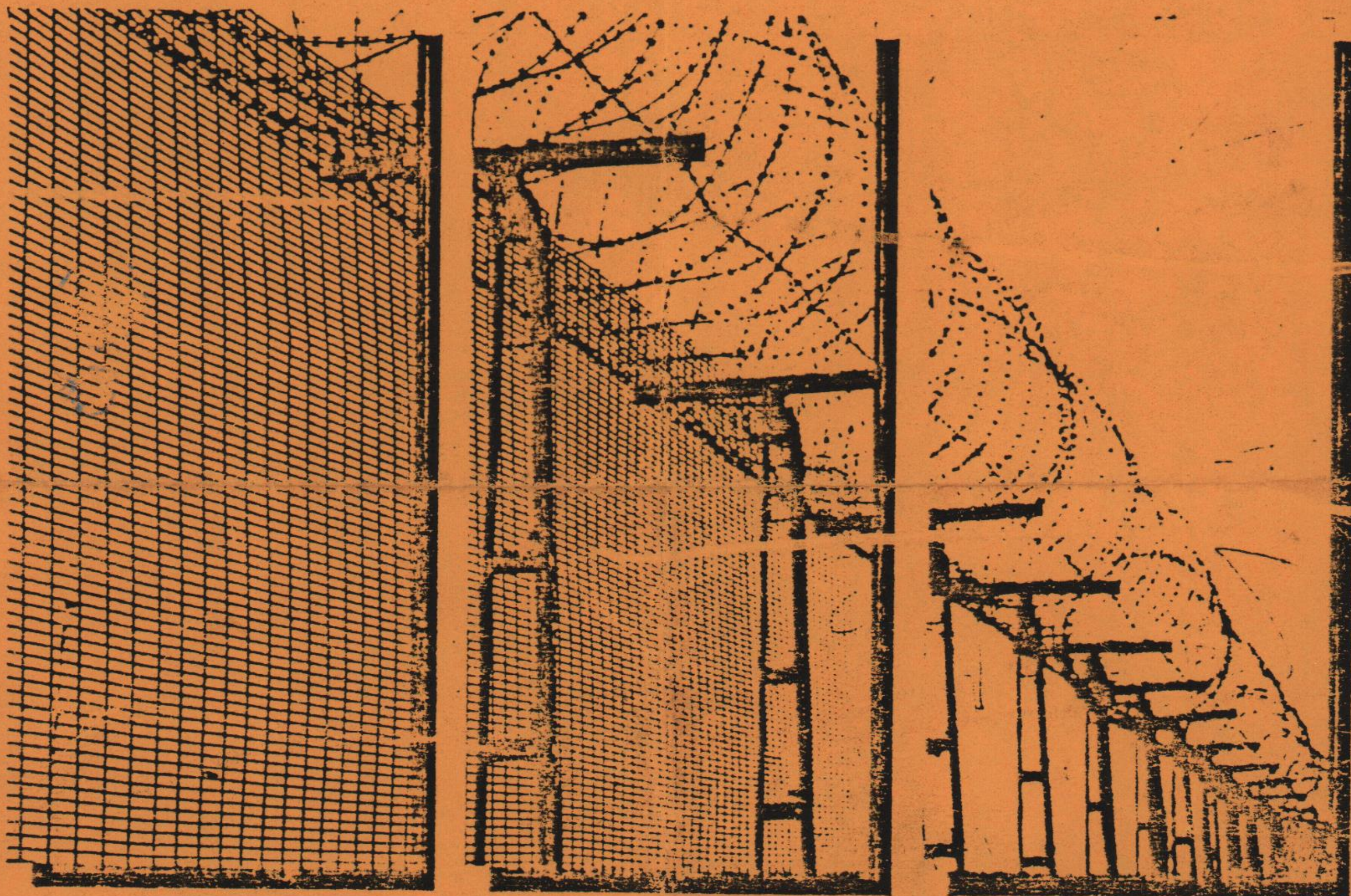

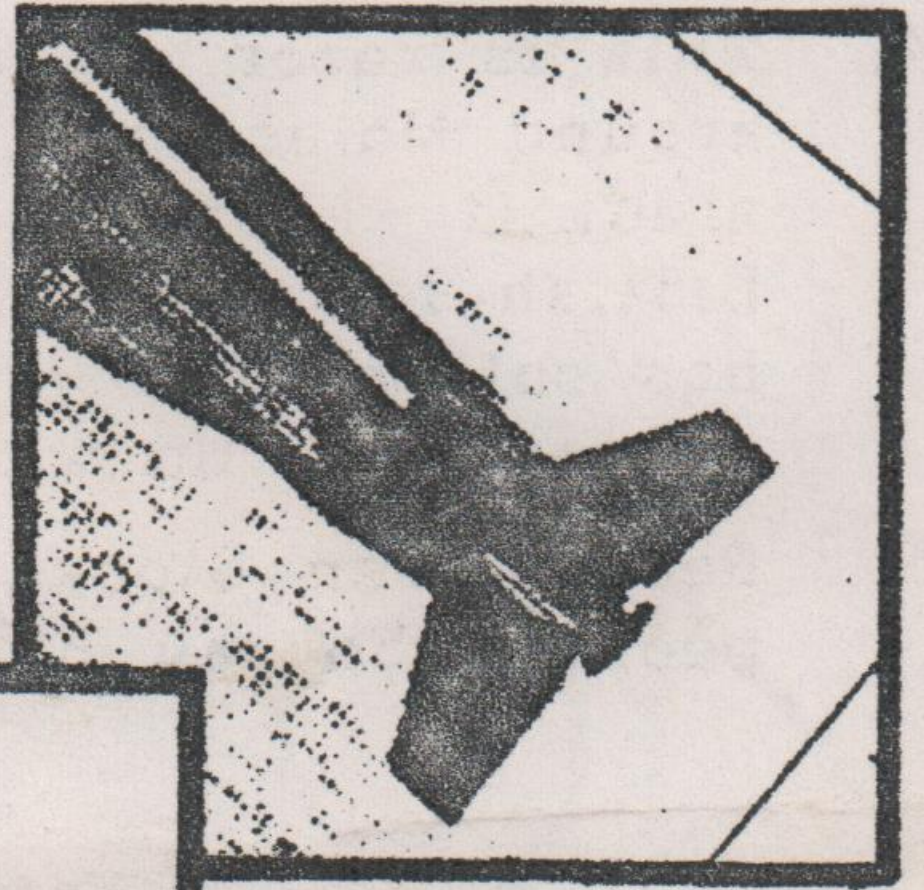

