





HOW TO MAKE A VEG-AN CAKE

Part two of a "Cook with Hedgehog"

YOU WILL NEED
► ½ pint of water/or soya milk
► 9oz (250g) Flour
► 4oz (100g) SUGAR
► 3 teaspoonsfull baking Powder
► ½ teaspoonful of SALT
► 4oz of Margerine (GRANGE IS best)
► METHOD FOR TREX

1. Cream together your 4oz of Sugar with your 4oz of Margerine/Trex (vegan) in a mixing bowl. This is hard work and requires beating the shit out of it with a fork, stop when its all mixed in nicely.

2. add your flour and start mixing that in. bung in the Salt + the Baking Powder.

3. add the water I beat it all together till it looks "goey". Its very hard work this so have a sofa handy to lie on afterwards.

4. Put it into a cake tin that has been "greased" (greasing is where, with a bit of greaseproof paper you coat the lining of the tin with a film of margerine or Trex)






