

It's been obvious to anyone with half a brain for some time that a law that singles out young is blatantly unfair. It certainly seemed so to Euan Sutherland, then 16, when the age of from 21 to 18 rather than Te. So, with the backing of Stonewall he took his case to Europe, claiming the the British Government were practising discrimination and denying him the same rights as other UK citizens. On 7th October 1997 the European Commision upheld his case together with a similar complaint brought by

gay men and criminalizes them consent for gay men was low-18 year old Chris Morris.

The Commission ruled that having an unequal age of consent for gay men was discrimination and a breach of the 'right to respect for private life'. Commissioners agreed with the British Medical Association that sexual orientation for both es is fixed by the age of 16 that 'the risk from predatory older men would appear to be as serious whether the victim was a man or a woman'.

In a ground-breaking decision the European Commission on Human Rights ruled that the British Government unequal age of consent laws are a breach of personal rights - and it now looks like the UK Parliament will have a free vote that will almost certainly equalise the age of consent for all British citizens before the end of the year.

Thus demolishing the arguement that young gay men in particular need additional state 'protection' from sexual activities they might later regret.

The European ruling also rejected the arguement that society has the right to express its disapproval of homosexuality through legislation.

There are currently over 100 prosecutions a year in the UK for underage gay sex but Home Secretary Jack Straw a supporter of 16 at the last vote - responded to the Strasbourg decision immediately by announcing a free vote on the age of consent 'at the earliest opportunity' and the change could become law within 18 months.

A Stonewall spokesperson was confident that a free vote would ensure a comfortable majority in favour of lowering the male gay age of consent to

But despite there being 4 out MPs in the Labour Government, the party isn't totally united on the issue. Donald Anderson MP (Swansea) has stated his intention to vote for the discriminatory 18 to be retained and it's estimated that around 30 Labour MPs will oppose reducing the age of consent to 16, including Cabinet ministers like David Blunkett and Ann Taylor.

A BMA report earlier this year stated that the average age of the first homosexual encounter was 15.7 years and expressed its concern that these young men need effective health education as they are especially at risk of HIV

because of their reluctance to seek professional help and advice for what is ruled as a criminal activity.

The final word for now goes to Euan. 'I took the case because I believe in equality. Enough damage has been done to people up and the country. You didn't have to be prosecuted, the mere threat, the mere idea of ending up in prison because of a sexual relation. ship is quite damaging to young people.

The Notts Hardship Fund has recently been set up by the Potter's House Trust in liaison with statutory services and provides financial assistance to people in Nottinghamshire living with HIV/AIDS who have limited financial means.

The fund will be administreded by The Potter's House which also runs a scheme providing practical help for people living with HIV/AIDS. The fund is supported by other HIV agencies in the county.

Grants can be made towards essential expensediture or living costs and are available to people living with HIV who either live in Nottinghamshire or access services within the county.

Applications can be made through a recognised agency in the field of health care, welfare rights or social services or individuals can apply directly themselves.

The Fund aims to respond quickly to all requests for help while at the same time maintaining high standards of accountability. Naturally, all applications are handled with the strictest confidence.

At present the fund is totally dependent on voluntary donations. So approaches from groups, organisations or individuals who are interested in organising fund-raisingt events are very welcome.

The fund was boosted recently by the recent brave sacrifice of Amanda Kaye who lives in Sneinton. Amanda announced on the

main stage at Pink Lace that she would be getting a sponsored haircut to raise money for the fund. A haircut! It doesn't sound like a big deal does it? - but you have to know that Amanda hash had a haircut for around seven years - and her striking red and green dreadlocks were a wonder to behold. 





All or most of their content can be found elsewhere for free. Don't part with your hard earned cash or plastic unless you are sure the site is something very special.

I have yet to find a site that warrants a membership fee just for looking. There are plenty of other ways to finance sites be it by advertising or donations. Although there are some 'chat' sites which do make a membership charge in return for various services, private personal chat areas and e-mail services for example - The State of Insanity is a good example of this where for a low monthly 'tax' you can become a 'citizen' of the state with various priviledges and the right to vote. But you can also use the State as a visitor without paying anything. You canh even get qa 'visa' so that you try out citizens rights before making up your mind about paying the tax. There are several related 'States' - The State of Enchantment, The State of Submission, The State of Affairs etc. One tax gives you all round citizenship.

If all you require is the Internet I suggest you contact your local library or college who may be able to provide you with casual access. And there are plans to open a community based Cybercafe in Mansfield Woodhouse in the very near future - watch this column for details.