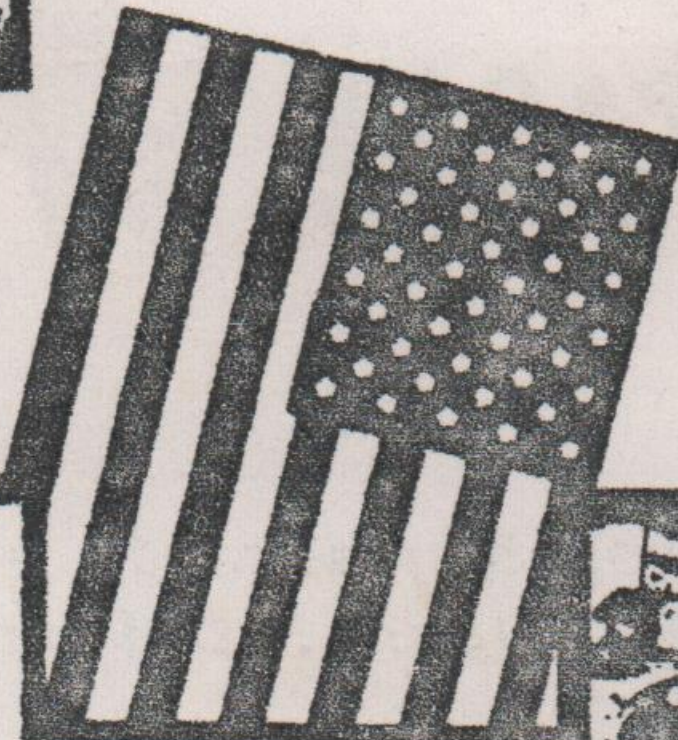

RECLAIM THE HILLS!

