Yeah, and it maintains the record industry because its fashionable to be radical, it ~~xx~~ sells alot of records, and the people in the music industry understand that very well, and as long as they're only saying things and not actually doing anything radical then everything gonna be alright.



R.F: It gets more obvious how alright they are in terms of being accepted by the business, like you can get articles about ~~these~~ supposedly revolutionary bands in NME or Sounds or The Guardian, and obviously they can't be doing anything ~~really~~ real, or else they wouldn't be allowed to have access to those places. I don't think its just chance or oversight that we've never been asked to do a session for John Peel... I ~~xx~~ don't think they can afford to give us space ~~aws~~ they see us as too much of a threat..... There's a process which the media attempts to do all the time on anyone.. I'm sure you'll find it happens to you.. They try to negate ~~xx~~ what you're doing, they either try and take you over or they try and negate you, make what you're doing seem ineffective. Usually its a two way thing, first they tell you that you're no good, then they give you how you can be better, which is usually like 'join with us, that would be alright, you'll be better'. It is a process of incorporation thats used by the system all the time, and ~~to~~ to avoid that you have to be



really ruthlessly independant.

BUT ITS IMPOSSIBLE TO BE TOTALLY INDEPENDANT, YOU'VE ALWAYS GOT TO GO AND BUY THINGS FROM THE SYSTEM, LIKE FOOD AND STUFF...

R.F: Yeah, sure, and those contradictions are really clear, nobody in Western Europe is actually free from the fact that western Europe is built on the raw materials of 75% of the world which isn't western Europe, like our whole technology and our whole way of living is grossly overindulgent seen in world terms, and we can't get out of that. There's no way we can give back to the rest of the world like the 200 years of slavery we've put Africa into, theres no way we can repay that or give them their rights any more, its all too steeped in it.

L.B: But there's the question of our own dignity in a system which is trying to turn us into lumps of shit

R.F: I think you have to make compromises all the time, the important point is not that

you have to make those compromises, but to be aware of when you're making those compromises and when they are necessary and when they're not. Specifically with us as a band it's whether we want to make compromises over how and where we want to play. We want to have as much control over that as we possibly can... We can't have total control but we can have a lot more than if we ~~XXXX~~ were just prepared to play support gigs with whoever wants us to do them.... I think it's important that when we do do gigs the situation is as good as it can be, so that there's as much chance as possible that people going into those gigs will have a different sort of experience than they would at say, The Marquee because basically I think rock music is really reactionary, a rock gig is a reactionary event, it's mainly male dominated and it's to do with getting drunk or taking drugs, it's a safety valve mechanism whereby people who are cooped up in a job all week can get pissed and get it all out of their system to loud music.

DO YOU FIND THAT MORE WOMEN ARE ATTRACTED TO YOU BECAUSE OF THE LYRICS WHICH SEEM TO BE MAINLY WOMEN'S ISSUES?

R.F: I don't think we do actually at the gigs. I think the gigs are still mainly male events which I think is awful really.

L.B: That's one of the reasons why we're not playing with Crass after the next few gigs because that's an area where we'd like to change the balance of our communication, because implicit in a lot of the criticisms we have of the system is to do with the fact that it's a male system and it goes by extreme male values, which we call patriarchal values. It's a patriarchal system, and the sexual divisions in it are absolutely crucial. Any change must come from what women do, and of course from what men do in that men's criticism of men has got to be much more developed, but we want to give more space for women to come to our gigs at the moment they don't in very large numbers, although we get a lot of support from women in peripheral ways they're not at the gigs, and that's something we want to correct. I think when we play on our own there's a lot of difference in the crude composition of the audience we attract different kinds of men and more women.

WHAT ELSE DO YOU THINK COULD BE DONE IN ORDER TO INVOLVE MORE WOMEN IN MUSIC?

R.F: Well, this is a double thing here. As a man I would say all I want to do is make sure that what I'm doing in rock music doesn't exclude women, but I also think that rock music is male, its male imagery, the electric guitar is a male phallic symbol, there's the aggressiveness on stage and that.... The important thing isn't to say 'more women should be in rock music' but that rock music should actually extend its boundaries to include women.. I think that a tradition of women's music would be completely different from the tradition of men's music in the rock field... I think as a band one of our main focuses is women's issues. We're trying to relate the domestic which is generally a female domain to what's happening in the world in general.

L.B: The standard answer when race relations was a big issue and white people were saying 'what can we do?', black people would say we can handle it ourselves, your job is to go back to the whites, that's where you should be active, you deal with white attitudes, we'll organise ourselves, in the same way we as male members of the group relate to the men, we're not to patronise women, our job is to challenge other men about their attitudes, about other men for one thing. The weakness amongst men is that they're divided for one thing, they relate to each other chiefly in a competitive form, there's a lack of closeness and of confrontation in the way our sexuality is manipulated to keep us in that position, there's a lot of work for us to do there. Meanwhile women are getting on with it in ways that nobody recognises or pays any attention to, and perhaps that's a good thing at the moment because that makes it a much purer expression, we'll hear about it soon enough.