Trident nuclear missiles are due in Britain in the 1990s. But two out of three people in Britain don't want to buy them. Trident warheads could increase Britain's nuclear killing power by up to 14 times. They will cost £10 billion — and they *could* cost the earth.

Coulport nuclear base near Glasgow is being expanded to store these warheads. The submarines which carry them will dock at nearby Faslane.

Coulport is in unspoiled countryside near Loch Lomond. People used to walk here and picnic beside Lochan Ghlas, the peace broken only by the cry of curlews. Now the Ministry of Defence have taken the land without local consent, large parts of the hills are being torn up and it is illegal to walk here without permission.

CND is holding a national non-violent direct action to reclaim this land. We want a nuclear-free Britain. Our mass trespass will risk breaking the law. But we believe this civil disobedience is justified: we will be upholding international law, which states that the mass killing of civilians is a crime. Our demonstration will be non-violent — we will act in peace for peace.

RESIST CRUISE

Plans are underway to transform the quiet grassland of Molesworth, Cambridgeshire into a massive US cruise missile base. 64 cruise missiles are planned to be installed by 1988.

FEB 6 1985—Michael Heseltine led a military style invasion of Molesworth to evict the peace movement. This ruthless show of force, an attempt to squash democratic protest and ignore public opinion, failed dramatically. It strengthened our opposition and sparked off a campaign of continuous protest. At Easter more than 20,000 people ringed the base and outside the barbed wire the vigil continues.

FEB 6 1986—To mark this anniversary National CND has called a day of action. It will take the form of a sitdown blockade at all the gates of the base, with the aim of disrupting the construction work.

Our non-violence will show that our action reflects our aim, that we want to build a peaceful world by peaceful means. Through civil disobedience we will be upholding international law which decrees that the mass killing of civilians is a crime. We will also be upholding majority opinion—over 50% of British people oppose US cruise missiles.

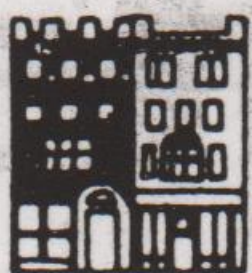

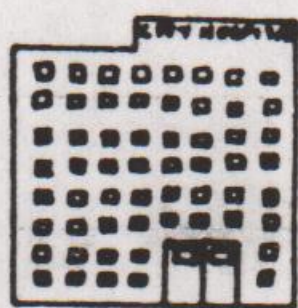

On February 6 there will be a national non-violent blockade of the Molesworth Cruise Missile Base.

Why?

The blockade is not directed against you, the people who are working on the base or delivering goods to the site.

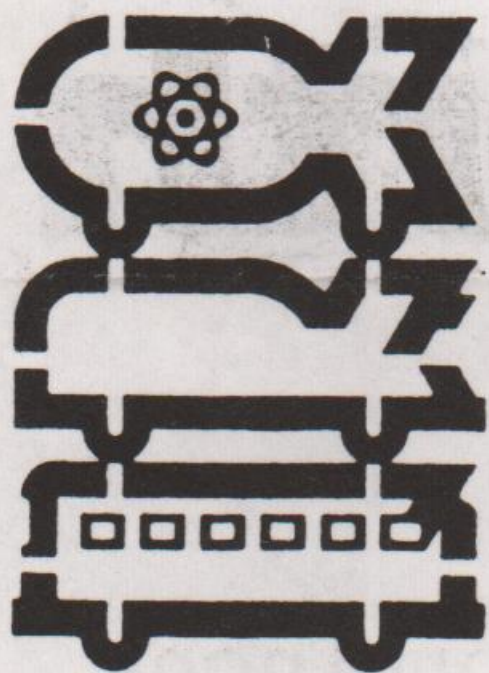
The Campaign for Nuclear Disarmament has organised the blockade against the Government's decision to deploy Cruise Missiles at the site.