R.F: What women do in their consciousness raising groups is to try and regain themselves, from all the shit they've been given since they were kids, and try and regain some confidence and some belief in who they really are, and I think that's something that should happen for men as well, you don't have to be Big Man, it's not necessary, you don't have to be ~~XXXX~~ uncaring, y'know, 'Big boys don't cry'.. Why not?.... Men have got to change their preconditioned roles as well, and that's really difficult. I come up against it every day, areas that I'm really aware are due to my preconditioning, which is something which has come from outside, ideas of how I should behave or what I should be doing or thinking which don't actually come from what I feel... And the more you're aware of it the more ~~XX~~ you're aware of it, the more they are everywhere.

GOING BACK TO 'HEX', THE MUSIC AND ARTWORK SEEMS TO HAVE AN AURA ABOUT IT LIKE WITCH-CRAFT. IS THIS AN ASPECT OF YOUR IMAGERY THAT YOU'VE DELIBERATELY CULTIVATED?

L.B: That mostly comes from 'Bremen Song' I think. It was deliberately developed, like the bands motif became the Crow and that. Vi wrote the song, which is sort of putting together all the various things that have happened to women through the ages, such as the oppression of women through the extermination of 900,000 'witches' in Europe, which was basically a mass destruction of female ~~XXXXXX~~ wisdom, although it's been portrayed by the likes of Dennis Wheatley as being ~~XXXXXX~~ devil worship and other unspeakable things, which is all basically propaganda. It's another part of the mechanism of the establishment

of patriarchal rule. The Roman Catholic church ~~MAKES~~ was instrumental in that extermination. And so much wisdom about natural healing and herb lore has been lost through that, and now we've got the drug industry instead which is supposed to be 'superior' but is the instrument of god knows how much oppression, which ties in with our song 'Under The Doctor' which is about all the drugs housewives use.