We believe that Cruise Missiles increase the risk of nuclear war. They help to make Britain even more of a nuclear target.

We are supported by the majority of the British people who according to virtually every opinion poll want American controlled Cruise Missiles withdrawn from this country.

Build for Peace

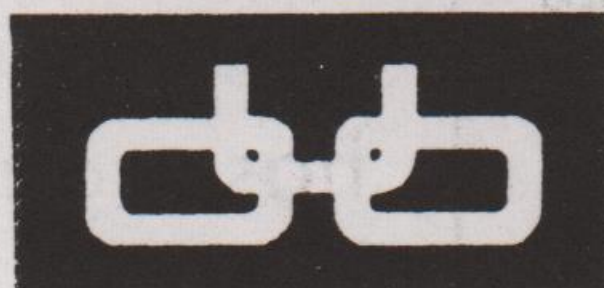
CND believes that the skills of building workers — your skills — should be used to build badly needed schools, hospitals and houses. This Government seems more determined to build concrete bunkers than to provide funds for the real social needs of the community.



Spending on housing would also create more jobs — for every £1 billion spent on 'defence' just over 20,000 jobs are created, for the same amount spent on housing over 60,000 jobs are created.

We hope to stop construction for the day on February 6th. We will be non-violently blockading the base all day. We hope that you will express your support and solidarity with us for peace and disarmament by staying away from the base on February 6th.