THE POISONS ARE NO LONGER WORKING QUITE AS CLOSELY WITH CRASS ~~KWXX~~ AS IN THE PAST, THEY WILL BE GIGGING INDEPENDANTLY AND ARE SHORTLY TO SET UP THEIR OWN RECORD LABEL. THE FIRST RELEASE WILL BE A DOUBLE LIVE ALBUM FEATURING CRASS, ANNIE ANXIETY AND THEMSELVES. 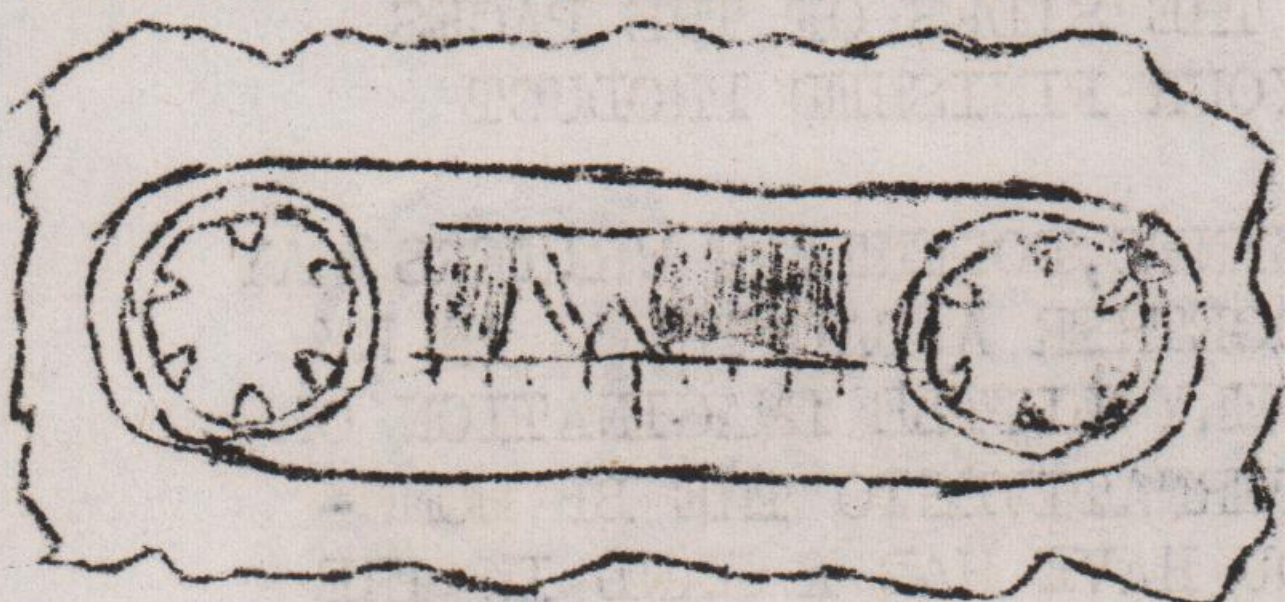
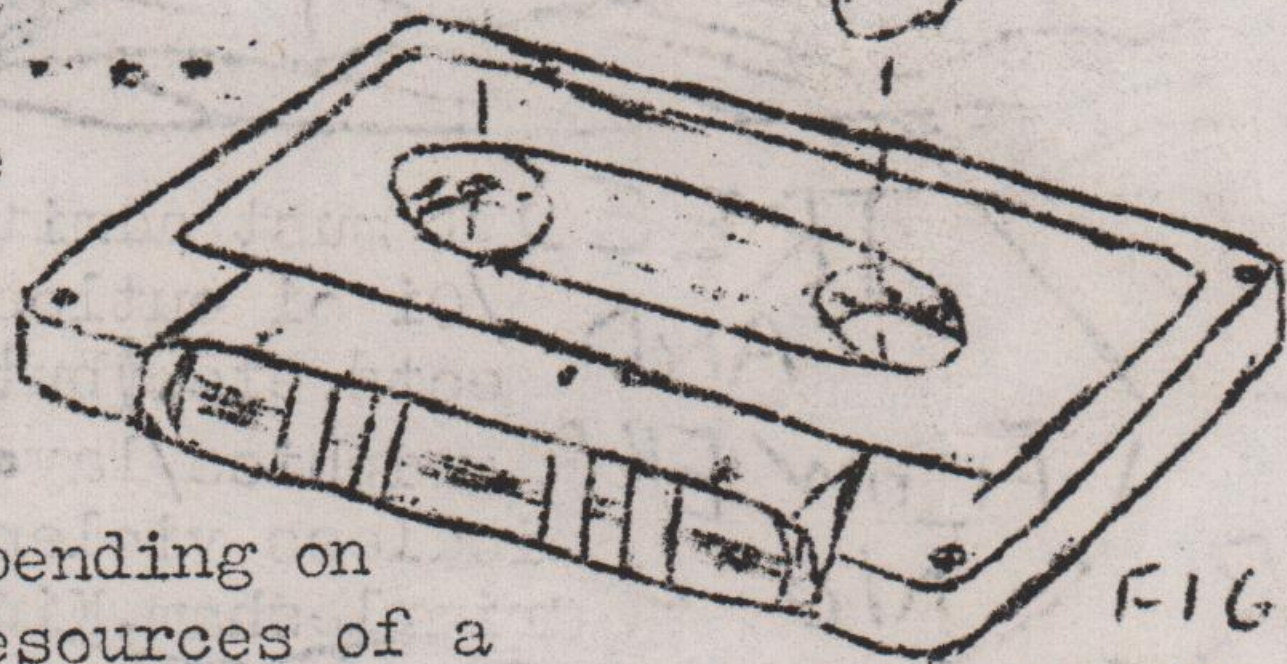

Recording and releasing your own tape is far more simple than you might think,in fact its so simple that I dont even know why I'm bothering to write this piece on it. Basically all you need is a master tape and 2 fairly high quality tape recorders.....

The master tape can vary in quality tremendously depending on how its recorded,obviously a tape made using the full resources of a proffesional studiois going to sound alot better than something recorded in your front room or kitchen,but sound quality isn't everything..The Strikey Zebras cassette was mostly recorded in my bedroom(apart from a few tracks recorded live in concert)and although sound quality isn't amazing to me it represents a far more accurate document of the spirit ofthe Zebras than some ultra-proffesional Roy Thomas Baker produced 16 track note perfect excercise in sound technology...However its wise to use your discretion when recording a tapeto release on an unsuspecting public-theres an awfull lot of grungey unlistehable crap floating about at present,and akl it succeeds in doing is getting the cassette revalutun a bad name.



Copying from the master can either be done by yourself if you've got two fairly decent tape recorders or else there are various places that will copy tapes for people including better badges,Dave Morgans of LPG(for address see page 14)fairly cheaply(esp. Dave Morgans, eg.80p per C60 inc.tape).Tapes on the New Crimes Tapes label are done by taping from master tapes from one cassette machine to another(one machine is a Bush stereo radio cassette,the other a mono ITT SL58 model)and I think that most people(cont on page 24)

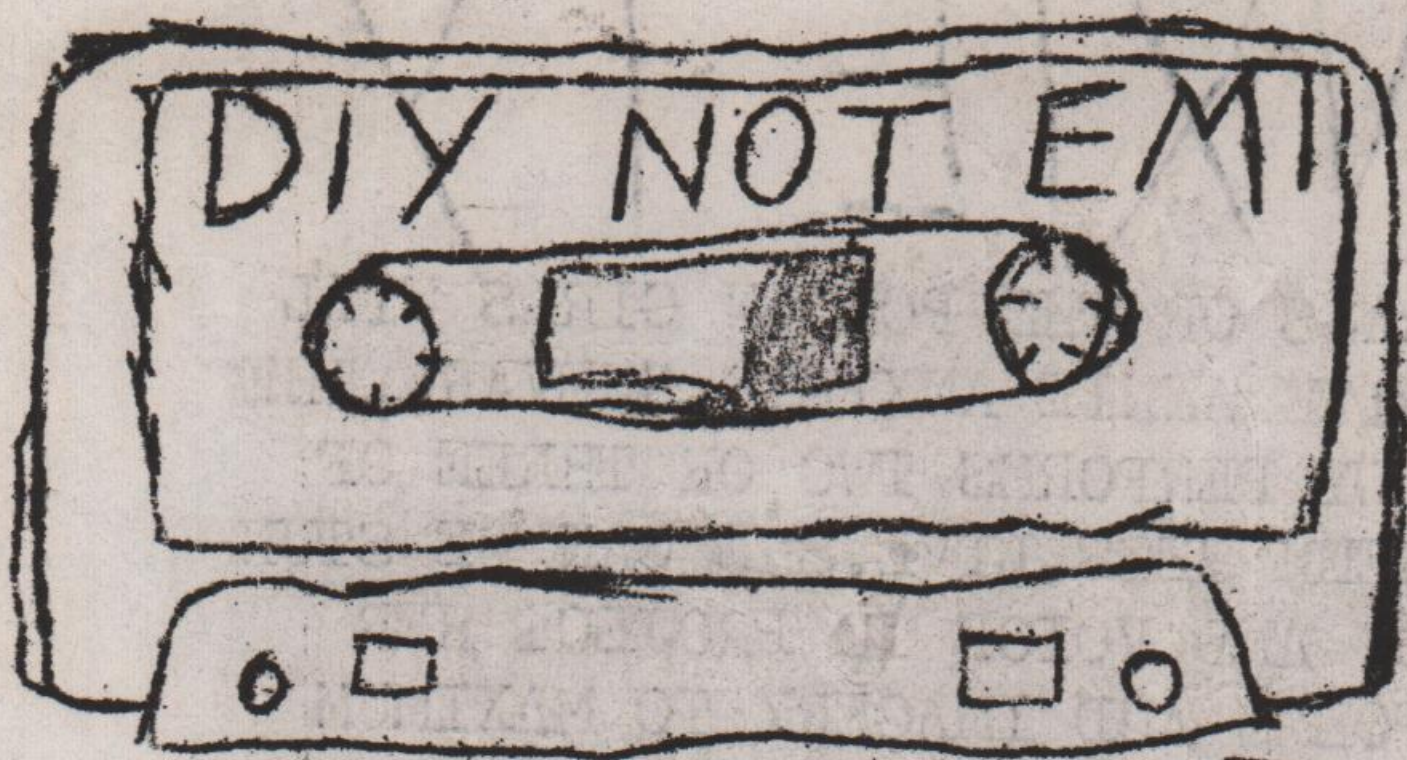

Flux of Pink Indians were a surprise addition to tonight's bill so I was quite shocked and pleased to be greeted by their 'Tapioca Sunrise' as I struggled through the door and past the bouncers.

After their short set, which included '1970's Have Been Made In Hong Kong', 'Tube Disaster', 'Left Me To Die' and others Annie Anxiety performed the startling 'Could This Be Love' over a jerky, disjointed disco beat. I didn't think she came over as well in this club environment as when I have seen her on past occasions, and the same went for Mike Duffields film, 'Total Control', which followed.

The Poison's set was basically the same as the 2 times I've seen them in the past, performing 'Promenade Immortelle', 'Persons Unknown', 'Bully Boys', 'Alienation' and loads more. As usual, they were excellent, but they too seemed to lose something in tonight's atmosphere.

Annie performed one more poem before Steve Ignorant appears, white stripe painted across his nose.... "Stand and deliver" he calls in a great madam Pant pisstake, and Crass explode into 'Punk Is Dead', a song which always makes me smile as "the velvet zippies in their bondage gear" pogo and sing along with every word! Next Eve Libertine, Joy Devivre and Andy Palmer share the vocals for 'Nagasaki Nightmare' before Eve does a few songs from Penis Envy. STEVE: Well, do you count being able to tune a guitar up as being a musician?

WHAT ARE YOUR INFLUENCES?

STEVE D: Sparks and the Residents. BRUCE: Gary Glitter; GARY: Anything really. The Fall. STEVE: Very early Kraftwerk. JON: The Fall and the Striped Zebras

HOW MANY GIGS HAVE YOU DONE SO FAR?