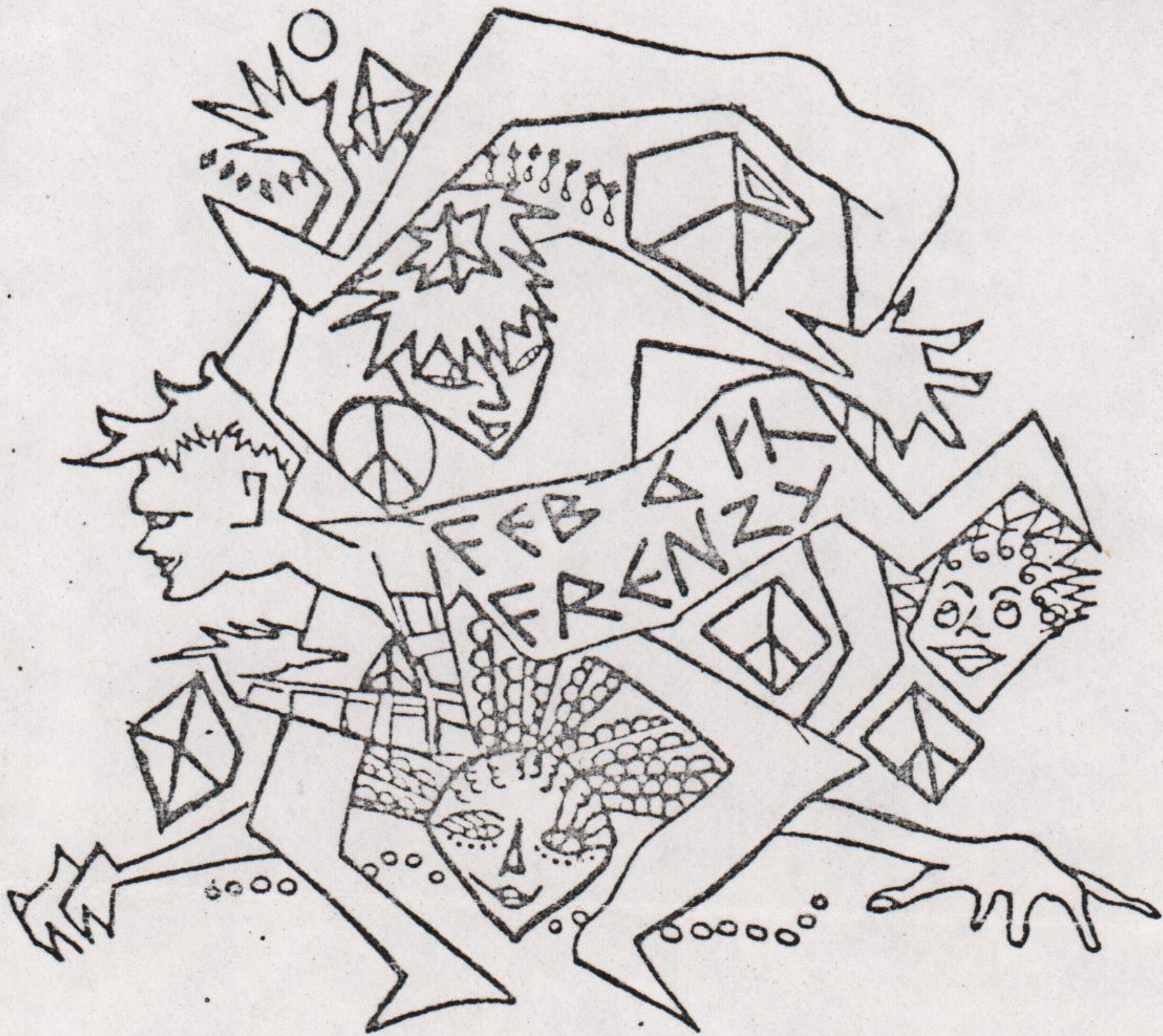

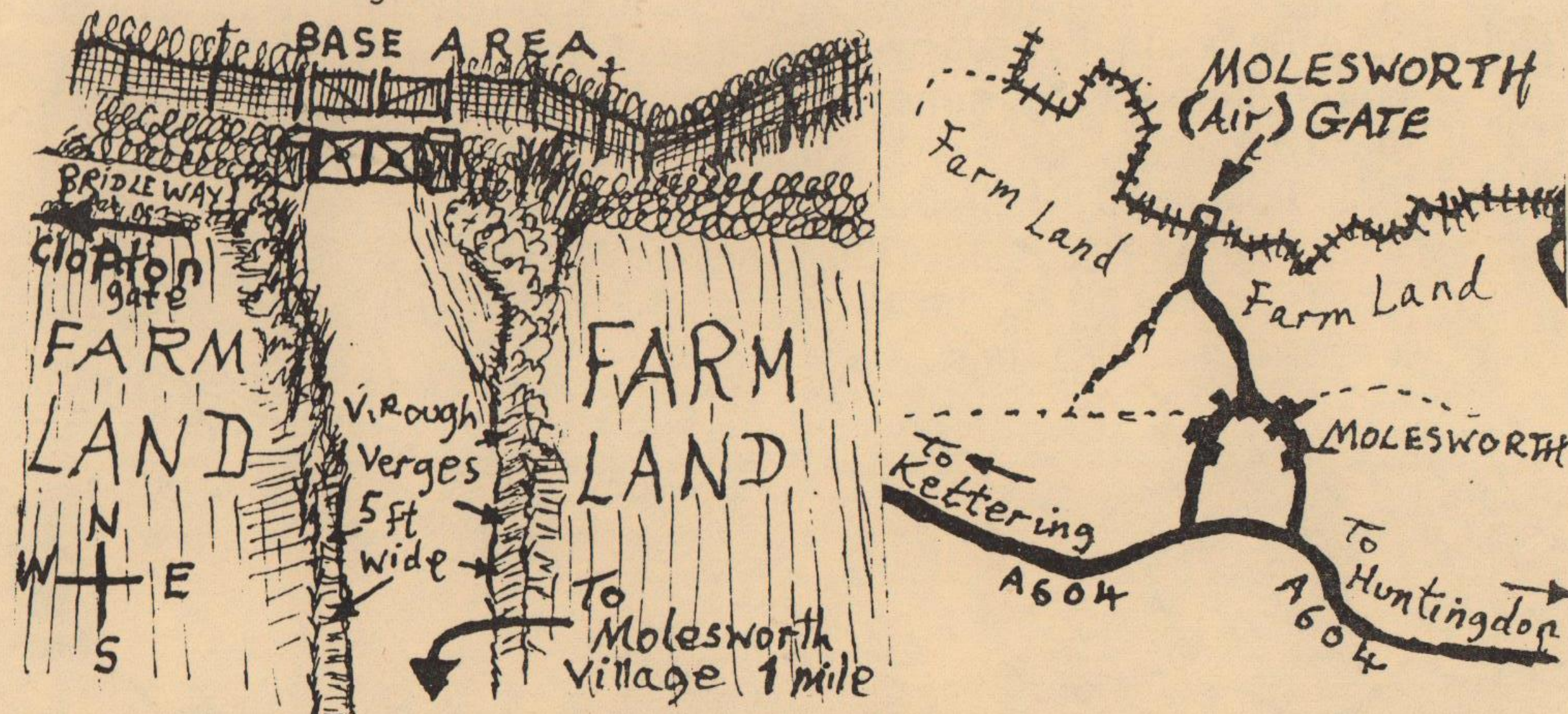
JOINING THE BLOCKADE

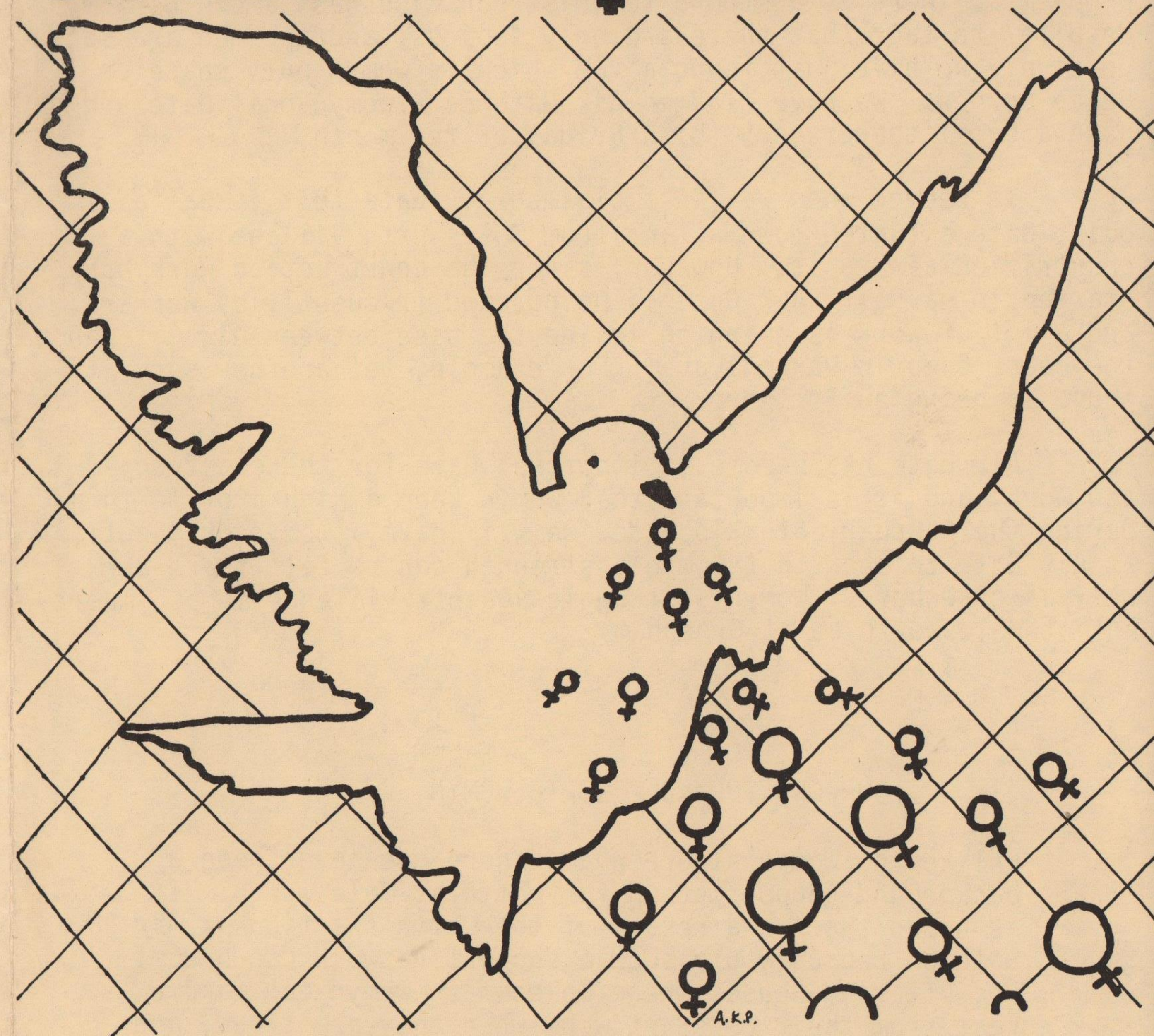

Molesworth, Womyn & Air Gate

It has often been the case with mixed Peace Camps that men out-number the womyn. We are conscious of this at Molesworth, and are positively discriminating. We have discussed the many reasons why women may find it difficult to come to a Camp where men out-number womyn. We believe that Molesworth is tackling some of the problems. There is a strong feminist consciousness among us womyn despite the fact that there are only 4 of us, and the men are supportive. We have just found a van which is womyn-only space on Peace Corner. We have claimed Air Gate as a womyn-only Gate and have a vigil there every third Friday of the month.

It seemed when we first claimed Air Gate that it was a quiet Gate situated down a lane from Molesworth Village with a countrified air to it. However, since the construction work has started in earnest, Air Gate is being used frequently by workers, and a lot of work is going on inside the base between Air Gate and the Peace Camp in Warren Lane. For example, yet another security fence is being built there.

Air Gate has become an important Gate for the construction work, and it is important that womyn keep a high profile there. During the February 6th Blockade, we will have a womyn-only action at Air Gate to show that womyn's strength can be felt there as well as elsewhere. Womyn's struggle against violence is as important at Molesworth as at Greenham.

SUPPORT THE MOLESWORTH WOMYN

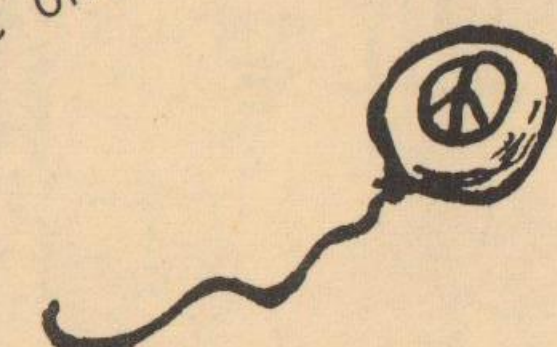

A MESSAGE FROM MOLESWORTH ON FEBRUARY 6th 1986

I want to tell you about Molesworth and why people decided to blockade the gates of a disused RAF air-field on the Cambridge|Northants border> Building work is going on at Molesworth NOW to build Britain's second Cruise Missile base there. Although about 60% of British people oppose the siting of these America missiles in our country, our government is going ahead with the work it began on February 6th 1985 when over 1,500 soldiers and police were used to evict 150 men, women and children who were camped on the site in peaceful protest.

On February 6th 1986 we have blockaded the gates of Molesworth to protest at what is being done in our name, and to halt symbolically the construction work for one day> Women at Air Gate have released balloons to carry the message far and wide - and to show people how far radioactive fall-out could travel from a nuclear explosion.