STEVE D: 3. JON: I thought we'd only done 2... STEVE D: Oh yes, it is 2. How was I to know. I've only just joined! Zero 6 in January and again in ~~June~~ May.

GARY: We got a brilliant reception.... They clapped!

HOW DO YOU GO ABOUT WRITING YOUR MATERIAL?

STEVE: Really you should ask us all individually. We never get together and say, 'Right, we'll write a song now', it's always either individuals or in pairs that our songs get written, and on Sundays we'll all get together and rehearse new songs.

GARY: We never have time to write when we're all together as we're too busy rehearsing material which is already written.

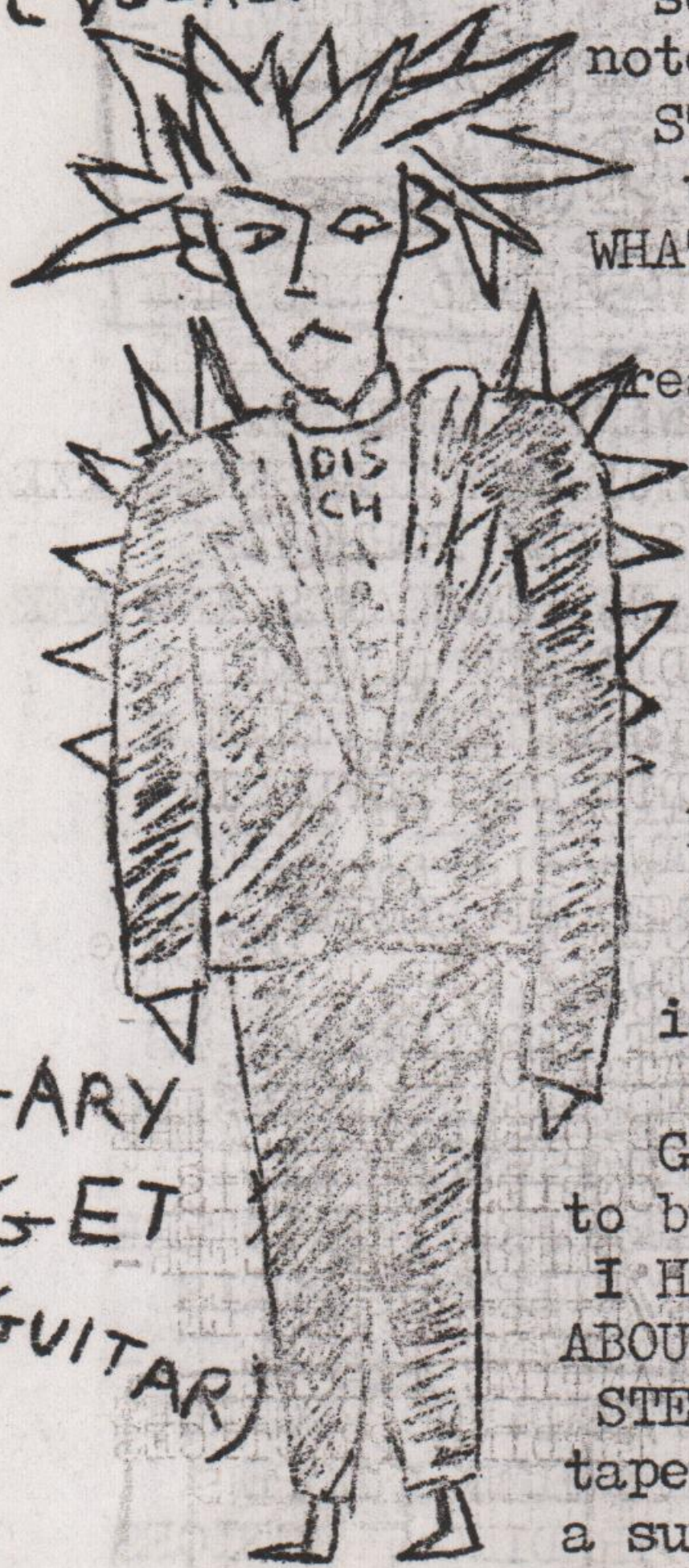

Maybe if this was the true picture it might be better if the bomb WAS dropped and our miserable existences were ended once and for all.

But I am not that much of a pessimist. I do NOT believe the old patriarchal ethic of 'fuck and kill thy neighbor' truly represents human nature, but is a perversion of human nature brought about originally by necessity, when there GENUINLY wasn't enough food and shelter to go round, when men GENUINLY had to fight for survival, and has been reinforced down through the centuries by generation upon generation of social conditioning and needless greed. Despite their faults, which are numerous, the existence of several non-hierarchical societies which have existed for thousands of years independently of the

development of the 'civilised world' based on ideals of trust, cooperation and sharing such as certain north American Indian tribes, pygmies, eskimoes etc. would seem to suggest definite evidence to discredit the myth of 'selfish mankind'... Native Cubans were unable to grasp the concept of private property when American pioneers first invaded, likewise, Sioux Indians were unable to do IQ tests as they could not conceive of the idea of not helping each other with the answers; they did not understand competitiveness... Eskimoes were unable to understand the concept of 'war' when first discovered.....

Which reality do you choose to believe in? Will you continue to support the ethics which crush the very worth of our lives, that turn our existences into lies? Or will you say no to the death dealers? Will you begin to choose ~~active~~ the alternatives? Will you choose to LIVE? The remembrance of Auschwitz, or the daily reality of the abattoir? // Slaughterhouse sights (pt. 1): 'There are at least 20 pigs bundled into a small pen, all screaming and clawing at each other, all trying to escape the terror befalling their comrades. At the opening of the enclosure a 'man' standing/flaying/grinning. One by one the young pigs are grabbed from out of the pit, then with no seen emotion he mercilessly gouges a hole in the main throat artery. Buckets of crimson blood spurt out in all directions. Almost simultaneously a chain is attached to the hind leg of the animal and it is viscerously pulled upwards overhead. The sounds, sight: pain. The animal is then dropped in a large vat of boiling water. All this happens when the defenseless animal is still alive. The body is then decapitated and cleaned of hair. Ham/bacon/pork/sausage/terror/pain/death//. Slaughterhouse sights (pt. 2): Once again the smiling butcher is standing ahead facing the incoming line of cattle, yet again one by one, while all the waiting line of calves will have to watch the horrible spectacle beforehand.

The 'man' lifts the blood stained pole axe, then brings it down with tremendous force ~~splitting~~ the skull of the beast, but too many times he can miss—causing the force to wrench ~~the~~ the eyes out of the sockets of the unfortunate animal. Then it is hoisted overhead, a deep river of death spews out over the sterile concrete floors. Almost next to the waiting calves are freshly hung carcasses, cauldrons of supposedly 'unuseable organs' being savaged by swarms of flies. Livers, hearts, kidneys hand overhead reminiscent of car assembly lines. Opposite, dismembered heads impaled on posts // THINK // WHY SHOULD ANYONE EAT MEAT? 5. Most religions condemn the eating of flesh. For example: "For meat destroy not the work of god. All things are pure; but it is evil for that man who eateth with offence"—Romans XIV:9. "Thou shalt not kill or destroy in my holy mountain"—Isiah X19. It is even one of the ten commandments: "THOU SHALT NOT KILL"... Yet still... there are 200 million cattle/400 million sheep/1000 million rabbits/2000 million poultry/1000 million birds/10 000 million fish are killed mainly for food, another 200 million animals are killed for their furs, and yet another 1 million for 'sport'. // But that was in 1956, today the figure is higher. Everytime you eat your breakfast of bacon, egg and sausage or when you pop into macdonalds for a snack you are creating that market. YOU are making the suffering and the pain last longer. Is your conscience clear? You only use words like beef sirloin, mutton, veal to cover up the fact that you're eating dead animal flesh. A form soft cannibalism. Would you still eat meat if it were you who had to smash the skulls open, if it were you who had to disembowel, strangle, wrench, cut, skin that 18 month old calf for the sake of a veal and ham pie? // You tell me because of tradition. At easter it is tradition to have Turkey, while at the same time look at the cuddly little chick on the easter egg wrapper and say 'Ah, isn't he cute'. Maybe Christ rose from the dead at easter, but I don't think those millions of slaughtered innocents will, and if they did do you think they would be so forgiving?

would agree that the quality is fairly ~~reasonable~~ reasonable.

You can sell alot of tapes by mail order by yourself, either by advertising in ~~the~~ fanzines or in the DIY column of sounds (the only reason there is any point in following the 'established music(k) press' now that the NME has stopped Garage Land in my opinion) although you can distribute if you so desire via several outlets including Rough Trade, Boggs Distribution, Smart Distributuion, LPG Distributuion etc. (for addresses see fanzine reviews). ~~Also~~ Also, local shops may be interested in taking a few copies. Some fanzines which specialise in covering independant tapes include LPG, Zero, Cassette Survival (write to Protag, Low Farm, Brigg Road, Messingham, Scunthorpe, Sth. Humberside), although most 'zines are sympathetic and will probably give you a mention if you write to them.

I think its worth making the effort to include a decent cover with a cassette. You can design your own and ~~print~~ print them by one of the methods mentioned in the 'zine section. A sheet of paper sized 21cm X 29.5cm (slightly less than the size of this page) will fold up nicely to fit inside a cassette box. the easiet way to make paper of that size is to get some the size of this paper (that is A4 size) and trim off the edge. If you want to make labels for your tape W.H. Smith sell 250 blank white adhesive labels which do nicely for ~~XXXXX~~ cassette labels. You can either rubber stamp details or write them on by hand (as with New Crimes tapes).....

Thats about it, again, if you can spare a tape send me a copy, good luck, J@h.

FLUX OF PINK INDIANS/ CONFLICT/ ?

TRIAD, BISHOPS STORTFORD 11/7/81

Crass, who were rumoured to be doing a 20 minute set, and the Subhumans failed to turn up, so a local group stood in. Their singertied very hard to sound cynical with his 'I hate you all' routine to the audience ~~XX~~, but somehow it didnt ring true.

Conflict played loud and fast, and had a good varied sound. A lot of skinheads were leaping around and bundling rather violently, and although I didn't want to take part it didn't bother me until various skinheads ~~XX~~ started to threaten people with physical violence unless they joined in. At the end of their set singer Colin made some rather irresponsible remarks which, ~~in my~~ in my opinion, only served to encourage the violent atmosphere which was developing.

After a break Flux came on opening with Tapioca sunrise, 1970's and Sick Butchers. I was thoroughly enjoying myself until some big MAN thought he'd prove his masculinity by punching me in the mouth without warning or provocation.

After about half an hour of seeing other people getting similar treatment we got so pissed off we left just ~~about~~ as about 20 British Movement bully boys went charging into the crowd.

This sort of mindless violence really ~~makes~~ makes me sick, and turned what could have been a great gig into a big disappointment. Why don't all you bully boys just fuck off. Don't you know you're not wanted?

AFTER THIS GIG I WROTE A LETTER TO COLIN OF CONFLICT CRITISISING THE SPEECH HE GAVE AT ~~THE~~ THE END OF ~~THEIR~~ THEIR SET WHICH IN MY OPINION ONLY MADE MATTERS WORSE. THIS IS THE REPLY HE SENT:

First of all I must apologise for the behaviour of most of the skins that I thought were going to behave at the Flux gig.

Judging by your letter I'm sure you will be pleased to hear that Conflict as a band are out of action.

Although I don't want to get into a bitching match I don't think you know ~~what~~ exactly what we tried to do as a group.

We live in the middle of a high skin-head population who have been trying to follow us and wreck everything we did from the word go. However, just lately we've been getting less and less following us about.

I know that speech at the end of our set was wrong but I was frustrated and came out with alot of the wrong words. I also know that you had been hit because just after that I was fighting with the skinheads, and also threw some out myself, but by taking this action within a week I'm in hospital (Greenwich) with 30 stitches in my face and am blind in one eye. Thus the reason for the band splitting.

If I regain my sight in that eye we are going to reform and carry on our gigging and recording schedule, but this time we are going to stop taking coaches togigs and are going to arrange our own security.


So as you can see I fucking despise violence but we are trapped ~~in~~ right in the middle of it.....

LOVE, COLIN, CONFLICT.

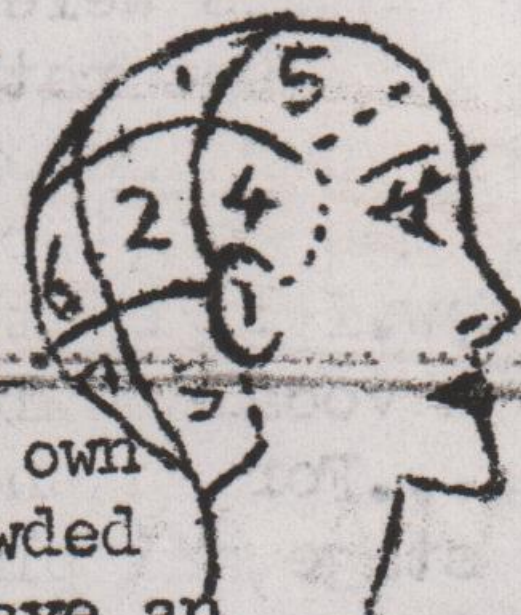

Renaldo and the Loaf have so far released one amazing tape on their own Rotcod label (reviewed on page 14), and have an LP released on The Residents' label, Ralph Records, so far only available in England as an import, though it should shortly be available in the UK on DO-IT records.....



'RATL has been together for 11 years ~~xx~~ is a duo and always has been. RATL are Renaldo M. and Ted the Loaf. Both bought first guitars together and unlearned to play them together. Always original compositions - invariably taped. Early influence ~~x~~ Tyrannosaurus Rex. Were acoustic until 1975 when Ted got an electric guitar. Did about 3 gigs in the early 70's at a local youth club. 1976: Circumstances separated us for 1 year, when we came back the music had changed. 1977: Early free improvisation, techniques, prepared guitars and noises, loops became important and much early groundwork to spawn sounds used later. Late 78: First time/songs evolved - confident of songs enough to release Struve & Sneff late 79 after abortive offer of contract on indi label in Cambridge. Struve + Sneff was not the material that was to be released; all that stuff is in the archive for what its worth. Renaldo visits West

Coast USA in Nov. '79. Calls into Ralph Records and leaves a copy of Struve/Sneff. Only record company approached. Infinitely suprised and delighted in July '80 by offer of contract with Ralph. LP 50% complete before offer. Renaldo and Ted visit ~~the~~ San Fransisco in Feb 81 to meet the mysterious Ralph people-nice people. Back to Feb 80. We meet up with other local groups who are putting together a local compilation LP. We participate.

3 tracks on 'South specific' LP on Brain Booster records: Medical Man/Bali Whine/Scottish Shuffle-First 2 remixed on Songs For Swinging Larvae LP (Ralph LP). Did one gig in April 80, 2 guitars + voice improvisation through long tape delay system. Gig reviewed in Smash Crash Crack Ring fanzine.

Well, guess thats it, except: Ralph releasing compilation LP called 'Franks Faves', we have one track included, 'Melyns Repose', not on the other LP.

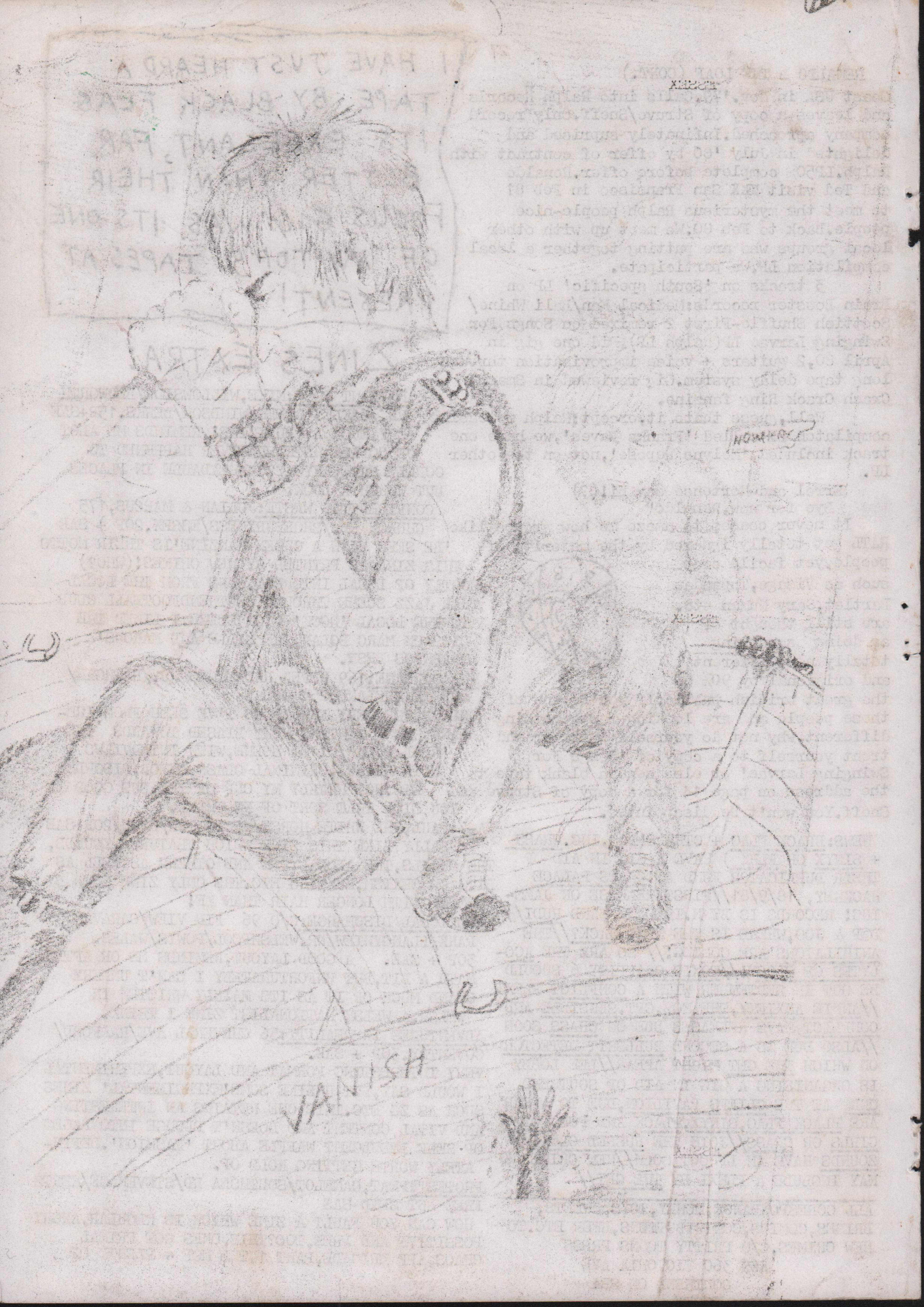
